Schmidt's Friday Night auctions a great place to be

YPSILANTI, Mich. — Spending lots of time at home can have its advantages; like being able to shop Friday night auctions held by Schmidt's Antiques, Inc. of Ypsilanti, Mich.; aptly named "Schmidt's Friday Nights".

The Friday, April 24 Schmidt online only sale had a great selection of items from a wide range of very popular collecting genres. Lamps are a huge collecting area and some lucky shopper took home a beauty. A mid 19th century bronze Astral lamp by Cornelius & Co., of Philadelphia was up for grabs and went to the bidder offering \$650. Prices do not include the 15 percent buyer's premium. Wearing a period, frosted, cut glass shade, the lamp had been converted for electricity and stood 20 ¼ inches tall.

Sporting items; especially decoys, continue to be a poplar. A 1940s era Charles Wilber (New Jersey) Brant goose decoy stamped "century" and having a carved wooden body with glass eyes, still wore its original painted surface. Measuring 19 inches long, this decoy garnered 22 bids before being won by the person offering \$420.

Pocket watches are getting a lot of attention as of late and this Schmidt event had several from which to choose. A favorite was the Illinois "Sangamo Special" railroad watch serial #3693128 having Arabic numerals that realized \$360. The 16 size watch's dial had some fine hairlines, but it was in working order.

Architectural anything is very popular be it wrought iron railing or wooden corbels. An early Italian carved and

Most Baby Boomers still remember chalkware, but if you were born after 1970, unless you are a serious chalkware collector, you probably have never heard of this popular American term. Chalkware refers to figurines made, most often, from molded plaster of Paris or carved gypsum. Most are then painted using oil paints or watercolors

In America, chalkware has been considered an important art form during three separate periods: from the late 18th centu-Below: Popeye the Sailor Man ry to the beginning of the 20th century, during the Great Depression, and during the 'mid-cencarnival chalkware figurine, circa tury modern' era as decorative lamps, figurines and wall decor from the 1940s-'60s.

1940, that is a cross-collectible piece and valued at \$80.



In the 1800s, chalkware was considered a serious decorative art form. During this time chalkware was used to create less expensive English Staffordshire pottery pieces, making chalkware a "poor man's" ceramic. Chalkware figurines, such as Staffordshire dog figurines, were especially popular during the late Victorian-era. These early chalkware pieces were hollow molded, so it is difficult to find unblemished pieces.

Depression era chalkware tend to be carnival chalkware pieces, which were jocular in appearance, representing kitschy images of exotic travel, cartoonish characters, and potty humor. Chalkware pig banks were especially popular as carnival giveaway pieces. These pieces were given away at carnivals throughout the United States as boardwalk game prizes during the 1930s - 1950s. Carnival Chalkware game prizes were replaced by stuffed animals around 1960, changing the face of the carnival midways forever.

Mid-Century Modern (MCM) chalkware flourished during the post-war time (1945-1965) as an inexpensive and expressive medium for the home, serving many types of taste and types of decorative need with table lamps, figurines, wall decor and tourist memorabilia. MCM chalkware pieces are still readily available in antique stores, estate sales, and auction houses. MCM chalkware was used as decorative pieces in homes for nearly 25 years, making this art form one of the seriously collectible art forms of the mid-20th cen-

MCM chalkware lamps, especially TV lamps, often romanticized exotic places, such as Asia, Africa, Native American, or Hawaii, with a focus on the idealized beauty of historic, natural, and abstract designs. Dancers (often sold as a male and female pair) were common MCM chalkware motifs.

painted window or door crest sold within estimate at \$260. Having a carved shell design on a molded plinth the 34 inch by 6 inch by 17 inch piece still retained its original painted decoration.

Vintage interior design elements continue to show up in present day homes thanks to some great pieces offered at auction for a fraction of what new would cost. For example a pair of 19th century Italian wall shelves with shaped tops and cut-out aprons went to \$300. Wearing a polychrome painted finish and having wrought iron hangers, the shelves measured 13 inches wide by 6 ½ inches high.

Collecting crockery will never go out of style, especially when pieces like the 19th century American stoneware cake crock decorated with cobalt blue foilage come up for bids. This example offered by Schmidt's was 12 inches in diameter and 6 ½ inches high, and sold for \$240.

At 7 ½ inches high, this bank brought \$100.

Mid-century chalkware pieces for the home also included household tools, such as string holders, disposable advertising pieces, small plaques, and popular kitchen decorations for the walls.

MCM chalkware remains the most expensive of all collectible chalkware, costing thousands of dollars for some rare or exotic pieces.

Not surprisingly, chalkware pieces were easy to reproduce, so some of the most successful pieces were shamefully reproduced over and over again. In 1953, Benjamin and Rena Stein, of Reglor, Calif., sued to stop reproduction of their copyrighted chalkware lamps and statuettes. The case went all the way to the US Supreme Court, who sided with the Steins, but nothing stopped the flood of reproduced chalkware pieces.

Still, for most collectors, carnival chalkware is the chalkware that screams nostalgia. Carnivals were America's summer-time playgrounds before Disney and other

amusement parks opened. The smell of cotton candy, screams of Ferris wheel riders, and the lights and barkers of the midway made carnivals thrilling entertainment for all ages, and everywhere, at every carnival there was chalkware.

Shooting galleries, games of chance, dart throwing, balloon breaking, or ring tossing, the midway attracted all ages. Carnivals had a single goal: entice everyone to spend a dime on a game of "skill."

Barkers shouted out challenges—"Step right up and win a prize!" More often than not, the prizes were chalkware figures.

Carnival chalkware pieces included tourist memorabilia, ashtrays, pig banks, bobble-heads, and cartoon figurines. Mickey Mouse, Popeye, and Porky Pig are just three of the many cartoon characters that were produced in chalkware and given away as game prizes at carnivals in the 1930s - '50s. Kewpie Dolls were still quite popular during this time, and hundreds of thousands of chalk Kewpie Dolls were given carnivals away at during this 25-year period. Some collectors only collect chalkware Kewpie Dolls, but the number of different designs is limited.

Although most collectors only seek chalkware pieces that interest them, some actually collect certain chalkware manufacturers, such as Alexander Baker Company (ABCO) of New York, Reglor of California, Jo Wallis Lamp Company, and Universal Statuary Corporation of Chicago.

Because chalkware chipped easily and its fragile colors exposed on the surface of the pieces rather than being fired with a glaze (their beeswax or varnish coatings gave them little protection), very few carnival chalkware pieces have survived without serious dings and scratches. Many carnival pieces were taken home only to become targets for slingshots and BB guns. Young girls, in the 1950s, used broken carnival chalkware pieces to draw sidewalk hopscotch games.

Even pieces that survived unscathed often look shabby and worn since they are fragile, and chalkware pieces, essentially cannot be cleaned, so a collection of carnival chalkware figurines remains somewhat dirty looking.
