Model Ts had bidders revving their engines at Bonnigson

CLYDE, Ohio — The Model T touring car was produced from 1908 to 1927, first being assembled by hand. In 1908, the price on the touring sedan version carried a huge price tag of \$850. That doesn't seem like much, but figuring in today's inflation, the cost is comparable to \$21,340. It had a two-cylinder engine and topped out at high speed of 45 miles per hour. It bragged of anywhere from 13 to 21

The price on this "Tin Lizzie" or "jitney" dropped to around \$300 in 1925. This "common man's" car was able to get the price down once the assembly line was put into use so that the middle class Americans could afford to buy it. The touring car version of the Model T accounted for close to 40 percent of all cars sold in the United States at the time. The Model T enjoyed the longest production run for Ford until the Volkswagen managed to surpass it.



Bonnigson & Associates had the good fortune to offer three Ford Model T automobiles at auction. The 1923 version of this four-door sedan was sporting a later restoration. This model had a two-speed rear end Above: This 1923 Ford Motel T kept the bidders coming and a Ricardo high compression back for more with the hopes of owning this piece of hishead. It also had been equipped with tory. It reached \$7,650. an anti-theft steering wheel and a

speedometer from a bicycle. It sold for \$7,650.

The second one offered was a 1927, which was the last year these beauties were produced. It was converted to a two-door pickup truck with an adjustable steering wheel. It could be adjusted to fit the driver or moved out of the way to make getting in and out easier. This one had 73 bids and sold for \$4,925.

The third one was advertised as a "jalopy" and sold for \$3,125. The "jalopy" term simply means it is an old, dilapidated motor vehicle that won't run or be road worthy

Collecting Vietnam-era posters for and against the war

Military recruitment posters are as old as America herself. On June 14, 1775, Congress voted to create the Continental Army to fight the British for our freedom. Immediately following, recruitment posters, known then as handbills or broadsides, were used to promote interest for enlistment in General Washington's Army. America was fledging, and it needed its youth to step up and fight, and recruitment posters provided the much-needed patriotic fervor needed. By the War of 1812, print shops were turning out elaborate recruitment posters, enticing American boys to finish the battle the Revolutionary War had began.

Military recruitment refers to the business of attracting young men and women to enlist in different branches of the military for training, employment, and deployment. Military recruitment offices use a wide range of media to attract recruits, including television, radio, cinema, online social media, the press, billboards, brochures, and, of course, recruitment posters.

Today collectors have a special interest in posters from the Vietnam War.

For more than 100 years, the most famous and collected recruitment poster has been the poster created by James Montgomery Flagg in 1917 for World War I. This poster showed Uncle Sam pointing at the viewer with the caption "I Want YOU FOR US ARMY." More than four million copies of the poster were printed JOIN NOW

during World War I, and this poster was revived for every American war of the 20th century, including the Vietnam War. Authentic Flagg posters, printed and used for recruitment during Vietnam, are highly sought after by Vietnam recruitment poster collectors.


There is another side to collecting Vietnam related posters and that is the collection of protest posters.

Although wars have always had protesters, the Vietnam War ignited a nation. American youth burnt draft cards, defied being drafted, ran to Canada, or hid in America's growing underground movement.

The counter-recruitment culture or anti-war activists, for the most part, opposed US military action in Vietnam as immoral, claiming the government intervened in Vietnam for political, economical, and imperialistic reasons. As our entire country exploded in counter-cultural activity, the Vietnam War offered a visual cause to focus anti-government activities against. War protestors tried to raise political consciousness through anti-war posters, most of which are still highly collectible nearly 50 years after the war ended.

While Vietnam recruitment posters sought to instill patriotism and heroism in youth, anti-war

posters sought to mobilize chaos. One Vietnam era anti-war poster was a parody of Flagg's "I Want YOU" poster, showing a skeleton Uncle Sam pointing a skeleton finger, suggesting that war is death, not heroic patriotism.

As with all collectibles, condition of a recruitment poster, along with rarity, determines price. Buyers should definitely "beware" when venturing into this fun collectible market since computer-generated copies can easily be made look authentic. to Restoration is acceptable on recruitment or antiwar posters, and reputable dealers will always inform a potential buyer that a poster has been restored.

Today, recruitment and protest posters from the Vietnam War remind us of the psychological, political, and patriotic differences that split our nation during the 1960s and '70s. These posters give an accurate, microscopic view of the Vietnam conflict that waged inside our borders, our schools, and our hearts.

If you desire to own some of these historical posters, expect to pay another high price. Many authentic Vietnam-era recruitment or protest posters sell on secondary markets, for \$250 or more. But what an interesting, thought provoking, and conversation starting collection they make when displayed side-by-side on a wall.

Green Book display part of permanent exhibits at Gilmore

HICKORY CORNERS, Mich. — In the spring of 1946, Jack Roosevelt Robinson, former multisport standout at UCLA and a U.S. Army veteran, and his bride of two weeks, Rachel, were flying from Los Angeles to Florida for baseball's spring training season. Yet twice along the route they were bumped from flights so their seats could be occupied by passengers with white skin. During a stopover in New Orleans, they were not allowed to eat in the "whites only" airport restaurant.

The Robinsons, Jackie — soon to wear the Brooklyn Dodgers' No. 42 on his back — and Rachel, were not alone. African-Americans faced discrimination in many aspects of life, including lodging, dining, when trying to find a drinking fountain or a restroom or even when trying to buy gasoline for their cars.

To ease their way, Victor Hugo Green published TheNegroTravelers' Green Book with a listing of places - some commercial, some private homes where Black people could stay and eat, where they could buy gas and even which towns to avoid for their own safety. Green, African-American mail carrier, was outlived by his annual book. He started it in the mid-1930s and his company kept it going until passage of civil rights legislation in the 1960s.

No doubt many people first learned of the Green Book in August, 2015 when The New York Times did a feature story about the book, or seeing the film, *Green Book*. However, visitors to the Gilmore Car Museum have been exposed to the book and its role on Black travel since late in 2014 when the museum opened its Green Book exhibit.

David Lyon, automotive historian and author, recently pointed out that Gilmore's display is likely, "the only Green Book exhibit at an automobile museum in this country, and perhaps the world."

The exhibit includes the life-like museum figures of a mother and daughter and a two-tone 1948 Buick sedan parked at an Esso filing station. Information panels provide details, a large video plays interviews with African-Americans who experienced discrimination while traveling and a copy of the Spring 1956 edition of a Green Book is there for museum visitors to examine.

"It's a story that had been pretty much forgotten," said museum curator Jay Follis. "We've had a tremendous number of people seeing it and saying, 'I've never heard of this'."

Victor Hugo Green was a native of Hackensack, N.J., and a mail carrier in New York City. His wife was from Virginia and as they traveled to visit family, they encountered Jim Crow restrictions. A Jewish friend showed Green a guidebook used to avoid "gentile-only" establishments and

Green started his Green Book. He enlisted mail carriers across the country to help him compile and update the listings.

There's a reason the gas station in the Gilmore museum diorama has an Esso pump. Esso was a brand of John D. Rockefeller's Standard Oil Company.

Follis explained that Esso had a program to help African-Americans buy and operate its service stations. Esso also provided offices and support for the staff that helped Green produce and publish his guides.

Rockefeller was married to Laura "Cettie" Spelman, a daughter of The abolitionists. Spelman home had been part of the Underground Railroad. Atlanta Baptist Female Seminary, founded late in the 19th century to educate young black women, would become Spelman Seminary and later Spelman College in honor of Cettie's family's work and contributions.

The Green Book diorama is one of two that are a permanent part of the Gilmore museum's display. The other — The American Exodus focuses on the hardships of the Depression-era migration from the Midwestern "Dust Bowl" to the promised-land on the West Coast. Both have had profound impacts on guests and are regularly used by the Museum's education team.

The Gilmore Car Museum—North America's Largest Auto Museum—is located mid-


way between Chicago and Detroit. In addition to nearly 400 vehicles, many of them housed in historic buildings and re-created automobile dealerships, its 90-acre campus includes a vin-

tage gasoline station and authentic 1941 Blue Moon Diner that serves lunch daily.
