1979 Sea Ray floats along with \$4,225 bid at Albrecht

VASSAR, Mich. — The spring lockdown spurred a permanent evolution for much of the economy. You see it with restaurants offering online ordering and grocers offering curbside pickup. Auctioneers also had to find ways to keep the doors open. Those that migrated to - or already had - an online presence were able to weather the situation, while those that didn't sat idle.

Online auctions are now an integral part of the landscape. Albrecht Auctions provides a good example. While they maintain two facilities in Vassar, it was online auctioning that kept the doors open while Michigan was shut down. Even after the state reopened, Albrecht's continued to capitalize on its online platform, bidnow.us. On Aug. 3, they hosted an impressive consignment auction featuring more than 4,900 lots spread across 30 categories. There was something for nearly everyone, from vehicles and machinery that sold in the thousands to collectibles selling for under \$10.

A dozen vehicles – everything from tractors to snowmobiles - often took the auction's top bids. A Massey-Ferguson 4WD tractor with loader earned first place at \$6,000 while a 2002 John Deere Gator with electric hoist (\$4,650) and a 1979 square body Chevy step-side pickup with 63,931 miles (\$4,600) grabbed second and third spots respectively.

Transportation items got even more interesting when a 1979 29-foot fiberglass Sea Ray cuddy cabin came up. Selling for \$4,225, it was outfitted with two 8-cylinder inboards, electronics, swim platform, and a tri-axle trailer. Marine antiques enthusiasts also had a Detroit Engine Works marine engine, likely dating from the first decade of the 20th-century; it eventually sold for \$395. Water lovers had other picks like four different vintage outboards selling from \$23 for a non-working Evinrude to a working 6HP Evinrude for \$165. A framed 1960s advertising poster

Marriage lamps symbolized wedded bliss

Who knew a lamp could signify wedded bliss? Such was the case though when Ripley & Co. created a line they referred to as "wedding lamps."

Daniel Ripley, Sr. was a prominent glassmaker in Pittsburgh. Ripley and George Duncan founded Ripley & Company glassworks in 1865 or '66, hoping to find their niche in a burgeoning American glass market. Ripley's factory was located adjacent to the Monongahela River, which provided easy river transportation for Ripley's glassware. Initially, Ripley, his son Daniel, Jr., and Duncan specialized in flint, cut, and engraved glass, offering the public a wide variety of functional glassware items.

Around 1870, Daniel Ripley, Sr. died, and Duncan purchased the remaining outstanding stock in the company, renaming the company George Duncan & Sons. But glassmaking was in the Ripley blood, so in 1874, Daniel Ripley, Jr. founded a second Ripley & Company, making pressed glassware, bar glass, and lamps. In 1891, Ripley & Co. merged with 17 other glass companies to form the United States Glass Company, which was a group of 18 separate







for Bob-Lo cruises which plied the Detroit River sold for \$68.50, probably to a Michigander with fond memories of the tour boat.

Petroliana and automobilia collectors had access to hundreds of items. Bidding went to \$310 for two 6-foot gas station signpost bases in restorable condition. Car and motorcycle restorers had an array of items like a 1930s four-piece hinged hood assembly (\$108), a late 1920s gas tank cowl (\$114), and a pair of 1940s Harley Davidson saddlebags (\$52). Even the most modest of wallets could afford one of three different sets of dealer sales catalogs, like a 19-piece set of good-condition 1940s-1950s Dodge brochures (\$28.88) or, the lot of five original Mobilgas service station uniform patches that sold for just \$14.50.

A small amount of railroad memorabilia included a good-condition 4-foot antique cat's-eye marble railroad crossing sign, with all the eyes intact, selling for \$534 and a 27-inch antique railroad "Track 1" sign, also with cat eyes, that sold for \$181. There were enticing aircraft items as well. A wood Sensenich airplane propeller, purportedly a remnant from a crash landing, went to \$110.99 after 53 bids. A 9-inch chrome jet-age fighter plane cigarette lighter went to \$100 with 54 bids.

For firearms buyers, there were five dozen lots of guns, ammunition, and accessories. A Dixie Gun Works .44 caliber black powder revolver got 65 bids, sending the price to \$259.78 while an Italian-made F.lli Pietta .44 caliber black powder revolver attracted 73 bids and sold for \$237.87. One of three long guns was a 1943-era Remington A3 30-06 A3 with sling; after 120 bids,

the hammer went down at \$800.

Fishing enthusiasts also had plenty to pursue. Two fish mounts - a 29-inch brown trout and a 31-inch steelhead trout sold for \$38.88 and \$36 respectively. Seventeen lots with various combinations of rods and reels sold from \$7 for a trio of vintage rods/reels to \$117 for a new St. Croix graphite rod with Shimano Spirex reel. Over two-dozen lures and pieces of tackle went from \$3 for several individual lures to \$62.76 for a fully stocked tackle box.

There were also hundreds of traditional antiques and collectibles. One of the more unusual pieces was an antique Peter Wright anvil attached to its original wood stand, paired with two sets of tongs. It sold for an impressive \$680. A non-working, but restorable 1930s Zenith console radio reached \$160.

glass companies, working together to standardize quality, workmanship, and, in some cases, prices of glassware in America. Ripley was elected as United States Glass Company's first president.

Ripley & Co. became famous for its fine glassware during Ripley's lifetime, including its innovative line of patented oil lamps. In 1868, Ripley received a patent for a hand lamp with two handles. The two handles made it possible for one person to safely hand the lamp to another person without setting the lamp on a table.

Ripley & Co. also produced the Ripley Hollow Stem Lamp, circa 1882. Each of these lamps possessed a hollow stem, which held, by means of a piece of cork, an artificial flower and twig.

Today, Ripley & Co.'s most sought after, collectible lamps Ripley's double-font "marriage lamps," which are sometimes called "wedding lamps." The double-font on Ripley's marriage lamps symbolized the man woman, and the one base symbolized the union of the man and woman into one body, which represented wedded bliss!

All marriage lamps were made of pressed glass, and the only colors I have ever seen were clear, milk glass, or blue (both light and cobalt). The bases on the lamps often followed a popular motif, such as baroque or lyre bases. Each lamp had a covered match holder on the top of the center support or stem (lamps that have lost the cover to their match holder are worth less than ones with the cover), and some lamps had acornformed fonts. And while many of the chimneys were plain in appearance, some of Ripley's chimneys sported petal tops. Nearly all marriage lamps stood 12 to 13 inches tall.

What truly sets Ripley's marriage lamps apart from standard, one-font, lamps is the price. Ripley's marriage lamps routinely sell for \$1,600 and up. Some of these lamps bring \$5,000 or more.

While all of Ripley's lamps are called oil lamps, they were manufactured during the kerosene era, so they probably began life as kerosene lamps. By the late 1800s, as oil became the dominate fuel source, nearly all of these lamps were converted to oil lamps.

ncola items soaked up bids at Alexander Auctions

MARTIN, Tenn. — For almost four months, the auction field has been nearly stalled because of COVID-19 quarantining. Yet, firms like Tennessee's Alexander Auctions & Real Estate Sales, which turned their efforts to online auctioning, were able to weather the situation better than most.

Alexander Auction's June 23 sale is a good illustration. The Tennessee auctioneer. with over five decades of experience, utilized an online-only sale for a dazzling auction of nearly 500 7Up collectibles that originated from a Tennessee estate. Conducted via the MarkNet Alliance platform, the sale featured more than 100 metal, tin, and lighted signs, along with numerous mirror signs, menu signs, and clocks. There were scores of magazine advertisements, posters, and lithographs that spanned the 20th century, as well as drink and dispenser machines, coolers, 300+ bottles, bottle caps, and contemporary collectibles.

Sign lovers had a field day, and the array was impressive. Right out of the gate, vintage signs grabbed three-figure prices. Lot 3, a 40-inch, 1960s St. Louis made "Fresh up with 7Up" bubble-style oval tin sign sold for \$350 despite showing some fading, wear, and possible repainting. Next up, grabbing \$150 was a 46-inch rectangular sign for the Diet version of 7Up known as "LIKE." The sign, originally manufactured by the 90 Stout Sign Company of St. Louis, showed some slight bends and wear. Other signs like a 1951-era, Pennsylvaniamade "Fresh Up" sign went for as much as \$850.

Later in the auction came advertising pieces for "Howdy", a drink that originated in the 1920s and eventually became 7Up. Lot 24 contained seven items, including a 9-inch "The Way to Howdy" tin sign, a hanging paper sign "Don't Say Orange Say Howdy," a hanging paper "Howdy Party" sign, a framed posted under plexiglass for "Creighton Bottling Works," a framed Howdy cartoon advertisement, a framed "Howdy Pioneer

Soda Works" label, and 9-inch "Drink Howdy" tin sign. A winning bid of \$625 grabbed it all.

> A small number of lighted signs were available including working neon 7Up logo in red and green that sold for \$145. Another partialworking neon

Clocks were popular. This 20-inch circular working clock sold for \$2,000.

sign sold for \$125. Winning bids on various lighted plastic signs ranged from under \$50 to over \$300.

There were numerous advertising items including an eye-catching 7Up display featuring a postwar Duraglass bottle resting on a chunk of clear glass resembling an ice block. It sold for \$115. Interested buyers had five 7Up branded door pushes to bid on, including a 30-inch silver rack with "7Up on each side of a center sign which read, "Fresh Up With 7-Up;" it fetched \$310.

Clocks were also popu-

lar as seen with lot 31, selling for the auction's highest bid of \$2,000. The good-condition, working lighted 20-inch plastic clock featured a black band around its circumference, labeled "7up Bottling Company, Martin, Tenn." Twenty other clocks sold for amounts ranging from \$16 to \$625.

Due to COVID concerns, inspections prior to auction were not permitted and onsite pickups were held by appointment only. Packing, shipping, and insurance were available. It may have been tions.com

shipping realities that damped interest on larger pieces like the 1960s-era Vendorlator vending machine which sold comparatively low. The glassdoored machine, still set up for 15-cent pricing, was picked up for just \$52.50 A beautiful freestanding store cooler labeled "Fresh Up With Seven-Up" sold for just \$180, while a dispenser head with a plastic 7Up emblem with spigots for 7Up, cola, orange and grape sodas went bit higher, to \$200.

View-Master's tiny photos brought the world home

Since Disneyland or Disney World are not an option this year due to the Covid-19 pandemic, why not 'visit' these parks through the eyes of a View-Master?

A practical idea perhaps, but not a novel one.

View-Master is a trademark name of a line of special-format stereoscopes and corresponding View-Master "reels" made of thin cardboard disks containing seven stereoscopic 3-D pairs of small transparent color photographs in film. Simply slip in a round disk containing 14 photos of your favorite subject and with a push of a button you can enjoy the scenes.

Vacation travel wasn't prolific in the 1930s and idea behind the advent of the View-Master was to bring such attractions to the general public.

The View-Master system was introduced in 1939, four years after the advent of Kodachrome color film made the use of small high-quality photographic color images practical. The item itself was first introduced at the New York World's Fair in 1939 and its intention was an alternative to the postcards.

At the onset, tourist attractions and travel views dominated View-Master's early list of reels, most of which were meant to be interesting to users of all ages. In the beginning, the subject of most reels were tourist attractions - Grand Canyon, Bryce Canyon, Niagara Falls, Everglades, Yellowstone National Park and other national parks. Manufacturers branched out from there with topical items like birds, flowers, trees and animals of all kinds.

"A View-Master reel holds 14 film transparencies in seven pairs, making up the seven stereoscopic images," says Dwight Hensley of Athens, Ohio is a regular vendor at the monthly Urbana (Ohio) Antique Show & Flea Market. Hensley collects old photos used in stereoscopes and possesses an array of View-Masters.

"The components of each pair are viewed simultaneously, one by each eye, thus simulating binocular depth deception. What a concept that was at the time," Hensley added.

View-Master was originally marketed through photo shops, stationery stores and scenic attraction gift shops.

"The best part of my collection is a Holmes stereoscope from the 19th Century," Hensley said. "I own several of those, but I have recently seen an upswing in those searching for not just the View-Master itself but the rotating cardboard disks. The disks are emerging more and more as people are savoring those disks depicting a favored music group or a special cartoon of theirs.

the Lone "Perhaps Ranger or Lassie was close to their heart and they want a piece of nostalgia. Those circular cardboards with unblemished film fetch from \$2 to \$5 for a generic piece like a park, monument or city. Most circular cardboards having any ties to Disney will have a much higher asking price."

But first, a glance back at the 'birth' of the View-Master.

The View-Master was invented by William Gruber, an organ maker and avid photographer who lived in Portland, Oregon. He had intended the item to be a children's toy and nothing more. Gruber was fascinated with a Victorian optical device known as a stereoscope, which created an illusion of 3D using two side-byside photographs. He fashioned his portable stereoscope using Kodachrome color film.

In 1933, Gruber was touring the Oregon Caves National Park and met Harold Graves, president of Sawyer's Inc., a company specializing in souvenir picture postcards. Gruber shared his vision, and Graves had the know-how in bringing Gruber's idea to life.

The two debuted the View-Master to the public at the World's Fair in New York (1939), where it was sold as a souvenir of the event. After the Fair, the two began selling the devices at specialty photography and stationery stores, and the reels they produced depicted scenes from national parks throughout the United States.

Gruber was instrumental in its construction. Gruber designed a machine that mounted the tiny pieces of Kodachrome 16-mm color transparency film into reels made from heavy paper stock. A special viewer was also designed and produced.

By 1941, more than 100,000 stores offered View-Masters to the general public. In 1941, the U.S. Government commissioned millions of View-Master reels from Gruber and Sawyers to teach servicemen how to identify airplanes and ships within shooting range. Thanks to the publicity from this war effort, View-Master was so well known by the mid-1940s that the company didn't have to advertise

And yes, there was competition. A similar manufacturer gave View-Master a run for its money and was called Tru-Vue. This company produced the filmstrips as well as the viewers themselves. Tru-Vue's viewers were made of bakelite and available in multiple colors. When held up to the light the images appeared in 3D.

Tru-Vue concentrated on subjects of attractive scenery, children's stories, travel, night life and current events.

In 1951, Sawyer's Inc. bought out this competition. Both View-Master and Tru-Vue products were manufactured in to the 1960s by Sawyers. That same year, Sawyer's Inc. gained the license to all of Walt Disney's characters and was permitted to use cel-style drawings from the actual films. Suddenly, the device had tremendous kid appear, and movies and TV characters became a staple of the View-Master line. Such nostalgic names as Captain Kangaroo, Pinky Lee, Mouseketeers, Roy Rogers, Flipper, The Monkees and The Beatles have all been recorded on these reels.

Other viewer manufacturers then included Novelview (1930s) as well as forgeries from Great Britain and Hong Kong.

The View-Master product line was long. Model D viewer was produced in the early 1950s and was available until the early 1970s.

Model E was introduced in 1955 with a more modern design, big ivory buttons on the picture changer levers, and a large "V" slot on top for easier reel insertion. It was released in brown and black. It was four inches high, five inches wide and four inches

Model F was introduced in 1958. It used C-cell batteries to power an internal lighting source, and led to an even more elaborate viewer in the Model F. Model G was the most prevalent. In 1962, the Bakelite models were replaced with lightweight thermoplastics, the first of which was the Model G.

"Most View-Masters viewers are remarkably common, so only the earliest models, like Model A and Model B, have any value on the market," Hensley said. "The blue-and-brown Model Bs are particularly scarce. Model D is coveted because it's the only viewer in the line with a focusing feature. The black Bakelite Model C, however, has proven indestructible and therefore, is easy to find.

In 1955, View-Master introduced three-reel packets, which often came with storybooks, and began phasing single reels out.

During the 1950s, when 3-D movies were all the rage, View-Masters would be placed in movie theater lobbies, loaded with preview reels of upcoming features. Moviegoers would look through the viewers to get a taste of 3-D films like "House of Wax" with Vincent Price, "They Called Him Hondo" with John Wayne, and "It Came From Outer Space" with Richard Carlson.

"Only 29 films were previews this way, so these reels are now hot items for collectors of View-Master," Hensley said. A "House of Wax" reel recently sold for \$400."

Hensley says that TV shows of the '60s like 'Lost in Space," "The Munsters," and "Adams Family" are particularly popular with collectors these days. He added that reels of "Star Trek", "Here's Lucy", The Beverly Hillbillies", and "Rowan & Martin's Laugh-In" are coveted pieces.

"Reels of popular movies and TV shows are hot items, Hensley said. "Often failed TV shows would end up as View-Master reels. Shows like "The Smith Family" starring Henry Fonda were not so coveted."

Vue-Master was eventually purchased by General Aniline and Film, or GAF, in 1966. G.A.F. pushed through several View-Master innovations, including the "talking" View-Master and View-Master projectors. The 1969 Apollo moon landing was also depicted in a View-Master reel.

"Reels made between 1960 and 1963 often had a blistering or bubbling effect on the paper that occurred in

manufacturing," Hensley said. "However, the real concern for collectors is if the film is damaged or missing, the reel can be deemed worthless."

View-Master dipped in popularity in the '70s.


By 1980, View-Master released the Show Beam Projector, a toy that combined the company's stereoscopic images and flashlight technology to produce a portable hand-held projector. The Show Beam used small film cartridges that were plugged into the side of the toy. Each cartridge contained 30 full-color 2D imag-

The ownership trail continued and in 1981, GAF sold View-Master to a group of investors who reconstituted themselves as View-Master International Group, or VMI. VMI acquired the Ideal Toy Company in 1984 and became known as the View-Master Ideal Group. V-M Ideal was purchased by Tyco Toys in 1989. Tyco merged with Mattel Inc. in 1997. V-M was placed organizationally in Mattel's preschool division and is now marketed under the Fisher-Price imprint, which continues emphasis on juvenile content.

In 1999, the View-Master was inducted into the Toy Hall of Fame. At this point in time, more than 1.5 million View-Master reels had been produced.

In 2009, Fishear-Price announced that it had stopped production of the scenic reels depicting tourist attractions.

"Not too many young people see the fascination with these, but the Baby Boomers remember them wall and want to latch on to their past," Hensley said. "What I'm seeing out there is a surge in those collecting the round reels themselves. I can't tell you how many times I've had people ask me if I had reels relating to Mickey Mouse, Barbie and Batman."
