Barnhart auction will be a lifetime of memories

READING, Mich. - In the early morning shadows of the large red barn with a white heart prominently painted on its sides, an element of auctioneering lore and history will come to an end.

On Sept. 19 at 10 a.m., Spieth and Satow Auctions Inc. will be selling the estate of Martin "Barney" Barnhart and his late wife, Ruby, in what promises to be a marathon of an auction.

Barnhart, who was America's oldest practicing auctioneer until he died in June 2019 at the age of 98, left a "lifetime collection of darn near everything," according to Darin Spieth, co-owner of Spieth and Satow Auctions.

Spieth should know: He was Barnhart's business partner for about 10 years and Barnhart "was one of my mentors." The auction has innumerable lots, old tractors (all in running condition), walking sticks, an extensive collection of pig memorabilia and many items bordering on the arcane and unusual.

"I can't tell you how many lots we'll be selling; it's way beyond counting," Spieth says. "But we're going to have two rings going all day. We'll be selling right at 10 hours and it will be fast paced. I'll be selling an item every 42 seconds ...

that's the way Barney would have wanted it." There will be no phone or Internet bidders.

"We don't operate that way, if you want to buy something you show up on auction day."

Again, Spieth's old partner and mentor would have agreed. It's their philosophy, that an auction can only be defined as a gathering of a live group of bidders clustered around an auctioneer. That way, the "true" market value is established.

It was the excitement of the crowd and the precise chant of the auctioneer that initially captivated a young Barney Barnhart, who attended Belgian draft horse auctions with his father in the late 1920s and early 1930s. Raised on the family farm, he was adept at harnessing a pair of Belgians early in the morning for a day in the field. Throughout much of the day, he worked on his chant, "selling" the pair Above: Selling on Sept. 19 by Spieth and Satow Auctions is a as he steadily plodded behind the animals.

"He would "sell" his sisters' dolls," according sold on a steel-wheeled cart. to his daughter, Penny Carothers. "He loved his farm and he loved auctioning. He worked hard to get the best prices for his consigners, and he was honest ... almost to a fault."

He was also very much a "people" person. He always arrived early at his auctions to mingle with the crowd before stepping up to the auction block. He volunteered to

call Bingo at a patient rehabilitation clinic, was on hand all his life to help 4-H kids sell their animals and loved to sing. "His favorite song was "It's A Wonderful World," Carothers said.

He was known throughout southern Michigan, Indiana

Dino is one dinosaur who will never go extinct

Harry F. Sinclair founded the Sinclair Oil Corporation in 1916, but it wasn't until 1930 that Sinclair truly became a household name, largely in part with the help of a peace-loving but massive Apatosaurus.

Sinclair Oil knew that the best lubricants in the oil industry derived from Pennsylvania grade crudes laid down more than 270 million years ago, but its advertising department wasn't sure how to educate American automobile owners. Sinclair wanted America to receive this sales message, "The oldest crudes make the best oils." Beginning in 1930, a series of Sinclair advertisements featured a dozen strange dinosaurs, ranging from the hideously fanged tyrannosaurus rex to the unaggressive, vegetarian Apatosaurus (popularly called a brontosaurus).

The curiosity value of this advertising campaign was tremendous. The public quickly equated the 40-ton brontosaurus with power, endurance, and stamina - the prime qualities of Sinclair products. The public's acceptance of the brontosaurus, affectionately called "Dino" (pronounced "Dye-no") led Sinclair Oil to register the brontosaurus as its trademark in 1932.

Dino received an official launching at the Chicago Century of Progress Exposition in 1933. This World's Fair featured Dino as created by P. G. Alen, creator of life-like papier-mâché animals for motion

pictures. Sinclair's





of the earth's surface and animal life as it existed millions of years ago. The dinosaurs were plaster models on steel skeleton frames with cloth and rubber covered joints. With the aid of internal machinery, they had lifelike motion.

The animated brontosaurus in the exhibit weighted two tons, and it was such a success that a smaller, rubber Dino the Dinosaur, with wiggling head and tail, was soon used for ads in Sinclair stations. An iconic trademark symbol was born.

Dino mushroomed into an advertising bonanza and collecting Dino became a national pastime. Some of the earliest collectible images of Dino appear on vintage Sinclair signs. The enamel-painted, round metal signs of the 1930s and 1940s are highly sought after today. Old oilcans depicting Dino are also in demand.

One of the "cutest" Dino collectibles is a bar of Dino Soap from the 1950s. The soap was a give-away promotional at gas stations around America. Today a mint bar in box sells for about \$18, but don't let the kids bathe with it for the price is sure to go up. Other Dino collectibles include postcards from the 1933 Chicago World's Fair that depict Dino, decks of cards with Dino on the back, copies of the 1948

Sinclair Farm Safety Book that featured Dino on the front and back cover (about \$30), and any of the several vintage Dino blow up displays.

For true Dino the Dinosaur connoisseurs, ultimate the Dino collectible would be the small-scale outdoor models that Sinclair Service stations displayed during the 1950s. These adorable looking brontosauruses seemed to be at every Sinclair station back then. Today, few exist but they are worth looking for since they are rare and guite sought after. They are rather large though, so unless you want one for a yard ornament, you might limit your enjoyment of them to those still on display at gas stations (like the one found at the Sinclair Station in Golden, Colo.).

Perhaps Sinclair Oil Corporation's greatest Dino promotion, making it also one of the most sought after of all Dino collectibles, is the 1935 dinosaur stamp album. These promotional books were issued at gas stations and could be filled only with colored dinosaur stamps that were issued one at a time each week at service stations, which kept motorists and their children coming back for more. In a single year, 4 million albums were distributed and over 48 million dinosaur stamps issued. This single Dino promotional earned Sinclair Oil millions of dollars in increased profits.

Finding an album in good condition today is a lot harder than it was in the summer of 1935, but owning the album is worth the hunt.

Old Sinclair credit cards that feature Dino are also collectible. These make fabulous looking art when framed in blocks of 30 or more and hung on the wall. Expect to pay about \$10 for these old cards. If you like ashtrays, a vintage 1947 Dino cast iron desk display makes a good ashtray. It is only 7 ½-inches long but is quite heavy and costs, if found, about \$75.

Today, industrial surveys repeatedly rank Dino the Dinosaur as one of the most potent symbols of American business success. Remarkably high percentages of people identify the Dino the Dinosaur with Sinclair Oil. This association is positive and pleasant. Children are as fascinated with the prehistoric uniqueness of Dino as are adults; therefore, the correlation with Sinclair begins at an early age. For Baby Boomers, Dino is both recognizable and nostalgic. Few children of the 1950s and 1960s failed to own at least one Dino toy.

Finally, Dino makes the perfect collectible for the entire family since parents and children alike are willing to hunt for this lovable dinosaur, proving that Dino's appeal will never go extinct.





FROM FRONT PAGE 1 and Ohio, his farm within a few miles of both contiguous states. He also auctioned in Texas, Minnesota, Florida and other states.

In the biting cold of winter, the 5-foot, 8-inch auctioneer who tipped the scales at about 125 pounds would don a full-length black bear coat to keep warm. He was a little man who lived to bring joy into his life and others. Every Christmas season he couldn't wait to put his slight frame into a Santa suit to the delight of his five children, five grandchildren and five great-grandchldren.

He was always an animal lover. "I remember, at one point, we had 37 cats. Some hung around the milk parlor, others stayed around the pig pen and several remained around the house," his daughter said. "He had a name for every one of the cats. His animals became more like pets, each of course named, rather than just farm animals.'

Barney Barnhart had that special "charisma," according to his daughter. The diminutive man wrapped up in a bear coat, pointing to bidders with a walking stick and steadily calling bids through the biting wind, was a subject of lore in auctioneer circles.

One widely spread story tells of just one of his "heroic" deeds at the auction block. His partner Spieth was a witness to the event, verifying this oft-told story. "We were up in the Brainard area Minnesota," Spieth recalled. "It was a big auction. We were selling an entire logging town, including a bank and jail. "During the auction someone stepped on a chipmunk. I thought it was a goner. But Barney stepped

out, took up that chipmunk and began giving it mouthto-mouth resuscitation. It was totally unreal. It took awhile for the animal to respond, but it finally came back to life, scrambled out of Barney's hands and went up a tree."

The bidders' applause was befitting to the fun he had before a crowd.

"I learned a lot from Barney," Spieth says. "He had an incredible work ethic. He would conduct three or four auctions a week for 50 years. While he was auctioning, Ruby took care of the farm and the animals. They both worked seven days a week on the farm, feeding, milking and taking care of the cattle. He was witty, funny and took pride in selling. He was definitely old school. He was tough; he could stand to the fire."

Barnhart lived on the family farm, where he was born, nearly all his life. He and his late wife, Ruby, raised five children on the farm. Prior to that, his parents lived their whole lives on the now 214-acre farm.

"In this auction, there's an accumulation of items that go back 175 to 180 years," Spieth said. "There are firearms, tons of farm equipment and lots of antiques and primitives. There has to be something here for everyone."

As well known as Barnhart was, Spieth is expecting a big turnout for

"He was a beloved, colorful character," he said. "He just fell into love with the chant, the people and the excitement that auctions offer. He brought a lot of love and passion to the business and was always ready to help others."

Invariably dressed in a high crowned fedora and necktie, with a walking stick in hand, the late Michigan auctioneer began each auction with the announcement: "We come today as friends and we will leave today as friends." It was with that that oft-spoken sentiment, that the little man with a heart as big as the one painted on his barn, departed the auctioneer ring.






