tabletop printing presses paired with metal cabinets containing assorted accessories; one reached \$104.50, the other \$27.50. At the bargain sum of \$16.50 went an early 20th-century Rotary Neostyle model 8-F mimeograph with its stand.

In addition to the presses was other print shop equipment including a booklet stapler and iron paper binder that sold for \$330. Nine letterpress cabinets from various eras of the 20th-century, each housing assorted type and spacers, sold from \$33 for a single printer's tray full of spacers to \$302 for a 40s-era letterpress cabinet complete with drawers filled with type.


Two impressive educational pieces continued the emphasis on graphics and the written word. An early 20th-century Chautauqua Art Desk,

sold for \$88. These lapstyle desks were associated with the Montessori movement, used in parents' homes to prepare children for vocations in the arts. There was also a circa 1920s Litho Plate Educational Board that sold sans its legs for \$44. Manufactured in Muncie, Ind., by the Richmond School Furniture Company, these folding blackboards were topped by a windable scroll containing teaching content intended to inspire children to write and draw.

Three dozen lots of books and ephemera were the next page-turners. A popular barrister bookcase, circa 1940s, filled with books spanning the 20th-century sold for \$170.50. There was also fierce competition among bidders for an 1859 Ingham & Livingston topographical map of the counties of Michigan, also sending it to \$170.50. A boxlot containing various

music books and magazines, including a 1918 musical program from the Gladmer Theater (Lansing) and а 19th-century Cathedral Music of England book, garnered an impressive \$143.

There was also all manner of vintage and antique desks - eight in total. A wooden rolltop desk from the early decades of the 20th-century went for \$88. A 1940s wood office desk complete with its contents (including more of those letterpress spacers) sold for \$77. The 146th running of the Kentucky Derby is now in the record books with Authentic coming down the homestretch as the winner in this most unusual of Derbys. The event, which normally is held in May was moved to September due to the pandemic. But, even the date change didn't help as the event ended up happening without the usual 150,000 raging fans at Churchhill Downs. There were no souvenirs, no programs and no mint juleps enjoyed at Louisville this year.

But there is one collector's item as coveted today as it has been for decades – the Kentucky Derby glass. And perhaps no one's collection is as monstrous as the one belonging to Harry Goldberg of LaGrange, Ky. His Derby memorabilia totals 4,700 pieces, including 1,800 drinking glasses and almost every Derby Festival pin.

When he began collecting Kentucky Derby memorabilia 22 years ago, Goldberg thought it would be a fun, cheap hobby.

"Twenty-two years ago I was working parttime

years a true julep glass was produced for general distribution and these are the most valuable, ranging from \$6,000 to \$16,000 depending on the condition and variation. There are few of these in existence.

The drink they chose to serve in the glass was the mint julep. The julep started out in Virginia as a high society beverage served in goblets with brandy or rum. The poorer denizens of Kentucky chose to mix the drink with a more proletariat liquor – bourbon. he said. "Variations with typographical errors, like Triple Crown titles attributed to the wrong horse, or difference in the image, like a horse missing a tail. Some of the 1982 glasses omitted the red star which indicated that Genuine Risk was a filly. The 1971 glass had Cananaro II on it but roughly 500 glasses were made without the Roman numeral on it. Mistakes glasses are out there."

at an auction house and saw these glasses come through, selling at three for two dollars, five for three dollars," said Goldberg, who lives just 22 miles from Churchill Downs but has never attended a race there. "Right then I thought I could get into this cheap, affordable hobby. Derby glasses from the 1980s and 1990s were reasonable, but things got more expensive when I went back in time. To this day my collection goes back to 1945."

The 'birth' of the Derby glass is a rather odd one. After the 1938 Kentucky Derby, the Churchill Downs staff noticed they were short more than a few water glasses. Fans, it turned out, were stealing the glasses to take home as souvenirs of their big day at the races.

Officials at the track had an idea: rather than continue to lose glassware to pilfering fans, why not make a special glass they could sell to fans to commemorate the day?

Churchill Downs took that idea to Harry Stevens. Stevens had built a successful business as a catering company for sporting venues. The next year (1939), Churchill Downs offered the first-ever commemorative Kentucky Derby glass. The next two World War II made glass hard to find tumblers were made in an aluminum version for 1940 and 1941 and a Bakelite version for 1941 to 1944. Bakelite glasses can fetch up to \$2,500 and up depending on the color.

Selling the drinks in the special glasses more than tripled drink sales at the track after that. In the early years, there were fewer than 100,000 commemorative glasses made. Today, more than 700,000 are made each year.

Goldberg's oldest Derby glass is the 71st running for the Kentucky Derby, held on June 9, 1945. The race was won by Hoop Jr. and was ridden by jockey Eddie Arcaro.

He has glasses from all Kentucky Derbys but two: 1951 and 1959. His collection is full of glass misprints and imperfections, which drastically increases the value of those glasses.

"Some of my favorites are the mistake glasses,"

Another one of Goldman's prized possessions, and sets that few collectors have, are color-by-color production glasses.

In addition to having Kentucky Derby glasses, he's obtained glasses from the Arkansas Derby, Florida Derby, Louisiana Derby, Pennsylvania Derby and others.

His collection also includes an extensive collection of Louisville Stoneware pottery, including coffee mugs, an ashtray and a lemonade pitcher.

And not just official merchandise, either. If it has to do with horse racing, it's in the room somewhere. There are several shelves of bobble-head dolls, representing trainers and jockeys. There are media passes, owners' passes and ticket stubs tucked in a drawer. He has a special glass case containing nothing but Secretariat memorabilia.

A large part of his collection is dedicated to Kentucky Derby Festival pins.

"All I'm missing in the 1973 pin," he said. "It's

the rarest."

It is also the first pin, and according to the Kentucky Derby Festival website, it will cost about \$1,000.

There are boxes and boxes of pins stacked on the floor and in display cases. There are metal pins, pins featuring different sponsors and pins for specific events.

But glasses dominate Goldberg's collection. From Derby shot glasses to wine glasses, plastic to aluminum. The variety is stunning.

Goldberg prefers to hunt for his collectibles. He searches yard sales, flea markets and estate sales. He rarely travels very far to fetch the items. For Goldberg, the "chase" for the glasses is more precious than the "ownership" of them.

"I have so many memories with my collection," he said. "So many people have found items and given me pieces, or they told me where I could get them. I won't mind trading someone for a glass, as long as I don't break up a two- or three- glass set. And I'll gladly add to my collection, as long as it's something good, something I don't have or just a rare oddball."

Just one bedroom of the Goldberg house is dedicated to Harry's passion. These items could easily fill another room and the living room. His wife, Bonnie, doesn't share the enthusiasm for his hobby and simply reminds her husband to "always keep the door to that room closed."

whiskey.

In November 1879, Buchanan moved to London and became an agent for Charles Mackinlay & Co, whiskey blenders. Buchanan quickly realized two things — he had a knack for making whiskey and all of England was an untapped market for bottled Scotch whiskey. Buchanan quit Mackinlay & Co. and Buchanan Blend became an overnight success, especially in the United States and in London, where members of the House of Commons sipped it. In honor of the House of Common members who drank his whiskey, Buchanan renamed the "House whiskey of Commons Finest Old Highland Whiskey."

Buchanan designed a striking black and white label for House of Commons whiskey, and very soon thereafter, drinkers began ordering that "Black and White" whiskey. In 1902Buchanan officially changed the name of his whiskey to Black & White. By 1909, Black & White whiskey was the most popular whiskey in all of England.

During the 1920s, Black & White Whiskey began utilizing the black and white terriers more heavily in its advertising. Soon thereafter, the black and white terriers became the symbol for Black and White Scotch Whiskey.

Black & White Scotch Whiskey became a household name, and the black and white terriers captured the hearts of collectors-both drinking and non-drinking collectors. For nearly 125 years, Black & White has produced a continuing line of collectible signs, advertising, glassware, and ceramic figurines, all with the black and white terrier on them.

Some of the most valuable Black & White Scotch Whiskey collectible items are advertising posters. Posters for the company routinely are offered on eBay with some of the posters valued at \$1,400.

There is even a Black & White Scotch Whiskey mechanical advertising sign with Scottie dogs that bark. This sign has been offered on eBay for around \$200.

Terrier figurines are also highly prized collectibles. Some, such as the black and white Scottish terrier figurines produced in Rosenthal, Germany, circa 1940, bring as much as \$500 on today's secondary markets.

Several cast-iron versions of Black & White's Scottie dogs have been cast and offered for sale

over the years. One set of figurines is the "Noir et Blanc" or Black and White Scottie Dogs that routinely sell for around \$60. These cast iron dogs make excellent doorstops.

Black & White Scotch Whiskey has produced serving pitchers, drinking glasses, tin trays, ashtrays, and many other collectible items over the years. Serving pitchers average about \$60 each, and tin trays from the 1950s, in good condition with clear images of the terriers, average \$80. While hardly anyone smokes anymore, ashtrays remain sought after collectibles. Black & White ashtrays often cost \$50 or more and seldom remain unsold when offered on Internet auction sites.

Not all black and white Scottie dog collectibles are associated with Black & White Scotch Whiskey. In fact, there are hundreds and hundreds of Scottie dog collectibles that dog lovers collect every year that have nothing to do with whiskey. But in a world where gray has become the political climate, it is refreshing to find a hobby, such as Black & White Scotch Whiskey, where everything is still easy to understand. In fact, there are no shades of gray in collecting Scotch Whiskey terriers—every one of them is either black or white.

Advertising galore at Indy Ad show, auction

LEBANON, Ind. - The Indiana antiques show, and auction venues will come back to life at the Boone County Fairgrounds with more than 250-antique advertising and toy dealers from around the country setting up for the Indy Ad Show on Sept. 25, followed by a 350-lot auction on Sept. 26.

Extra staff will be assigned inside the buildings continually wiping down tables and other interior features. Social distancing will also be suggested.

"We've had a lot of questions about whether the show is on, and everything is going as planned," Canchola said. The auction scheduled at 4:30 p.m. on Sept. 26 will also be hosted by Proxibid and LiveAuctioneers bidding platforms.

"We'll be offering phone bidding and absentee bids,"
