Schlitz sign brewed a \$50,000 bid at Showtime event

Three advanced collectors whose specialties were Western memorabilia, pressed steel toys and advertising had their items combined into a blockbuster auction by Showtime Auction Services.


Taking top honors was a large Joseph Schlitz Brewing Co. sign. It was a reverse glass painting in excellent condition. This rare beauty depicted the factory with mother-of-pearl windows from the early 1900s. It was framed nicely in a wooden frame and blue background, which made the factory stand out. Showing the location as 8th and Walnut, in Milwaukee, Wis., the building appeared to actually glow. It would command attention anywhere it was hung for display as it measured a full 62 inches square. The selling price on this one-of-a kind advertising treasure was an impressive \$50,000.

Bringing another resounding bid in the advertising category was an extremely rare Anheuser Busch paper advertising sign. Touting the Anheuser Busch beer as "famous bottled beer

around the world", this paper treasure showed the triumphal journey of the Anheuser Busch Brewing Association. So many brilliant colors and graphics jump out to make this advertising piece an item to study. It depicted a parade of countries celebrating Anheuser Busch. It included Tony Faust's Arabic headquarters and the Brewing Association shipping depot. For this one being paper, it was in excellent condition, only showing a bit of age discoloration around the perimeter. It was framed under glass and measure 48½ by 36 inches overall. The clouds in the light blue sky contrasted with all the fantastic colors showing in the clothes the people wore, from the dark uniforms of the gentlemen to the bold blues of a sash against a white dress of a lady riding atop a float that

Celebrate Cookie Monster Day by eating your favorite snack

Nov. 2 is Cookie Monster Day, which celebrates the birthday of the popular Sesame Street character. Muppet creator Jim Henson envisioned and drew rough sketches of Cookie Monster on Nov. 2, 1965. And in 1966, Henson's Cookie Monster prototype made its television debut as a "Wheel-Stealer" on an unaired General Mills television commercial for a GM snack food.

Alison Inches' book, Jim Henson's Designs and Doodles, published in 2003, explains Cookie Monster's creation: "In 1966, Henson drew three monsters that ate cookies and appeared in a General Foods commercial that featured three crunchy snack foods: Wheels, Crowns and Flutes. A different monster represented each snack. The Wheel-Stealer was a short, fuzzy monster with wonky eyes and sharply pointed teeth, which would later evolve into Cookie Monster. The Flute-Snatcher was a speed demon with a long, sharp nose and windblown hair. The Crown-Grabber was a hulk of a monster with a Boris Karloff accent and teeth that resembled giant knitting needles. These monsters had insatiable appetites for the snack foods they were named after."

In 1967, Cookie Monster was featured in an IBM training film that included a self-destructing "coffee break machine." American got its first real glimpse of Cookie Monster when this IBM skit aired on the Ed Sullivan Show on Oct. 8, 1967.

Frito-Lay contracted with Henson to use Cookie Monster in three television advertisements for

Munchos potato snack, which was created for kids. These commercials referred to the Muppet puppet (that would become Cooking Monster) as Arnold the Munching Monster. Frito-Lay offered Cookie Monster a long-term contract, but he declined, sensing his acting career was about to take off.

Cookie Monster's true claim to fame came in 1969 when he first appeared on Sesame Street as an "extra" with an undefined role and presence. In fact, Cookie Monster did not even have a name until his second season on Sesame Street! In a song in 2004, it was revealed that Cookie Monster's original name was Sid or Sidney.

Kids immediately loved the big, blue, cookie-eating monster, and Henson saw huge possibilities for the monster. One Muppet sketch featured the then unnamed monster as the winner of a television quiz show. For winning the show, the monster was "given the choice of \$10,000 cash, a new car, a trip to Hawaii, or a cookie." He took the cookie, earning the name "Cookie Monster." Finally, Henson bowed to the inevitable and gave his monster the name that all of us know and love—Cookie Monster. And by the end of his second season on Sesame Street, Cookie Monster was a scene-stealing success, especially when he uttered one of his most iconic sayings, "Me want cookie!"

Cookie Monster is best known for his blue fur, large, googly eyes, simple language skills, and love of cookies (actually his appetite is so large, he loves to







was being carried in the parade. There were elephants and camels, people feasting, and some dancing. Obviously, a great time was being had by everyone. So, what would you think a piece of paper that advertised a still famous beer would sell for? This one kept rising in price and the bidding didn't stop until it reached a very impressive \$19,000.

Coming in right behind the Anheuser Busch sign was a Glencoe Brewing sign. If you research the

Company, you will find many different conflicting opening and closing years. The most popular one seems to contend that it opened in 1901 and closed in 1920. So, this very rare Vitrolite corner sign shows Uncle Sam holding up a bottle of Glencoe beer which was manufactured in Glencoe, Minn. This advertising sign was still in the original copper flashed frame. There had been a bit of restoration to the bottle and the beer lettering, but it was a professional job, so was con-

sidered to be in excellent condition. Showtime Auction Services had only seen one other sign like this one. It sold for an impressive \$17,000.

Another reverse glass sign proved to be one of the most sought-after reverse glass signs for the advanced collector. An extremely rare Rye whiskey sign had the FUF or flying "U" prominently displayed at the top center. Under that was a horse-drawn wagon and at the bottom it said, "J.E. Choisser, Forsyth, Mont.". This reverse glass piece was in excellent condition and brought a respectable final bid price of \$16,000.

Staying in the advertising category, but changing styles a bit, there were several Coca-Cola tin serving trays auctioned off. Taking top honors was an original 1908 Coca-Cola tray. This one was put out by the Western Coca-Cola Bottling Company out of Chicago. It was in excellent condition and measured only 12 inches in diameter. Yet sometimes the smaller items will bring more money than the larger ones at auction. And this was certainly one of those items. This one pictured a gorgeous lady with wavy hair which fell past her waist. She was draped in a white garment and sitting on a red-covered stool. The bottle of Coca-Cola she was holding is not what attracted the viewers' attention though. The white garment only covered her from the waist down, so the viewer saw all of her from the waist up. Around the outside of the oval frame, were the words, "Whenever Ginger Ale, Seltzer or Soda is good, Coca-Cola is better. Try it." This very rare tin tray kept the bidders on their toes as the price kept rising. It took a high bid of \$9,000 to claim ownership of this tin serving tray.

A 1904 Coca-Cola tin serving tray brought a bid of \$4,000, while one from 1903 was sold for \$3,750. The price of \$2,250 marked the sale of a tray from 1909 and one from 1912.

Moving on to some more common items, the sale of some vintage toasters brought their fair share of attention. A grouping of six vintage toasters kept

the bids rolling in. The group contained a McGraw Electric, Model 1A4 single slice chrome toaster; a Hotpoint El Tosto, by Landers, Frary & Clark, "Universal"; a Maybaum with a black Bakelite base and handles, type 581 from Germany; a Universal electric toaster deluxe with ivory pendant handles and buttons on the base dated 1929; and an X-2 toaster. The X-2 toaster is the one that drove the price up. This toaster is so rare, that most toaster books don't even have a photo. Instead, they use a print of the patent paper for the toaster. Research on the always reliable internet, brought up absolutely nothing on this toaster. But the collectors must have known the value of this rare item. The price for toasting your bread on this grouping of toasters was a jaw-dropping \$8,000.

The entertainment from long ago is still entertainment today. A Mills Dewey up-right 5-cent coin operated slot machine was beautiful. It was built somewhere between 1899 and 1930. The quartersawn oak cabinet really drew attention with the copper-flashed hardware. The cabinet and hardware had been restored at some point, but this slot machine was in very good working condition. It came with the key, which was a plus. It brought a high bid of \$10,000.

Samuel Anderson Robb (1851-1928) was an American sculptor. He was best known for his carved wooden figures for tobacco shops and circus wagons. Robb was born in New York City, the son of a Scottish shipwright. He served his apprenticeship and went to work for William Demuth carving tobacco figures. This Indian was unsigned and stood 80 inches tall. He had wonderful color and patina. The Indian is holding a hunting spear, looking up. He is dressed in a dark red and very pale blue typical Indian garb. He stands on top of a plain stand awaiting his new home. The final bid price on this Indian was \$21,000.

A second Cigar Store Indian, also carved by Robb, brought a similar price. He was dressed in brighter colors, and much of the paint appeared to be original. The top half of his spear was broken off and there were age cracks throughout. It had normal wear and great patina. This one was also unsigned. It stood 59 inches tall. The hammer came down on the bid of \$18,000 on this Indian.

A couple of salesman samples were auctioned off. A hay baler that came complete with the original carrying case was sold for \$6,750. And a salesman's sample saloon back-bar brought a high bid of \$2,500.

The toys put up for auction were some of the most sought after in the pressed steel collecting field. A rare, Hoenes Viking pressed steel toy construction truck was offered for sale. Being sold as only one of six of these known to exist, the bidding kept going up quickly. This truck was made in 1927 and was green and yellow. It was in all original condition and brought a final high bid of \$5,500.

Coming in right behind with a sale price of \$5,000, was a Buddy L outdoor pressed steel hand car. Manufactured somewhere between 1930 and 1932, this Model 500 was one of four known to exist.

And not trailing behind by much was a Buddy L pressed steel toy trench digger. It was Model 400


and built somewhere between 1928 and 1931. In all original condition, it took \$4,500 to be the proud owner of this toy.

Presidential pie safe easily won the bidding at \$37,400

LONE JACK, Mo. - Bidders at Soulis Auctions may have tried to guess the late Gerald Mueller's occupation from his collection of trade signs. With 15 barber poles in the sale, he must have been a barber. Or maybe an optometrist? A reasonable guess considering Mueller owned nine wood, tin and metal spectacle signs, some with eerie eyeballs. With 10 iron watch face trade signs, master carver Samuel perhaps he'd taken Robb (1851-1928). The watchmaking. up He probably wasn't maker,

or pharmacist though; there were only one, two or three signs for those jobs. Sorry, amateur psychologists. Mueller had careers in sales and finance in Sioux City, Iowa; he just loved trade signs, weathervanes, barber poles, pie safes and one spectacular Indian.

The Sept. 19 sale led off with the Indian - a 19th century pine tobacconist figure attributed to New York 69-inch-tall wheeled figure of a Native

locksmith, bootmaker into the sale with safe was hammered \$8,000/\$12,000 an estimate. On their website. Soulis provided a 4-minute video that examined every minute detail of the figure as well as every area of paint loss, repaint and damage. Soulis opened bidding at \$4,000 and wooden the wooden princess sold onsite for \$13,200.

It didn't take long that high mark be surpassed. "Presidential pie safes are very rare with only four known," said Dirk Soulis on his website. Each of the 16 tins in the 68 by 39 by 16 American woman went inch Midwestern pie

with the name "Lincoln" surrounded by American flags, stars and a single strand punched border. The safe opened at \$3,000, one-half its low estimate and then soared to \$37,400.

Other than tobacconist figure, the top trade sign of the sale was a zinc and gilded iron trade for optician L.D. Cutler of Windsor Locks, Connecticut. Cutler's double sided 23 ½ by 9 by ½ inch hand-painted sign with spectacles and human eyes sold for \$12,100.

Mueller's weathervane collection included pigs, horses, deer, sulkies, cows, eagles, sheep, a pigeon, arrows, a rooster, a jockey, touring cars and one beaver. Bidders kept quiet in the days approaching the sale. There were only a few pre-sale bids for a 33 1/4 by 26 by 3 inch running weathervane stag attributed to J. W. Fiske & Company. That changed when the stag opened at \$1,500 and galloped through 23 bids to emerge the leader of the menagerie pack at \$20,900.

A rare zinc beaver lightening weathervane was manufactured by W. C. Shinn of Lincoln, Neb., during the first quarter of the 20th century. The beaver with a maple leaf in its mouth sold onsite for \$7,150.

The sale's

barber pole came with head, flowing mane, an unusual painted wooden bracket that set the pole on an angle from the wall. In red, white, blue, gold and silver paint with a large painted ball finial, the 43-inch pole sold for \$5,428.

There was only one carved carousel horse in the sale, a circa 1920 C.W. Parker outer row jumper with tucked

glass eyes, carved blankets, original iron stirrups and the name "Betty" painted on her breast collar. The jumper sold for \$3,300.

He allows guests to bid from their cars. To participate in the Drive-In auction, bidders drive their cars under the raised sides of the auction tent and encircle the floor bidders and the auction Bidders podium. remain in their car and bid either via the internet or with a large paddle they wave out their window. "In some cases, drive-in bidders are closer to the auction podium that those in chairs," said Soulis.




