Montgomery & Assoc., Inc to handle the job. The RJM auctioneers are accustomed to helping industrial companies downsize, typically selling large equipment, semi-trucks, trailers, and other machinery. 
offered at this diverse auction. There was a one-day preview scheduled prior to the online sale. The two wedding service companies used their items to create an entire event for the wedding couple, including large items to stage the ceremony and small pieces to decorate it. Early American-made pewter can be expensive to collect




Pewter is a metal alloy, traditionally between 85 and 99 percent tin, with the remaining elements consisting of 1to 15 percent copper, which acts as a hardener. Occasionally, lead was added to the lower grades of pewter, which gives pewter a bluish tint. The word "pewter" is probably a variation of the word spelter. "Spelter" became peautre in French, and many other languages. From the French, the English derived the word "pewter."

There are three grades of pewter: 1) fine, for eating ware, with 96-99 percent tin, and 1 to 4 percent copper; Below: Very rare, early 2) trifle, also for eating and drinking utensils but duller in appearance, with 92 percent pewter tin, 1 to 6 percent copper, and up to 4 percent lead; and 3) lay or "ley" metal, not for American eating or drinking utensils, which could contain up to 15 percent lead. inkwell, circa 1700s, Modern pewter mixes the tin with copper, antimony, and/or bismuth as from Williamsburg, Va. This unmarked piece opposed to lead. The lead additive made certain grades of pewter heavier than other grades, and as a rule of thumb, the lighter the piece, the

better made it is since lead-based pewter is the cheapest form of

Physically, pewter is a bright, shiny metal that is very similar in appearance to silver; hence, when it was first commercially offered for sale, pewter became known as the "Poor Man's Silver." Like silver, pewter oxidizes to a dull gray over time if left untreated. Pewter is a very malleable alloy, being soft enough to carve with hand tools, and it also takes good impressions from punches or presses. Because of this inherent softness and malleability, however, pewter



cannot be used as a toolmaking metal. Some types of pewter pieces, such as candlesticks, were turned on a metal lathe. Pieces produced through this technique are sometimes referred to as "holloware."

Use of pewter was common from pre-Roman times through Middle Ages, continuing its popularity until the various developments in glassmaking and potterv during the 18th and 19th centuries. About 1850 (about the beginning of Industrial the Revolution), stoneware and china replaced pewter as the chief tableware. Massproduction of glass products later replaced pewter in day-to-day usage.

gradually Pewter stopped being used and by 1850, it was just about gone. Around 1950. however, resurgence of the craft brought pewter back from extinction. Many American housewives of the 1950s and '60s collected pewter pieces. Pewter pieces and reproductions continue production today, mainly as decorative or specialty items.

Unlidded mugs and lidded tankards may be the most familiar pewter artifacts from the late 17th and 18th centuries, although the metal is also used for many other items including porringers (a shallow cup or bowl with a tableware. So early handle), plates, dishes, American-made pewter basins, measures, cups, communion

teapots, sugar bowls, steins and cream jugs. In the early 19th century, of fashion changes witnessed a decline in the use of pewter flatware, but demand increased production of both cast and spun pewter tea sets, whaleoil lamps, candlesticks, etc. Later in the century, pewter alloys were often used as a base metal for silver-plated objects.

Surprisingly, early American pewter is more valuable than European pewter of the same era. Hardy pewter smiths founded the American pewter trade. Prior to the American Revolution, tin was unavailable in the American Colonies because the world's major source of tin was Cornwall, England, and the English protected its own trade by refusing to export tin. Undaunted, the early American pewter smiths sought out worn and broken pewter objects and melted them down for recasting. This early recycling effort produced most of the Americanmade pewter prior to the Revolutionary War. Unfortunately, due to the recycling of pewter, fewer than 10 pieces of 17th Century American pewter are known to exist, and less than 100 pieces made prior to 1750 exist today.

Following the Revolutionary War, American pewter smiths were able to obtain tin, but, paradoxically, social customs changed around this time and pottery replaced pewter as spoons, is both expensive and flagons, hard to find.

For a while, pewter

production continued as the base metal in silverplated objects. Today, much of the pewter found in antique shops is late-19th century pewter pieces that were once silver-plated over a base of pewter but since then have been stripped of their plating.


Evaluation of pewter is quite complicated and, if you desire to collect pewter, you should attempt to become a true expert before risking serious money on inferior items. Two early American smiths to look for are William Will of Philadelphia or Samuel Hamlin of Providence Rhode Island. Also, early English pewter smiths sometimes put an "X" or "London" on pieces made of high quality. And the "rose and crown"—a circular rose capped by a crown became a symbol of high-quality pewter that American smiths also used.

Marks such as those mentioned are easily faked, so beware of buying expensive "old" pewter because fakes and forgeries abound. Many a knowledgeable collector has been misled and added a fake to their collection, and later, when trying to sell it, discovered itworthless.

Today's pewter might once again be considered a "poor man's silver" since it is only decorative for the most part, employing no functional use. Collectible statuettes, figurines, replica coins, and pendants are examples of pewter pieces today. And decorative plates and tankards are quite common on today's market.







was claimed with a final bid of \$3,800. An ivory spiral shaped crystal mandap with 8-foot-tall pillars proved popular, closing at \$1,350. A smaller curved ivory and gold "mustache" (a description for the shape of the curved archway) mandap with 6 large and 8 small pillars finished at \$850, while four ornate white 38-inch mandap pillars with matching trim captured a

final bid of \$925. Furniture is an integral part of the wedding ceremony. Consisting of white and gold cloth, elaborate frames, and beautiful styles these items proved popular. An eye-catching wedding sofa with white upholstery and a carved gold frame measuring 72 inches was rehomed with a final bid of \$775. A plainer, all white 66-inch sofa in the style of a modern loveseat closed at \$525. Two white wedding chairs with intricate carved gold frames were claimed with high bids of \$420 each. There was an appealing variety of other styles and materials. mostly in white or gold, of wedding chairs and benches, with them closing between \$95-240 each.

ceremony, the Indian bride might make her entrance while being transported in a Doli decorative wedding carriage, which is a box mounted on poles for carrying. The one offered at this sale measured 5 by 3 feet and consisted of a carved gold frame, red and white curtains, and gold poles to transport it. A final bid of \$1,400 was required to take possession of this prize.

The traditional Indian wedding is adorned with many symbols of the pageantry. Those attending wear bold, colorful clothing and the decorations reflect the joy of the event. There were several items presented at this auction that would enhance the scene, including a pair of peacock mandap pillars standing 93 inches tall. This brilliant blue, green, and gold set was taken with a high bid of \$120. Ornate vases of various sizes and materials were offered. For example, a set of four slender, delicately decorated silver, burgundy, and gold ceramic 5-foot-tall vases were claimed with a high bid of \$400. A similar set-in gold and silver reached a final bid of \$140. Candles and their accessories were also prominent. Several 25-inch tall five-arm gold metal candelabra style candle holders featuring As part of the wedding crystal beaded globes at the end of each swirled arm were claimed with bids from \$90-100 each.

Decorative metal columns with stained glass sides were also popular candle holders, with a set of nine going for \$142 and a set of six for \$75. Satin pillows, decorative umbrellas, and beautiful curtains, tablecloths, and items consisting of chiffon, silk, satin, sequined fabric, linen, and crush fabrics were also available to help dec-

orate the event. Statues and figurines certainly perform an integral part in the festivities. A dancing image of Shiva (male god with four arms) in gold surrounded by a white circle of flowers was constructed in plaster and measured 70 by 64 inches. It was taken with a high bid of \$190. A 64-inch-tall plaster statue of Ganesh, a figure with a large elephant head on a man's body, done in pastel shades of yellow, pink, and blue drew a final bid of \$90. A lot consisting of three Ganesh figures in gold measuring 25 inches tall and festively dancing drew a \$320 final bid. A colorfully dressed group of six plaster musicians measuring 15 inches tall in their seated poses as they played various instruments earned a high bid of \$160. Numerous lots of metal, wood, plastic, porcelain, or plaster figures consisting of musicians, dancers, women serving food, or other festive subjects finished in gold or realistic colors drew bids ranging from \$20-160.

While the wedding

inventory drew much interest and excitement, there were many more items in this auction that were more typical of an RJM event. 





"Over the centuries, the designs, denominations and metallic content of coins can tell us a great deal about civilizations, past, and present, such as famous and not-so-famous political and historical figures, important events and landmarks," explained Dickes. "There's no coin shortage during National Coin Week."
