## Thermometers were hot at Harritt Group Estate Sale

NEW ALBANY, Ind. — With the coming of spring, it's become noticeable how many auctioneers are moving back to live, in-person sales. Yet, similar to what's happened in education, a year's lockdown has led many auction houses across the country to pivot into online auctions. It's "the new nor-vintage red and gold one. mal" and perhaps a full third of

all auctions now have some form of online component, whether that means online-only or a hybrid sale involving face-to-face and virtual settings.

While many companies are employing popular platforms like LiveAuctioneers and HiBid for their online selling, others are making use of proprietary options. The latter is the case with Indiana's Harritt Group which has been using a private-labeled version of Auction Mobility. It's been a busy first quarter online; since January, they've held 14 personal property auctions with the platform. Seven of those (with an eighth on the way) involved a single estate - the lifetime collection of William Schmidt. So far, over 1,500 lots from the estate have been auctioned spanning categories as diverse as toys, railroadiana, stoneware, advertising, graniteware, and cast iron.

The seventh installment, which ran March 25-April 1 featured 225 lots, with advertising pieces, trunks, and blanket chests, Bruce Fox aluminum tableware, along with farm items like milking stools and farm implement seats among the offerings.

While prices across the first six installments regularly went to high three-figure and occasional four-figure sums, this sale seemed to meet price resistance around \$300. The

## Fuller Brush man cleans up with collectors

BY LARRY LEMASTERS

In 1948, Red Skelton starred as Red Jones, a down-and-out worker, trying to make good as a door-to-door salesman in The Fuller Brush Man. Prior to selling for Fuller Brush, Red was fired from every job he tried. While this show is a comedy, except for the name and a few other changes, the story could be that of Alfred C. Fuller, the founder of the Fuller Brush Company.


As a child, the 11th of 12, Fuller began picking berries for a neighbor. He earned 1 cent per quart, and on a good day, if he hustled, he earned 30 cents for a long, 12-hour workday. Of those early workdays, Fuller once said, "The only way I learned how to earn money was by giving a definite measure of production for it. There was no loafing on the job, no fringe benefits that encouraged idleness."

Realizing that productivity was booming in big cities, Fuller left the farm at age 18 and moved to Boston to live with his sister and make his fortune. Three years later, after moving from job to job, he was selling brushes door-to-door for William Staples. Finally, in 1906, at the young age of 21, Alfred Fuller decided that he could make a superior brush product — better and more useful than anything on the market, so, working from a bench





between the coal bin and furnace in his sister's basement, Fuller made his brushes and founded The Fuller Brush Company. Fuller set out to make, in his own words, "...the best products of their kind in the world."

Fuller spoke to his customers, housewives and maids, and asked them "what kind of brushes they needed" and "what work should a brush perform?" He then built better brushes and took them into his customers' homes so that the women could see how well the brushes worked. This was the true birth of door-to-door sales in America that later would sweep the country, selling everything from brushes to vacuums to encyclopedia sets.

The work ethic Fuller learned in the berry fields of Nova Scotia paid off. Fuller Brush salesmen drew no salary from the company. Each salesman was paid a commission based on their own sales. So, the harder one worked, the more income one could earn.

By 1910 The Fuller Brush Company had 270 dealers throughout the United States. All were following the business plan and ethics of the still-20-something Alfred Fuller.

Fuller's success was built on a few strong principles — he believed in personal relationships. and he always tried to keep his word to everyone. He exhibited cheerfulness to all and strove to treat all people fairly.

Fuller Brush Company's motto reflects the attitude of the man who founded it: "With equal opportunity to all and due consideration for each person involved in every transaction, a business will succeed." From the beginning, Alfred Fuller established three basic rules for his company: 1) Make it work; 2) Make it last; and 3) Guarantee it no matter what. Today, a century later, The Fuller Brush Company still is guided by these words.

The Fuller Brush Company became a cultural icon known for its hard-working sales force. The company revolutionized the manufacturing process for brushes and made door-to-door selling practical, acceptable, and rewarding.

Today, people still buy Fuller Brushes, and collectors search antique stores, estate sales, and flea markets for Fuller Brush merchandise and marketing items.

Besides looking for movie posters of Red Skelton's The Fuller Brush Man, collectors search for Walt Disney's The Three Little Pigs where the Big Bad Wolf is disguised as a Fuller Brush man and, of course, some of the fabulous and unusual products that Fuller Brush has sold over the years.

Perhaps the strangest item that Fuller Brush ever sold was a "Holiday"

snowman, complete with paper decorations. No doubt modeled after Frosty, Fuller's snowman, in good condition, sells for around \$40 on the secondary market.

Fuller also sold "manly" items, such as "Seafarer After Shave" that came in a 7 ½ inch seafarer bottle. Made in Japan, these bottles are worth about \$35 today.

Fuller Brush even published its own magazine — the Fuller Brush Magazine — back in the late 1950s and early 1960s. Each issue, in good condition, brings about

Some Fuller Brush items, such as its shaving brush, were made with Bakelite handles, so they are cross-collectible. And some items, such as a Fuller Brush letter opener, are considered advertising pieces; especially since the plastic ones date from the 1930s.


In many ways Fuller Brush represents a good and nostalgic time in America. Door-to-door salesmen are today looked upon as nuisances, but there was a day when a clean-cut man walking down the sidewalk with a suitcase full of wares was looked upon as a welcomed guest in most homes. Today, collectors strive to recapture that historic era by searching out Fuller Brush items. Each brush, magazine, or after-shave bottle brings the collector one step closer to experiencing the knock on his door and the call, "Fuller Brush Man!"



## Useful antique furniture sold well at Merritt Auction



GREENVILLE, Mich. — When it comes to workmanship, beauty, and durability, modern furniture just can't compare with the handsome pieces of the past. At a recent online auction that combined a few estates, Merritt Auction Service moved 474 lots of interesting and useful items, but the antique furniture was clearly the highlight of the day. Items were located at the Merritt Auction facility in Greenville with in-person pick up or shipping options after the

The star of the show was the large oak country store display cabinet. Standing approximately 90 inches tall by 48 inches wide, this amazing item was structurally very sound and in clean condition. The oak grain was prominent throughout and the carved details along the sides and across the top really finished the look. There were four generous shelves measuring 29 inches deep and two glass doors to allow items to be viewed. The two drawers on the bottom were highquality construction with dovetailed joints. The unit rested on four steel wheels. It required a high bid of \$1,500 to claim this prize.

glass front presented an attractive option for the collector who wished to protectively display their treasures. Measuring 75 inches tall by 51 inches wide, the four wooden shelves provided 16 inches of depth to hold most any item. It included original hardware and a lock and key for the door. The carvings along the sides and top finished off this beautiful item and a high bid of \$350 took it home. Another slightly smaller oak curved glass cabinet finished at \$235 and a dark-stained double glass door solid oak cabinet or bookcase with wooden lattice decoration, wooden wheels, and eight shelves closed at \$205. Attractively designed, yet very functional, a massive oak high boy six-drawer chest stood 53 inches tall by 40 inches wide. The carved backsplash on top displayed a leaf vine design. The sturdy construction included reinforced sides and dovetail joints in the drawers. It left with a high bid of \$400.

Two other popular wooden furniture items

diverted from the oak theme and were eagerly claimed. A towering Victorian walnut drop front secretary with a glass enclosed three-shelf bookcase measured 8 feet tall by 47 inches wide. This stately item was in excellent condition with the original glass which was very old but intact. The drop front surface provided ample desk space and two wooden cabinet doors below covered additional storage. This cabinet would be a center piece in any home, and it left with a high bid of \$300. An incredibly useful 40-drawer antique painted wood industrial cabinet in very good con-



highest amount of \$375 went to a 12-inch Standard Oil thermometer from 1964 bearing the slogan "Count on American Heating Oils for Heating Comfort." Only two other lots — also advertising pieces —reached the Below: Items like this Cub Cadet bear from International Harvester, which sold for \$230, show the continued popularity of unique advertising pieces.



\$300 threshold. One was a working square Coca-Cola fishtail clock with red and green hands, marked Pam Clock Co. Inc., New Rochelle, N.Y., selling for \$300. The other was an aluminum Coca-Cola door push, labeled "Ice Cold in Bottles" that also hit \$300.

Plenty sold in the \$100-\$299 range, including four additional thermometers. One lot, selling for \$160 contained a Royal Crown Cola branded pair, one scaled in Fahrenheit, the other in Fahrenheit/Celsius. A high bid of \$150 picked up a Double Cola tin thermom-

eter with the slogan "Drink Double Cola - You'll Like It Better". About a quarter of the signs available sold for three figures, including a modern O'Doul's neon beer sign picking up \$220, a vintage 26-inch metal John Deere sign close behind at \$210, and a Buster Brown Socks display going for \$180.

Many other categories had items reaching the three-figure range. Three of nine soda caddies reached that level - a red and yellow RC-Cola one from the 1940s, complete with bottles hit \$275 while another early RC Cola caddie with a rope handle made it to \$120. Of 16 lots of trunks, shipping crates, and chests, two dovetailed blanket chests pulled \$130 and \$100. And, four of the farm implement seats broke \$100, including a cast-iron McCormick seat in original finish that closed at \$110, and a cast-iron Stoddard M-85 seat, marked Dayton Ohio, in original finish, also selling for \$110.

The \$100-plus bidding

continued for several one-off items like a cast iron International Harvester Cub Cadet bear statue from 1949 that snagged \$230, an Art Deco-era scooter in original red paint, selling for \$120, and a pair of wood duck cigarette dispenser boxes for \$170.

Those half-dozen Bruce Fox pieces, attributable to the metalsmith and commercial artist popular from the late 1930s to 1960s, never got out of the two-figure range. Most popular was the numbered 16-inch cast aluminum lobster dish which reached \$95. Another numbered piece, an orchidshaped serving dish was snagged for \$65 while a sumac leaf dish was acquired for just \$60.

One buyer picked up an antique cast iron balance scale made by Torsion Balance Company for \$30. Another scooped up an unusual primitive wood and cast iron ice scooter for just





technology to allow one to use a smart device to remote control and monitor the smoking process. With side wood chip loading, built-in meat probe thermometer, removeable drip pan, this convenient device was claimed with a high bid of \$220.

A few guns were offered, each with its own following. A Springfield Stevens Arms Company single shot 12-gauge shotgun made Massachusetts closed at \$110, as did a Springfield .22 caliber model 187N. A Savage Hiawatha .22 long rifle model 587 that was missing its tube but everything else was intact closed at \$105. Whether purchased for sentimental or collectible reasons, the Daisy Red Ryder BB gun proved very popular. It had the Red Ryder name etched into the wooden gun stock, the Daisy name stamped into the metal, and the original yellow sticker with loading and firing instructions was still attached. Advertised as the most popular BB gun in the world, this classic in good condition closed at \$120. Unrelated to these guns, a 12 pound can of Dupont Hi-Skor 700-X Smokeless Powder, listed as never being opened, drew a final bid of \$200.

An interesting historical remnant proved to be quite popular. It was just the 7.67 heavy barrel with bipod that appeared to be from an Israeli FN FALO battle rifle. It was originally designed in the early 1960s for military use as a squad automatic weapon. This barrel looked like it may not have been used. The auctioneer also showed a photo of the entire gun for comparison. This sturdy weapon was won with a \$180 bid.

Along with the guns, there were several deer head mounts that sold at \$28-40. Duck and turkey mounts finished lower, and a fascinating blowfish specimen closed at \$34. A very elaborate antler mount with approximately 13 points finished at \$50.

The auction also consisted of beautiful glassware, games, toys, useful items, and some costume jewelry. Most of the jewelry was inexpensive, but there was one delicate 14k gold necklace that finished at \$120.Then there were the unique pieces that drew curiosity and interest. For example, the antique "Super Jumbo" slot machine listed in very nice shape, including working lights, a functioning game, and the keys. Interestingly, the front was stamped

"amusement only". This relic of the past was claimed with a high bid of \$205. Only one railroad collectible was present, which was a C&O railroad switch man Adlake Kero lantern with an embossed globe. This interesting memento closed with a high price of \$90. Finally, to exemplify the variety of this

sale, a new in box Briggs Pendant bathtub measuring 60 by 30 inches with left hand drain finished with a bid of \$65.




