Tiny toy vehicles drove away with big prices at Freeland Auction

FREELAND, Mich. Dr. Wallace W. Pike served as a physician in the Flint, Mich., area for more than five decades. He was also a passionate toy collector, a hobby he shared with his four children. They would travel to toy shows and shop mail order catalogs to obtain many hard-to-find models from around the world, particularly racing vehicles. This incredible collection was housed in the family home for years, but it was now time to find other collectors who would enjoy it. This online estate auction was conducted by Freeland Auction Services. The inventory consisted of 900 lots of accurately represented vehicles that ex-



hibited the detail and quality of the cars they were modelled after.

Taking top honors was the Western Models WMS 25 1939 Railton record car.

British flags crossed on the front hood. It was made in England and was offered with the original cardboard box. The actual race car that this model is based on was an aero-engineered race car that in 1938 broke the land speed record with a speed of 353.3 mph. This

sleek silver model claimed the winners circle with a final bid of \$550.

Fruit crate labels touting Mom are popular with collectors

Mothers have led advertising campaigns in America since the Industrial Revolution changed our country in the mid-1800s. Mass production and color lithographing combined techniques to make products that would sell to the average American household. And the one thing that or poor, was mothers.

colorful labels to America, and lithographic labels soon were the rage, becoming the first commercial art. The goal was easy: use bold colors and images to catch the customer's eye and promote USA-grown fruit over European-grown fruit.

ida and California. Companies splashed fancy names and fancy designs on the fruit labels, such as Angora "Cats" brand, Ojai Nordhoff oranges, Moon brand oranges, and Indian Hill citrus fruit. But the most iconic image and name coming out of California on a fruit crate was the Mother's Day pears label.

As the fruit market all Americans had, rich grew larger each season, immense competi-European artists in- tion at the local markets troduced the concept of erupted. Orchard owners, mostly in California, used lithographic labels to bring attention to their fruit. Labels quickly appeared on cedar crates full of fruit and vegetables. Orchards soon chose San Francisco lithographers to produce the needed labels, and the most famous of all these early lithographers was Max Schmidt, a young German immigrant who


bustion engines. The car is fastened or tethered to a central post by a 33-foot steel cable and travels on a circular track. They move amazingly fast. The current world record for the top tether car speed is reported to be 214 miles per hour. The winner in this group was the Ohlsson & Rice Inc. gas powered tether car. This bright red, 8-inch-long vehicle was listed as pre-1950s and came complete with the cast-iron driver. Offered in near-mint condition, it required a final bid of \$450 to drive it away. Five other tether cars by Real McCoy, Cameron Precision, and Thimble Drome sold for \$350-210.

Another eye-catching item that was listed as "museum quality" was a Super Dinky Camion Pinder AVEC Remorque-Cage et fauves 881. It consisted of a truck and trailer that was set up to transport circus animals in cages and was still in the original packaging, including all the wonderful accessories. When fully assembled (this was not as it was new in box) the trailer housed a plastic lion, tiger, and black panther that were visible when the sides of the trailer were folded down. The name translates to trailer cage with wild beasts. This 13-inch-long rig finished with a final bid of \$500.

Corgi models were abundant throughout this sale, but the most popular one was the Corgi Toys rare "Black Beauty" Green Hornet Crime Fighting Car. Offered still mounted to the display package and with the outer original box, this handsome black vehicle touted its "seer and flying radar scanner." With an image of a hornet on the rooftop, the car offered a direct connection to the 1960s television show or the 1940s comic book series. This dashing model left with a high bid of \$325. A Corgi Toys Volkswagen bug 1200 in East African safari trim complete with plastic rhinoceros escaped with a high bid of \$240, while a Corgi Toys Volkswagen breakdown truck 490 die-cast scale model in original box featuring an operating winch with towing hook, hinged toolbox with plated tools, and spring suspension departed with a high bid of \$190. \$160. Promotional models proved to be very desirable, as shown by a Volkswagen produced by German company Cursor-Modell. This Mod 143 promotional model in characteristic red was an accurate representation of the original Volkswagen bug. It was offered with the cardboard box that bore the VW logo, along with "Volkswagenwerk AG". A successful collector added it to their inventory with a high bid of \$190. The Volkswagen name itself also proved to be popular as another rare promotional model by German company Cursor-Modell, a 7.67 green Volkswagen bus with box, was



claimed with a high bid of \$160. The Rolls Royce offered here did not resemble the passenger car that comes to mind with that name. The Western Models WMS 9 1933 Campbell-Rolls Royce Blue Bird was modelled after the land speed record car. Originally commissioned by Malcolm Campbell, a powerful Rolls Royce engine was used to achieve the speed and power he required. The actual car set a record of 272 mph in 1933. This die cast model that was made in England closed with a high bid of \$140.

Among the models of construc-

tion equipment, the one featuring the most incredible detail and precision was the bright yellow Caterpillar Track-Type Tractor CAT D11N die-cast Conrad Dozer. It was new in box and in pristine condition. This mighty midget closed with a bid of \$110. 

Fruit Crate

velopment of pre-printed cardboard boxes forced expensive wooden crates with paper labels into extinction. Even before the first cardboard box fell off the assembly line, historians and collectors were scrounging old barns and warehouses, looking for unused stocks of labels.

As the desire to collect fruit crate labels, as both a thing of value and a work of art, grew, a secondary market developed for them. Today, collectors continue to seek out these paper-bits of history.

Age is one of the primary factors in determining value for fruit crate labels. The oldest—and because of age, the rarest labels date back to the 1880s. Design also plays an important part in the value of fruit crate labels. For some unknown reason, labels from orange crates were more imaginatively designed than labels from other fruit crates; therefore, orange labels are more valued today. Also, California labels are generally worth more than labels promoting Florida or Texas fruit.

Age of a label can also be discerned in its design. Fruit crate labels from the 1880s through the late 1920s had highly detailed, picturesque scenes with a 3-dimensional effect. These types of labels are considered rare and, if found, their prices reflect their rarity. In the late 1920s, advertising art in general changed, becoming simpler, flatter, and bolder — similar to what we would consider

labels, while highly collectible, seldom bring as much on the secondary market as the detailed, earlier labels.


Often collectors specialize in a "type" of fruit crate label. An interesting and desirable type is crate labels with moms either in the name or in the design, such as Mother-in-law oranges, Colonial Mother oranges, Mother Colony brand fruit, Mammy Brand oranges, and Mother and Child lemon citrus fruit. And a fun category of fruit crate labels is women's names, such as Laurie apples, Sweet Sue apples, and Mary Agnes sweet potatoes.

Be aware that some fruit crate labels, such as Mammy brand oranges from Florida, helped spread negative stereotypes about women and people of color.

Pillows with fruit crate label images are great decorating items for collectors, but the pillows often cost far more than



vintage Authentic, fruit crate labels often sell for \$50 -\$150, making a collection of them expensive. But it is possible to accumulate a fun and less expensive collection. Reproduction art print fruit crate labels are high quality and glossy, so they are quite striking, and most of them sell for around \$8, making them affordable. Also, art print labels are 8.75×12.5 inches, so they are large enough to make fabulous wall collections of rare labels that could not be found any other way.


