ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Winchester BSA gun shoots impressive \$3,750 bid

TIPTON, Mich. — Each year a group of auctioneers gets together and puts on a “Super Auc-



tion.” There are 10 different auctions at the same location at the same time with two auction rings going at a time and then switching rings every hour.

This year’s event featured American Eagle Auction and Appraisal, Belhorn Auctions LLC, Braun and Helmer Auction Service, Joseph Saine Auctions, Laura Mantle Auctioneer, Mathias Donat, & David Helmer.

Session one included pottery and estate furniture, along with some great antique smalls in one ring while estate coins sold in the other

ring. A Roseville pottery bowl measuring 6 inches in the blackberry pattern, and a two-handle green Freesia vase, sold together as a set. There was some serious bidding on this gorgeous set and the hammer didn’t fall until it reached the price of \$325. A Czech Art Deco nudes vase in malachite held its own when it sold for \$275.

There was some excitement over a set of three Grand Ledge Sewer tile lions. The first one was on a log and saw the bidding rise to \$110. The second two were sold as a set. One of these was looking right and was signed “Emery 1902”. The second one was signed “Z.W.S.”. They brought a very impressive high bid of \$400.

An incredible Buck Jones collection was offered. It was all contained in a scrapbook, which did show water damage. There were two signed photographs, more than 100 lobby cards, magazine cut-outs, posters, 450 official photos, Daisy advertisements, and 46 arcade cards. It was a fascinating collection that had taken years to amass. The new owner quickly snatched it up for safekeeping with his winning bid of \$450.

Another one of the fun pieces was a very intricate handmade neoclassical bird cage. This wooden structure was for a very special bird as it was complete with a nice tall turret in the center and four smaller turrets on all the corners. It was a very interesting piece as the more you studied it, the more details jumped out at you. It sold for \$125.

There was an awesome oak cabinet that generated a lot of interest. It was a Robert J. Goldsmith,

marked piece from Wabash Ave., Chicago, Ill. It consisted of a beautiful grain from quarter-sawn oak with sliding glass doors. This was a massive piece and most likely adorned the wall in an old pharmacy or general store. The new owners had inspected it carefully before the auctions started and their final bid price of \$1,200 marked the piece sold.

A very impressive bed-

Moser glass touted as ‘King of Glass, Glass of Kings’

Ludwig Moser and Karlovy Vary founded Ludwig Moser & Söhne in 1857. The workshop was originally founded to polish and engrave blank, often-large glass pieces. The company became famous for engraving blank glass from Loetz,

Meyr’s Neffe and Harrachov. Within a few years, Moser began designing and making its own art glass products.

In 1873, at the Vienna International Exhibition, Ludwig Moser was awarded a medal for merit, which inspired him. Later that same year he was appointed the exclusive supplier of

art glass to Emperor Franz Joseph I of Austria.

After winning medals at the World Exhibitions in Paris in 1879 and 1889, Moser, in 1893, purchased a glass factory in Meierhofen bei Karlsbad to create a full service glassworks company. Moser named his company Karlsbader Glasindustrie

Gesellschaft Ludwig Moser & Söhne, and at its height, it employed 400 glass workers, making it a large factory.

In 1904, Moser began a new century by becoming the glassmaker to the kings of Europe. First, the company received a warrant to supply glass to the Imperial Court of the Emperor of Austria, and a few years later it became the glass supplier for England’s King Edward VII.

It was during this time that Moser’s sale’s slogan became *King of Glass, Glass of Kings* due to the company’s association with famous clientele such as Edward VII, Pope Pius XI, King Luís I of Portugal and his wife, Maria Pia of Savoy, and Turkish sultan Abdul Hamid II.

In 1915, Moser was awarded a medal at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition. Louis Comfort Tiffany, comment-





ing on Moser winning the medal, said, “It is well deserved for his outstanding work in hot Bohemian glass with applied decorations.”

room set brought good money. This was a Bernhardt set which included a four-post king canopy bed with the mattress, a three-section wardrobe and two end tables. It was beautifully done in oak and the bidding kept climbing rapidly on this one. The final sale price was \$950.

An equally pretty bedroom set was all in wicker. This was a Henry Link wicker Lexington bedroom set of four pieces which included the bed, a tall boy dresser, and end table and a vanity with an oval mirror. This set

was in great condition and sold for \$500.

Jewelry was a big draw during Session 2. A set of three Victorian hair work pieces included a gold two-sided locket pendent and two reversible hair work pieces. These sold for \$160. Two pieces of Victorian hair jewelry sold for \$485. The first one was a woven hair bracelet with a fourteen-carat gold hair work locket. The other was a ten-carat hair work pin with a locket on the back.

Two Edwardian cameos were ten-carat gold. One was a man with a sword and the other was a silver frame of a king with a harp. They sold for \$225. A pair of 14-carat gold citrine cameo earrings and an emerald lizard pin made the bidding climb all the way to \$400, while a pair of opal rings sold for \$425. One ring was a 10-carat opal and ruby and the other was a fourteen-carat opal and diamond.

Bringing the same \$425 bid was a set of two Victorian pins. One was a 14-carat snake on a crescent moon and the other was a 14-carat pin with an Egyptian scarab. Seems the Victorian ladies liked the creepy crawly things.

A 14-carat gold bracelet with garnets brought an impressive bid of \$800. However, the bid-

ding got serious when a 14-carat pearl, garnet and diamond bangle and a nine-carat bangle with amethyst decorations were pocketed for \$1,100. A set of two Victorian child's bangles kept the prices high as they sold for \$1,250. One was a 10-carat and the other was a 14-carat, both with pearl decorations.

If you wanted to own a set of silver service, you better have just raised your bidder number and left it in the air. The bids came in extremely rapidly on this one. It was a Towle "Old Colonial" 95-piece sterling silver service set for eight. It was 111.34 ounces and sold for a great price of

\$1,900.

Moving on to a lifetime collection of military pins, a rare World War I Naval embroidered silk "Remembrance of my Cruise Around the World" with a photo of the US Navy diver was beautifully framed. It showed a printed map of his route and was in a 23 by 29-inch walnut frame. The condition was excellent. The back of the picture identified the USN diver as Chief Gunners Mate Stephen J. Drellishak. He set a depth record of 274 feet off Long Island Sound on Nov. 3, 1914 while on the USS Walker. In March of 1915, Chief Gunner Drellishak was part of a four-man dive team who successfully salvaged the US Navy's first submarine accident off the island of Oahu, Hawaii. The Navy lost

21 of the crew from acid-eaten rivets which flooded the vessel quickly. This information comes from a note found on the back of this piece. This final bid price on this beautiful piece of history was \$425.


A recruiting poster for World War I was dated 1915. This poster was trying to entice single men into the British military service. It measured 19 by 29 inches in a gilt frame. It was in excellent condition with original light mailing folds. It was purchased in 1995 from the Henry Ford Museum collection through an exclusive mail-in bid event with copies of documents included. It sold for \$275.

The firearm collection drew the most bidders. The star of this show was a Winchester Model 9422XTR, 22 caliber S-L-L-R. This Eagle

Scout lever action rifle had the Boy Scouts of American medal coin in the stock. It also had a spade design and other engravings. It was a commemorative etching piece and came in the original wooden box. The final sale price on this star weaponry was \$3,750.

A Browning BAR .338 Winchester rifle with both ram and bear engravings was offered for sale. It had some checkering, plus the added draw of a Leopold 2x7 Vari-X scope and leather strap. This one made the bidding hard to keep up with as the bids rolled in rather quickly. The final sale price came in at \$1,650.

Trade cards used imagery and gimmicks to promote

Trade cards first appeared in 17th-century Europe. They were small, sturdy pieces of paper advertising the wares of tradesmen. At the advent of chromolithography over a century later, their texts were embellished with eye-catching multi-color images. Though trade cards were found in America after the Civil War, they gained widespread popularity following the 1867 Philadelphia Centennial.

Scores were custom-made advertisements for products or services. Others offered simple, pre-printed stock images with blank areas front and back that, when customized with company names, addresses, and merchandise details, suited any commodity and were less costly to print. A single design could be used by multiple advertisers. Cards could be found featuring images as diverse as elves, angels, pets, children, veggie people, and politicians.

Though many trade cards were simple, others were more complex novelties. Some, when inverted, transformed frowning faces to smiling ones, or revealed surprises when held up to light. Some featured playful optical illusions or hidden objects. Others, like popular

pop-up books, featured charming twists, pull tabs, or transformational before-and-after slats. Trade cards sometimes enticed customers with replicas of the products they promoted. Die cut oblongs plugging pickles, for example, were often colored green. Those plugging watermelons were rosy red.

Manufacturers not only distributed millions of souvenir trade cards at major exhibitions, but also tucked them into their merchandise packaging. They also supplied them to traveling salesmen and shopkeepers, who handed them out, like prizes, with every purchase. Trade card marketing value, as an advertising

medium, was enormous. Their images, backed by persuasive texts, were not only alluring; but also built profitable long-term name and brand recognition. As a result, few businesses, large or small, failed to promote them.

Specialty shops for example, distributed trade cards advertising corsets, suspenders, umbrellas, gloves, suits, or trousers. Cosmetic companies advertised soap powder, hair grower, toothpaste, and facial powder. Household manufacturers touted everything from kettles, canisters, washboards, and sad irons to trendy treadle sewing machines. Tobacco shops plugged ever-popular cigars,

cigarettes, and chewing tobacco. Farm suppliers pushed plows, reapers, wagons, windmills, seed, and fertilizers.

Trade cards, like news media of today, also advertised theater, dance, musical, and sporting events like roller skating, sailing, snow shoeing, and sledding. Others, depicting acrobats, actors, or magicians, were come-hithers for exhibitions, competitions, fairs, carnivals, and amusement parks. Moreover, as New Years, Valentine's Day, or Halloween approached, trade cards persuaded people to purchase themed toys, gifts, and decorations.

During the 1880s, health-conscious Victorians were especially concerned with disease. Doctors, druggists, and vendors of dubious wares distributed trade cards advertising sure-cure tonics, herbals, liniments, and other nostrums. Some, like Dr. Buckland's Scotch Oats Essence, claimed to treat opium habits, drunkenness, paralysis, sciatica, and epilepsy. Some claimed that plant-based barley malt, ginger ale, and sarsaparilla remedied indigestion, and nausea. Tarrant's Seltzer Aperient, claimed not only to cure indigestion, but also allay sick headache, sour stomach, vomiting, fever, and skin eruptions "arising from impure or

over-heated blood."

Since infectious diseases, like diphtheria, dysentery, and scarlet fever, threatened young lives, many mid-19th century trade cards promoted healthful safeguards. One particularly appealing example pictures a

cherubic child reaching for a bottle of Scott's Emulsion (active ingredient: cod liver oil) "because he likes it." "He was a delicate, sickly little fellow, thin and wasted," reads its reverse text. But when dosed as directed, it declares, he became a "rollicking

healthy boy" with color in his cheeks.

Trade cards also promoted products peculiar to their time, like Eskay's Albumenized Food, a combination of easily digested cereal and egg albumin credited with nourished old and young alike. Others advertised "magnetized" foods that, due to specialized production methods, promised invigorating vitalization.

Indeed, food-related trade cards were the most abundant of all. Many recommended wholesome products like Highland Evaporated Cream, Junket Buttermilk Tablets or Imperial Granum Medical Food, a milk and wheat gruel for nursing mothers, infants, and invalids.

During this era, numerous households baked delicate rolls and pastries from scratch. Since ovens were often unreliable — and many believed that loud noises caused cakes to fall, cream of tartar, magic "infallible" yeast, and all sorts of baking powders were bestsellers. Trade cards also advertised products like exotic spices, Uncle Jerry's Pan Cake Flour and Cottolene shortening, an innovative beef suet and

cottonseed oil alternative to lard. Others promoted convenient, pre-prepared foods like Counselman's Royal Hams, Libby's Corned Beef, Armour Breakfast Sausage, and Heinz Tomato Soup.

Due to their fondness for preserving keepsakes, many people kept the trade cards and collected them in albums or scrapbooks. To the delight of manufacturers, this pleasant pastime not only increased sales; it also transformed enthusiastic collectors, typically adolescent girls, into unwitting brand endorsers. Through the 1890s, cards were often produced in sets. As a result, some sought those featuring unfolding narratives. Others collected single-topic cards depicting, say, sewing notions, scenes from Shakespeare plays, or sweets like rock candy, molasses bars, or wine gums. In fact, the term "trading card" may have originated because the girls likely completed sets by trading cards among themselves.

In the early 1900s, interest in trade cards slowly faded away as they were replaced by more cost-effective magazine and newspaper advertising. In time, avidly assembled albums and scrapbooks were tucked away in bureau drawers and attics.

Decades later, when scholars and collectors showed renewed interest, many realized that these forgotten volumes were historical treasures. Each of their cards offers tantalizing clues to the past. When seen as a whole, however, each album reflects not only the collector's worldview but also, through text and images, a fascinating overview of mid-19th century life.

Vintage trading cards

reveal not only favorite foods, fashions, pastimes, and leisure activities of their time. They also reveal aspects of family life, gender roles, and health concerns, as well as accepted values, cares, and desires. In addition to aspects of social history, trade cards also reflect the evolution of printing techniques, advertising, and commerce.

Many trading cards on the market today have been carefully sourced

from these historic albums. They can range from a few dollars to thousands if in pristine condition and considered rare.

Collectors may find Victorian Trade Cards: Historical Reference & Value Guide, a catalog and price guide by Dave Cheadle and Russ Mascieri, of interest. This beautifully illustrated volume, arranged by categories, is not only a feast of historic information, but also offers

practical collecting tips. Similarly, The Before and After Trade Card, written by the noted collector Ben Crane, features over 200 entertaining before-and-after cards. Each depicts a problem, then "solves" it through visual use of its advertised product. This intriguing book, arranged by category, also features a handy bibliography, index of advertised products, and an index of the printers who produced these cards.

Perhaps Ludwig Moser's greatest achievement was developing a lead-free sodium-potassium glass that is far more ecologically friendly than most 20th century glass. Moser's new glass was extremely hard and durable and it remains the basic glass of the Moser company for most of its products in the 21st century.

Following the death of Ludwig Moser in 1916, his son, Leo, took over the company, expanding it by moving into Art Nouveau glass pieces that earned a Grand Prize award at the Paris International Exhibition of Decorative Art in 1925.

As Art Nouveau designs flourished, Moser produced its most notable and desirable pieces — its famed *Fipop* series. *Fipop* glass involved heavily engraved glass pieces with images of lilies. This series of glass became instantly popular and several American glass companies tried to reproduce it, calling their work *Woodland* and *Deerwood*. But Moser signed its pieces, so original Moser glass is easily distinguished from common American glassware.

For almost five decades Moser glass suffered but somehow managed to remain vibrant. First the

Great Depression of the 1930s greatly harmed Moser, forcing the company to release over 160 employees. But the true harm came in the rise of Nazi Germany. Leo Moser, a Jew, was forced to resign from the company his father founded, and in 1938

he and his family fled Czechoslovakia when Hitler annexed most of it. Leo Moser escaped after his country was occupied by Nazi Germany.

Following World War II, Moser glass company was more or less nationalized by the Communist regime

that controlled the entire Czech glass industry. The international reputation of Moser helped it to retain some independence, but it was not until the fall of the USSR in 1989 that Moser was once again a free company to design and sell glass as it chose to do so.

Novice collectors or simply lovers of art glass may want to plan a vacation to the Czech Republic. Moser's factory museum is open to the public and tells a 150-year history of the

work of Ludwig Moser with more than 2,000 Moser pieces on display.

Today, Moser is a luxury glass company in Karlovy Vary, Czech Republic with a United States distribution company in Virginia. Moser is known for manufacturing expensive stemware, vases, candlesticks, etc. that is used in palaces, restaurants, and homes. While quite expensive, Moser produces some of the most collected 20th century decorative glass.


