Prices ranged from \$6 for a single box of Western Super-X 22 rimfire cartridges to \$32 for a lot of 4 Super-X 22 long rifle shells. There were also nine lots of vintage animal traps, including a lot of four Conibear traps picking up \$19, and a Sterling MJ 500 Fox and Coyote Trap that sold for \$16. Toy collectors can still move milk with miniature trucks

In "Fiddler on the Roof," Tevye is a poor Jewish milkman, who delivers milk in a horsedrawn cart. Before the movie is over Tevye himself is pulling the cart. A pulled cart represents the earliest type of milk delivery.

Milk delivery used to be an important part of a family's daily life that was often taken for granted. As towns grew getting milk from the cow to the farmer to the grocery store or directly to a consumer's back porch grew. Today, not only the history of milk delivery but also the conveyances used to deliver fresh milk is important to historians and collectors.

delivery in Milk America began with the farmers, like Tevye,

More and more families began seeking out local dairy farmers to purchase milk from, but it soon became apparent that farmers needed to deliver their milk if they wished to sell it. blossomed. The earliest milkmen or farmers carried milk in bulk containers, not in bottles. Using a dipper, the deliveryman would dip milk into a family's milk pitcher or home container. In 1878, the first milk bottle was patented, making milk delivery easier, more

Since homes had iceboxes, not refrigerators, daily milk delivery was necessary to prevent spoilage.

In the 20th century, insulated milk boxes appeared on the front or rear porches of houses. allowing the person to place empties into the box and allowing the milkman to deliver or replace the empties with

ment for the milk was often left inside the box.

When motorized transportation came on the milk trucks of all types replaced the horse and cart, revolutionizing milk delivery.

Following World War II, the rise in refrigeration and automobile ownership allowed for the rise in larger grostores. People cerv







animal traps to \$10 for another lot with a Duke model paired with another small trap.

Sports enthusiasts also had a lot to pursue, including four Louisville bats. A Hillerich & Bradsby Mickey Mantle model MM4 sold at \$7. Right behind it, a Hillerich & Bradsby Johnny Bench Louisville Slugger got \$6. Two little league bats, a Hillerich & Bradsby Norm Cash little league 21-inch bat pulled \$7 while a Louisville Pro Willie Horton 30-inch little league bat went for \$6.

In addition to the ammunition, traps, and bats, sporting lots also contained vintage tennis rackets (\$4), restorable antique snowshoes (\$6), and even a Walker Bay 9-foot, three-person sailboat with a new rudder (\$235).

Lots of automobilia and petroliana came next. Among the collections of hubcaps and oil cans were 22 lots of license plates, mostly from Michigan. There were also dozens of lots of bottles and assorted glassware. One of the highest amounts (\$28) went for a 1970s era 5-gallon drinking water bottle. A lot of 16 vintage beer bottles reached \$30; another containing 18 beer bottles was taken for \$18. A group of 16 clear and green canning jars, most with lids. sold for \$16 while close behind, a single ½-gallon Lockport Mason canning jar with lid bid to \$14.

tanker trucks carry milk, and nearly overnight the need for home delivery ended, and the delivery milkman became extinct.

Today, milkmen and their conveyances are kept alive in the collections of tov and model milk trucks.

There are several different Marx, Dinky, Matchbox, and Buddy L milk trucks on the secondary markets. One of the most expensive is the Marx "Diary Milk delivery trucks, circa Truck" from the 1930s. 1950s, that are also Originally painted "milk" white, these sheet metal trucks have three milk churns, cans, in the back that fit inside a slotted bed. Labeled "Marcrest Diary," these trucks are offered on eBay in used (badly in need of restoration) condition for around \$165. Occasionally, one of these Marx milk trucks are offered in mint condition with original box for around \$700, making them one of the more expensive toy milk trucks around.

Dinky and Matchbox were competing companies, both based in England, but Dinky easily wins the milk truck race. Matchbox produced a nice milk truck

in the 1960s with cream-colored milk bottles that is valued at around \$90 today (mint with box), but Dinky provided children and then collectors with a plethora of milk trucks, including its die cast Studebaker milk truck of the 1950s. Labeled "Nestle," these trucks came with 10 milk churns. Today, with original box and all parts, in played with condition, these trucks are valued at \$1,100.

Dinky also produced Citroen and Ford milk expensive "toys" for a collector. The Citroen milk truck is valued at over \$1,000 today, and the Dinky Ford milk truck is valued at over \$800.

An interesting toy milk truck to watch for is the Sifo wooden milk truck from the 1950s. Sifo Company (also Sifo Toys) produced wooden children's toys, primarily filling an early educational niche. Sifo made their toys in Norway, Mich., so they are all "Made in USA." The company closed its doors in 1975. Sifo's wooden milk truck, with all six milk churns but in used condition, is valued at \$70.

Some rare, hard to

find milk trucks includes INGAP Padova's tin wind-up truck from the 1930s with six churns (\$650), Richard's Toy Company's, of Canada, ride-on "Milk Truck, "circa 1940s, that is made of pressed steel (\$500), and Trujillo's Leche "Milk" truck. Trujillo is a Mexican toy company from the 1960s, and its milk truck is valued at \$450 on today's markets.

There are lots of wonderful and exciting antique toy milk trucks just waiting for new collectors.







Coleman tool collection will power Chupp/United Auctions offering

SHIPSHEWANA, Ind. -Hanging in Myrna Coleman's home in western New York is a poignant sign.

It reads: "We may not have it all together, but together we have it all."

During those 26 years, Dan and Myrna Coleman built what is regarded by many as the largest hand tool collection in America. Given that it's difficult to quantify such a claim, owning more than 2,600 levels, 500 plus hammers, and numerous hand wood planes while building and outgrowing their museum many times

over lends credibility to such bragging rights.

Not that the Coleman ever bragged, but Auctioneer Greg Carter, with United Auctions of Utica, New York, said he has heard the claim "at least 20 times" from tool collectors.

"I've also heard that," Myrna says.

Dan and Myrna worked together as title pipeline analysts for gas and oil companies, throughout much of the United States. Their playtime was filled by auctions, flea markets, antique tool shows and anywhere they could see a new tool or hear a new story. See Chupp page 12



"The job enabled us to have the collection," she said. "Then it got so big, that the collecting overtook the job. It became our priority."

They also amassed more than 2,000 pieces of American pottery, including Hull, Hall, Roseville, Fiesta and more, but their true passion was hand tools.

Myrna, herself, was interested in collecting hammers, "any hammer 7-pounds and under." While traveling on assignments that could take anywhere from a few weeks to more than a year, they became active members of tool clubs in several states. They worked and played right up until last Christmas, before 84-year-old Dan became ill and died in February.

A large part of the hand tool collection, co-brokered by Carter, will be selling at Chupp Auctions in northern Indiana. About 400 special antique tools from the Coleman collection will be sold during Chupp's auction on June 3-5.

Carter, the western New York auctioneer, who is working with Chupp Auctions, said a decision was made months ago to have the sale in Indiana because business in New York was so haphazardly governed during the Covid pandemic.

"We just thought that Indiana was a little more stable," he said. "It had remained mostly in business throughout much of the pandemic." But, Carter added, as a gesture of goodwill to western New York buyers, United Auctions will bring sold items back to its home base – free of shipping charges – for successful bidders

This sale will mark the first offered segment of the massive Coleman Collection which Carter said will continue to sale "well into 2022."

Bidding for the auction will be live at the Chupp auction house in Shipshewana, in addition to online bidding with LiveAuctioneers, Invaluable and AuctionZip.

The three-day auction will also feature the Olan and Janie Bentley Collection of cut out wrenches, antique and vintage seed corn advertising and farm primitives.

From the Coleman Collection alone, there will be offered more than 80 levels, numerous hand planes, chisel sets, braces, hammers and hatchets, Stanley four-square tools, Keen Kutter tools, a 1918 framed Stanley calendar, several anvils, primitive and machinist toolboxes and advertising postcards.

The Coleman Collection includes several near mint condition tools in display cases. Chief among these sets is a Bedrock corrugated plane set, including every model made by Stanley Works during the early 20th century, including the Model No. 602 (C), considered the "Holy Grail" of plane collectors. In addition, a Stanley Bedrock No. 602 will also be sold in a separate lot.

Another "star of the sale" is a store display case of Stanley Bailey planes, initially found by Myrna, which includes all the early Bailey planes from the No. 1 through the No. 8 Models.

"I always liked to surprise Dan with my finds," Myrna says. "He would get so excited. He did much of the research and I tagged many of the tools with information on their background. I always liked

the history you could feel from holding an old tool in your hands. In great part, this was what built America.

"I collect some of what people would think are the oddest things, like old iron register (heating) covers and foot pedals and treadles from sewing machines, especially the real ornate decorated ones. They make great wall hangers.

"It might be a little crazy, but life is so interesting. How can you pass these things up?"

Among the rarities is a 6-inch Disston & Sons brass advertising ashtray from the pioneering saw manufacturing company.

On June 4, the second day of the Chupp Auction, will focus on the Olen and Janie Bentley collection, which includes more than 75 cut-out wretches, including early tools made by C&J, John Bull, Bradley Wonders, Casaday, Comet and W Plow Co. Bentley's esteemed collection of seed corn advertising items

include more than 150 seed corn license plate toppers, more than 200 seed corn signs and more than 60 seed corn bags.

Also included in the 3-day sale will be a salesman sample John Deere grain drill box, which is expected to be highly contested among collectors.

Not to be overlooked is a "one of a kind" exact scale model of an early designed Buick created by an employee in the company's experimental department in 1921. Measuring 42 inches long, 16 inches wide and 19 inches tall, the model was a showpiece of the 1923 Detroit Car Show. It was entirely handmade, except for the Goodrich Silvertown tires that were purchased for \$4 each




