Tools and advertising were hot at Chupp/United

SHIPSHEWANA, Ind. - Myrna Coleman collected hammers, specifically hammers weighing less than seven pounds. She added them to the collection of her husband, Dan, who collected hand tools. During their 26 years together, they amassed what thought to be one of the largest hand tool collections in the United States, which included more than 500 hammers.

When Dan died in February, Myrna decided have an auction. Auctioneer Greg Carter with United Auctions of Utica, N.Y., was contacted to take on this huge assignment. This led to a joining with Chupp Auctions in Shipshewana to help with the selling. The sale also included items belonging to Olen and Janie Bentley, who also

had some great tools, seed corn advertising pieces, and some pieces that were one-of-a-kind items. Their collection included some really unique cut-out wrenches.

The piece that stole the show was no surprise. A scale model Buick car, all handmade except for the Goodrich Silvertown tires that were purchased for was just \$4 each in 1921, was a real treasure. This model was displayed in the 1923 Detroit Car Show. It was made by Joe Borromey, who worked in the Buick experimental department in 1921. The exact scale model measure 42 by 16 by 19 inches. The model had no engine and the steering wheel gear was stripped. One brace in the soft top was broken and one engine cover bracket was missing. But it was an amazing piece and when

Key guns could protect a jailer as he unlocked cell

There was a time when gun makers and lock makers teamed up to create a weapon that could be used in self defense by

Key guns were developed so a jailor could lock fired guns; however, or unlock a jail door and, if an inmate tried escaping, the jailer could shoot the inmate through the key that he was still

key guns were chambered for smaller musket balls, such as .32 or .38 calibers. They were made for about 200 years between the 17th and 19th centuries.

Key guns were made when flintlock and percussion cap mechanisms some key guns were throw backs to earlier times and used matchlock mechanisms that required a cigarette or holding. For this reason, match to ignite a fuse

hanging from a touchhole (they worked basically like lighting a fire cracker). Jailers could not both turn the key and have their finger on the trigger, so matchlock key guns were often pre-

Key guns were primitive weapons that were not very reliable. For instance, once the key was inserted into a lock and turned, the gun barrel could not quickly be removed from the door lock and aimed at a prisoner, making firing key guns dangerous for the jailor.

A combination of key and gun are rare today, collectors eagerly watch for them at auction. But pricing these miniature weapons is often difficult. One was

offered on the television show Pawn Stars that was said to be from the 1600s and was ultimately valued at \$450. But that seems low for a key gun in working condition. However, in August 2020, Pawn Stars purchased a key gun, made in Nuremberg, which was from the 1600s and considered top of the line for such guns. The cost was \$5,200 with a possible auction price of \$10,000 given. www.icollector.com offered a cast iron matchlock key gun, circa 1600s, at auction in 2014. This gun sold for \$1,500.

The difficult part of buying a key gun is the term "working condition." No one in his right mind would shoot a 400-yearold pistol, but, on the other hand, if no one

shoots it, no one knows if due to acid and common it is truly in working condition. Most collectors have nothing to worry about since these guns are rare enough that most collectors only see them in their dreams.

Another serious consideration is the material used to manufacture the gun. Some guns were made of cast iron, and many replica guns still are, but a cast iron gun corrodes badly when fired

In 2011, www.thefirearmblog.com showed a black power gun, with touch hole, that was said to be a .32 caliber black powder jailer's key gun from the 1850s. This is possible since the purported date is towards the end of the key gun era. A touch hole gun was dangerous because it did

the bidding opened up, the price just kept on climbing. Bids came in very quickly as the in-house and online bidders competed to be the new owner of the prized model car. And the selling price wasn't cheap. You had to have deep pockets to put this car in your collection. The final hammer didn't fall until the price reached a very impressive \$18,000 bid.

A red Van Brunt grain drill display measured 36 by 24 inches. Sporting yellow lettering that declared it a John Deere piece, this grain drill box store display was meant to sit on a countertop. It sold for \$10,000. A Minneapolis-Moline tractor and farm machinery sign was in very good condition. The bright red letters stood out against the black background. It was surrounded by a wood frame and measured 60 by 36 inches. The final sale price on this advertising collectible was \$7,750.

Sticking with the advertising signs, a "Chilled Oliver Plows" sign brought a selling price of \$6,000. This one measured 96 by 13 inches. It was sandstone on wood and was in very good condition. It had a new wood frame surrounding it. A second "Chilled & Steel, Walking and Riding Plows" sign measured 48 by 5 inches. It was a single-sided piece and sold for \$2,000. And an embossed single-sided Oliver sign measuring 28 by 10 inches sold for \$1,600. It was marked "Clarke Hdwre Co., Culpeper, VA" and was in very good condition.

A very different kind of advertising piece was put out by Borden. A mechanical cow standing 70 inches tall was in excellent condition. It was still in working order. She seemed to be right at home in her red gingham dress. She was holding a young cow dressed in blue and white and had a kitchen towel draped over

her arm. This display was sold for the bid price of

> How much would you pay for an old wrench? Seemed the collectors of small hand tools had no bottoms in their pockets when the cut-out wrenches were offered. A C & J cut-out wrench measured a mere 7 inches. This cast iron piece refused to take a back seat as the bidding kept rising quickly when it was offered for sale. The final sale price stopped at \$5,800. A Hortu & JR cut-out wrench didn't show any weakness when the bidding was opened up on this French tool. It had raised lettering across the center of the wrench which spelled out the origin of the small 6-inch tool. The price didn't stay small since the bidding reached an impressive \$4,250 before it was sold.

A Bradleys Wonder D99 cut out wrench measured 14 inches in length. This cast iron work tool reached a selling price of \$1,000. An Ames cutout wrench was a very different looking work tool. This one measured 9 inches and had two heads on one end and one on the other. It brought a final bid price of \$1,100. And a John Bull 11-inch cutout wrench held its own with a sale price of \$1,000.

There were several tool planes offered for sale. A Stanley Bailey corrugated plane set included all models and the Stanley No. 1. The case measured 32 by 47 by 9 inches and there was a stand to put it on. This store display looked showroom ready, appearing to be right from the salesman that delivered it to the store owner to help sell the Stanley Bailey planes. The hammer didn't come down on this piece of history until the bidders reached a price of \$3,400.

A Stanley No. 1 smooth plane was sold for \$1,100 as was a Stanley N. 444 tongue and groove plane. A Stanley Bedrock #602 plane came in right behind these with a winning bid of \$1,000. And a Stanley No. 212 plane

was sold for \$850.

All these tools had to be contained somewhere and a thirty-drawer machinist chest certainly offered up plenty of options. This vintage piece measured 30 by 54 by 21 inches. It was marked "Hamilton Manufacturing" and had one drawer that had been replaced. The drawer pulls appeared to be all original and the dark patina testified to its age. The bid price to load this

unit up was \$2,000.

A model of an Old Towne, Maine, canoe was made by Guy Cyr. This one measured 66 inches in length and was one of only four that he made. It sold for \$1,200. An Old Towne canoe/sailboat with rudder measured 16 inches long. It had the original rudder and was a sailboat version of the canoe. The seat caning was damaged on this piece but it still sold for \$800.

A S.S. Smidley feeder was a salesman sample

and measured a mere 4 by 9 by 8 inches. It was marked "Wash, C.H. OH" and was in good condition. Made mostly of wood which had been painted orange, it had a tin roof. The advertising printing was still in great readable condition also. The sale price on this one was \$2,100.





Truman Presidential Library reopens after renovation

INDEPENDENCE, Mo. (AP) — After nearly two years of renovations complicated by COVID-19 restrictions, the Harry S. Truman Presidential Library and Museum is ready to welcome visitors back with an updated focus on how Truman's legacy resonates today.

The museum opens to the public July 2, with hours and visitor numbers initially restricted because of pandemic regulations.

Visitors will find a museum completely reimagined during its most extensive renovation since it opened in 1957 in Truman's hometown of Independence, Mo., an eastern suburb of Kansas City. The nearly \$30 million project includes a sparkling new entrance; many more artifacts, photographs, videos and films; and exhibits that encourage visitors to touch and interact with displays.

One solemn gallery showcases Truman's first four months in office, some of the most consequential months in U.S. history. Germany surrendered, the U.S. dropped nuclear bombs on Japan to end World War II, and world leaders at the Potsdam conference determined the makeup of the postwar world.

Nearly everyone knows Truman dropped the bombs, but his legacy was formed in the next 7 1/2 years of his presidency, when he set out to win the peace and put the world back together, said Museum Director Kurt Graham.

"If you focus only on the bomb, you miss the heart of his legacy. My job isn't to say he got everything right, but I think it's important for people, especially young people, to realize that Harry Truman had more influence on the world they have inherited than most other U.S. presidents," he said.

After starting in the new 3,000-square-foot Grandview Hall entrance, visitors first see Truman giving a speech in 1945 when he was running as Franklin Delano Roosevelt's vice president. FDR died only 82 days into that term, leaving the world wondering, "who is this farmer from Missouri who is taking over the free world?" Graham said.



not use a wick. One merely touched a hole with a cigar or lighted twig, and the fire's heat and spark traveled down the hole, igniting gun powder. These were the simplest made of all key guns, and it would have been relatively easy to make one of these from primitive cast iron molds.

Some, unusual key guns were made with the lock assembly and nipple for cap inside the key's circular handle. appears that just a slight amount of palm pressure would ignite this pistol, giving a prisoner a bellyache if the ball actually hit him.

None of my research revealed whether a key gun was ever actually fired at a prisoner.







filled his booth with antique cast iron kitchenware items priced from \$25 up. He offered a no. 2 Griswold early 1900s 6-inch skillet for \$1,050, while a no. 50 gem pan was offered for \$775.

In some cases, items of local interest found their way to the fairgrounds and were sold at the show. Dealer Cory Johnson offered two large 1920s colorful mint condition advertising sign cloth banners from his grandfather's locally owned Cook Oil Co. service station in downtown Allegan, which closed years ago. The banners, with an illustration of a service station attendant pouring denatured alcohol into a vintage automobile radiator, measured 30 by 50 inches each and sold quickly. They were tagged at \$450 each.

Johnson lives in the home of his late grand-father, who started the business Johnson said he discovered the banners in the basement, carefully wrapped in a plastic bag and obviously stored away many years ago.

Still another local connection came with dealer Damon Granger of Traverse City, Mich., who set up at Allegan with wife Angela offering antique advertising signs.

Granger, who hosts the twice -a-year Indoor Indianapolis Advertising Shows, was approached at the Memorial weekend show by an Allegan resident who said his family owned a local hardware store years ago and had two 1950s Winchester guns and ammo newold-stock tin signs. The resident wondered if Granger was interested in purchasing them. The two met later in the day and made a deal which Granger said, "made both of us happy.'

While Granger completed the deal, advertising sign collectors checked out his unusual triangular 1800s clothing store porcelain 18-by 14-inch advertising sign priced at \$750.

As the show ended, Wood said he was "glad to see old friends, both dealers and shoppers, back on the fairgrounds enjoying the day,"

Because of health restrictions some booths were spaced apart more than usual. The Allegan Antiques Market, located midway between Kalamazoo and Grand Rapids, is held the last Sunday of each month during the warm-weather season.







