ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Costume jewelry sparked when it hit the block at Pamela Rose

WHITEHOUSE, Ohio — Pamela Rose Auction Company was tasked with settling the estate of Betty Dick of Lucas County, Ohio.

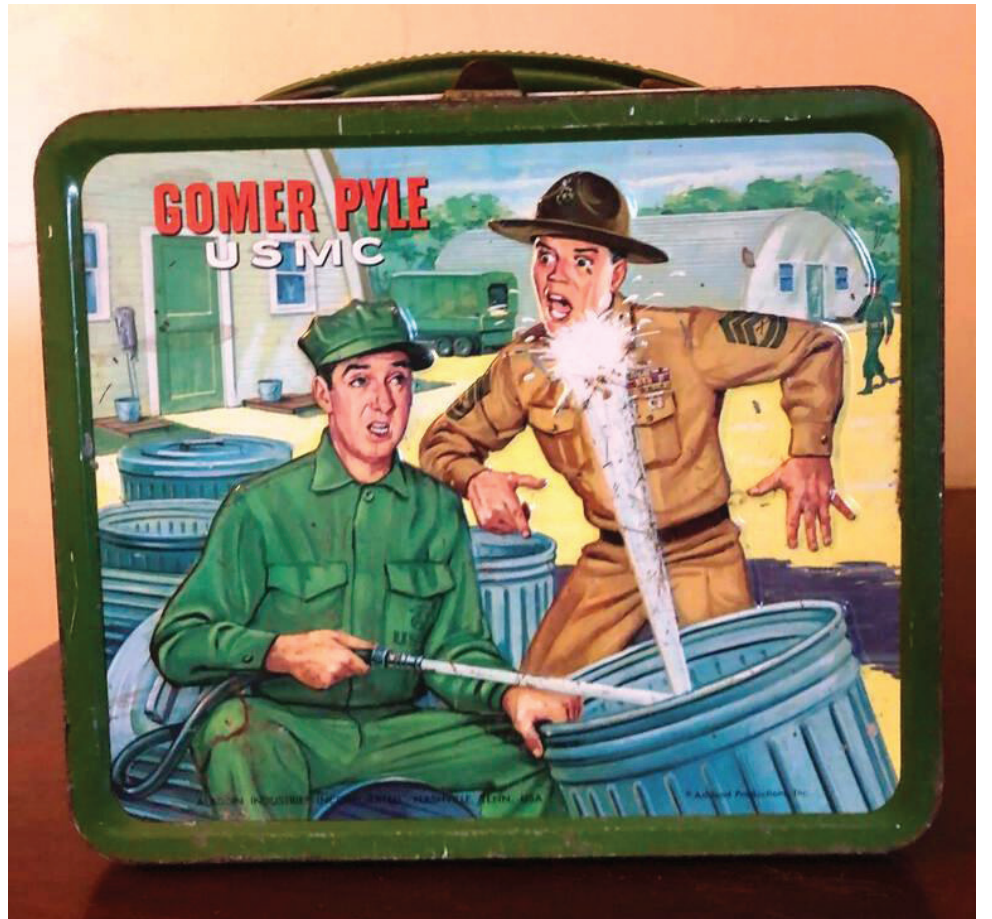
The online-only auction ran for two weeks from July 7-20 with a live inspection available on July 19. There were 365 lots were offered, including a pool table, tools, jewelry, watches, toys, and home decor.

The auction's surprise high bid of \$1,100 went to a lot of costume jewelry. Much of the collection was Deco-era and contained everything from necklaces and earrings to rings and bracelets, along with assorted accessories like a tie pin and compact. A couple of interesting non-jewelry pieces were included, like an inscribed Cross pen and pencil set, and a cast-iron stove burner cap circa 1900s. Several other collections of costume jewelry also sold high. One containing earrings, necklaces, pins, and cufflinks reached \$650. It was followed at \$550 by another that had among its contents a pair of shark tooth earrings and a turquoise L Bassa Capricorn necklace. Two more collections took \$375 and \$350 respectively.

Renwal trucks revved up the imagination during play

As a little boy growing up in the 1950s, some of my first toy trucks were Renwal plastic trucks. I recently purchased a red Renwal pickup truck at an antique mall for \$6.95. I wasn't buying a plastic truck as much as I was buying a truckload of childhood memories. It sits on my desk as I write this, bringing smiles of nostalgic days gone by.

Irving Lawner founded the Renwal Company (Renwal is Lawner spelled backwards) in 1939 and began distributing house wares, such as glass knives. Following World War II, Renwal began manufacturing inexpensive plastic toys, including his famous lines of 1/16th scale doll furniture and sturdy plastic cars and trucks. Nearly all Baby Boomer children played on their front porches or in their backyards with Renwal plastic trucks during the 1950s. Every truck in Renwal's wide range of plastic toy trucks is considered a collector item today, especially mint conditioned Renwal plastic trucks from the 1950s.

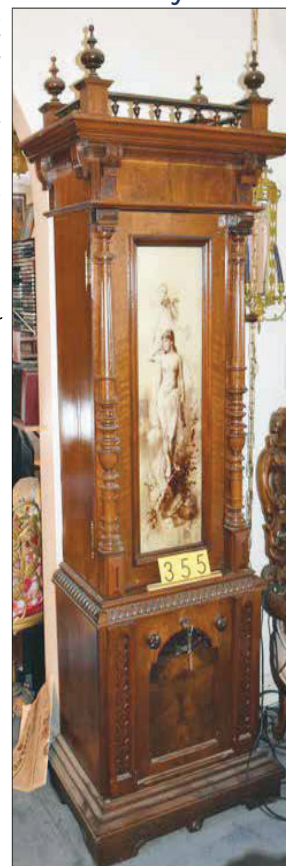

Jewelry was prevalent and not limited to the costume variety. The auction’s second and third high bids went to two silver and turquoise pieces - a squash blossom-style necklace in good condition which reached \$1,000 and a turquoise belt with a sterling silver buckle that sold for \$750.

Bidders intent on jewelry but with modest budgets still picked up some amazing buys. A sterling silver bracelet with a topaz pendant went for \$50. A lot of women’s jewelry marked “Made in Spain” containing a bracelet and two sets of matching earrings was taken home for just \$9.50.

One of the auction’s featured items was a United Billiards pool table. Unfortunately, while it had the set of billiard balls, it appeared to have been garage or barn kept and was in rough condition; it scored only \$110. The cues were offered in a later box lot along with two model boats and other assorted items that went for \$25.

There were plenty of

toys and related collectibles, including several lots of Hubley metal vehicles. One lot contained several Hubley roadster kits in various states of assembly, some boxed, and each with guides and certificates of authenticity. That lot sold for a nice \$90. A 1930s Hubley-made Dornier DO-X flying boat, appearing intact, took off at \$50. A Hubley metal tractor, also appearing complete but with worn paint, sold for \$40.

Toy lovers chased other great items like a Benjamin Franklin model 342 air rifle, bidding it to \$240. Close behind, at \$230, went a pair of Crosman 1400 air rifles. A 1960s Gomer Pyle USMC lunch box made it to \$90.

Tools, like jewelry, filled much of the auction. Power tools included an AC 225-amp Lincoln Electric welder and mask, picked up for \$150; a Delta ShopMaster model SS350 scroll saw hit \$110; and a Craftsman router table with router was snagged for \$70. On the low end went lots like a circular saw paired with a Craftsman sander that got purchased for \$6.50.

Winning bids on hand tools ran from a high of

\$80 for a mixed lot of sockets and wrenches from brands like Cornell, Craftsman, and Brazil, to lows like the \$14 paid for a set of four pipe wrenches.

Somewhat unusual were several lots containing stacks of wood/lumber and outside scrap piles. One lot of assorted wood and wooden tables went for \$350. Other wood lots sold from \$30 to \$190. Metal recyclers likely chased those the scrap piles, with their contents of old petroleum-type cans, fencing, broken farm implements, and miscellaneous scrap metal. Two lots sold - one for \$300 and the other for \$60. And, in case the buyer needed a way to take that scrap home, a utility trailer was also on the block, pulled away at \$220.

Also, a bit offbeat in this auction were four body parts for a 1970s MGB roadster. The items included the windshield frame with glass, won for \$25, a passenger door taken for \$6, and a hood and trunk, each going for a mere \$3.

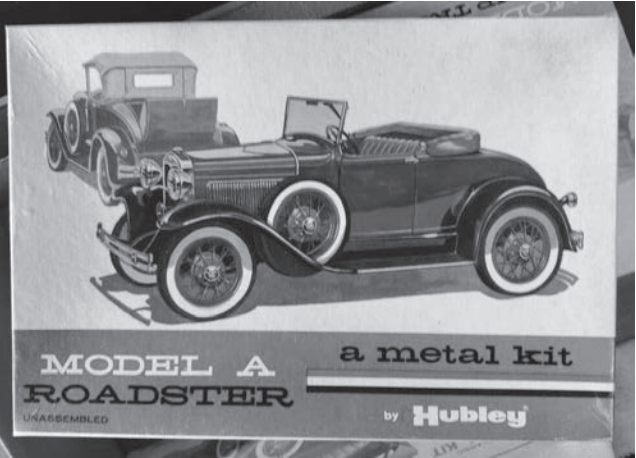

Great for trivia night is ‘This Day in Collecting History’

The first time I heard of the book “This Day in Collecting History,” the frustrated author in me thought, “Rats, why didn’t I think of that? What a cool idea.” But then, holding the 272-page paperback book in my hands, I was glad I hadn’t. It became clear to me that such a challenge would not be as easy as it seemed. Talk about your labor of love.

How many man (and woman) hours must it have taken to think up 366-plus witticisms, historical nuggets, and the like, all falling into the stated categories of the book’s subtitle, “A Year of Art, Memorabilia & Other Treasures Sold”? A gargantuan task in itself. For that matter, the editing process alone would probably have done me in. And then there’s the task of tracking down appropriate illustrations. No thanks. But mercifully, the husband-and-wife team of Michael A.

and Marla K. McLeod was clearly up to the challenge. And we all should be glad that they were.

Like other Schiffer publications, this book feels and looks good. More importantly, the information inside these pages is taken on good authority: Michael, as it turns out, served for 16 years as editor of the now-defunct “Southeastern Antiquing and Collecting Magazine.” For the record, he credits Marla as having provided the inspiration for the project; she, in turn, served as fact checker.

The format is straightforward: Each date has at least one entry (the birthday of someone notable, for instance, or the anniversary of an important historical event), as well as a detailed account of the sale of a related item (say, a costume worn in a famous role, the sale of a first edition or an autograph, something like that). There is an accompanying photograph for nearly every entry.

For the reader, where to begin? As I see it, there are several different ways to approach this chock-full-of-trivia book. Within the first five minutes of having it in my hand, I looked up dates including my birthday, my daughter’s and grandkids’ birthdays, and Christmas, just to see what was happening then. Turns out that I share a birthday with

Hall of Famer “Dizzy” Dean; Kat and Knute (“Win just one for the Gipper”) Rockne made their entrance into the world on the same day, different century. New Year’s Day is remarkable for two reasons: It was the day that President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation as well as being the day that Paul Revere was born. Flipping to the last page, I noted that New Year’s Eve was the natal day of artist Henri Matisse, as well as a host of others, including Buddy Ebsen and Sylvester Stallone, Johnny Depp and Tony Curtis, Phyllis Diller and Richard Chamberlain, each slipping under the wire as a last-minute tax deduction.

Or you could start with the date of receiving the book and proceed from there. Writing this on August 9, I see that on this day in 1944, Smokey the Bear made his debut. A 1957 string holder in his likeness made \$152 on eBay five years ago. And for those not knowing the uses for a string holder, there is a short explanation. Spoiler alert: Tomorrow I’ll find out that on August 10, 1846, President James K. Polk signed an executive order establishing the Smithsonian Institution (I looked ahead). And the day after that. . . well, you get the idea.

Best of all is the fact that this book contains a comprehensive index. Feeling curious about, say, the Beatles? Wedged in between Michael Jackson’s “Beat It” jacket and Beatrix Potter’s “Tale of Peter Rabbit” are several listings for Ringo, one for Paul, and a sprinkling

relating to John for his guitar, his wire-rim eyeglasses, and for the “Double Fantasy” album (which technically, is not a Beatles album, just saying). What, no George? Looks like Pierre-Auguste Renoir was also born on February 25 and aced out “the quiet Beatle.” Sigh. Similarly, I see no mention of Hugh Grant, although Cary and Ulysses S. (no relation) represent famous Grants. Likewise, Coca-Cola but no Pepsi-Cola. Joking aside, generalized categories make it easy to learn about Academy Awards, photographs, and rings, as well as stamps, sculptures, and signatures.

Handy for bar bets, ideal for trivia night fans, and just plain interesting for the rest of us, this book might be the perfect gift for the collectors on your holiday list (it’s later than you think!). Order an extra one for yourself.
