

er with two handkerchief boxes on top drew a final bid of \$250. The handsome round oak dining table featured a polished finish and carved feet. It measured 48 inches and expanded to 68 inches with two extensions. This beauty found a new home with a high bid of \$250. An unusual sidewinder oak dresser consisted of one side built up with extra storage compartments while the other side supported a tall, narmirror. This eye-catching piece drew a final bid of \$150. A vintage washstand displaying a mirror housed in a lyre-style frame finished at \$120, while a wider oak stand without a mirror but with three drawers and carved trim closed at \$140. An ornate 62-inch-long wood pew, complete with arm rests. left with a final bid of \$150.

Many useful household items were offered, but it was the downsizing of the collectibles that truly made this auction unique. Two hundred of the auc-

tion lots featured "half dolls." These interesting characters from the early 20th century consisted of just the upper half of a person, usually female. They were produced in porcelain, without legs so they could be attached to something useful, such as pin cushions, powder boxes, whisk brooms, or other things that would be enhanced by this decoration. Prices ranged widely depending on the design of the doll, if a known company produced it, and if it was outfitted with the rest of the body. One of the most popular items was the flapper, complete with gold satin dress, gold shoes, jewelry, and make up. She cleared a final bid of \$350. A group of four half dolls combined models by Goebel and Dressel & Kister. One of the ladies in the group had a fulllength pink lace fabric gown and the other three were in appealing poses. This lot closed at \$350. Another group produced by Dressel & Kister included a medieval half doll along with three others who were all fullbody models. The tallest in the group stood 8inches, two wore fabric dresses and two were molded porcelain. This group drew a final bid of \$275. A lot consisting of numerous sets of porcelain legs finished at \$200, a half doll 18-inch-tall lamp consisting of a woman standing under a fabric canopy closed at \$101, and dozens of lots with single or multiple half dolls finished in the

Ceramic or chalkware string holders were made to look like the faces of people or animals with the string coming out of their mouth. Some were wall mounted while others rested on a countertop. Due to their fragile nature, they often have chips or cracks, but this collection was in excellent condition. Several in this sale depicted African Americans, often in outfits or poses that can be disturbing to some people. The highest selling example was of a black

woman wearing a green head scarf and a broad smile with the string coming out of her teeth. It took a final bid of \$130 to claim her. A full body Aunt Jemima string holder in her familiar outfit left with a high bid of \$66, and a black clown head finished at \$55.

Thirty-four head vases made up yet another collection. These models of women's heads dressed in various styles and poses had openings at the top for a small plant. The top selling example here was a blonde woman wearing a hooded jacket and white turtleneck sweater. She measured 7 inches tall and was marked "Rubens Originals © Los Angeles Made in Japan". This pretty piece went for \$62. Her style was much more modern than the rest of the examples which closed between

A limited number of characters from the Walt Disney Classics Collection (WDCC) series were present. The Fantasia 5-inch-tall figure "Mischievous Apprentice" won the top bid at \$87. A 1997 Walt Disney Collectors Society members-only sculpture showing 8-inch-tall Goofy strolling along with holes in his shoes topped out at \$61, a 1996 Tinkerbell ornament and stand left for \$53, and other pieces sold in the \$40-50 range.

Finally, Pioneer Auctions offered an interesting twist to the auction. The final lot of the sale was labeled "All In" and consisted of all the lots that did not obtain a bid during the auction. This mystery grab bag included lamps, plastic plates, board games, car mats, toy race cars, collectible plates, blinds, and even a vintage clock radio. It was claimed with a \$10 bid.



TOM MIX

Horse, making millions of American children want to grow up to be cowboys. Early in his movie career, Mix was dubbed "King of the Cowbovs." which he respectfully tried to live up to his entire life.

Tom Mix made personal appearances all over the country, rivaling the travel and appearances of famed western comic, Will Rogers. In 1905, Mix rode in President Theodore Roosevelt's inaugural parade, and in 1929 Mix was a pallbearer at the funeral of Wyatt Earp, famed frontier lawman.

newspapers reported, "Movie star Tom Mix cried during Earp's service."

Mix began his film career as a supporting actorinthe Selig Polyscope Company's "The Cowboy Millionaire," which was released in October 1909. Selig Polyscope Company filmed more than 100 of Mix's western films on location in Las Vegas.


Mix soon moved into movie stardom, reportedly earning as much as \$7,500 a week. And in 1929-31, he appeared with the Sells-Floto Circus at a reported weekly salary of \$20,000 (equivalent to \$301,000 in 2020). In 1935, Mix reportedly bought the Sam B. Dill Circus, which he had appeared with for

the previous few years.

Every Wed. 5pm

Tom Mix's last screen appearance was as star of a 15-episode sound Mascot Pictures serial, The Miracle Rider (1935). He reportedly, in the middle of the Great Depression, earned \$40,000 for four weeks of filming.

In 1933, Ralston Purina produced the Tom Mix Ralston Straight Shooters radio series, which was popular through the early 1950s, over a decade after Mix's death. The Ralston Purina Company offered ads during the radio program for listeners to write in for a series of 12 special Ralston/Tom Mix comic books available only by writing the Ralston Purina Company by mail. Today, this series of comic books are eagerly

sought-after collectibles.

Mix also had a long and colorful career in other comic books. The Golden Age of Westernthemed comics was the 1940s - '50s, during

which time Mix's heroic western deeds were well established. Fawcett Comics published a total of 61 Tom Mix Western






comics from 1948 -1953. And L. Miller & Son's published 85 issues of Tom Mix Western Comics from 1948 - 1951.

Mix singlehandedly built Hollywood's west-

ern genre movies, but perhaps his greatest film legacy is Marion Morrison. Morrison had a career ending injury while playing football for the University of Southern California. Mix took Morrison under his wing and found work for him moving props on the

Studios. caught the acting bug, changed his name to John Wayne, and became America's greatest western movie star of all time. And he owed his career to Tom

Tom Mix died, at age 60, on Oct. 12, 1940, when his car overturned on Arizona State Route 79, near Florence, Ariz. A small stone memorial marks




his body on this spot and whose characterization and portrayals in life served to better fix memories of the old West in the minds of living men."


