Estate auction for an auctioneer

EAGLE, Mich. — K & M Auctions saw the final hurrah on July 10 as Kelly McAllister's memorial estate auction was held. Kelly opened K & M Auctions in 1993 and operated it successfully for 28 years. He also spent a lot of time helping his brother. Mike, at McAllister Auctions. The McAllister boys grew up in the business, with Kelly auctioneering since his teenage years. On this day, brother Greg McAllister had the bitter-sweet job of selling off the items Kelly had accumulated over the years to settle the estate. The entire family was there for the day, sharing stories, laughter and tears. Kelly never became a collector of any one item. He just accumulated things that appealed to him.

"How he got all this stuff into a 750 square foot house, I don't know. And how we

got it all out, I don't know," said Greg. Kelly didn't want a funeral. He wanted a time for family and all the friends he had made over the years to get together and enjoy each other. A poem by Nikita Gill was read during the brief memorial service that took place before the auction that summarized the attitude which Kelly carried throughout his life. "I hope you are blessed with a heart like wildflowers. Strong enough to rise again after being trampled upon, tough enough to weather the worst of the summer storms, and able to grow and flourish even in the most broken places."

A Murray fire and rescue pedal car was jokingly sold as "Kelly's first car". This item was rolled away for a bid of \$100. A signed 1984 color poster of the Detroit Tigers along with a pennant from the same year sold for \$25. A pair of green lamps with beautiful crystals hang-

Ocarinas have carried a tune for thousands of years

materials have been used, including bone, metal, glass, and wood. The word "ocarina" comes from the Italian word for "little goose."

The first known Ocarina flutes date back 12,000 years ago; however, Oriental cultures, such as China and Japan, and Mesoamerican cultures, such as those found in South America, have long histories of ocarinas being used for song and dance, and these are the cultures that kept ocarina flutes alive for the last few thousand years.

The first record of ocarinas in Europe came after Spanish conquistador Hernán Cortés' expedition to explore the New World.

Both the Aztec and Mayan civilizations used versions of the ocarina in their musical and religious celebrations. Cortés witnessed the Aztecs sing and dance in accompaniment with the ocarina, and he brought the instrument, music, and dance back to Spain. Other European countries quickly copied the ocarinas being made in Spain, and the use of ocarina as a musical instrument spread so quickly that it became known as the toy musical instrument of the European Renaissance.

One of the oldest ocarinas discovered in Europe was found in excavations outside of Runik, Kosovo (formerly part of Serbia).

Runik is the site of an important Neolithic (period dating to the end of the Stone Age, 10,000 - 4,500 BCE) settlement, and excavations there uncovered a baked-clay oca-























































Gold and guns brought in the bidders to Schwartz

STURGIS, Mich. — Selling off coins and guns proved to be a profitable day for Schwartz Auctions and its consignors. Magnifying eye pieces strong lights which allowed the bidders to get up close looks at the coins before they sold. And the rifles were lined up on tables so they could be inspected.

Taking top honors in coins was a \$10 1910 Denver minted gold piece. This one was graded MS61 by P.C.G.S., which is one of the top places to get coins graded. An Indian head on the front in full headdress, is marked underneath with the year of the coin. There are thirteen stars flanking the Indian head. On the back are an eagle side view and the words "ten dol-

lars" and "In God We Trust". The eagle is standing on a branch with his wings at rest. This one sold for the respectable price of \$1,150.

And hanging in there with a sale price right were out, along with behind the top seller was an 1899 Liberty Head \$10 gold eagle coin. These were struck in huge numbers, but many have long since been melted down, so the numbers have significantly diminished. These tiny pieces of history are sought after by both coin collectors and bullion investors because these gold eagles contain a full 0.4896 ounces of gold. The bidding rose quickly to the final price of \$875.

Dating from 1905 \$5 AU coin with an "S" mint mark sold for \$475. And right behind that was a \$5 gold coin from 1898 which was quickly pocketed away for a bid of \$450.

A \$5 gold coin from 1881 proved to be a good value as it sold for \$425; while a 50-cent piece of

These were made exclusively for members of the NAHC, some with bone handles. This was a great display piece and sold for \$700, complete with the case.



Modern European ocarina flutes date to the 1800s when an Italian musician, Giuseppe Donati, transformed a toy ocarina into a modcomprehensive musical instrument.

In 1964, John Taylor, an English mathematician, developed a fingering system that allowed ocarinas to play a full chromatic octave using only four holes. This 4-hole system is now called "the English fingering system," and it is used extensively for pendant ocarinas that are made to hang from the neck like a pendant or necklace. The English fingering on some records. system is also used on multi-chambered ocari-

nas that are designed to play more than one note at a time.

Ocarina flutes feaprominently in ture NES and Nintendo 64 video games, which may have led to ocarina's increasing popularity in the 20th century.

Musical collectors began collecting ocarinas because of the different styles and shapes available. The best-known style of an ocarina is the Sweet Potato style, which has a rounded shape and is held in a horizontal position with both hands. Both 10-hole and 12-hole Sweet Potato ocarinas are popular today with musicians and are used as background sound

Ponytail items were perfect for back to school

So, what do ancient Greek women, 1970s male rock stars, and folks who have not visited a hair salon during the pandemic all have in common? It's a ponytail worn high, low, or somewhere in between, pulled up tightly and carefully secured with a rubber band, or casually gathered and held in place with a clip or barrette.

But back in the late 1950s, this popular style was more than just a convenient way to manage long hair. Marking a rite of passage, young girls unbraided their pigtails, gathered their hair into one clump, and anticipated the day when they would become teenagers. Among famous ponytails of the time were the one Sandra Dee sported on

the big screen in "Gidget" and the signature topknot worn by Barbie, the doll introduced in 1959 at the New York Toy Fair.

Sensing a trend and seizing an opportunity to capitalize on a new fad,

one astute businessman in particular designed "Ponytail" merchandise for discount department stores and dime stores. The target market was junior high school-aged girls. Did these items

sell? You bet they did. And are these ponytail-inspired relics still hunted down and collected by nostalgic mid-century collectors? Well, you probably already know the

Although some of the finer points of the history of "Ponytail" have been lost over time, some things are known. There's no disputing the fact that Don Levine was on the cutting edge of this trend. A longtime designer and inspiration for popular toys, Levine was the man who perfected the process of covering cardboard with vinyl, according to Californian Deb Clarke, an avid collector of "retro"

Aware of the overnight success of Barbie (and knowing a good thing when he saw it), Levine employed his process to produce vinyl cases that would keep a doll and her wardrobe in one easy-tocarry container. The first doll cases he put on the market were branded, not "Barbie" (which was trademarked), but "Ponytail." His generic figure of a teenage girl had no other name, but it was See Ponytails page 18



But wait, there's more! For the past several years, typewriters have







obvious to even the most casual observer what he had in mind, as evidenced by the four pictured silhouettes of a fashionable teen that could only be Barbie.

Ruth Handler, the "mother" of the Barbie doll, took notice, and she and Levine subsequently came to an agreement, according to Clarke. The results? Levine's next doll case to hit the market bore not only the word "Ponytail" but also the name "Barbie." Levine followed up with a case featuring the famous doll in one of her most elegant outfits, a strapless pink evening gown accessorized with a white fur stole ("Enchanted Evening"). As Mattel went on to expand the world of Barbie to include Ken (her beau) and Midge (her gal pal), Levine kept pace with larger cases produced to accommodate these dolls and their accoutrements. Further capitalizing on the popularity of Barbie and her social circle, he introduced various soft-sided lunch boxes.

But Levine did not limit himself to Barbie-related accessories; he designed a full line of personal and school-related "Ponytail" accessories geared to pre-teens, according to collector Jimmie Bucci. Bucci was first drawn to this collecting category several years ago when he spied a bedcover that featured a '50s $\,$ teen motif. One thing led to another, and he soon found himself collecting all things "Ponytail."

The Massachusetts resident's collection includes an array of "Ponytail" and related items. Bucci said that young girls of the time must have dreamt of living the lifestyle of a teenager: lying on their backs with their feet in the air, wearing pedal pushers, and listening to records, writing letters, and talking on the telephone. Think Ann Margaret in "Bye Bye Birdie," Bucci suggested.

To be certain, many collectors still seek "Ponytail" soft lunch boxes that survived milk leaks. But other items not exposed lunchtime spills abound, according to Bucci. They include record cases ("Tune Totes" or "Rhythm Totes") for 45 rpms (including even one that pictures Pat Boone), scrapbooks, and autograph books. One popular carry-on travel case, the "aviator bag," came in a variety of colors and featured a picture-within-a-picture of Ponytail waving goodbye while carrying her own miniature Ponytail aviator bag. Banks ("Stash for Cash") and eyeglass cases are

collectable, as are soft-sided photo albums and picture frames ("This is 'Him" included stock photos of Rock Hudson, Frankie Avalon, and others)

For the more academically minded preteens, there were pencil cases and pencil holders, desk blotters and dictionaries ("Miss Know It All' by Ponytail"). Fold-up locker vanities, marking graduation from elementary school to junior high, were perfect for that between-class touch-up, thanks to a comb and mirror. "My Treasures" boxes (with a key) and diaries (also with a key) suggest that keeping private property private was of

collectable, as are soft-sid- the utmost importance, ed photo albums and pic- according to Bucci.

Collectors continue to look for different products with names other than "Ponytail," including "Deb-U-Teen" and "date line," as well as "Siris." Levine is known to have worked with several manufacturing companies, and these variations seem to be in keeping with licensing agreements made at the time. Not surprisingly, there were also "knock-offs." Examples of these items in Bucci's collection (in addition to the aforementioned bedcover) are aprons and flannel yard goods, paper party accessories, and day-of-the-week hankies, as well as figurines.


Later generations would have "Hello Kitty" and Lisa Frank merchandise. But what happened that "Ponytail" faded from view? According to Clarke, the answer probably lies in the fate of the hairdo that started it all. Thanks to new trendsetters, including First Lady Jacqueline Kennedy, as well as hairspray, new bouffant hairdos became popular. In 1962, even Barbie traded in her strapless striped maillot and ponytail for a sleek red bathing suit and a "bubble cut."

And as for Don Levine, he went on to develop more toys. Remember G.I. Joe?


