# Gold glittered at Leist Auctioneers event

CHEBOYGAN, Mich. — A recent estate auction in Northern Michigan was hosted by Leist Auctioneers. While the company frequently runs “live” auctions, selling everything from real estate to livestock, they felt that this sale, featuring fine furniture, gold and silver items, collectibles, and art, as well as household items, should be held online. There was an in-person preview offered on the day of the sale, but everything else was handled via the internet. The prices listed here do not include the

buyer's premium.

There were 318 lots total, with a wide variety of beautiful and useful items. The most popular sale of the day was the lot that featured gold jewelry. It consisted of two 14K gold necklaces, with one of the chains holding an antique Hampden pocket watch in beautiful condition. The second chain displayed a gold peso. There was an additional 18K chain necklace connected to a gold globe charm that was mounted in a gold ring that allowed it to rotate. This attractive package was claimed with a final bid of \$710.

Other eye-catching jewelry lots were also pre-

sented, giving a little insight into the original owner. For example, a costume jewelry collection of several earrings, brooches, and necklaces

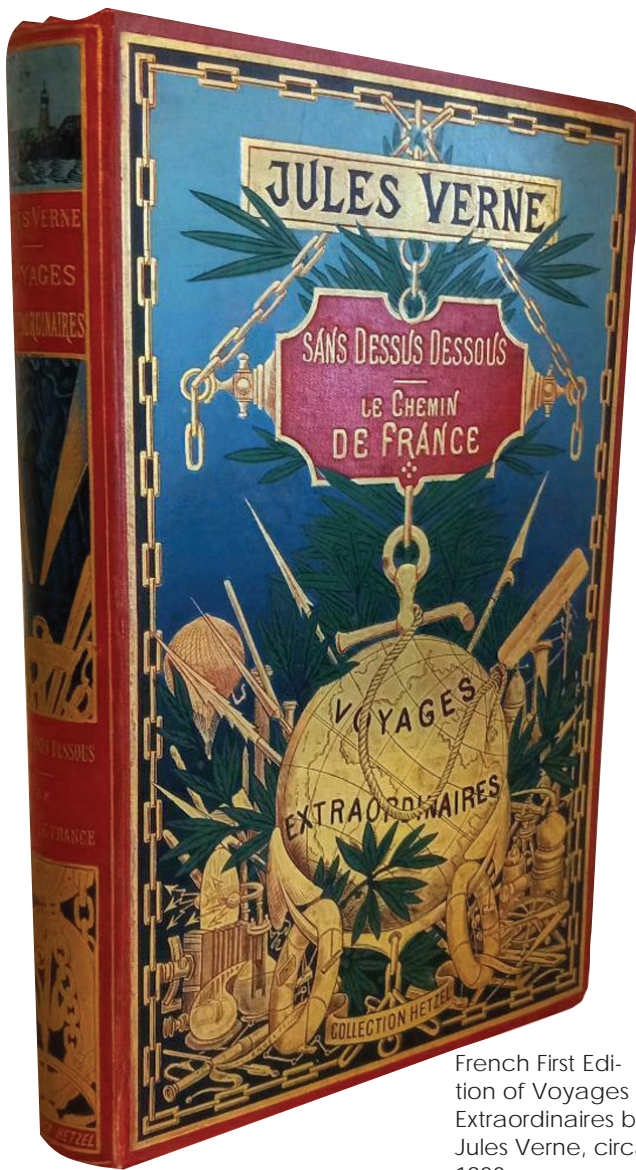
included a pin that spelled out “Born to Shop”. This glittering collection was claimed with

# Take a journey with Jules Verne

Jules Gabriel Verne (1828-1905) was a French novelist, who has been called the “Father of Science Fiction.” Early in his career, Verne was lucky to meet publisher Pierre-Jules Hetzel, who teamed with Verne to create a series of novels called “Voyages Extraordinaires.” This series of books included Verne’s bestselling adventures such as “Journey to the Center of the Earth” (1864), “Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea” (1870), and “Around the World in Eighty Days” (1872).

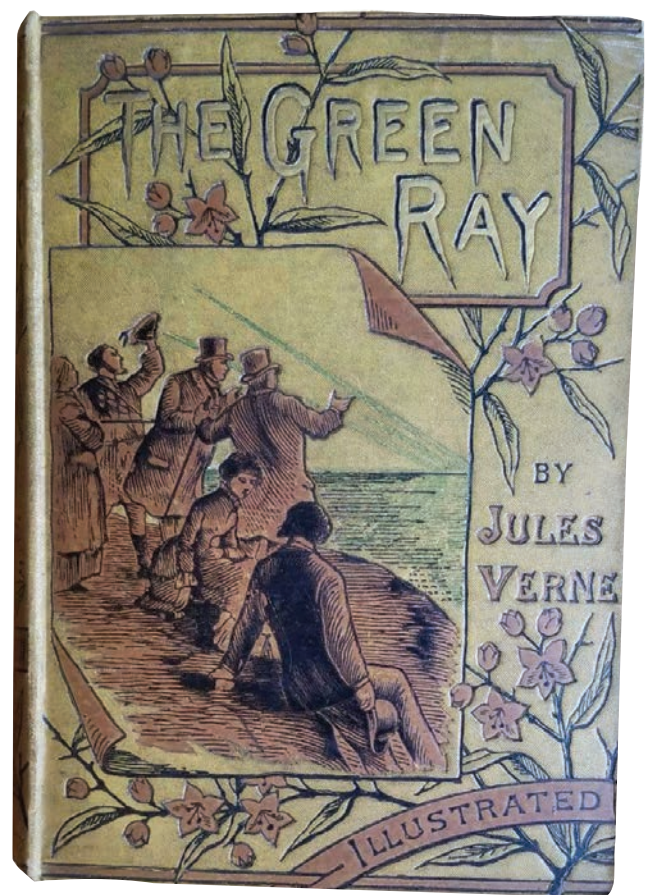
Verne’s novels were mostly set in the late 1800s after the Industrial Revolution in England that ushered in unheard of technological advances. Verne perfectly captured these advances, some decades before

their times, such as the submarine Nautilus from “Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea,” with words, allowing readers to be transported to places no one had ever been to before.

Nearly all of Verne’s novels have been adapted for film (20,000 Leagues Under the Sea was first made into a silent short movie in 1907 by French filmmaker Georges Méliès). And comic book collectors adore comics based on Verne’s stories since the action, graphics, and thrills are boundless.

While critics have not always loved Verne’s novels, his books have mesmerized the general reading public since his first work, “Five Weeks in a Balloon,” was published in 1863.

Verne is considered the second most-translated author in the world, standing solidly



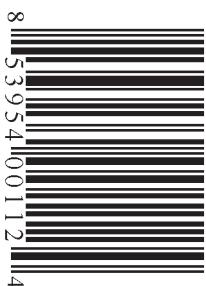
Above: The Green Ray by Jules Verne. This 1st British Edition, dated 1894, is valued at \$9,000.

between Agatha Christie and William Shakespeare.

Verne originally followed in his father’s footsteps, studying law.

While living in Paris, studying to become an attorney, Verne fed his passion for theater by

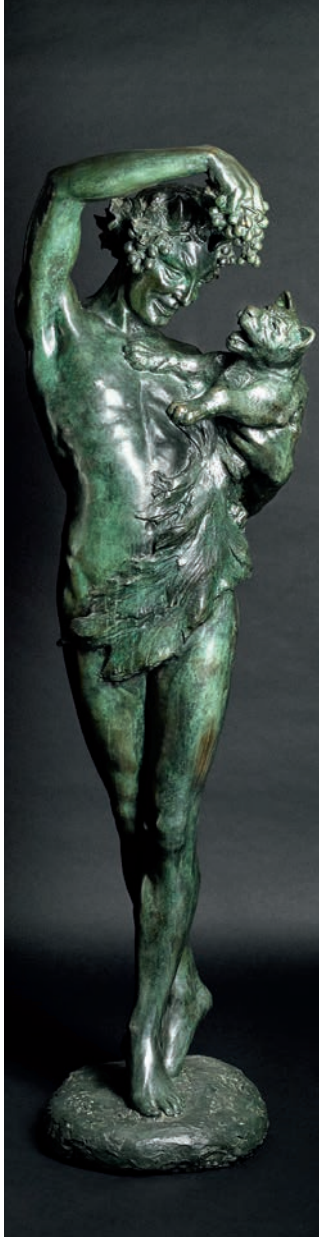

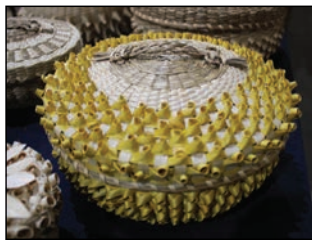

a high bid of \$97.50. A group consisting of turquoise costume jewelry necklaces plus silver bracelets and necklaces finished at \$90, and another generous lot of colorful costume jewelry pins, including giraffes and elephants, finished at \$85. Silver chains and charms sold in batches for \$60-77.50.

The useful items at an auction are usually popular as additions or replacements to the buyers’ households. There were plenty of very nice options offered here. The Craftsman LT2000 lawn and garden tractor, featuring a 19.5 hp engine, 42-inch mower deck, and a collection system in good working order was eagerly claimed with a high bid of \$570. The Frigidaire 18 cu. ft. top freezer refrigerator model FFHT1826 with a chrome finish left for a new job with a high bid of \$285. A VIZIO Razor LED 60-inch flatscreen television with remote was rehomed with a final bid of \$240, while a smaller Vizio 47-inch flatscreen with remote left for \$127. Food cooking was covered with the Traeger electric smoker and grill that closed at \$195, the chrome finish Frigidaire glass top range at \$165, and a very clean Dyna-Flo gas and charcoal BBQ for \$80.

Some very attractive furniture options were also available. A cabinet offered as a TV buffet stand consisted of a sturdy wooden frame,

two drawers with marble-like fronts, two cabinet doors with frosted glass panels, and an open shelf. It was pictured holding one of the flatscreen televisions, so it was capable of handling that weight. This attractive and utilitarian item was claimed with a final bid of \$185. An incredible burl wood dresser measuring 44 inches tall featured dovetail joints. Although missing a key, this five-drawer handsome piece finished at \$175. A 39-inch tall, lyre-shaped antique dresser with a long rectangle mirror was produced by West Michigan Furniture Company. Its unusual appearance helped draw a final bid of \$155. Towering above them all, the massive 80 inch tall and 36 inch wide wooden rectangular lighted display cabinet with glass doors and sides was pictured holding many of the collectible items for sale on this day. This robust, yet plain, unit was claimed with a final bid of \$122.50.

A few musical instruments made an appearance at this auction, with the Roland EP-77 digital piano taking the lead. Offered with keyboard stand, attached music stand, and padded bench, this popular set bowed out at \$255. An Amigo Model AM 30 acoustic guitar with case closed at \$62.50, while an Amigo Model AM15 acoustic guitar finished at \$52.50. A First Act five-piece drum kit with cymbal, hi-hat, drum throne,

and drumsticks left with a final bid of \$52.50.

A few attractive collectibles were scattered among the auction lots, adding an artistic touch to the offerings. A graceful Lladro seated figure, signed by S. Deboir and J. Ruiz was numbered 358. It appeared to depict Don Quixote wearing his customary hat and writing on a stack of papers while holding an ink well and quill pen. It was claimed with a final bid of \$155. A signed Bev Doolittle print titled “Sacred Ground” showed a man riding a horse while leading another through a birch tree forest. It was #6013/69996, measured 16 by 43 inches, and left with two additional framed pieces for a final bid of \$117.50. A reverent, all white, 13-piece Lenox nativity scene featuring the holy family, three wise men, shepherds, and large animals was still in its original package and was claimed with a final bid of \$85. Several items were offered for the Christmas season, but the most collectible lot was the set of four Santa cookie jars produced by Fitz and Floyd, some still in original boxes. These various depictions of the jolly old elf closed at \$40.

A few outdoor items also drew the attention of the bidding audience, due to their unusual nature. First, there were two metal benches constructed of white seats and backs, but their supports and legs were fashioned from ship anchors. This clever design proved popular, earning a final bid of \$155. A lot combining a metal rooster weathervane and a metal flamingo yard ornament was picked up with a final bid of \$77.50. And for the railroad enthusiast or historian, a metal railroad signal and Dietz lantern were provided. There was a cautionary message that the signal appeared to be a reproduction, but that didn’t dampen the enthusiasm as they closed at \$80.

## Jason Clark wins bid-calling contest

ST. IGNACE, Mich. – Professional auctioneer, Jason Clark from Alma, Mich., took top honors at the GoToAuction.com Midwest Auctioneer Championship.

The GoToAuction.com Midwest Auctioneer Championship saw a field of 16 auctioneers from around the Midwest competing for the title of the Grand Champion. The championship was held in conjunction with the Midwest Auctioneers Roundup hosted by the Michigan Auctioneers Association.

There were five finalists: Noah Smith of Howard City, Mich., (5th place), Jason Lamoreaux of Belding, Mich., (4th place), Grant Cole of Beulah, Mich., (3rd place), Ed Leist of Petoskey, Mich., (2nd place) and of course, the Champion Jason Clark. All finalists received a plaque commemorating their achievement and a cash prize.

Clark was born and raised on a small dairy farm and exposed to a lot of auctions. One of his earliest memories of an auction was a small farm liquidation that his Uncle Dick and Bill Clark conducted north of Breckenridge, Mich. Clark says, “I remember this sale because it was the first sale, I felt the excitement of the auctioneer saying ‘SOLD’ to me personally. I was bidding on a small two-wheel trailer that I could haul my pig manure in. I remember the excitement of the auction, with the huge crowd of people standing around and visiting, the auctioneers on the loudspeakers, and the food wagon – it seemed more like the county fair than an auction!” Determined to be a good auctioneer like his Uncle Dick, he practiced around the farm and sold a lot of cattle off a 4010 John Deere while feeding them. He didn’t realize it at the time, but pretty much everyone around the farm could hear him, but instead of

laughing, they encouraged him.

That encouragement led to his first paying job with John Tomaschko working as a contract auctioneer. After four years working for other auctioneers, he felt comfortable enough to be in business on his own and purchased Pioneer Auction Service from his Uncle Dick. Over the 15 years he’s been in the industry, he’s competed five times in the Michigan Auctioneer Championship. The first few times, his nerves got the best of him and was so hard on himself he didn’t come back for a few years. Every time he competed, he felt he left as a better auctioneer, so he kept trying.

“I would strongly encourage any auctioneer to become a member of the Michigan Auctioneers Association and to compete in the available competitions. You will better yourself and your auction business all around,” Clark said. This was the first time Clark competed in the GoToAuction.com Midwest Auctioneer Championship. He said “The appeal of this contest is that it’s all about bid calling. I was nervous, but not having an interview made it less nerve-racking.” Clark dedicated his win to his Dad and his Uncle Dick, who have both passed in the last two years.

The GoToAuction.com Midwest Auctioneer Championship was broadcasted live to a worldwide audience. If you missed it, the videos are available on [www.youtube.com/michiganauktioneers](http://www.youtube.com/michiganauktioneers). “This is a unique competition in the sense there isn’t much in the way of rules – other than they must wear a hat, any hat and sell what they are selling within a two-minute time frame. Contestants are scored exclusively on their real-world auction chant – and man, do they put on an authentic show,” said GoToAuction.com co-founder and Marketing Director, Kenny Lindsay, CAI.

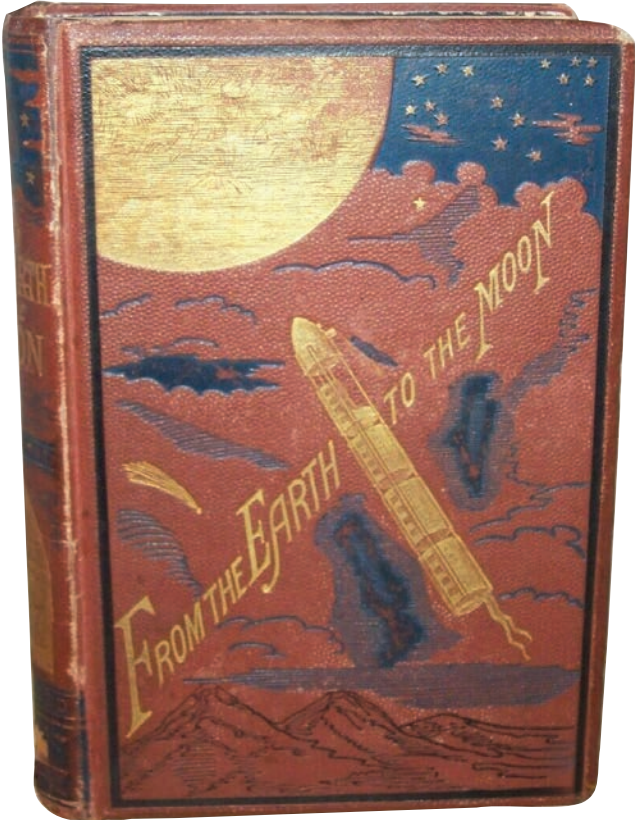
writing several underappreciated plays. When discussing his inspiration to give up the law and write adventure stories, Verne said, “I was greatly under the influence of Victor Hugo, indeed, very excited by reading and re-reading his works. At that time, I could have recited by heart whole pages of Notre Dame de Paris [The Hunchback of Notre-Dame], but it was his dramatic work that most influenced me.”

In August 1851 Pierre-Michel-François Chevalier the editor-in-chief of the magazine Musée des familles (The Family Museum) published a short story by Verne, A Voyage in a Balloon. This story, with its combination of adventurous narrative, travel themes, and detailed historical research, would later be described by Verne as “the first indication of the line of novel that I was destined to follow.”

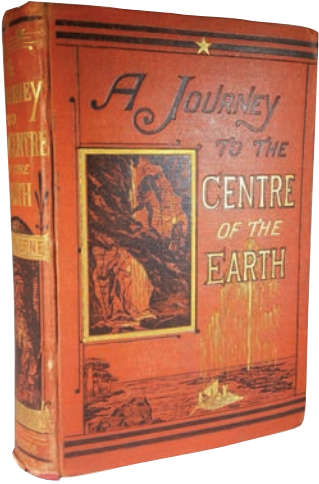
Scholars often pigeonhole Verne’s illustrious career into three phases,

Above: Illustrated First USA Edition, 1874, of From Earth to the Moon by Jules Verne is valued at \$1,650.

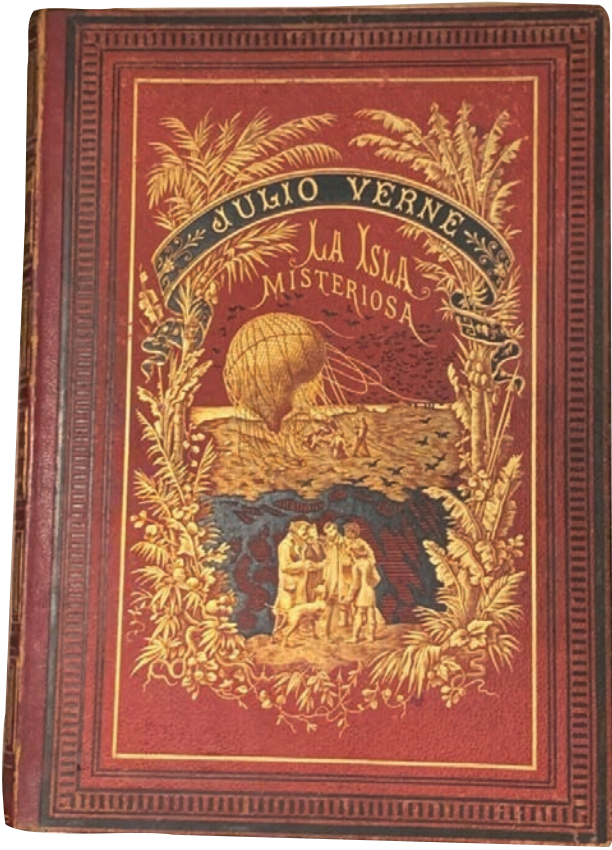


Above: First Edition of A Journey to the Centre of the Earth, 1874, by Jules Verne that is valued at \$8,000.

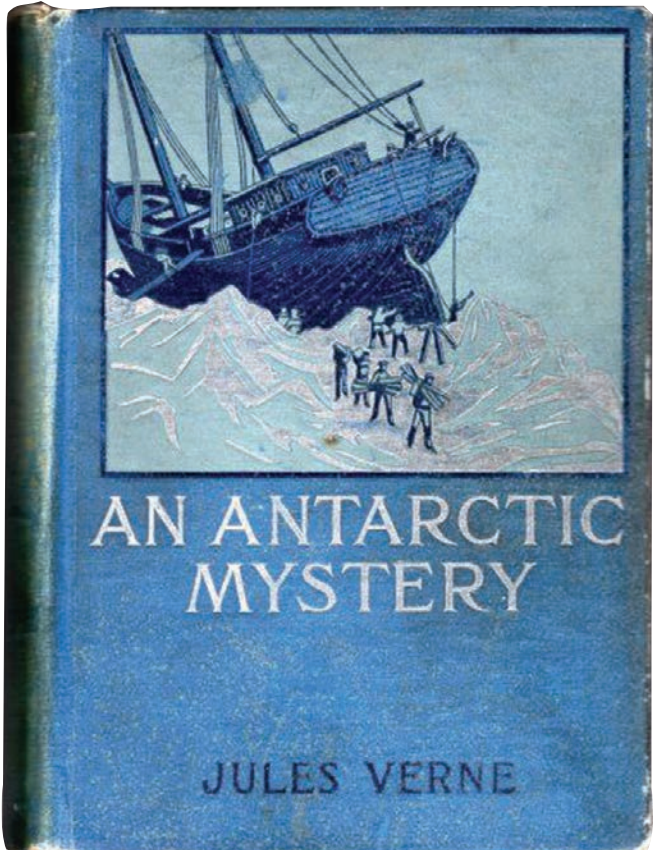
but it is his, so-called, second phase, from 1886 until his death in 1905, that showcased Verne’s pessimistic dark side. In these years, the tone of Verne’s novels changed. He began exploring the dangers of technology brought about by pride-filled scientists in such works as Maitre du monde (Master of the World), published in 1904.

In all, Jules Verne authored more than 60 books (most notably the 54 novels comprising the Voyages Extraordinaires). His vivid imagination conjured hundreds of memorable characters, such as Captain Nemo, and imagined countless innovations years before their time, such as the Nautilus, space travel, terrestrial flight and deep-sea exploration. Verne saw a future few minds could see, and he wrote of that future prolifically. In fact, when Jules Verne died, he left behind an entire drawerful of nearly completed manuscripts.

Today, original first edition copies of Verne’s books sell for a small fortune. A first U.S. edition of “20,000 Leagues Under the Seas” has been valued as high as \$25,000.

# Nemadji pottery did its best to hide its Minnesota roots

Nemadji pottery has a decidedly Southwestern look with its eye-catching mix of multi-colored swirls against an earth-tone base. Those who see it for the first time might assume it was made in Arizona or New Mexico. Few would guess northeastern Minnesota.

From the company’s earliest days, its “up North” origins were underplayed. A Nemadji catalog from the 1960s notes that the pottery was “made largely from designs of ancient Indian pottery, and many of their traditional shapes are preserved in our designs.” As late as 1982, Better Homes & Gardens praised Nemadji’s “rich earthen hues . . . made by the American Indians,” and many eBay listings still tout Nemadji as the perfect addition to a Native American collection. The implied connection was emphasized in the inserts that accompanied each item sold:

“From the bottom of ancient Lake Nemadji are secured the clays from which Nemadji tile and pottery are

made. The Indians used this clay left by the ice sheet to make cooking pots and vases, and in the ancient warrior’s grave are found fragments of his favorite cooking pot. Research has shown us how to imitate the pottery made from these same clays by the ancient Ojibwe tribes.

“Nemadji pottery expresses the soul of the Arrowhead Country and of the Redman, who, though long since gone to the Happy Hunting

Ground, still haunts our shores and woods.”

With that hyperbole, some confusion over the pottery’s heritage is understandable. But what exactly is Nemadji? The story begins with ceramist Frank Johnson, an employee of Red Wing Union Stoneware, the Minnesota firm famed for its salt glaze crocks and jugs. In 1920, with dreams of starting his own business, Johnson headed north — just about as far north as you can get in

Minnesota without falling into Lake Superior.

Here, Johnson founded the Northern Clay Products Corporation in Nemadji Township, just northeast of Moose Lake. The location, conveniently situated on a large bed of native Minnesota clay, was ideal for Johnson’s purposes. Specializing in industrial brick, as well as some decorative hand-thrown pottery, Northern Clay was a success. But more capital was needed. For that, Johnson called on prominent Moose Lake attorney and lumberman, Clayton J. Dodge.

Dodge was happy to oblige. The renamed “Nemadji Tile and Pottery Company” soon won acclaim for its decorative tile, used primarily for flooring. Hand-thrown Nemadji pottery was also popular, and there the diffi-

culty set in. Dodge saw decorative pottery as a sure thing for the country’s burgeoning tourist trade. Johnson, however, had no interest in mass-produced ware, and the partnership ended.

His 1929 replacement proved largely responsible for the Nemadji designs today’s collectors covet. Danish immigrant Eric Hellman had no qualms about creating the original thrown pottery needed to fashion molds for mass production. Hellman also modernized the Nemadji kilns and trained the company’s workers in adding individual touches to give each piece of pottery a “one-of-a-kind” look. Most importantly, Hellman introduced the “cold striped” painting process which produced Nemadji’s signature multi-colored swirls.

These “color baths”

involved dripping different colors of synthetic enamels into a metal wash tub filled with water, laced with a bit of vinegar to aid cohesion. The craftsman would then blow lightly on the paint swirls, creating a patch of clear water in their center. A pottery piece was dipped in the clear water, and the colors quickly raced to adhere. A final twist before removal from the water resulted in the colorful swirls.

For once, the company’s promotional claims were right on the money. The ads trumpeted that “the coloring of Nemadji pottery is accomplished in a manner that allows no two pieces to be exactly alike.”

Hellman’s influence at Nemadji was massive, yet his stay was short-lived. He remained there only until

1931, before leaving for Colorado, and the eventual establishment of his own studio near the Garden of the Gods. However, his contribution to the Nemadji story can't be overemphasized. Despite the introduction of other product lines over the years, Hellman's original designs and techniques remained Nemadji's bread-and-butter. That lasted right up until the company's closing in 2002.

Nemadji was essentially "art pottery for the masses", but two things were necessary to guarantee its continued success: dependable sales outlets, and an intriguing storyline which would captivate potential buyers.

Nemadji found the ideal retail outlet in gift shops catering to the tourist trade. As highway travel became more commonplace, particularly after World War II, families piled into the station wagon for fun-filled trips into the Wild West (or at least South Dakota). Souvenirs of



these rambles were called for, and Nemadji was there. Each winter, commissioned Nemadji sales representatives made the rounds of trading posts and tourist stops, taking orders for the

following year's lineup of vases and pots. Each spring, Nemadji employees worked overtime to fill that avalanche of orders. And each summer, weary-but-happy travelers headed for home,

clutching the treasured "Nemadji Indian Pottery" picked up during their journeys.

When it came to a sellable storyline, there were of course all those ads and inserts, romantically lauding the "Indian" heritage of Nemadji Pottery. Clayton Dodge took things a step further, with base stamps featuring an arrowhead, and the wording "Hand Made Nemadji Indian Pottery (from Native Clay)." To please those tourists in search of authenticity, Dodge even had a variety of other stampings available, depending on where a particular shipment was to be sold: "Nemadji Blackhills Pottery"; "Nemadji Badlands Pottery--Contains Badlands Clay"; and the more all-encompassing moniker, "No.

Dak."

That custom died out, but in the 1950s, Ted Hustead, founder of South Dakota's ubiquitous tourist attraction Wall Drug, asked Nemadji to resume stamping "Contains Badlands Clay" on pottery sold at his store. Harold Wahlstrom, then Nemadji's owner, turned down the request, even after Hustead sent a box of "Badlands Clay," suggesting Wahlstrom mix a bit in with each batch, to justify the stamp.

Was there any real connection at all between Nemadji and Native Americans? The answer is "sort of." Although the Moose Lake area was once home to the Ojibwe, by the time of the town's founding in 1870, most of the original inhabitants had long since been moved to reservations. They did leave behind, however, a notable reminder of their presence: the name "Nemadji." What did it mean? Translated as "left hand," "Nemadji" was simply a directional term for the region's first river on the left, which emptied into Lake Superior.

And that was it. Despite the legends and wishful thinking, there was no "Nemadji tribe" behind Nemadji Pottery. Instead, in an era before cultural appropriation was recognized, enterprising ceramists created their own swirling interpretations of "Southwest style" pottery, and publicists did the rest. While not what original buyers presumed it to be, Nemadji Pottery has since found its own niche, particularly as an accent for Mission and Modern décor schemes. It's affordable, too: most pieces sell for well under \$50. Nemadji once filled souvenir shops nationwide. Taken on its own terms, as a lovely example of mid-century Midwest entrepreneurship, Nemadji continues to fill collectors' shelves today.

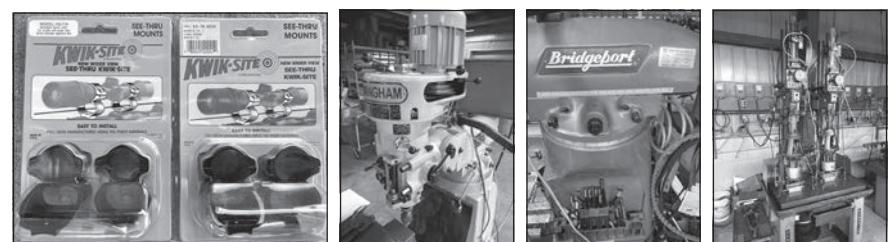
