ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

1956 Ford Thunderbird drove away with \$35,640

ALLEN PARK, Mich. — Many people collect car memorabilia, but few are given the opportunities that William (Bill) Vicary enjoyed. His

friendship with the Ford family provided numerous wonderful specimens to add to his ever-growing collection, including many autographed items commemorating special occasions. Since this collection included actual antique cars along with models, signs, and more, Bill housed this array in his own museum. When he died, his 2,960 square foot building and the collection inside were sold at a large estate auction. Chuck Cryderman and Associates was hired for the task, and the results were impressive! This online auction provided opportunities for in-person inspection prior to the event, and the staff competently handled arrangements and ques-

tions throughout the week. Prices listed include the 10% buyer's premium.

The attractive, multi-purpose building was situated on an ample corner lot with alley access, a garage door, shop space, and a large show room. It served perfectly as Bill's Ford Museum and hosted many visitors and events throughout the years. Selling real estate via an online auction comes with challenges, but Chuck set up the ground rules ahead of time and it went smoothly. The successful buyer needed to provide a 10% non-refundable deposit immediately, and close with cash within 30 days.

Jim Beam fire truck decanters race into the heat

As most of us know, a decanter is a vessel used to hold the decantation of a liquid, most often wine but in the 20th century, whiskey became a popular alcoholic beverage sold in decanters.

Decantation is a pro-

cess that separates a liquid from a solid, such as a solid mixture in suspension. Wine, especially home brewed wine, is still decanted in this manner since the grape pulp or other solid mixture that is in suspension in the wine must be allowed to decant or settled to the bottom so that the good

wine may be poured from the top. If you've ever drunk wine that had pulp floating in it, you realize how valuable the process of decantation is to good wine.

On the other hand, whiskey does not need decanted. Any suspended solid is separated from the whiskey long before it is bottled. But cognac and single malt Scotch whiskey have been, historically, sold in stoppered decanters for centuries, mainly for advertising purposes. The main reason to put whiskey in a decanter is for sales appeal and style, and the volume found in a whiskey decanter is often equivalent to a standard bottle of whiskey (many decanters held 750 ml of 80 proof, Kentucky straight bourbon whiskey).

A decorative whiskey decanter brings style to anyone's home bar. Clear

whiskey decanters also show off the clarity of the whiskey. But, for the most part, the purchase of whiskey in a decanter is truly a decorative purchase, which, in the case of collectors becomes the means of a wonderful decanter collection for

home, office, or party den.

Decorative decanters, which have various shapes, sizes, and designs (teardrop, square, round, large, small, crystal, stainless steel, old, and new), have traditionally been made of both clear and colored glass or crys-

tal. Since the shapes and sizes are practically endless, collectors look for unusual decanters or decanters that reflect their hobbies or profession.

One of the most

This appealing structure was claimed for a final price of \$156,200.

In the year 1956, Elvis Presley had the number one song, “Heartbreak Hotel”, and the Ford Thunderbird was a hot set of wheels. What a thrill to be able to see one at this estate auction! Featuring a removable hard top with porthole windows, rear bumper mounted spare wheel, and a glossy cream-colored finish, it looked like it did the day it rolled out of the factory. This dream car was claimed with a respectable bid of \$35,640.

There were a few other incredible antique Fords also in immaculate condition with eye-catching features. 1929 was the first year that wood paneling was used, and it looked very handsome on a Model A body. With a spotless interior and sleek exterior, this unusual treasure came with newspaper stories and framed art featuring the car. It required a final bid of \$20,350 to take it home. Another less-common vehicle was the 1929 Ford Model A pickup. Carefully restored to original condition, it was then customized with a wooden panel mounted on the side edges of the truck bed that read “Nancy’s tea & treats”. Nancy was the name of Bill’s

beloved wife. This boxy beauty drove off with a final bid of \$16,830. The 1930 Ford Model A, 2-door sedan was offered as Bill’s original car. It was listed with a rebuilt short block and 15,864 miles. This more familiar version of the Model A in black closed at \$11,770.

In addition to the full-sized cars there was a delightful array of appealing pedal cars, mostly Fords, in excellent condition. Many of these models featured realistic details, including engines that looked like they could run. However, the highest selling model was not a Ford, but a Murray Jolly Roger pedal car boat, complete with outboard motor. It had one wheel in front and two in back, resembling a tricycle in operation. This unusual model finished with a final bid of \$935. Next, a 1940s Ford pedal

car with a Mullins trailer represented a time when cars had small trunks so extra space was needed for travel. The red car was hitched to a realistic trailer, complete with removeable lid. This unusual duo drew a final bid of \$660. A red convertible 1937 Ford pedal car with headlights bore the hand-written message “To Bill With admiration, Bill Ford” on the hood, and it included photos of the two men. It was claimed with a high bid of \$660. A sweet 1940s Ford Good Humor pedal car with a simulated ice cream freezer box mounted on the rear finished at \$418, and the rest finished between \$99-264.

With 883 lots in this online auction, there was so much more to see, including model cars, vintage car parts, tools, toys, gas pump globes, and related items. There were also some unusual gems that stood out on their own. For example, the double-sided Firestone enamel sign with original metal hanger that advertised tire and battery service proved to be very desirable. It measured 4 feet long by 22 inches tall and came with its original metal hanger. It was claimed with a final bid of \$1,320.

A Lyle gun is a short-barreled cannon that is found on most ships. It is a line-throwing device that can be

used for numerous maritime situations, including to throw a line long distances to someone who needs to be rescued. This one came with a note explaining its provenance and it required a final bid of \$935 to claim it.

A brilliant yellow and blue banner featuring a flying bluebird was documented as having flown

on the Benson Ford freighter. The ship, part of a fleet owned by Ford, was used to haul iron ore and other materials for the company in the Great Lakes. The ship was named for Henry Ford’s grandson Benson. The banner, complete with letter of explanation, finished with a high bid of \$374. Finally, a very

ornate antique Ansonia mantel clock made in New York, with a black lacquer body, gold trim, and a white porcelain face, complete with key, drew a final bid of \$220.

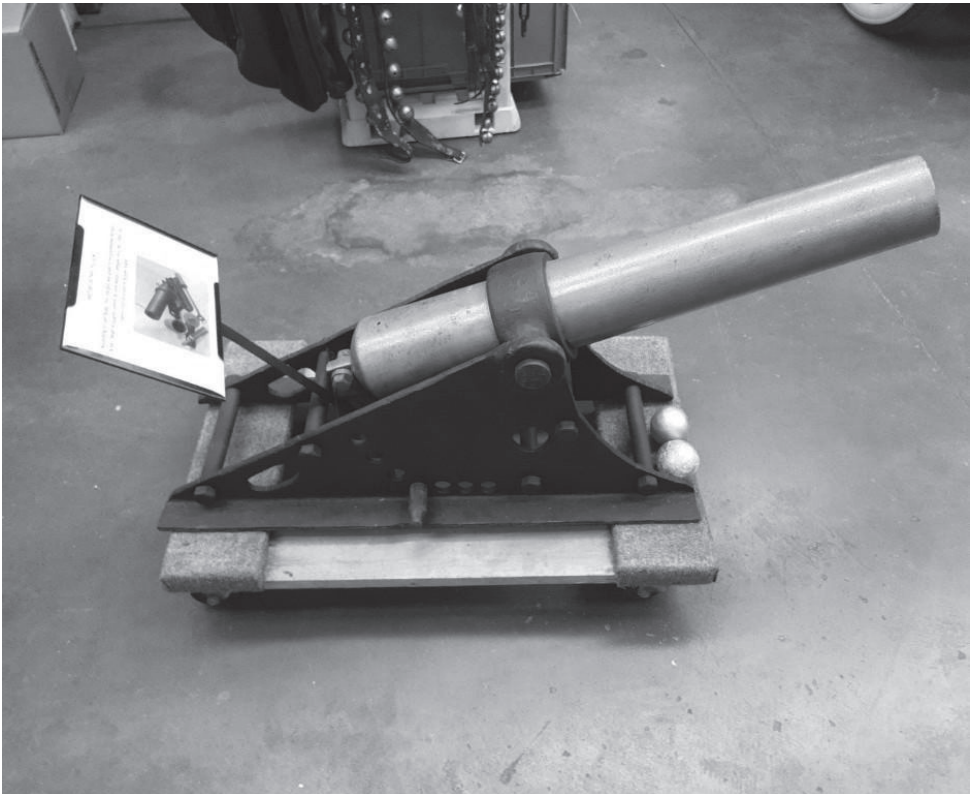

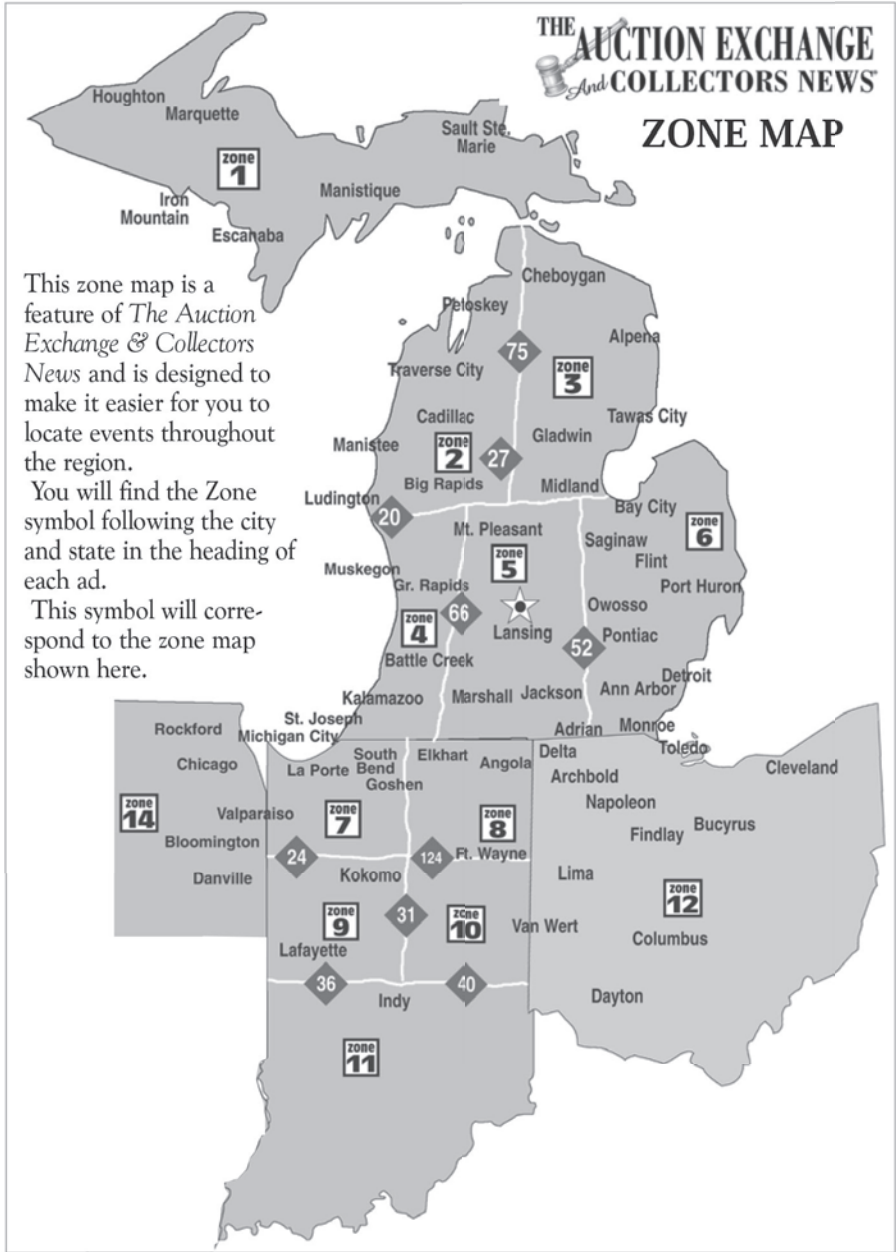

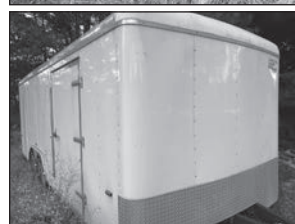

Centennial Farm Antiques readies for Harvest Festival

DEWITT, Mich. — It's harvest season in this small community (pop. 4,507), about 10 miles north of Lansing, and its prime time for antiquers to

take in the bounty of vintage goods and antiques at the 14th annual October Antique Harvest Festival on Oct. 9 and 10.

Each year, Jill Albert from Centennial Farm Antiques, on Howe Road outside DeWitt, fills up her big showpiece red and white barn with antiques, while other vendors may take to the hen house, the granary or set up outside.

Jill loves the farm. Her grandfather bought the farm in 1891. The first owner built the barn using large hand-hewn timber, pegging the pieces together with wood pegs and carefully leveling up the entry into the bank barn for a team of horses.

Her grandfather, Henry Henning, was a 16-year-old ship stow-

away from Germany, coming to the United States with little money, language skills or friends. After skirting by Ellis Island, he ultimately made his way to DeWitt. Little is known about this period, only that through f hard work and a passable knowledge of the English language, he grabbed his piece of land and gained his hold in America.

Her dad, Leo Henning, bought out two sisters' plots in the 1930s after his father died. It's where Jill Albert has spent – and enjoys - her life.

"I just love old things," she says. "It's the care and the pride people took in building things ... it was a simpler time. And everything that was made then, was made to last."

Each year she has had up to 20 vendors at the event, which at her insistence bring their best wares. Because of unpredictable weather, she can never predict the dealer turnout, because of it's a nice day the yard is filled with sellers.

She charges no entry to customers. Her outside vendors can sell free. There are refreshments on the grounds. Many of her dealers come from outside the area in Michigan, with the vast majority being full-time antique dealers, she says.

The 14th Annual Antique Harvest Festival, which is always conducted on the second weekend of October, will be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Oct. 9 and 10.

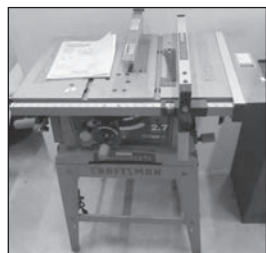

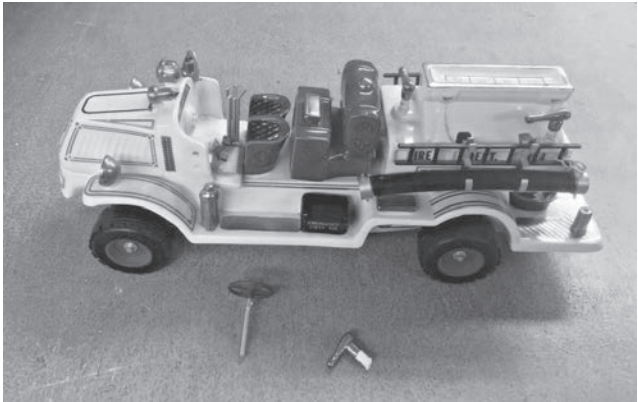

sought-after decanter collections is Jim Beam's historic fire vehicle decanters, which focused on historic fire engines. These decanters are cross-collectible since whiskey collectors, decanter collectors, and fire truck collectors all search for them.

Fire engine whiskey

decanter have been advertised as "ready to put the fires out," but the fires referred to were, probably, more psychological than flaming.

Jim Beam's historic fire engine decanters boast minute details such as hubcaps, headlamps, and pipes connecting the water tank to the steam chamber. Although primarily made of ceramic with plastic accessories, these decanters are

detailed enough to capture the imagination of fireman and collectors.

Fortunately for collectors, Jim Beam decanters are affordable. Issued in 1981, Beam's 1923 Ahrens-Fox fire engine decanter, in empty condition, is valued at \$100. This decanter holds special meaning for some American collectors since Ahrens-Fox Fire Engine Company was an Ohio-based fire engine manufacturer.

Not all Jim Beam fire engine decanters depict motorized decanters. One of the company's best-looking whiskey

decanter was its No. 313 decanter, depicting an 1867 Mississippi fire engine. This decanter was issued in 1978 and, today, is valued at \$60.

To some degree, the popularity of collecting Jim Beam fire engine decanters has waned. Baby Boomers were the generation that was known as "collectors," and, today, this generation of collectors is selling off its collections. But this is good news.

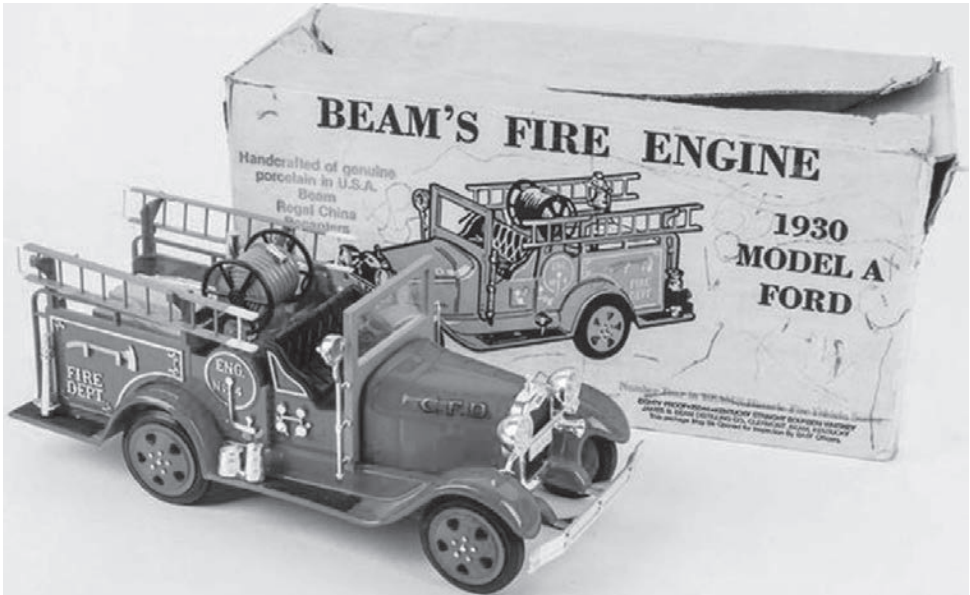
Jim Beam fire engine decanters will never become extinct if men like to drink and little boys dream of becoming firemen.

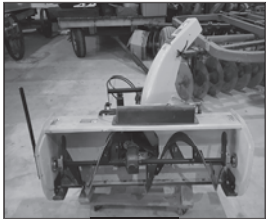
