Indiana stoneware and coverlets soar high at Davies auction

Lafayette, Ind. — Years ago unless a piece of furniture, stoneware, or textile

originated from the eastern portion of the U.S., collectors — let's be honest — turned up their noses. Not anymore. Pieces from the South and Midwest have now acquired

their own legion of advocates with Indiana items also having a strong fan-base.

Regionalism was in full force at the online-only Davies Auctions' held Oct. 14 with early American country furniture, early Indiana stoneware, Indiana coverlets, early lighting, country accessories, toys, primitives, general store items, Civil War era autographs, and the like selling strong.

"The stoneware, coverlets, cherry furni-

ture, and early lighting were from the collection of Ken and the late Donna Almon of Indianapolis with the rest of items being from a variety of consignors," said auctioneer Doug Davies.

Indiana stoneware continues to gain momentum in the marketplace. Such pieces have that organic utilitarianism collectors love. Where before such everyday pieces might have been overlooked, they now are both hard

Davisburg Antiques Festival had fabulous finds

DAVISBURG, Mich. — Vendors and shoppers came out for the recent Davisburg Antique Festival which was held at Springfield Oaks County Park.

Vendor Patrick McGar-

vey, from Grand Rapids, had a booth that was fascinating to browse in, even if it brought back some horrible childhood memories for many shoppers. He had an old dentist chair that dated from 1910. The patent dates were still easily readable under the seat. The base of the seat could be moved up or down, depending on

the height of the patient. It operated with pedal power and was complete with the pedal device that the dentist had to work with his foot while he drilled on the teeth.

McGarvey also had a newer dental device that was missing some pieces. It was a non-descript ivory color, with "arms" reaching out everywhere. It had the air and drill attachment, a place for the spit bowl which would have had the water constantly swirling around. There was a glass that was used by everyone for rinsing the mouth and two small glass containers that the dentist could fill with whatever he might need for the day. McGarvey has been into antiques for more than 30 years and had filled his booth with many heavy pieces like these two dental items. Everything he had was somehow involved with cast iron.

"I'm getting too old for this," McGarvey grinned. But the grin gave away the fact that he loved what he was doing.

Bill and Joan Kalmar from St. Clair, Mich., had a booth filled with vintage household items and furniture. They offered a wall trunk dating from the 1890s. It was made so that once it was pushed up against a wall, it would still open fully without pulling it out to leave room for the lid. Priced at \$425, this piece from the past had the original pieces inside. It was manufactured by the Eggeman Duguid Company out of Toledo, Ohio. Once this treasure was opened, there was ample room inside to use it today for storage of blankets in the living room or just to stash some items you wanted close, but not out to clutter your area. The original top tray would hold some smaller

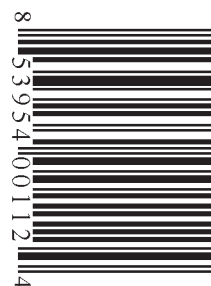

items, neatly organizing them for you and plenty of bulk storage underneath.

The Kalmar's also had a wall candle sconce. This item was only priced at \$33 and would be perfect for a modern power out-

age. It was made to hang on the wall and a tall candle would be placed inside the chimney. The candle could then be lit in the evenings for a nice romantic light or used to

to find and eagerly snatched up when they surface.

An 8-gallon early stoneware semi-ovoid jar wearing an impressed “8” and “Manufactor of A. & L. Uhl, Evansville, Ind. 20” was estimated to bring between \$100 and \$200, but instead required the winning bidder pony up \$3,300. Prices do not include the 15 percent buyer’s premium. At its widest point, the diameter of the jar was 13 inches and it stood 20 inches tall.

Impressed with “Martin Stuckey” and with a scratched in number “6”, this 6-gallon stoneware jar from Loogootee, Martin Co.,

Indiana, also sold strong realizing \$2,500. Other Indiana stoneware of note include a 4-gallon ovoid jar from Parke County, Indiana, wearing the impressed mark of “D.L. Atcheson, Annapolis, IA”. Atcheson started his pottery in 1841 and died in 1853. This 15-inch tall and 11 inch in diameter (at its widest point) jar sold for \$1,100. “IA” is an earlier state abbreviation for Indiana. A 1-gallon, 10-inch tall, ovoid stoneware jug impressed “Annapolis, IA” along with an impressed star, another Parke Co., Indiana, piece brought \$1,000.

Indiana decorative arts were also represented. A four-color Indiana, two-piece coverlet by William Deeds, Pipe Crick, Harrison

Twp. Miami County, Ind., and dated 1857 sold for \$2,200 against a \$600-\$800 estimate. Having a rooster border and fringe on three sides, this coverlet measured 72 inches wide by 87 inches long. “I was surprised by the number of people bidding on the coverlets; actually, more than those bidding on the stoneware,” Davies said. “The condition of the coverlets was good, so that was a major factor.”

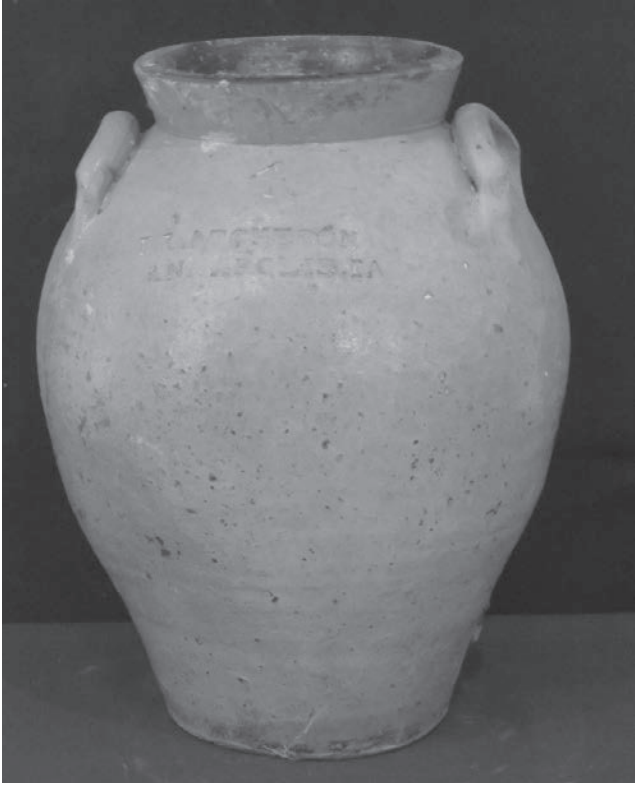
An Indiana impressionist fall landscape with a cabin by Sister Mary Rufinia (1881-1959) sold for \$1,600. Rufina was a Catholic nun who painted and gave lessons in the Lafayette, Ind., Diocese. This oil on Masonite work measured 25 inches by 30 inches.

Furniture offered at this October auction did not necessarily come from the Midwest. A Southern cherry sugar chest having a

dovetailed case, dovetailed drawer, interior divider, and lock with an inlaid escutcheon was bid to \$1,500. It stood 34 inches tall. And a diminutive (at 42 inches high) walnut jelly cupboard with two dovetailed drawers and poplar side came in at \$1,300.

Another surprise for Davies was the lot of insulators that sold strong. “These were part of the Almon’s things, and I was not really sure if they would be noticed,” Davies said. “I was wrong about that.”

A lot of seven glass and four pottery insulators sold for \$650 against an estimate of \$20 to \$50. Included in the lot were two Mickey Mouse style insulators in aqua and green marked Heminggray, one cobalt blue glass example, one white pottery piece marked Lapp 1928 and two 6-inch-tall green glass pieces to name a few. “We had 600 bidders

registered for this auction, and we continue to do very well selling only online,” Davies notes. “I believe holding online only sales will be how we continue to do our auctions

since we have done well for our consignors doing so.”

Auburn Cord Duesenberg Museum gets \$500,000 grant

AUBURN, Ind. — The Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum has been awarded a \$500,000 matching grant from the National Park Service through the Save America’s Treasures program to preserve and restore its National Historic Landmark Building. The SAT program is funded through the Historic Preservation Fund using revenue from Outer Continental Shelf oil lease revenue, not tax dollars.

For forty-seven years, the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum has provided a meaningful experience through the significant portrayal of the automotive industry as a transformation in the American story. “We are dedicated to preserving the history of design, engineering, and architecture; celebrating its relevance to our present and future; and continuing to be a driving force,” officials said.

In 2018 the museum launched a capital campaign with a goal of \$5 million to address the critical needs of the building and to embark upon an informed preservation and rehabilitation plan that will honor the legacy of all who contributed to one of the country’s most innovative and influential periods. A Historic Structures Report has been the guide to this preservation and restoration plan, and with this Save America’s Treasures grant, the museum has reached the halfway mark of its \$5 million goal.

The campaign’s future funding-dependent phases will repair, restore, and preserve all the original metal windows and frames, deteriorating brick and mortar, deteriorating cast iron window lintels, replace electrical, plumbing, and HVAC equipment, repoint masonry, and clean and protect the building for another hundred years.

Through completed scientific paint analysis, period appropriate paint restoration of the Company Showroom and other parts of the building that have never been open to the public before will also be implemented in future phases.

Ninety years ago, industrialist E.L. Cord commissioned the design and construction of the building to be a capstone to his empire. Designed by A.M. Strauss, the Art Deco masterpiece served as the brain and nerve center of the Auburn Automobile Company and Duesenberg, Inc. Out of this building came some of the most epic and forward-thinking designs in automotive history. Innovative designers, marketing geniuses, and tenacious engineers all contributed.

light a room with the flame safely enclosed in a glass chimney. It had a beautiful brass look to it and a reflective brass piece behind to help project the light outward in to the room.

A booth set up right along the front edge of this show, just down from the classic cars, proved to be one which was hard to get out of. A child's toy pictured a crying bear sitting in the dentist' chair. The graphics on this box were very vivid in color. Inside was the original toy in untouched condition. It was made by S & E in Japan. Dated 1948, this piece from the past was priced at \$1,000. The dentist bear puts the drill in the patients' mouth and the head of the patient vibrates from the drilling process. This was a battery-operated tin toy in pristine condition.

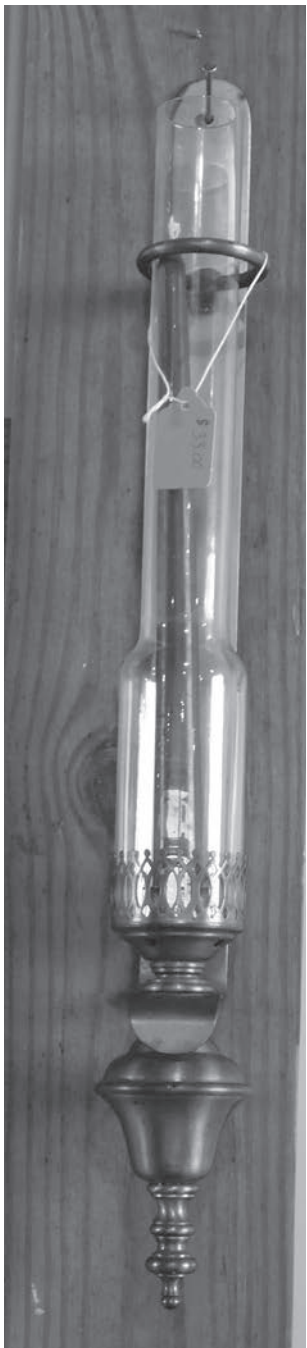
A Pepsi-Cola radio dated back before World War II. Holding to the \$1,000 price tag, this radio was a very rare

Toaster association holds convention

COLUMBIA, S.C. — The Toaster Collectors Association (TCA) held its annual convention, Octoastertfest, Oct. 14-16 in Columbia hosted by Ken and Cordie Huggins.

Ken is the holder of the Guinness World Record for largest toaster collection. He documented 1,284 toasters in his collection as of July 31, 2012, but has added hundreds more since. Twenty members attended coming from Minnesota to Texas and several states in between. The annual conventions began in 1999 and several members have been hosts. The members are encouraged to bring toaster displays, favorite toasters or new acquisitions. Awards are given for best display and best toaster in several category types. Buying, selling and trading is also part of the convention.

Toasters as well as other electric heating devices (irons, stoves, heaters, cof-

fee makers, waffle makers, etc.) became commercially successful following Albert Marsh's 1906 invention of nickel chromium (nichrome) wire that would glow red hot without burning out. GE is generally credited with the first successful mass-produced toaster, the porcelain based model D12, in 1908. The first automatic popup toaster, the Toastmaster 1A1, came out in 1927 following the invention of the commercial bread slicer for bakeries.

Interestingly, no electric toasters are being produced in the US today, most coming from China.

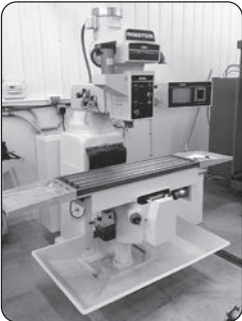

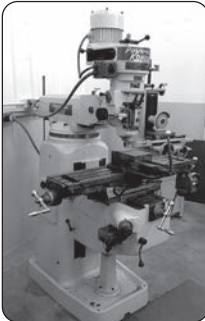

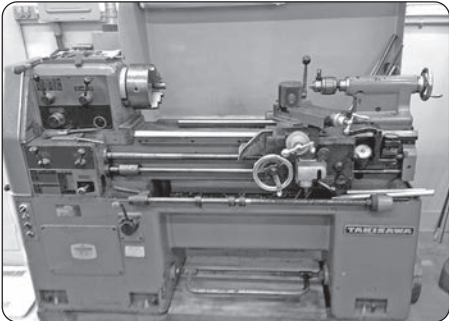
