### Lady's porcelain glove box warmed up to \$480 bid

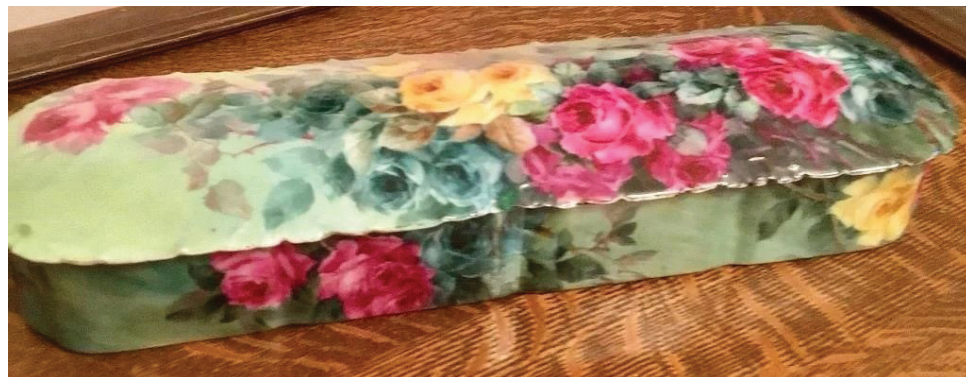
HEMLOCK, Mich. — Bob and Mary Jane Turner owned and operated Turner Flower Shop for 35 years in Hemlock.

They were known for their unique arrangements and antique collections. Wegner Auctioneers was given the opportunity to disperse this extraordinary estate consisting of antique fur-

niture, beautiful glassware and pottery, and many more unusual and eye-catching items, as well as items from their household, floral shop and garage. The 577 lots of this online sale represented only a portion of the entire inventory, and there will be at least one more auction to finish the job. Prices listed here do not include the buyer's premium.

Decorative items performed well at this sale, with an exquisite

hand-painted lady's glove box leading the way. This 15-inch-long porcelain container with bold red, yellow, and blue roses and a scalloped lid was in excellent condition despite its very fragile nature. It provided a very tempting picture and was claimed with a

high bid of \$480. Another lot featuring an assortment of three hand-painted plates or possibly trays (since they had handles) was attributed to Bavaria or Austria. Beautifully decorated with red and pink roses and rose buds, these large plates closed with a

final bid of \$175.

A dainty pink glass epergne presented an eye-catching display featuring a generous bowl at the base supporting three upright flower stems as well as a hang-

### Gurley candles could light up the Thanksgiving table

During the 1950s and '60s, perhaps the Golden Years of Thanksgiving Day when families celebrated every Thanksgiving Day gathered together around a table, Gurley Novelty manufactured nearly every Thanksgiving holiday candle purchased, which was millions of candles. Gurley's goal was to light up America's holiday season.

Baby Boomers remember seeing Gurley candles on their parent's Thanksgiving Day tables.

The Gurley Thanksgiving line featured whimsical holiday icons, such as turkeys, in a variety of designs and colors, allowing for collections to grow over the years.

Interesting enough,

Gurley holiday candles, designed and manufactured by Franklin Gurley, were collectible right from their creative inception.

Franklin C. Gurley took over a confectionary company in Buffalo, N.Y., in 1927, when he purchased the W&F Manufacturing Company, which specialized in all kinds of candies, including edible paraf-

fin novelties.

In 1939 Socony-Vacuum Oil Company (ExxonMobile today) approached Gurley about manufacturing candles using excess paraffin produced as a by-product of Socony-Vacuum's oil refinery in Olean, N.Y. Franklin Gurley decided to use this paraffin to produce highly detailed holiday can-

dles.

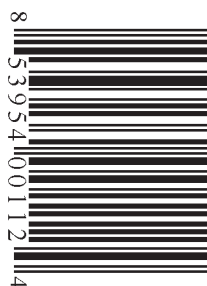
The original Gurley candles were manufactured under the name Tavern Novelty Candles. In 1949 the name was changed to Gurley Novelty Candles when Franklin Gurley became sole owner and expanded the candle-making part of the business until it

ing basket. This delightful centerpiece in perfect condition earned a high bid of \$230. An electric lamp consisting of a deep rose-colored glass hob-nail shade was offered as possibly being made by Fenton. Supported on a metal base with the look of an oil lamp, this attractive accessory finished with a high bid of \$185. Pink seemed to be the favored color, as further shown by a Gone with Wind style electrified lamp. Also having the appearance of an oil lamp, this tall beauty was supported on a wooden spindle with a large rose-colored globe on top and a smaller pink one below decorated with lilacs. It required a bid of \$155 to take it home. Two more appealing, electrified hurricane/ Gone with the Wind style lamps with floral decorations on their glass shades finished at

\$102.50 each. A pleasingly colorful round glass covered butter or cheese dish provided a desirable image. The clear blue glass was decorated with whimsical representations of brightly colored yellow daisies along with their leaves and stems. The dish was offered with its metal carrier. Even though it was reported to have two small chips on the outer edge, it still was eagerly claimed with a final bid of \$125. Several handsome wood furniture items were offered, all in exceptionally nice condition and ready for a new home. There were a variety of vanity dressers with large mirrors, various configurations of drawers, shelves, ledges, and ornate frames, and most had marble tops. The top bid winner in this category was the Eastlake style dresser with a white marble vanity top that was part of a bedroom set. The dresser alone drew a final bid of \$165. A similar Eastlake style dresser with a white marble vanity top finished at \$155. A dresser featuring a green mar-

ble vanity top closed at \$145, while a massive dresser with a large gray marble slab surface and three large drawers reached \$135. A few sets of metal furniture were also available. A wrought iron set featuring a round, glass-topped bistro table with two padded chairs finished at \$110. An equally appealing metal oblong (6 by 8 feet) table with glass top and 6 matching chairs unfortunately did not have seats or cushions, so it was taken with a bid of \$30.

For something com-

pletely different, there was an antique nickel, brass, and marble National cash register dating from circa 1915. It was in exceptional cosmetic condition, but some of the keys may have been sticking. This massive relic from another time was rehomed with a high bid of \$380.

Two old cast iron school bells with their mounting yokes were available. At least one of them was clearly stamped C.S. Bell Co Hillsboro, Ohio. The one that showed less wear was claimed with a final bid of \$145 while the other with some corrosion was close behind at \$140.

Advertising items with a local connection are always popular. A large metal tin reading “Triumph Blend Symons Bros & Co. Fine Roasted Coffees Saginaw E.S. Mich” was a keepsake from a nearby city. It is not clear what the “E.S.” stood for, but at one time there was a town called E. Saginaw that was later absorbed by Saginaw. Or possibly it referred to East South Michigan. This green box with brightly colored lettering was claimed with a final bid of \$140. A mixed lot of glassware from Hemlock merchants no longer in business featured logo merchandise from Pretzer & Fuller (2 vases), Henry Heintz (glass), and O.W. Bauer (ashtray). A local history buff claimed their prize with a high bid of \$37.50.

# Beistle decorations can bring Thanksgiving to the table

Most Thanksgiving honeycomb decorations are not as popular as Halloween or Christmas honeycomb decorations, after all, ghosts, witches, and Santa Claus almost always beats out a tom turkey decoration. But collectors' tastes are changing. Today many collectors seek Thanksgiving honeycomb.

While no one knows exactly when Thanksgiving Day decorations were first mass-produced, most collectors agree that Beistle Company of Pennsylvania led the production of these Turkey-day decorations for all of the 20th century.

Martin Luther Beistle, circa 1900, founded the Beistle Company with the idea of creating artificial plants, made from paper, for hotel lobbies.

Shortly after founding the company, Beistle traveled to Heidelberg, Germany, and observed the manufacturing of a honeycombing technique of working with paper. Beistle instantly saw the possible application of honeycomb holiday decorations.

By 1910, Beistle

had imported the German technology to produce honeycomb tissue paper decorations, and around 1920 Beistle partnered with the Paper Novelty Company to produce a complete line of paper decorations for holidays such as Thanksgiving, including Beistle's soon-to-be-famous honeycomb turkey decorations.

In its simplest form, a honeycomb design uses multiple sheets of colored tissue paper that are layered and folded, and then rectangular squares are cut out of the paper. When the required de-

sign is completed, the layered tissue paper is then glued to small strips of cardboard to give the honeycomb structure stability. Honeycomb structures, even simply tissue paper turkey decorations depend on the geometry found in a honeycomb to form hollow cells between thin vertical walls.

Collectors search diligently for Beistle honeycomb Thanksgiving decorations, including turkeys, corn shocks, scarecrows, orange balls, Native Americans, pilgrims, and pumpkins. Vintage or new, Beistle

honeycomb turkeys will gobble up your guests' attention on Thanksgiving Day.

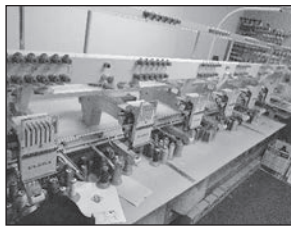

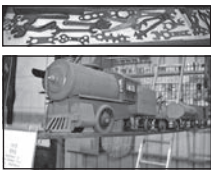

accounted for 98 percent of all sales, but many of the oldest Gurlley candles still have the "Tavern Novelty" tag on the bottom of the candle.

Regardless of the holiday, each Gurley candle was hand crafted, using several different molds. This attention to quality allowed Gurley to manufacture and sell extremely detailed holiday candles.

Some of the types of Gurley Thanksgiving candles include turkeys, pumpkins, autumn leaves, pilgrims, Native Americans, churches, and ships. Many different designs of turkeys were created and sold, and the pilgrims and Native Americans came in both male and female. The ship candle wasn't really a candle at all. Modeled after the Mayflower (the original Pilgrim ship), the ship was a solid wax candle holder that held a green tapered candle.

While it is difficult to “date” a Gurley candle, one quick way is to look at its sales price sticker on the bottom of the candle. Tavern Candles and some of the earliest Gurley Candles sold for 10¢ each, and the price seemed to increase by

The Gurley Candle Company closed its doors in the early 1980s, and almost immediately reproduction Gurley candles hit the secondary markets. One company, the Vermont Country Store, has been reproducing Gurley candles for years.

When purchasing a Gurley Thanksgiving Day candle, in order to better ensure that it is the “real” thing, only buy those candles with an original Tavern Novelty or Gurley Novelty sticker on the bottom. Also be aware that reproduction candles are brighter in color

than original Gurley candles. And, finally, only buy candles with unburned wicks. Gurley candles melt quickly and drip profusely, so the only way people were able to decorate with them year-after-year was to never burn them.

Not many Gurley Thanksgiving candles are truly rare, but some are much harder to find than others. Ones to look for include the Mayflower candleholder, a Native American Chief (most Gurley Native Americans did not have a head-dress), and the Colonial chapel candle with its high steeple pointing to God.

Expect to pay from \$5 to \$100 for authentic Gurley Thanksgiving Candles, depending on rarity and condition.

There are still hundreds of thousands of mint condition Gurley candles on the secondary markets, which is good news for beginning Gurley collectors.



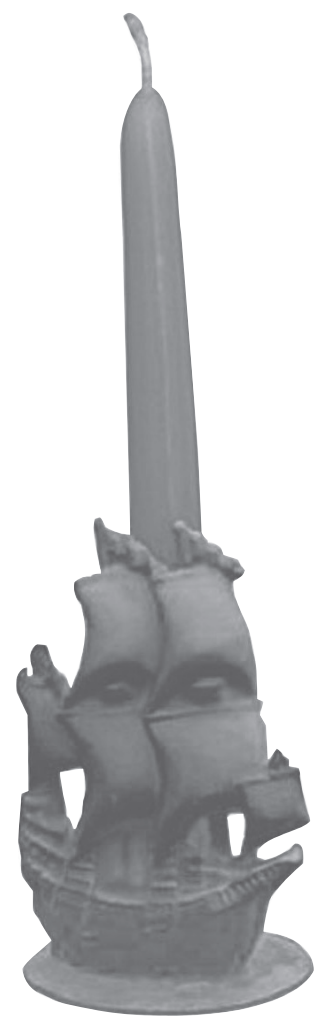
