Tether car races to \$440 at DenOtter auction

ARLINGTON Heights, Ill. — A variety of toys, dolls, and collectibles were offered recently at a DenOtter auction, including many hard-to-find

Since this was an early December sale, some of these items may have been destined to be holiday gifts for some lucky folks. The prices here do not include the buyer's premium.

Dolls, toy cars, and Pokemon trading cards dominated this event. The top lot of the day was the 1940s Challenger metal tether car. These fascinating models measure about 12 inches long, are powered by actual gasoline motors, and are raced by being tethered with a 33-foot steel cable to a central post. This aluminum automobile, unfortunately, was offered without the motor, but still drove home an impressive bid of \$440.

The racing car theme

and unusual treasures. proved popular for the best-selling model cars. Two 2008 Speed Racer Mach 5 diecast model cars by Hot Wheels were claimed with a final bid of \$85. A set of 1971 Wild Wheelie cars consisting of a Hot Wheels Don Prudhomme Snake 1 Dragster and a Tom McEwen Mongoose I Blue Dragster, each measuring about 4-inches long, finished at \$80 for the pair.

For a completely different automotive experience, there was a pink Mattel Barbie "Me and My Mustang" deluxe set offered in new condition, still sealed in its package. It included one Barbie doll, and the car was pictured as being able to "magically expand from 2-to-4-seater" to accommodate up to four dolls. It






Settle down for a Little Golden Christmas story

Little Golden Books can make the perfect Christmas decoration with their colorful titles.

As an added bonus, guests can read them in just a few minutes.

The Artists and Writers Guild, a subsidiary of Western Publishing and Lithographing Company



of Racine, Wis., first published Little Golden Books, in association with Simon & Schuster, 79 ago, in 1942. There were 12 titles in the original series: Three Little Kittens, Bedtime Stories, The Alphabet from A to Z, Mother Goose, Prayers for Children, The Little Red Hen, Nursery Songs, The Poky Little Puppy, The Golden Book of Fairy Tales, Baby's Book, The Animals of Farmer Jones, and This Little Piggy and Other Counting Rhymes. Each book cost 25¢.


When first published, Little Golden Books were as popular with mothers as they were with children. Even in hard times, mothers considered the books inexpensive. And

Little Golden Books were one of the first children's book series to be offered for sale in grocery stores and five & dime stores, such as Woolworth's.

Collectors today always seek out the original 12 titles, which have become something of a Holy Grail in Little Golden Book collecting. Other books based on vintage television shows and movies are also popular. Books such as Bambi (1949), Captain Kangaroo (1959), Alice in Wonderland (1951) Howdy Doody (1955), and the Lone Ranger in 1956 are eagerly sought after. There are even Little Golden Book collectors who only collect Disney editions. One of the most fun and most rewarding Little Golden



Book collections is its line Christmas books, which thrilled children then and still thrill collectors today.

Besides The Christmas Story, some of the Little Golden Book Christmas










bidding on an MRC (Model Rectifier Corporation) 1955 Elvis pink Cadillac 1:18 scale diecast model car in original box that featured a photo of Elvis on the front. This nostalgic item was taken with a high bid of \$40.

A wide variety of dolls, from babies to sophisticated adults, were available. The highest-selling darling was the Ashton Drake Jasmine's First Birthday 22-inch collectible vinyl and cloth weighted doll by Waltraud Hanl. She was sold with her original box and papers and proved irresistible, requiring a bid of \$240 to adopt her. Another unusual offering was the Annette Himstedt Taki Japanese baby girl Puppen Kinder vinyl and cloth weighted doll. Measuring approximately 22-inches long, she was from the Barefoot Children Collection. Her box included a cover decorated with images of dolls featuring various nationalities and there was also a booklet and certificate of authenticity. This cutie drew a final bid of \$210. A smartly attired Robert Tonner Ellowyne Wilde Imagination "Sushi for One" Limited Edition 16-inch fashion vinyl doll, new in box presented an attractive picture. She was produced in 2006. The paperwork in the box included a cryptic poem about Ellowyne Wilde by Lorraine T. Bonecki. She found a new home with a final bid of \$140.

An impish Susan Krey Baby Primi Bambini 20-inch doll in a limited edition of 97 featured a porcelain head, arms, and legs with a cloth weighted body. Her beautiful blue glass eyes gave her a very realistic look, and her delicate lacy blue dress, original box and certificate were all in excellent condition. This rare sweetheart was claimed with a high bid of \$130. A wide variety of other dolls by Alexander, Robert Tonner, Lee Middleton / Reva Schick, and Mattel were also eagerly claimed by collectors.

A large lot consisting of 23 1980s Hasbro 3 ¾-inch GI Joe and Lanard figures in various uniforms and outfits, numerous weapons, stands, equipment such as a shovel and an axe, backpacks, and even a military dog proved very popular, drawing a final bid of \$270. To help equip these fighters there was a group of 1980s Hasbro 3 34-inch scale GI tanks, vehicles, large weapons, tools, and ammunition that was taken with a final bid of \$90.

Pokemon items were scattered throughout the

sale and did very well. A solitary Pokemon trading card was the star of this category. It was a 1999 Pokemon Fossil Horsea 1st Edition Gem mint 10 card graded by PSA/DNA. It featured a Horsea char-Ashton Drake, Madame acter that was capable of blowing a smokescreen to protect against other players' attacks. It was sealed in plastic and in mint condition, earning a high bid of \$230. A group of 26 Pokemon Trading Card Movie Game Series Cards presented an unusual offering. These are cards that were given out at a movie and then traded in at a Warner Brothers store, except these were never traded in. All but one were still in their sealed plastic packing and this highly desirable lot closed at \$180. Other large lots of Pokemon cards included 31 First Generation cards that finished at \$160, 88 assorted Gym Hero cards for \$140, plus other equally large

groupings for \$60-140.

Many game cartridges, consoles, and accessories for Nintendo NES, Wii, and P2 were offered for the nostalgic collector or player. However, one particular lot stood out. There were two "Berserker" and one "Fleshy" Gem ini Collectors Edition of Freak Controllers for PS2 sculpted by Jeff Kokin, the renowned movie miniature and action figure artist. Still new in their packages. these hand-painted novelties closed at \$210 for the trio.



After almost 2-year hiatus, Scott Show returns to Columbus, Ohio

By WILLIAM FLOOD

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Scott Antique Show returned to the Columbus market the weekend of November 27-28, after nearly two years of COVID forced hiatus. Both dealers and customers were waiting.

Scott Antique Markets began over three decades ago by former antique dealer Don Scott. Antique shows were quite different 30 years ago and Scott felt a calling to start his own series that placed a greater emphasis on customer service. The events quickly grew in popularity and vendors and guests flock from across the country to Expo centers in Atlanta, Ga., and Columbus, Ohio, to attend the markets.

Before the pandemic hit, Scott shows ran monthly in Columbus from November through March. However, lockdowns forced the Columbus series to shutter early on, and it remained

on hiatus until November 2021. Meanwhile, Atlanta's markets continued somewhat business-as-usual through much of 2020 and 2021. The operational contrast stemmed from Ohio's more stringent COVID precautions. Statewide masking mandates and restrictions on indoor events remained in effect through early summer of 2021. On top of statewide mandates, Columbus and surrounding Franklin

County had their own; those remained in force even after state regulations were lifted. During the Scott weekend when Columbus's



books that collectors seek are Noel (the story of a Christmas tree ornament), Frosty the Snowman, Jingle Bells, and Rudolf the Red-Nosed Reindeer.

Walt Disney Productions copyrighted several Little Golden Books Christmas books, such as Mickey's Christmas Carol, Santa's Toy Shop, and Mickey Mouse Goes Christmas Shopping. These books are all considered cross collectible, and they give a wonderful Disney-depth to any Christmas book collection.

Collectors also seek Big Golden Books, such as The Golden Christmas Book (this book is famous for the wonderful honey-comb paper Christmas tree that unfolds when you open the book) and The Night Before Christmas based on the all-time classic Christmas poem by Clement C. Moore.

Mint condition Little Golden Books are rare since they were published for young children who colored in them, chewed on them, and transferred dirt and sticky candy from hand to page in nearly all




Above and right: Vintage, 1947 Big Golden Christmas Book, 1st edition, which is valued at \$140. The book has a beautiful honeycomb illustration.


of them. But even with these imperfections, popularity continues to make prices soar on the secondary markets.


Good condition or, rarely, mint condition books bring much higher prices and add prestige and depth to any collection.


Above: Walt Disney's Santa's Toy Shop, circa 1950, is 24-pages long and valued at \$45.







Forget supply chain issues; buy vintage games

Sink a battleship, defeat a king, snag your dream date for the prom. Build a hotel on the Boardwalk, put a "Z" tile on "triple word score," accuse Miss Scarlett of murder with a lead pipe in the Conservatory. It's all in an afternoon's (or evening's) diversion, all with the comforts of home. As people have spent more time indoors due to the pandemic, many have turned to old favorites. Combine that with the upcoming holidays (not to mention cold weather): The popularity of board and card games is burgeoning on the retail front and increasingly popular among collectors. And experts have the numbers to prove it.

While today's games have roots that extend back multiple centuries and span worldwide cultures, the first American board games were produced in the 1800s. Early examples include "The Travellers Tour Through the United States" (introduced in 1822, markers are advanced by a spinner, not dice, across a map) and "Mansion of Happi-" (first published

"Goose," it encourages moralistic behavior).

They were just the beginning: Since then, thousands of board and card games have been manufactured, according to Desi Scarpone, a dedicated collector. As for the current market, he confirmed that interest (and prices) are up. "There was definitely a time when board games were in a slump. Nothing was selling," noted Scarpone, author of books on the subject (including a series of Schiffer-published titles). "But it seems like the next generation of kids are now adults, and they are looking for the games of their youth."

Scarpone said he's amazed that relatively recent games, including "It From the Pit," "Fireball Island," "Tornado Rex," and "Hero Quest," all games that he "wouldn't have given a second glance to," are now "consistently selling for hundreds of dollars." Similarly, games from the 1960s, particularly TV-related ones, are commanding surprisingly high prices.

Among his "too many" personal favorites are "Voice of the Mummy," 'Skittle Bowl," "Green

the early Italian game as well as "Barnabas Collins Dark Shadows Game" and "Dogfight." Recent acquisitions Hasbro's include "Banana Splits Game," Milton Bradley's "Wina-Card Trading Game" and Lakeside's Boomb!"

Scarpone tries to buy only complete games in good condition, but there are exceptions. He finally cobbled together a complete "That Girl," after three tries. On the other hand, he has a 1964 "Munster" game that is "missing a side of the box, but I think it's better to have any copy, regardless of condition, rather than none."

But for those who just want to play the game, the collector pointed out, condition is not a factor. And old is often better than new. "New reissues of old games are usually far inferior, from materials to artwork to implements. A vintage game will always look, feel, and play better than a modern reissue. It could be nostalgia clogging up my senses, but almost everyone I meet says the same thing. They buy a new game for their children, thinking they will have the same experience they had as in 1843 and inspired by Ghost" and "Can't Stop," a child, and it falls

short. Play vintage!"

And as it turns out, this rising popularity of games is not just subjective: Those thinking that board and card games are little more than child's (or adult's) play might be surprised to learn of the intensity of market research on the subject. Just ask Dallin Hatch, an analysis expert for Pattern, a global ecommerce accelerator.

"We know that families get together during the holidays and either buy new games or take down dusty ones from "We decided to see if the data bears that out." A list of popular board and card games was compiled, and thus began a study in 2019 that tracked trends in online demand. As expected, this assumption was confirmed, as interest surged at the beginning of each year's holiday shopping sea-

What could not have been predicted at the outset of the study, though, was the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. An "overnight spike" was reported on March 22, 2020, due to the national lockdown. Since that time, the curves on Pattern's graphs have continued

to mirror those of the CDC's reports of infec-

As for which games in particular are being played, chess ("one of the oldest games around") proved to be the most popular tabletop game of all, topping out with a 400 percent increase over the threeyear period. "I should have seen this coming," Hatch remarked. No doubt, he continued, the popularity of Netflix's "The Queen's Gambit," which premiered in October 2020, contributed to this phenomethe shelf," Hatch began. non. But even without the series, what Hatch referred to as "the king of board games" has "staying power," up 47 percent over last year and resulting in a "new baseline for the game."

Behind chess in popularity were "Uno," Pokémon cards, "Clue," and "Risk," a 2021 inductee into the National Toy Hall of Fame at The Strong Museum of Play.

Meanwhile, no game showed a larger increase in demand than did "Settlers of Catan" ("it takes a while to play"). It was followed by such diverse titles as "Hungry Hungry Hippos," and "Ticket to Ride" (a game about train travel and no relation to the Beatles' song of the same name). Likewise, the game "Pandemic" enjoyed renewed popularity. In general, Hatch noted, games requiring four players were more popular than those played by two (chess and "Connect Four" are exceptions to that rule, however). Games for adults seem to be enjoying a larger upswing than those geared toward children.

The bottom line is that "now more than ever, board and card games have risen in popularity." And this is not just a hunch, but rather, borne out by statistics. Furthermore, now might well be the time to buy previously played versions of games like "Monopoly" and "Clue," not as collectibles, but as favorites to be played. This strategy, Hatch said, might well be a way to deal with inflationary prices among new games, not to mention a way to circumvent supply chain shortages. "It's hard to predict how the world will look next year," he concluded. But when it comes to estate and yard sales, "Collectors and dealers would be doing themselves a favor by keeping an eye out and buying early in the year."
