Fine furniture had strong appeal at Heartland show

WILMINGTON, Ohio — The Ohio Country Antiques Show returned to the Roberts Centre in

on Saturday, April 9. The event is one of three Heartland Antique shows scheduled for 2022 by Jennifer A. Sabin Show Management.

Heartland events are

distinctive in that they focus on traditional antiques rather than being a more generalized antiques show. In this round, 57 dealers arrived from the Midwest and as far away as Missouri and New Hampshire. They brought early America to life with merchandise that ranged from Amish pie safes and rustic farm tables to redware pottery and generations-old quilts. The array of 18th, 19th, and even early 20th-century primitive and formal furniture was dazzling. Of note, all merchandise was guaranteed as represented, with original finish.

The shows typically draw around 1,000 attendees and help dispel the myth that good-quality, traditional antiques

have lost their appeal. People still want to own a piece of history. When the doors opened, buyers quickly snatched up everything from country cabinets to smalls like whiskey jugs and hand-carved ducks. One dealer,

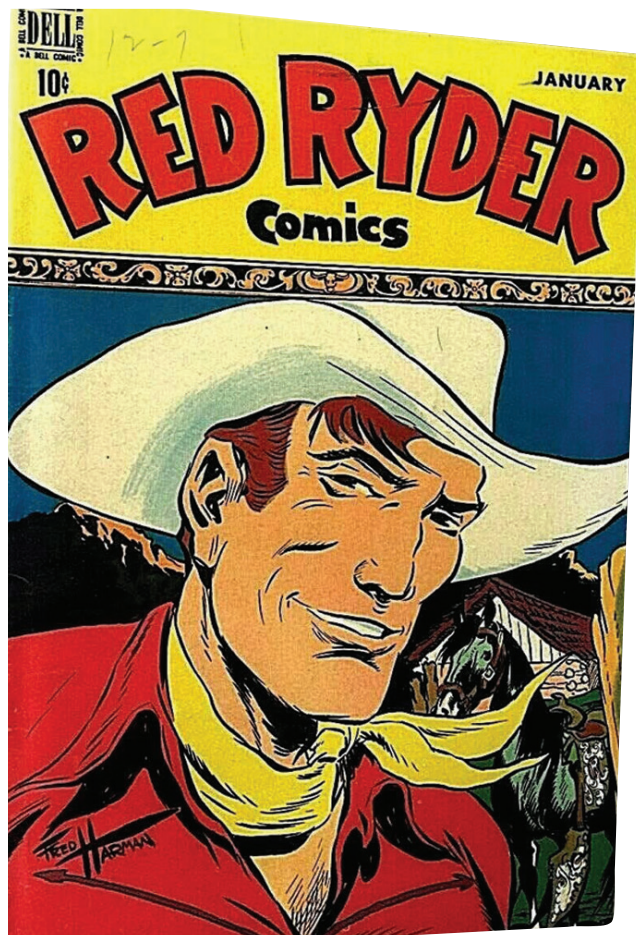
Chris Smith from Waynesville, Ohio, had affixed six "sold" tags to merchandise within the first half-hour. Two hung on large pieces of primitive furniture; the others were on accent pieces. Those tagged items didn't

account for the pieces buyers had already removed.

Most booths had an obvious appeal because they looked like pages plucked from a country

Red Ryder more than a BB gun

Red Ryder was a syndicated Western comic strip from November 6, 1938, through 1965. Stephen Slesinger and western artist Fred Harman created the original Red Ryder strip, which became the inspiration for books, movies, and comic books, and it inspired a potpourri of Red Ryder merchandise that is still collected today.

Slesinger and Harman, who was a charter member of Cowboy Artists of America, worked in New York City for over a year, carefully planning and laying out Red Ryder's future in comic pages, movies, radio shows, contests, and merchandizing tie-ins. Slesinger had a lot of experience creating entire "packages" around fictional characters. He pioneered what became known as "synergy," where the whole concept of a character is greater than any one part. He had made such characters as Tarzan and Winnie the Pooh mega-dollar character franchises, so he set his sights on Red Ryder, determined to make Red a household name. And Slesinger suc-

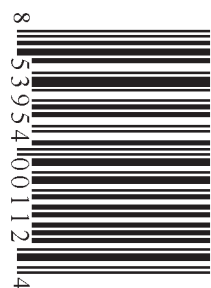


ceeded.

Red was a tough, no-nonsense cowboy who lived on the Painted Valley Ranch in the 1890s. Red loved his mighty horse Thunder and sticking his nose into trouble. His best friend and sidekick

was Little Beaver, a Native American boy who followed Red Ryder everywhere on his pinto horse Papoose. Red Ryder was loved by millions of Americans, but some of

magazine. Such was the case with Beth Pulsipher Antiques. The Michigan dealer has sold off and on at the Ohio show for years. In addition to country furniture and decor items, her tables were rife with her signature items - antique sewing tools and accessories. A green country cupboard anchoring the outside of her booth was available for \$385. Inside was a two-tiered cupboard for \$285. Attracting constant atten-

tion was the 1870s fitted sewing box, almost complete, with just one original tool missing. It was priced confidently at \$695. R.L. Meyers had a booth that also celebrated early-American life. The Valparaiso, Indiana, dealer was at the show for just the fourth time, with an array of furniture and decorative items going back to the early 19th-century. Nicely staged together was a circa 1820s bottle (\$295); a smattering of wood kitchen work bowls (\$375-\$695) and two folk art paintings of young women for \$425 each.

Close by was a good-condition four tin pie safe for \$1,150. From Lebanon, Ohio came Deborah Fisher, a veteran antique dealer of 45 years who has sold at the show nearly since its inception. Her booth, another testament to Americana, included a blue-painted 1800s cupboard priced at \$2,675, an 1800s blue pantry box for \$475, and a salt-glazed redware jug at \$275.

In contrast to all dealers offering country and primitive items, the gallery-like space of Columbus, Ohio's Angler House was filled with fine furniture. Owner John La Follette has sold at Heartland shows since the 1980s. His pieces included a French walnut dressing table circa 1760-1780 priced for \$975 and a Federal-era mahogany drop-leaf dining table for \$650. An Alpine child's chair, marked 1825, was available for just \$95.

Also contrasting were the numerous Native American items stocking the booth of Akron's Gary Promey Antiques. Displayed prominently on one wall was a Navajo storm pattern rug for \$575. Two other Navajo rugs were on shelves for \$650 and \$525. Promey was not the only seller of Native American wares. Grosbeak Antiques from Indiana had a collection of Pima, Taghkanic, and Pit River Indian baskets ranging in price from \$215 to \$695.

Andrew Richmond of the Ohio Company in

Marietta, Ohio likes to bring a few unusual items to these shows. He started in the auction business; now, he appraises, consults, and sells online and at a half-dozen shows each year. This time, he brought two 19th-century rifles with Ohio provenance. One was a beautiful 1860 Tyler from Trumbull, County for \$2,500; the other, attributed to a Piqua, Ohio, family, was priced at \$1,400. Buyers not interested in firearms may have appreciated several pieces of wall art, including an early 20th-century oil-on-canvas seascape for \$625 or a circa 1928 Metalcraft toy Zeppelin for \$850.

Folk art has enduring popularity. Linda Roggow from Grand Rapids, Michigan, is convinced of that. Her booth had numerous folk-art pieces including several made for children. Two standouts were a handmade Noah's Ark with 22 animals available for \$675 and a child's play dresser crafted from cigar boxes tagged at \$195.

Because of the age, caliber, and often rarity of merchandise at Heartland shows, buyers will find prices typically in the solid three- and four-figure range. Rarely will pieces be found for less than \$50. One dealer at Saturday's show, Ohio's Canvasback Antiques was an exception to the norm. They offered numerous pieces for smaller budgets, including an Atlantic cold blast lantern for \$49, a pair of sugar nips for \$45, and two hay hooks priced for \$12 and \$10 each.

The next Heartland event will take place Saturday, June 4 at the Wayne County Fairgrounds in Richmond, Indiana. The show returns to the Roberts Centre in Wilmington, Ohio on Saturday, October 15.

Slesinger's depictions of Native Americans, especially Little Beaver are considered stereotypes and offensive today. For instance, Little Beaver was depicted as speaking a broken, pidgin-style English, which included his most famous catchphrase "You betchum, Red Ryder."

Other characters in Red Ryder story lines included Red's aunt, the Duchess, his girlfriend, Beth Wilder, and his arch-nemesis, Ace Hanlon.

Red Ryder has the distinction of being the lon-

gest running and most popular of all Western genre comic characters, and the character became one of the longest running business relationships in the history of licensing.

The mass-market appeal of Red Ryder led to a stampede of collectible items that still has genuine Red Ryder items selling to collectors of all ages. Foremost in Red Ryder collectibles are his long-running comic book series. Slesinger's Hawley Publications issued the first Red Ryder comic book in September 1940. And Hi-Spot comics issued one other single-issue Red Ryder comic book. Then Dell Comics launched its series of Red Ryder

comic books, helping make Red Ryder a household name.

Dell Comics published its first Red Ryder comic book in August 1941, changing the name to Red Ryder Ranch Magazine, starting with issue #145. The earliest Red Ryder Dell comic books consisted of reprints of the newspaper comic strip. This changed in June 1947. With the release of issue #47, all Dell Red Ryder comic books were produced with original stories and drawings. In all, Dell published 151 Red Ryder comic books, ending in 1957, which remains one of the longest continuous runs for any Western-themed comic

book.

Red Ryder comic books make formidable collections all by themselves, especially if you seek all Red Ryder comic books. From 1954 – 1984, Novaro published 474 regular edition comic books, in Spanish, in 21 different countries and territories. A complete collection of Red Ryder comic books would be staggering and, probably, take a lifetime to collect.

Red Ryder also appeared on radio and in movies. In 1940, a 12-chapter movie serial of Red Ryder (The Adventures of Red Ryder) appeared, starring Don "Red" Barry as Red Ryder and Tommy Cook as Little Beaver. This initial serial was followed by 27 Red Ryder movies (the last four movies were in color). Collectors search for movie posters and tapes or CDs of these lost Red Ryder movies.

The most famous actor to ever appear in a Red Ryder movie was Robert Blake, who portrayed Little Beaver. Blake was credited at the time as Bobby Blake.

Two television Red Ryder pilots were shot (they sometimes show up on television western CDs), and in 1963 Gunsmoke featured an episode (I Call Him Wonder) that was supposed to be a pilot for a new Red Ryder television series. It featured Little Beaver as Wonder and was adapted from the story of

how Red Ryder and Little Beaver originally met each other. None of these TV pilots reached fruition, but they give collectors new directions to search for Red Ryder productions.

One of the most famous Red Ryder collectibles is the "Daisy Red Ryder Carbine-Action Two-Hundred

Shot Range Model Air Rifle BB Gun" that Ralphie wanted for Christmas in the 1983 movie "A Christmas Story." These rifles are still being made (with wooden stocks) and are fun collectibles to take in the backyard and blink at tin cans. But be careful, "You'll shoot your eye out!"

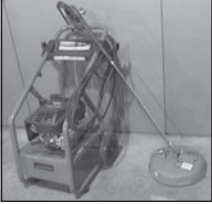

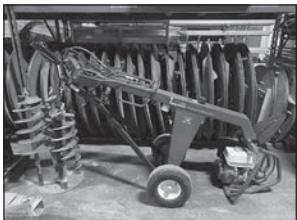

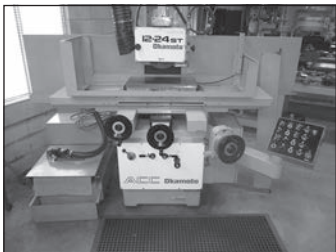
