ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

1960s Tonka farm set plows ahead with \$5,000 bid

SHIPSHEWANA, Ind. — Ertl, Tonka, Smith Miller, John Deere,

Buddy L, and Oliver were some of the familiar names featured at this recent toy auction. There were farm vehicles, construction equipment,

trucks, and even 22 lots of pedal cars, tractors, and related items. Many of these vintage items came with their original boxes and most were in like new or gently used condition. Lyle and Dale Chupp of Chupp Auctions & Real Estate expertly handled the task of dispersing this amazing collection online. Prices here do not include the buyer's premium.

Whether it was nostalgia or pandemic buying that inspired the bidding, many of these great items shattered their pre-auction estimates. The supreme example of this was the early 1960s Tonka #2120 Farm Set, consisting of a white panel truck pulling a

2-horse trailer and a red panel truck hauling a cow with a wagon hitched behind, plus a bag of accessories. The box had moderate wear, but the toys themselves were in perfect condition. The bidders agreed, driving the final price to \$5,000.

The Tonka name con-

tinued to prove popular. A lot consisting of a late 1950s Tonka B-204 truck and trailer rental set up boxed in its original packaging paired with a Tonka Farms panel truck was claimed with a high bid of \$4,900. A red 1961 Tonka B-215 bulk storage truck set, com-

plete with stands and tanks, drew a final bid of \$2,300, a green Tonka Farms #2430 horse van with two plastic horses and picture box finished at \$1,200, and a 1959 Tonka B-203 Sanitary Service set consisting of a

Patsy dolls were a staple in the play room for decades

Many a Baby Boomer owned an Effanbee Patsy doll.

Bernard Fleischaker and Hugo Baum founded the Effanbee Doll Company in 1912. And while the company has had a series of owners, it still produces dolls today. Well-known dolls that have been produced by Effanbee include Patsy, Skippy (Patsy's boyfriend), and Betsy McCall. Effanbee's best known doll is Patsy.

Effanbee began production at the beginning of the composition doll era (1912), and the company prospered immediately. Designed by Bernard Lipfert, Patsy was first offered for sale, under her original name

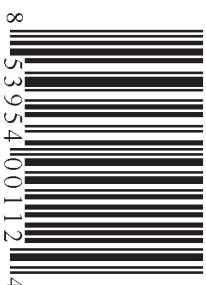
"Mimi" in 1927, but she was renamed Patsy in 1928. Effanbee patented Patsy's unique neck joint that allowed her to pose and stand-alone. Later Patsy and her family of dolls were made of hard plastic, vinyl, and rubber, but they were still quite popular.

Patsy dolls range in size from Wee Patsy (about 5 3/4 inches) to Mama Patsy (about 29 inches). The original Patsy was intended to portray an actual-looking three year old girl with short bobbed red hair and molded head-

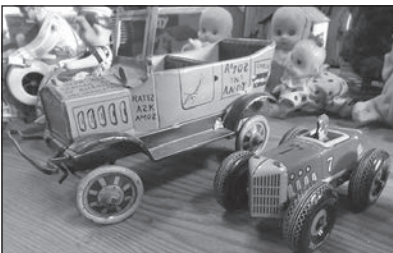

large white truck and two refuse dumpsters closed at \$1,100.

The Smith Miller name performed well, with several examples of the hard-working trucking industry. Offered in the original foam packaging, a Smith Miller double trailer semi featured the logos of Wonder Bread and Hostess Cup Cakes on the two different trailers. This limited edition item in good condition earned a final bid of \$1,000. The Smith Miller custom grain hauler truck with grain hauler trailer was equipped with several realistic details including panels, handles, hinges, M&J mud flaps, and a Knapheide logo. Listed in excellent condition, it was claimed with a final bid of \$900. A well-made Smith Miller log load truck with trailer featured a robust load of very thick tree trunks. It attracted a final bid of \$475 despite some restoration.

Farm toy tractors and other equipment replicas can be found in a variety of scales, mostly 1/8, 1/16, 1/32, 1/43, and 1/64. This means that, for example, with a 1/8 scale model one inch of the toy represents eight inches of the actual vehicle. Models in the 1/16 scale measure approximately 12 inches long and this is a popular size. However, the more massive 1/8 scale (approximately 20 inches long) is harder to find and some collectors seek them out. This auction offered 44 of the 1/8 scale tractors, and they drew much interest. A handsome and hard to find 1/8 scale model John Deere 720 tractor in excellent condition was eagerly taken with a final bid of \$2,200. An interesting 1950s 1/8 scale model John Deere A, new in box and signed by Joseph Ertl provided a very collectible package, finishing at \$750. A packaged, yellow 1/8 scale model Oliver 1850 tractor from the 2017 Pennsylvania Farm Show was taken for \$650, and a 1/8 scale model Farmall 826 Turbo Gold Demonstrator that was new in box finished at \$500. Several more

ranged from \$225-500.

Cast iron toys represented an earlier vintage and also proved to be popular. Dating from the early 1940s, a yellow Arcade cast iron Oliver 7 Superior manure spreader measuring about 10 inches long showed some rust and wear, but all stickers and paint were original. This realistic replica of a handy farm implement was taken home with a final bid of \$250. A very intricately-designed 24-inch long cast iron fire wagon with a driver holding reins for 3 galloping horses, another fireman on the back, ladders, and other details was listed as being in good original condition with a small crack. This eye-catching collectible was claimed with a high bid of \$200. Farm vehicles, a circus wagon, and even a boat depicting the landing of Columbus were also offered in cast iron.

Various models of pedal cars provided a child-sized version of the toys, and there were a variety of interesting designs. Leading the pack was an incredible Ertl custom John Deere 8RX 410 tracked pedal tractor in excellent condition. Also known as a crawler tractor this is a vehicle that runs on tracks instead of wheels. The complex design looked like it would be a lot of fun to operate. This masterpiece found a new job with a final bid of \$800. More traditional-looking pedal tractors included a purple Oliver 1850 that closed at \$650, two Eska John Deere models that

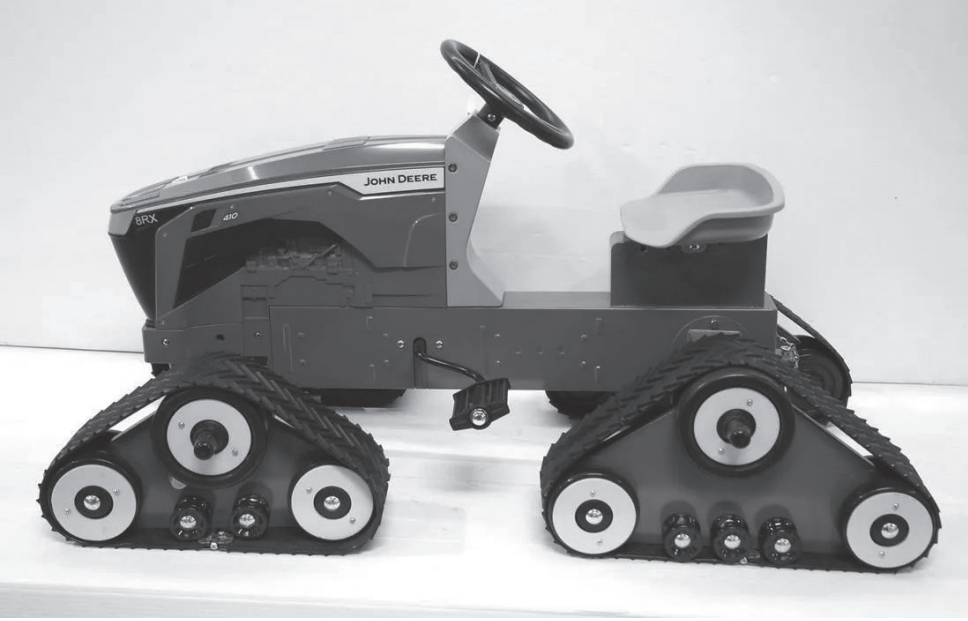
left for \$600 each, and an Ertl Farmall 1206 Turbo pedal tractor at \$550, plus others. A detailed pedal woody station wagon with a reverse seat for a passenger or cargo had some older restorations but still drew a final bid of \$500. A useful John Deere sun canopy for pedal tractors was also available. This large yellow cloth cover with metal frame displayed the John Deere logo and the words “Quality Farm Equipment” and looked just like the ones used in the field. This great add on was taken with a final bid of \$700.

There were a few horse-drawn vehicles made of cast iron, tin, wood, or diecast steel. A very well made John Deere horse-drawn planter hitched to a team of horses measured 13½” long. This attractive set up featured seed boxes, a metal tractor seat for the farmer, work harnesses on the horses, metal wheels and operational levers. It was all mounted on a wooden platform for display. This very accurate replica proved popular, requiring a high bid of \$450 to claim it. Other horse-drawn items included buggies, carts, and even circus wagons, ranging from \$50-275.

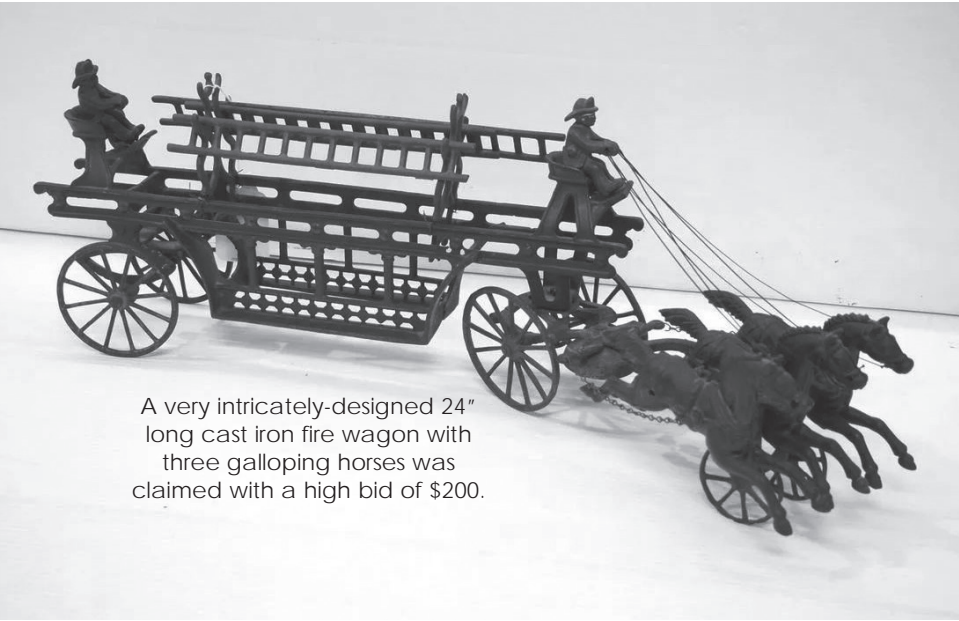

For an auctioneer to achieve the Michigan Certified Auctioneer designation, candidates must submit evidence of meeting or exceeding the rigorous certification requirements. Candidates must have conducted at least 100 auctions in their professional career; received a minimum of ten Letters of Recommendation from satisfied customers; complete at least 50 hours of demonstrating specialized knowledge and advanced auction education –or- evidence of being an auction industry instructor; have served on a committee or held an elected office within the past 10 years with the Michigan Auctioneers

Association; competed in at least three state and/or national competitions and passed a written test and oral interview by the MAA Certification Committee.

Certifications are valid for one year. For recertification, MAA has developed a maintenance model that focuses on continuing competence of the Certified Michigan Auctioneer. This new “Maintenance of Certified Michigan Auctioneer” model includes the following elements: Professional standing in the Michigan auction industry, commitment to lifelong learning through professional development, practice performance through examples of expertise through a test of knowledge in the profession.

The Michigan Auctioneers Association established CMA as the governing body that awards certification to professional auctioneers who meet approved requirements. The Michigan Auctioneers Association oversees the Certified Michigan Auctioneer certification and maintenance of certification programs and awards certificates to MAA auctioneers who meet requirements.



and sold separately so that the doll could be “dressed” up by little girls.

Collectors hunt for vintage, pre-1960, Patsy dolls, especially those in mint condition. Early, composition Patsy dolls can sell for over \$600.

According to Denise Van Patten (author of All About Effanbee Dolls), “Tonner Dolls purchased Effanbee Dolls out of bankruptcy in 2002 and revitalized the company with the introduction of high-quality reproduction Effanbee dolls,” so make sure, if you are paying a premium price, that you are actually purchasing an original Effanbee Patsy doll.

The company also formed a Patsy Doll Club, complete with a free metal pinback membership pin. All children who owned a Patsy or who simply wrote Effanbee Company and requested membership could join. Today, these vintage pins and accompanying paperwork sell for about \$35.

At the height of her popularity, Effanbee promoted Patsy dolls with a club newspaper The Patsytown News, which collectors also seek today. This was one of the first marketing ploys aimed directly at children, forming the basis for later clubs such as the Mickey Mouse Club.

During World War II, Skippy dolls were sold wearing military uniforms, which are still prized today by collectors. Another marketing ploy used by Effanbee during the war years was to make Patsy family dolls with small magnets embedded in their hands. The magnets allowed the dolls to hold small accessories, such as a United States flag. When looking for Patsy dolls, carry a small piece of metal, such as a metal key, and test the hands to see if they have magnets. If they do, the doll was made during World War II and has greater interest and value.

Even with clever advertising ploys, the war years wreaked havoc on Effanbee. According to Van Patten, “The loss of income during the war years brought the Effanbee success story into a decline. In 1946, Effanbee was sold to Noma Electric” in the first of many sales of the venerable doll company.

If you are looking for the Effanbee name on a Patsy, try looking on the doll’s upper back. Nearly all of the Patsy line were embossed “Effanbee” on the back. Along with the Effanbee logo, you will often find the name of the doll too, such as “Effanbee Patsy JR Doll.” Effanbee emphasized in its advertising that the Effanbee trademark and the doll’s name were on the back. One interesting Patsy is the 1946 Patsy Joan that had a body marked “Effandbee” with an extra “d” instead of the company’s actual name—“Effanbee.” And,

to confuse matters, some 1946 Patsy Dolls only had a wrist tag, which over time has been lost on many of these dolls. The wrist tag alone makes a great addition to a collection.

Effanbee collectors are fortunate in that there is so much to collect. Many collectors look as hard for advertising material as they do for the dolls. The types of advertising seem endless—Effanbee books, Patsy books, paper dolls, newspaper

articles and advertising, magazine ads, Effanbee catalogs, Patsy Doll Club advertising and certificates, boxes, and the list goes on. There are even Patsy figurines. It is easy to see that a serious collector could accumulate a good collection reasonably quickly.

colors used, facial features, garment design or even a unique function such as the fact that turning the heads on dolls from Naruko results in a special squeaky sound. Some dolls have bottoms that screw off leaving room for a note or tiny item.

After World War II artists in Japan focused on making Kokeshis to fill gift shops for tourists. These newer dolls often do not fit the traditional styles were often mass produced. Serious collectors look for the older, handmade dolls. Marianne Bayer of Huntsville, Ala., has an impressive collection of Kokeshi dolls that she acquired while living in Japan for several years. Just as many of us hit garage and estate sales, Marianne would get up at the crack of dawn on Sundays to go to shrine sales at Buddhist temples. Never paying more than 200 yen each (currently \$1.57 in US dollars) Marianne was able to amass more than 100 dolls.
