LPs surprised bidders when they played big bids



HOWELL, Mich. The recent auction of the Mark J. Radziewicz estate was advertised as featuring hunting and camping equipment as well as firearms, but the surprise of the day turned out to be the numerous lots of classic rock vinyl LPs that did exceptionally well. The auction consisting of 822 lots was presented online-only by Tim Narhi Auctioneer & Associates and was very well received. Prices here do not include the buyers' premium.

Top selling lot of the day was the 2002 Buick LeSabre Custom with 3.8-liter V-6 engine and 224,000 miles. This handsome black car was reported to run well, and





on" by Magnum, plus more by artists Boston, Ted Nugent, Mötley Crüe, George Thorogood, Y&T, Motorhead, and Molly Hatchet. Some of the album covers showed wear, but most looked new. This grouping was eagerly claimed with a high bid of \$625.

Not far behind, another group of 11 LPs including Billy Squier "Don't Say No", several by AC/ DC such as "Fly On The Wall", The Pretenders "Get Close", plus Aerosmith, and Robert Plant brought in an impressive sale, finishing with a bid of \$525. A grouping of 10 albums featuring Van Halen, The Tubes, Scorpions, Saxon, and Rush also proved popular with a final bid of \$425. Familiar names such as ZZ Top, Eric Clapton, Bon Jovi, Deep Purple, Journey, Judas Priest, Iron Maiden, plus several more were similarly grouped and left with bids in the \$300-375 range. Numerous other classic rock and metal albums were also sold throughout the day. An incredible wall of CDs consisting of approximately 300 individual and boxed set selections displayed on a massive

shelf featured artists found on the albums plus many more and was taken with a final bid of \$375. A Washburn acoustic guitar model DK20T with spare strings, tuner, gig bag, strap, instruction book, and guitar polish would allow the buyer to play along with the music for a final bid of \$150.

A limited number of firearms were available. The Marlin Firearms Company 336CS microgroove barrel 30/30 Win lever action side ejection rifle proved popular with the hunters, drawing a final bid of \$325. A Winchester 1300 shotgun equipped with a slug barrel and vent rib closed at \$275, while a Mossberg 20 gauge pump action shotgun with slug barrel and a Ruger 10-22 .22 rifle LR (semi-automatic) with sling strap each finished at \$250. An unusual, light wood shotgun was stamped "Made in Brazil by Companhia Brasileira de Cartuchos". This single shot 20 gauge firearm closed at \$80. A handy Homak 7-gun safe complete with keyed lock would provide useful storage with a final bid of \$85. A very nice Polaris Express compound bow with 28" draw length and 60-70 pound peak weight complete with case finished at \$25. For target

practice, there was a Blueridge 3D white tail buck target in good condition that was claimed for \$27.50.

A variety of sporting and camping equipment was offered, most items in excellent condition. These included the 4 x 6' canvas Shappell ice shanty in like new condition that drew a final bid of \$110. The accompanying Flambeau fishing bag filled with 6 trays of sinkers, lead, hooks, bobbers, lures, and other fishing supplies closed at \$40. The 9' x 8' 4-pole family dome tent by Columbia appeared to be new in box and was taken with a final bid of \$60. Items to make the campsite comfy included a reclining chair that went for \$30, plus Coleman cooking equipment, propane stove and heater, and a tote filled with fanny packs, freeze dried food, fuel canister, bug killer and repellants. and water bottles that were all purchased economically. The new in box camouflage Wolverine hiking boots size 9.5 were an excellent purchase with a final bid of \$27.50. A set of hunting vests and pants drew a \$32.50 final bid.

Sports cards were another area of interest, and there was a nice selection to choose from. There was a 6-piece set of football jersey sports cards consisting of Tom Brady, Ricky Williams, Jimmy Smith, Rob Moore, Aaron Shea, and Frank Wycheck that finished with a high bid of \$170. These unusual cards contain a fragment of authentic game-worn jersey pieces. Next, a selection of 7 signed football cards featured Terry Bradshaw, Tomlinson/Toefield (Pros and Prospects), Freddie Milons, Clinton Portis, LaDainian Tomlinson, Antwaan Randle, and Jim Drukenmiller. This great group finished at \$130. Boxed assortments of hockey cards drew \$90 and \$80 bids, while boxed lots of football, baseball, and Nascar cards also proved popular. An actual, full jersey signed "To Sue, Bob Probert" by the Detroit Red


Wings hockey forward #24 brought a final bid of \$60.

voring in food. Brewed ginger beer first appeared in Yorkshire, England, in the early- to mid-1700s. However, traditional ginger beer is a sweetened, carbonated, non-alcoholic drink, which is quite popular. Historically, ginger beer was produced by the natural fermentation of prepared ginger spice, yeast, and sugar.

Ginger beer dates from the colonial spice trade with the Orient and the sugar cane trade with Caribbean islands. Ginger beer has always been popular in England and its colonies from the 1700s onward, including a strong following in the American colonies. In 1855, English excise tax laws limited the alcohol content of ginger beer to 2% (some people consider ginger beer to be a form of ginger wine because of the low alcoholic content), and since that time most ginger beer producers

have maintained a non-alcoholic beer. Stone Ginger beer continued as a popular drink in England and North America (both Canada and United States) from the 18th century until Prohibition.

Alcoholic ginger beer is brewed in the United Kingdom and sold worldwide. One modern alcoholic ginger beer is Crabbie's, which is labeled "Alcoholic Ginger Beer" to distinguish it from its non-alcoholic counterparts. Miller Crabbie, a merchant in Edinburgh, Scotland, founded Crabbie's in 1801. Modern production of Crabbie's Ginger Beer occurs in Liverpool, England. Collectors love to drink Crabbie's ginger beer and collect the beer's empty bottles.

Novice collectors often believe stone ginger beer is so named because it is sold in ceramic "stone" bottles, but that isn't true. Stone ginger beer is sold in both ceramic and glass bottles because it is called "stone" for an entirely different reason.

Brewers have only been able to purchase metal kettles for beer production since the Industrial Revolution, circa 1850 in London. This posed a real problemhow to heat water without a metal container to place on the fire? The answer was simplestones! Historically, people have heated water and other liquids by heating river stones in a fire, and then throwing the heated stones into the water. Stones such as these became known of brewing stones or boiling stones.

Beer won't brew without heating the mash, but the wort (the liquid extracted from the mash) is where the sugar is contained. Brewing yeast ferments the wort, producing beer. Boiling wort with hot brewing stones is hard, sometimes-impossible work, so, ancient ginger beer brewers sim-

ply heated the mash with stones but not the wort. Today, stone ginger beer is brewed in copper kettles, which heat faster and more evenly than stones.

Today, the majority of brewed ginger beer follows what is known as the "original ginger beer" recipe: Water, sugar, ginger, optional ingredients (such as lemon juice or cream of tartar, and ginger beer

The United States is full of garage breweries, and ginger beer is one of the easiest beers to produce. For this reason, brewers, since about 1920, have collected ginger beer stoneware bottles and glass bottles, depending on the reason for collecting. Collectors interested in the history of stone ginger beer seek stoneware bottles from the 1800s while collectors interested in any brewery, especially modern breweries, collect ginger beer glass bottles.

Early stone ginger beer bottles were made of local clays and were usually left brown in color with etchings of the bottler's name or city. Around 1880, as stoneware bottles began to compete with glass bottles, stoneware ginger beer bottles became sleeker with colorful shoulder slips and stamped logos designed to attract consumers. As glass became more and more available, toward 1900, ginger beer continued to be bottled in stoneware bottles for cosmetic reasons—ginger beer is usually unattractive in appearance with a cloudy or murky appearance, so

stoneware bottles, unlike clear glass bottles, hid the beer's appearance.

Novice collectors may want to read American Stone: Ginger & Root Beer Stoneware Bottles, edited by Donald & Elizabeth Yates. Published in 1996, this collector guide covers stoneware ginger bottles from 1790 - 1920. It is occasionally found on eBay for around \$100.

sought after and collected.

Learning the glassblowing trade while still a boy, Leon Joseph Houze, Sr., emigrated from Belgium to America in 1879. After working for the Day William Window Glass Company in Kent, Ohio, he and his four brothers founded Houze Brothers Glass in Meadville, Pa. After a second fire at their window glass factory, they decided not to rebuild. Instead, the brothers went their separate wavs.

Leon continued to move about, building glass factories in Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, New York, West Virginia, and Pennsylvania. In 1899, he landed in the Pennsvlvania town of Port Marion, located in the southwest corner of the state at the convergence of the Cheat and Monongahela Rivers. There he built the Jeannette Window Glass Company; a few years later, in 1902, he returned to Port Marion to build the Federated Glass Company. Having been named president and manager of Federated, Houze built two additional glass plants in the town. By 1923, he had bought all four of these glass con-

them under the name of tical items such as lensthe L.J. Houze Convex Glass Company.

An innovator in the development of colored sheet glass, Leon Houze held 40 patents, according to family records shared by his greatgreat nephew, John Houze. Leon's three sons all worked at the factory and continued in their father's footsteps past his retirement in 1938. In addition to window glass (including 60 exterior windows for the post-World War II renovation of the White House) and projects for various governmental agencies, the company also manufactured a wide variety of glass cerns and incorporated products, including prac-

es for sunglasses, goggles, and binoculars; as well as tail lights and gearshift and window knobs for automobiles. Additionally, Houze also produced lamps and lamp shades, vases and toy glass dishes, and a broad assortment of other items for the home.

Then, in 1948, Roger J. Houze, grandson of the company's founder, put his artistic abilities to the test. What would happen if a small piece of glass was cut and curved on the ends and then emblazoned with pictures, logos and advertisements? According to company records, Houze first produced

Christmas cards on glass trays in 1950 under the name of a new department for the company, "Houze Art." This enterprise came to attract the talents of such artists as Peter Max, Dan Baird, and Tommy Parzinger, all of whom were commissioned to produce designs for this wing of the company. Even though the family sold the company in 1954 and its supply of bent glass ran out in 1974, the department continued to produce these wares until 1995. The doors of Houze closed in 2004.

At about that same time, collectors were beginning to spot these curious little glass gizmos popping up at yard sales and thrift shops, selling for a dime or a quarter a piece. There was something about them that made them intriguing. Was it their clever savings, sometimes a bit snarky or even a little risqué (by 1960s standards)? Or maybe it was the graphics, which harkened back to a simpler (but swanky) time? Among those attracted was collector Jimmie Bucci.

"I started picking them up on a whim," the Boston-area collector said, "and then I realized, 'I really like them." Whenever he saw these glass greetings originally intended to extend good wishes for birthdays and rapid healing, as well as thoughts for getting well or congratulations on the birth of a new baby, he snapped them up. "And, of course, those wishing a 'Merry Christmas."

Bucci was, once again, hooked. In the course of his search, he began finding examples that appeared to be company favors, as well as souvenirs of the New York World's Fair and Disney. Many of the examples he found were still in their original boxes, suggesting that they might have been purchased and either saved and not mailed, or passed on in person, even though the boxes noted fourth class postage was all that was required to send the contents, marked "glass." On the other hand, in his extensive collection, Bucci noted that "one or two" have been sent. In his mind, they all appear to be "pretty secure in their boxes, "with some still retaining their original "Houze Art" sticker, illustrated with an artist's palette. Some, he added, retain an original plastic "ribbon" wrapped around the box corners to keep the lid in place.

As to where they were first sold, Bucci recalled

that at his first job in a dime store with an adjacent gift shop, such greetings were sold in the latter, not the former. Their original price remains somewhat of a mystery ("they took off the price tags"). As for identifying features of the "cards," in addition to bent corners, they often have a smoky gray background, although sometimes, the graphics on the front obscure this. As a credit to the process, Bucci noted, "I have never seen them with chipped or worn paint." Some examples feature gold paint accents.

Collecting Houze Art glass greetings was something of a lark in the beginning, he continued. "But now people know they're worth something." Consequently, they've become "harder and harder to find," and certainly, at higher prices than before. Furthermore, he suspects that other companies made "knock-offs."

On the other hand, Bucci's collection continues to give him pleasure. His Boston-area home is likely to be bedecked with glass greetings around the holidays. Although many of day, Dear. them are traditional in design, his favorites are those that feature, for instance, Santa on a rocketship or those picturing turquoise and pink trees. And then there's the one with the kid on Santa's lap and the words, "lies, lies, lies."

Naturally, those that are "comical and clever" are particularly desirable. Bucci cites one with an image of a Model-T car and the words "From one old heap to another, Happy Birthday." Another favorite, picturing a piano, inquires, "Out of tune? Get well soon." How about "Happy Birthday to the best sport of them all" with images of sports equipment? There's the anniversary card, with a politician proclaiming, "What this country needs is more couples like you."

You get the idea. But then there are the ones that collectors are particularly drawn to, ones that Bucci characterizes as "creepy insulting." Best example? "Happy Birthday, Dear. Though you are psychotic, neurotic, narcissistic and traumatic with hypersensitive schizophrenic tendencies, I love you." Could Hallmark have said it any better?
