these hard to find models to their own collections. The highest-selling item in this sale was the orange Smitty Toys heavy duty wrecker. Originally produced in the 1940s, Smitty Toys of California started by making trucks of wood due to limited metal supplies during the war. developed their die cast line of trucks. The company has changed hands a few times, but it still produces the "Smitty" line in the USA. This particular truck measured 21 inches long and was in excellent condition with all of the rigging and lights in place. It drew an enthusi-

astic final bid of \$1,200.

As expected, over one third of the lots consisted of model tow trucks or wreckers and they dominated the upper range of the prices for this auction. There were several other outstanding exam-





ples. These included the Buddy L Quality Toys wrecking truck made of cast metal that measured 28 inches long with an elaborate rotating boom, lettering and paint intact, and even a dashboard logo that proved to be a tempting choice, requiring a final bid of \$575 to claim it. A Keystone wrecker, No. 78, was also appropriately equipped. It measured 28 inches long and was taken with a high bid of \$450. An entirely different means of vehicle transportation was exhibited by a Tonka ramp hoist cast metal flatbed tow truck. Measuring 20 inches long, this red model in excellent condition left with a high bid of \$450. A handsome 1953 white M.I.C. (Miller Ironson Corp) of California Official Tow Car cast metal tow truck with accessories intact and measuring 16 inches long closed at \$375, while a Cities Towing Service cast metal tow truck closed at \$225.

Three "Ride On" trucks were offered, which is a model that is appropriate for toddlers to "drive". The child straddles it while sitting in the seat on top and pushes it along with their feet on either side. The Buddy "L" Ride On Wrecking Truck measured 27 inches long and drew a respectable bid of \$500 even though it was missing the steering wheel. It had been cleverly replaced with a rigid metal handle that functioned in its place. A Texaco Metal Ride On Tow Truck with wooden handle grip for steering that measured 25 inches long finished at \$290, and a smiling plastic Disney Tow Mater Power Quad 6 Volt Ride On in the original box suitable for ages 1.5-3 years old closed at \$80.

Related to the towing business, there were 58 lots with AAA items including signs, license plate holders, badges, and awards. A large 30 by 23 inch porcelain Chester County Emergency Service AAA double-sided oval

proved popular, requiring a final bid of \$375 to claim it. An eye-catching blue and gold round plaque from AAA Detroit Automobile Club 18500 displayed the words "Thieves Will Be Prosecuted". It measured 3 inches wide and left with a bid of \$170. There was even a hand-held crosswalk red stop sign with the AAA logo on the top that went for \$65. There were also three CAA emblems, including a 1955 CAA Manitoba Motor League plate badge which featured a silver bison that was rehomed for a bid of \$80.

License plate badges are mounted on the vehicle above the plate and fastened with the same bolts. Many include the words "drive safely" as a message to fellow travelers. Leading this category was the Texaco Drive Safely plate badge. It measured 6 inches wide and of course featured the iconic red flying horse. It left with a high bid of \$90. Several bore various AAA emblems, but two others included logos of Farm Bureau or Lions Club.


An obscure automobile model was commemorated here with the Metropolitan Club badge. This item was created for the Metropolitan owner's club, created by Nash Motors for their new customers. This small car encouraged the philosophy of thrift, and the badge displayed their motto "Motores Prudentiores" or More Intelligent

Motoring along with relevant images such as an oil well and a bank book. Measuring 3 inches wide, this hard-to-find historical relic closed at \$35.

The most exciting item on this auction was the museum-worthy 1925 red Acme Wrecker Service Pedal Car by American National. It is one of only two examples of this model. It measured 51 inches long by 22 inches wide and had all of the accessories including the windshield, towing chain, head lamps, and steering wheel. This rare treasure received 22 bids but did not make the reserve. Look for it at the fourth Edward "Duane" Hertz toy auction on Sept. 18. 

10 pennies bring more than \$1.1 million at auction

IRVINE, Calif. — Who says a penny isn't worth much these days? Ten century-old Lincoln cents sold at auction for a combined \$1.1 million, according to GreatCollections (www. GreatCollections.com) of Irvine, California, the auction house that offered the valuable pennies.

"One of the 10, a firstyear of issue Lincoln cent from 1909 with designer Victor D. Brenner's initials, V.D.B., on the 'tail's side' sold for \$365,625, a record price for that coin," said Ian Russell, president of Great-Collections. "Four other pennies dated between 1909 and 1915 and also in superb quality brought more than \$100,000 each."

The 10 pennies were specially struck proof coins made for collectors by the United States Mint in Philadelphia in the early years of the Lincoln cents. All are still in pristine, mint red condition and sold for a combined total \$1,113,174.

"The coins were from a New York collector who carefully assembled his collection over a 50-year period of searching for the finest known coins of their kind. He won many awards over the years for his Red Copper Collection," explained Russell.

initials at the bottom of the back side of the cents were removed soon after the production of Lincoln cents began in 1909. They are now located on the front of the coins just above the rim below Lincoln's arm.

The 1909 V.D.B proof cent was authenticated and graded mint state red 67+ (on the numismatic grading scale of 1 to 70) by Professional Coin Grading Service. It is tied for the finest known surviving example of less than 1,200 specially struck by the Mint in 1909, the centennial of President Lincoln's birth.

"It is the king of Lincoln proof cents," stated Russell.

sion set (the RCA 630-TS) in 1946. However, many countries produced earlier sets. In 1926, Kenjiro Takayanagi demonstrated the first television system using a cathode ray tube at Hamamatsu Industrial High School in Japan, and in 1930, the first mass-produced television set, The Baird, was offered in England, eventually selling about 1,000 sets. Telefunken of Germany produced the commercially made electronic television sets with CRT in 1934.

Approximately 7,500 electronic television sets were made in the United States before the War Production Board stopped their manufacture in April 1942, following the attack on Pearl Harbor. Production of these and additional dispossets resumed in August able income. In 1946.5 1945 with consumers percent of U.S. homes eager to own a TV.

net design all took on themes influenced by atomic science, which included Space Age designs. Just as countries raced to be the first in space, television cabinet designers raced to be the first in America's living rooms. Atomic motifs and space age symbols became the rage in television design with some television sets appearing like consul controls on the Star Ship Enterprise.

In an attempt to visually "show" Americans how atomic particles looked, television sets followed the atomic age design motifs such as geometric atomic patterns, barkcloth patterns, melamine counter tops, star and galaxy themes, and cabinetry built symbolically to are no "cheap" Space represent Atomic Age design. Most of these atomic designs took on a

sci-fi "futuristic" design pattern where the race space became mid-century modernism in the American living room. Space age television set designs captured America's optimism and faith in a burgeoning technological state as well as the faith in America's young President John Kennedy, who promised man would be on the moon before the end of the 1960s.

In 2001, the Brooklyn Museum of Art held an Atomic Age Exhibition entitled "Vital forms: American art and designs in the atomic age, 1940-1960." Part of this exhibition, and other exhibitions like it, was atomic television sets.



Above: Round, silver Space Age Panasonic television set.




Above: Arkay, a US television company, produced this knock-off Kuba-Komet in 1960. Although inspired by the Komet, this set had a much shorter life span
