1993 ruby red Corvette charged to a \$15,800 bid

DUNDEE, Mich. — Barb Chlebek was described as an independent, resourceful woman and a “jack of all trades”, as she held a variety of jobs including plumber’s assistant, waitress, and later a warehouse manager for Borders Bookstores. She also loved to spend time outdoors, planting and maintaining her yard.

Her home furnishings were a source of enjoyment, and she would shop for and decorate her home with beautiful seasonal and holiday items. The inventory presented in this estate auction gives examples of her great taste and artistic ability. Most of the furnishings

and accessories were ready for their new owners to immediately enjoy. Dundee Auction House was hired to disperse this varied selection of great items, and the auction, consisting of 393 lots, took place online only. Prices listed here do not include the buyer’s premium.

The highest selling item of the day was the 1993 Chevrolet 40th

Anniversary Corvette, one of only 240 produced. The manufacturer described it as being ruby red, both inside and out, with leather bucket seats. It had 38,000 actual miles, was always kept inside, and the care this automobile received was obvious. It sold without reserve for a final bid of \$15,800.

A second car in the

sale also generated much interest, as it was a nostalgic 1953 lemon yellow Chevrolet Bel Air with maroon top, upholstered bench front seat, and white wall tires. The old style round speedometer and steering wheel with metal horn ring truly brought back memories

for those of that era. This car was also in immaculate condition and drove off with a final bid of \$7,000.

A variety of wristwatches and pocket watches were presented and eagerly claimed. One lot in particular

Brush Pottery cookie jars bring smiles to collectors

The Brush Pottery Company was created in 1925 when the Brush-McCoy Pottery Company dissolved. The history of Brush Pottery Company, prior to the dissolution in 1925, is straightforward but faceted. George



Brush worked for and trained in many American potteries, including J.B. Owens, Globe Stoneware, Clay Products Company of Crooksville, Ohio, and his own company—Brush Pottery—that burned down in 1908. Following this disastrous fire, Brush decided not to rebuild his pottery company, so, in 1911, he took the job of general manager of the J.W. McCoy Pottery Company.

In 1911, the McCoy Pottery Company merged with Brush’s defunct Brush Pottery Company to form the Brush-McCoy Pottery Company. This was a successful merger, and the new company quickly grew into one of the largest pottery manufacturing

companies in the United States.

Brush-McCoy operated pottery plants in both Roseville and Zanesville, Ohio, until 1918 when a fire in the Zanesville plant forced a move of all Brush-McCoy pottery operations to its Roseville plant. The company continued a successful business for the next seven years, but in 1925 the McCoy family withdrew from the merger, reforming McCoy Pottery, and Brush once again decided to go it alone. Brush continued manufacturing pottery in the Roseville plant, under the Brush Pottery name, until 1982 when Brush Pottery closed its doors.

From its conception, Brush Pottery manufactured decorative ceramic

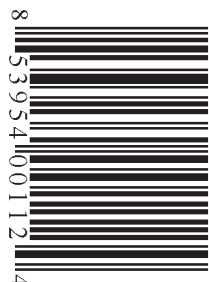


Above: Vintage, Brush “Davy Crockett” cookie jar, circa 1950s, that is valued in the range of \$235 - \$450.

items, ceramic kitchen-ware, vases, ceramic garden wares, such as pots, and ceramic cookie jars, for which the company became famous. In fact, Brush Pottery is credited with being one of the first U.S. potteries to produce cookie jars, making it an innovator at the time. Brush produced its first cookie jar in 1929. Cookie jars continued to be an important ceramic line for Brush Pottery until it closed in 1982.

While all Brush Pottery items are collectible today, collectors, dealers, and interior designers routinely search for Brush cookie jars. Brush’s figurative cookie jars are highly sought, especially some of its famous character cookie jars, which originated in the 1940s, such as Little Red Riding Hood, Peter Pan, Davy Crockett, Little Boy Blue, Raggedy Ann, Humpty Dumpty, and Hillbilly Frog, which has become Brush’s most desired cookie jar among collectors.

George Brush began signing his ceramic pieces early on. Most of the older Brush ceramic pieces were marked with the name “Brush” or “K24 Brush USA” in impressed letters or a symbolic artist’s palette or jar full of paintbrushes. Because George Brush and Nelson McCoy owned Brush-McCoy Pottery for so many years, many of the oldest Brush pieces are often confused with McCoy pieces. Novice collectors should become familiar with Brush’s signature marks as they are the surest field test that the piece you are looking at is genuine Brush Pottery; however, not all original Brush cookie jars were marked, making identification sometimes difficult.

Hillbilly Frog is one of Brush’s most sought after cookie jars. Released in

1968, this cookie jar coincided with the “hillbilly” theme sweeping America at the time. Collectors and decorators like this cookie jar because it is kitschy and literally screams 1960s. But this period piece comes at a stiff price. Expect to pay \$4,500 or more for a Hillbilly Frog cookie jar in near mint condition. While there is no “average” price for any of the Brush cookie jars, many of the lesser known jars range in price from \$250 – 500 with sought after cookie jars ranging as high as \$850.

Ceramic ware is one of the easiest types of antiques to reproduce, and the enormous profits found in selling “fake” cookie jars makes reproduction inevitable. In the 1990s a series of cookie jars marked “Brush McCoy” appeared, but these jars

have no relationship with the old Brush Pottery. Many of these reproduced cookie jars are marked with a paintbrush between the words “Brush” and “McCoy.” Fortunately, collectors have noticed a general rule that seems to apply to reproduction Brush cookie jars. Authentic Brush Pottery marks found on its cookie jars are incised or pressed below the surface while new, reproduction, Brush McCoy pottery marks are all found in raised molded letters.

Reproduction Brush cookie jars, with the Brush McCoy mark, often shows signs of highly pronounced crazing. Novice collectors often mistake this crazing as a sign of age-cracks, but the crazing was intentionally added at the time of production to make the cookie jar appear old.

Concrete figures stand in tribute to Wisconsin artist

BY DAVE MCCORMICK

PHILLIPS, Wis. — Fred Smith started construction in 1948 of his Concrete Park, located in Phillips, Wis., in Price County. Smith had worn many hats during his lifetime: dance hall musician, farmer, a lumberjack and bar owner.

With his creative skills he fashioned 237 unique figures; his conglomeration of creatures is deemed one of most exceptional presentations of folk art in the country.

Following Smith's death in 1976, the Wisconsin Concrete Park was acquired by the Kohler Foundation who in turn endowed it to

Price County. Today, the Price County Forestry & Parks as well as Tourism departments along with the Friends of Fred Smith, Inc. maintain the grounds and all the concrete figures. Maintaining the figures is an ongoing process to keep them from deteriorating.

Fred Smith was self-taught. His process in creating his figures started with the statues made of wooden frames wrapped with wire. They were then covered with cement and bedecked with an

assortment of broken glass.

Smith’s works came from local legends as well as heros from history. He also created many different animals. His most impressive work was the life-sized Budweiser Clydesdale team—eight horses, two ponies, one dog, and a wagon loaded with beer barrels.

When asked why he created his cement figure; he replied “Nobody knows why I made them. Not even me.”

In 1964 Fred suffered a stroke. This caused him to halt work on his project. For the next decade Fred spoke of adding new figures but nothing came of it. He passed away in 1976. Unfortunately, a storm tore through the area and damaged many of the figures. That’s when the Kohler Foundation stepped in took over operations; the foundation repaired the statues and the grounds. In efforts to keep the park’s figures in good condition new bric-a-brac and paint

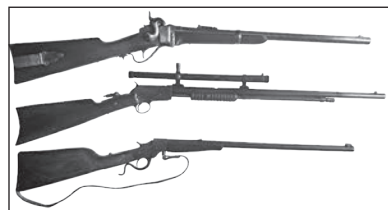

Salt and pepper nodders always have the perfect answer

Nodders are the original “yes-men.”

Just set a nodder in action, and the answers are always in the affirmative. With such ongoing positive reinforcement, it’s no wonder nodders have remained popular throughout the centuries.

The first nodders, (or, to give them their formal name, “pagods”), were introduced in ancient China, and used in religious rituals. Actually, a type of bell, these Chinese brass figurines represented various deities. The figural heads were attached with metal pins. When struck with a hammer, vibrations would start each head nodding.

By the 1700s, European firms had adapted the nodding feature for use in porcelain and bisque figurines. By now, it wasn’t only the heads that nodded. Separate pin attachments meant that the slightest movement could set hands, mouths, ears, (and, in the case of animals, tails), wagging. Designs ranged from the regal (elaborately attired

Asian potentates), to the slightly naughty (on “nodder girl” ashtrays, smoke trails set both the reclining lady’s hand fan and her extended leg in leisurely motion.)

With the dawn of the 20th century, metal nodding mechanisms gave way to plastic and elastic riggings, making nodders both simpler to manufac-

ture, and more affordable. Many were children’s toys representing characters from the comic pages. The “bobblehead,” an offshoot of the nodder, had its head (or as in the case of hip-swaying hula dolls, other bodily parts), spring-mounted.

For the most part, nodders were purely decorative, with one exception:

the kitchen. From the mid-20th century onward, the coziest American kitchens were graced with useful nodders in the form of salt-and-pepper shakers. In addition to performing their assigned task, S & P nodders also provided exactly

the hoped-for answers to the most pressing start-of-day questions: “Should I have that extra strip of bacon?” “How about another pancake?” With nodders, the response was always happily the same: “Sure! Go right ahead!”

Nodders fascinate because, unlike most other salt-and-peppers, they “do” something in addition to their designated function. The first S & P nodders, widely available in the 1920s

and ‘30s, were primarily produced in Germany and Japan for export. With the onset of World War II, export gates clanged shut. For the duration, salt-and-peppers and other giftware items were domestically produced. Following the war, imports resumed, and nodders retained their first-market popularity throughout the 1950s.

The great majority of salt-and-pepper nodders are porcelain, allowing for the most flexibility in shape and decoration. Porcelain also keeps the seasoning inside at its most fresh and flavorful. Sizing is fairly consistent; a nodder set measures roughly 3 ½ inches high by 4 inches wide. Nodder bases are often interchangeable, differing only in their hand-painted flourishes, or their applied decals celebrating a location or event.

Rather than the wire

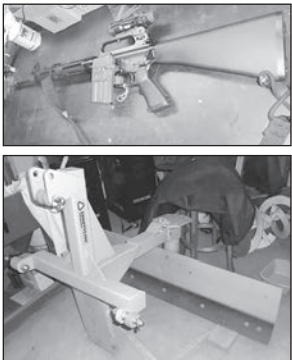

mechanisms of earlier nodders, the removable porcelain shakers are mounted on the porcelain base by means of side “wings,” which hold them in place on the lip of each opening; a mere touch sets them in motion (nodders missing a wing are therefore unusable). The condiments themselves are held in the ceramic pegs extending below the figural portion of each removable shaker. The shakers don’t hold much

seasoning, but with whimsies such as these, practicality is never a major concern. A variation on the nodder pair also includes a central “mustard pot,” allowing for another condiment. And here’s an interesting note: filled shakers seem to nod with more consistency than empty ones.

While the bases may be similar, on the removable shakers themselves imagination runs riot. Animal lovers can populate their kitchens with an entire nodder menagerie. While fish, deer, and chickens are the most popular motifs, the design range includes almost every denizen of field and stream. There are winsome bear, bashful donkey, and playful kitten nodders. Pheasant, bluebird, and turkey nodders too, plus graceful flamingos and hot-to-trot racehorses. There’s even that oddity, the “yes and no” nodder: on a kangaroo pair, the mother’s head nods one way, the joey’s another.

Locale souvenirs were a popular nodder topic. Matador and bull nodders, on a base emblazoned with a “Souvenir of Mexico” decal, brought back memories of a trip south of the border; tail-swishing alligator nodders served as toothy mementos of Florida. Sometimes, the nodders and their locale logo seem curiously out of synch: a

kissing-Dutch couple flirts atop a base with a decal touting the “Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Sioux Narrows, Ontario, Canada,”

Topping the nodder line are figural novelties. No collection can really be considered complete without a pair of “Chattering Teeth” skulls. On one skeletal souvenir stamped “Thousand Islands, N.Y.,” the bottom set of choppers is molded into the base. The top set is part of the removable skull.

Another favorite: a somewhat-worse-for-wear couple popping out of the side of a beer barrel. Although often cited as a tribute to a wild ride over Niagara Falls, the glazed expressions (and multiple eye placement) of the couple seem more plausibly a tribute to a wild night on the town. A variation on this design, bearing the motto, “Ve get too soon oldt und too late schmart,” gives credence to the latter theory.

In modern interpretations, a nodder theme can be carried throughout the piece. There’s a bridal pair — of pigs, no less — decked out in full wedding regalia, their ample bodies forming the nod-

der base. On another set, the coils of a somewhat sinister-looking snake form the base; the snake’s head and tail are the shakers.

Salt-and-pepper nodders were an ideal souvenir of happy vacation days, and just the right gift for friends and neighbors back home. No need for them to ask where you’d been: they could read it right on the nodder decal. Nodders were just the right price too, with sets originally selling for around 50 cents. And, since so many were produced, many remain readily available. A quick eBay search will bring up hundreds of nodder S & Ps, averaging between \$25-65, dependent on design and decoration; condiment sets run in the \$65-85 range. Prices are even more reasonable for nodders picked up at garage and estate sales.

However, those interested in giving the nod to nodders will sometimes find the acquisition battle fierce. Salt-and-pepper sets in general remain among the most desirable of vintage “household” collectibles. You may be interested in acquiring only nodders; a salt-and-pepper collector with a

more “seasoned” interest may also want those nodders—along with every other S & P pair within reach. Niche interests can also wreak havoc on the budding nodder collector. You may want that Eskimo and polar bear pair because the figures nod. Someone else may want them because their prime collecting interest is all things Eskimo. (Or polar bear.)

Salt-and-pepper nodders brightened many kitchens of the past, and continue to add a whimsical novelty accent to the kitchens of today. Nodders can be arranged as an eye-catching shelf display, or, even better, put to their intended use (they do, after all, perform an actual function). Regardless of choice, one thing’s for certain: vintage nodders are definitely worth their salt.

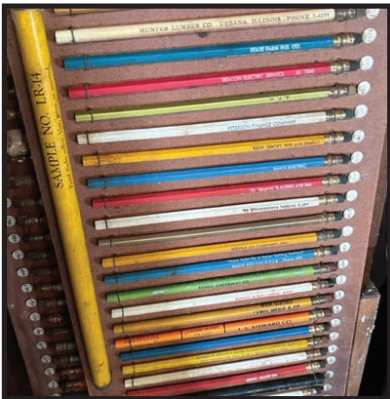
