Ohio's Stony Ridge Auction Sept. 1 auction brought in some impressive bids. The 433-lot phone bids, and simulcast online on LiveAuctioneers.

Getting the most fanfare - and achieving the auction's highest winning bid — was a rare hand-carved folk art walking cane from the Civil War era. The 39 inch long staff featured an American eagle with a federal shield at the top. Below it was carved figures of a black man, a Civil War soldier, a Native American, and a shield painted with 117th NY Infantry. The unique piece sold for



We will however be placing these documents with the items they describe and will be available for visual inspection at the preview time advertised. With these documents, Captain Welch proves that he did not remove any items from protected Great Lakes marine sanctuary zones and he bought most of his salvaged items from the famous diver James Mularkey (died 2017) purchasing almost 20 years ago, way past any statute of limitation stated in the State of Michigan laws.

Auctioneer's Note: After 45 years of auctioning 100s of antique filled estates, I (Doug Dalton Auctioneer) have never had the opportunity to sell a major nautical collection of this caliber & provenance. We have taken over 1400 photos & have made detailed listings of the lots including sizes plus we have provided condition reports and the provenance on salvaged objects. When we found duplicate items in the ephemera material, we only took photos of 1 piece. Keep that in mind when reviewing the auction pictures and reading the text listings. We also found many of the large metal objects had custom wood shipping crates. While most of those can be reused for future shipping, some will need repairs from their original shipping use. 



shaped tin and wood maple sugar molds went for \$475. Another rarity, a tiger maple, heartshaped butter stamp bid to \$450.

Holiday-themed lots were also prevalent in this auction. They included 31 Santa figures and related items. Among them was a 9 ½-inch antique German Belsnickel Santa candy container that sold for \$850. The figure donned a rabbit fur beard and faux fur trimmed cloth and stood upon a mica decorated base. Another Belsnickle Santa reached \$750. The 12-inch 19th-century figure, in overall good condition, wore a crepe paper costume over a stuffed wood body. A papier-mache Santa Claus and sleigh store display reached yet another three-figure bid at \$600.

Other Christmas items sold well including a 6-pound Christmas bell windmill weight that went for \$600. A 5-inch German Schafer & Vater porcelain Christmas flask, with a replaced stopper, sold for \$325. For decorating under the tree was a set of paper houses, church buildings, and wooden figures that plates. The neoclassical went home for \$300.

suggest that formal china has lost its appeal. This auction would indicate otherwise. The hammer went down at \$525 for an early 1900s French L.R.L. Limoges 12-piece table setting. The excellent-condition set was gilded and featured hand-painted game birds. Another buyer parted with \$375 for a 12-piece set of Vienna set, in excellent condi-

marks and images of Achilles, Jupiter, and Venus, among other figures from Greek mythology. To complement the set was a 10-inch mid-century cut glass pitcher and six tumblers featuring gilding cut away to reveal clear glass. The collection sold for \$175.

Antique toys were numerous; winning bids ran the gamut from high three-figures to under \$20. A working condition cast iron "bad accident" mechanical bank from the late 1800s-early 1900s went for \$700. At the other end of the spectrum, a steam toy water mill with a mill worker figurine only reached \$20. And, a group of tin toys hailing from the 1920s to the 1950s got snagged for just \$5.

Auction-wide, half of the lots sold in the three-figure range. Plenty of opportunities camel for those with modest budgets. A 19th-century set of wood butter paddles sold for just \$10 as did a framed 19th-century chromolithograph of whales and dolphins by Henry Johnson. A \$5 bid won a collection of ephemera with 1907 recipe cards, 1940s ration checks, and a 1947 Cincinnati auction catalog.

Some surprising lots were passed over. Among them was a late 19th century Ohio pine and poplar school master's desk, that had pre-bid estimates between \$250 and \$500. Also passed was a sixpiece Art Deco agate marble desk set which had pre-bid estimates as high as \$250. Perhaps those will reappear in one of Stony Ridge's future sales, alongside another batch of enticing traditional antiques.





milk glass production appeared in the late 1880s through 1910, covering the last part of the Victorian Era. Milk glass during the Victorian Era was produced in a wide variety of types and shapes, including "lacy edge" and "lattice edge" pieces. Nearly all house wares during the late Victorian Era were made in milk glass, including, but not limited to, plates, spoon holders, oil lamps, goblets, mugs, milk pitchers, creamers, sugar bowls, salt and pepper shakers, sugar shakers, syrup pitchers, candlesticks, toothpick holders, compotes, cake plates, serving bowls, vases, covered dishes, perfume bottles, dresser sets, and knickknack trays.

How blue milk glass is produced is quite technical. Basically, blue milk glass contains "dispersion of particles with refractive index significantly different from the glass matrix, which scatter light by the Tyndall effect." The Tyndall effect is light scattering by particles in a very fine suspension, such as molten milk glass. Using the Tyndall effect, blue light is scattered much more strongly than red light, producing blue milk glass. The size, distribution, and density of the light particles control the overall effect, which may range from light blue to dark bluish-turquoise.

Although many companies have produced blue milk glass objects, one of the best known of these companies is Sowerby Glassworks. As early as 1807, there are records of Sowerby Glassworks operating in Gateshead, England.

From 1870 onward, Sowerby was best known for its high quality pressed milk glass. For nearly 100 years, Sowerby led the world in milk glass production and design. In 1882, Sowerby operated Sowerby's Ellison Street Glassworks, which historians called the largest pressed glass

operation in the world, employing approximately 1,000 men. In order to appeal to the largest group of buyers, Sowerby produced pressed art milk glass in a number of designs, including designs by Walter Crane and Christopher Dresser. Women particularly liked Sowerby's Japanese and Egyptian milk glass designs and the company's pressed glass copies of Wedgwood pottery designs. Sowerby's goal was to bring art glass to the masses by making pressed milk glass affordable to anyone who wanted it.

Sowerby's artistic designs were mostly produced on the surface of the glass. The company's posy holders and vases were considered attractive, decorative pieces. Quality production was imperative since the true art was the design of the molds. Once the molds were satisfactory, pressed milk glass pieces were then produced in the thousands. Sowerby capi-

talized on the Industrial Revolution, mass-producing its milk glass products.

Some of Sowerby's most popular milk glass colors were turquoise blue, peacock blue, and Sowerby blue, which was the company's standard blue milk glass color. All of these colors, though, are considered variations of blue milk glass.

Novice collectors love blue milk glass. Sowerby blue glass is beautiful, abundantly available, and priced reasonable, allowing new collectors to achieve a nice collection in a relative short period of time without breaking the bank.
















Sway along with the Tiki soundtrack

If you haven't heard yet, a tiki revival is afoot, complete with exciting tikithemed establishments, art, and events. There are modern-day carvers, mixologists, and even bands following in the footsteps of some impressive forebears.

A big part of tiki culture has always been its soundtrack, which like the tiki statues and bamboo furniture, creates a sense of South Seas escapism. Whether in a Polynesian establishment or a home tiki bar, the "correct" music is important to the overall vibe. That, by the way, has nothing to do with Jimmy Buffet or Jamaican steel drums. Rather, it's rooted in a small handful of musical genres that were part of the original tiki scene in the 1950s and 60s, which have legions of new fans.

Tikiphiles often hunt for original records that hold the enticing sounds and great imagery that was such a part of tiki's heritage. If you would like to outfit your collection with some of that original vinyl, here is a rundown of what to look for.

Exotica


More than any other, the tiki scene became associated with this genre of

music. The style emerged in the 1950s, intended to evoke a sense of escapism and being transported to an exotic locale, often in the South Seas. Even Disney drew upon the musical style to create the soundtrack for its Enchanted Tiki Room attraction.

Exotica creates the mental journey by pairing instrumental music with heavy doses of native drumming, ethnic instruments, and even jungle sounds like bird calls and primate screams. The effect often comes across like a score from a South Seas flick. The co-founder of Liberty Records coined the term 'exotica' to describe the evocative elements.

While exotica's roots predate the 1950s, the origins are commonly assigned to virtuoso Les Baxter and his 1952 album, Ritual of the Savage. Among the album's tracks was Quiet Village, which has become a cornerstone of tiki music. Baxter described the tune as a "musical portrait of a tropical village deserted in the midday heat." Baxter continued producing into the 1970s, releasing more than 60 albums that echoed everything from African rhythms to pseudo-space themes.

If Les Baxter put exotica on the map, then it was pianist Martin Denny who brought it to tiki.

In 1954, the infamous Don the Beach-comber asked Denny to perform at the Shell Bar at Honolulu's Hawaiian Village. Denny formed a band for the gig that included Arthur Lyman, who added the vibraphone and jungle calls that became synonymous with exotica music. Denny's 1957 cover of Quiet Village, which contained the signature sounds, earned more acclaim than Baxter's.

Denny described his style as conjuring "what a lot of people imagined the islands to be." Like Baxter and other exotica artists, Denny incorporated a variety of inspirations into his work,

including Afro-Cuban, Middle-eastern, and Asian.

Arthur Lyman eventually struck out on his own. He recorded nearly three-dozen exotica-style albums including the famous records Taboo and Yellow Bird and continued to play to audiences long past tiki's peak.

A handful of other artists were popular during exotica's heyday. They included Mexican composer Juan García Esquivel (known simply as Esquivel) who introduce the space-age and lounge sounds and Hollywood score composer Robert Drasnin who continued in the styles of Baxter and Denny.

Exotica quickly fell out of vogue as baby boomers came of age and eschewed the tastes of their parents.

Hawaiian

In the years around Hawaii's state-hood in 1959, there was a frenzy for all things Hawaiian. The entertainment industry attempted to capitalize on the craze with touring acts and recorded music



1915 until the early 1960s. After World War II, demand for tropiintensified as thousands of GIs started returning from the Pacific theater. Rodgers and Hammerstein's 1949 musical South Pacific was born from that.

Record companies responded by releasing a variety of South Seas particularly Hawaiian inspired music. The category can be roughly divided into two camps: traditional Hawaiian and Hapa Haole (or half foreign).

Traditional Hawaiian folk records sometimes captured native drumming and chanting known as Mele. Others showcased string instruments like the ukulele and slack key guitar, often providing the backdrop for Hawaii's famous falsetto singing. Bands like the Waikikis and singers such as Alfred Apaka and Eddie Kamae made $_{
m this}$ format famous.

Conversely, Hapa Haole was the music industry's attempt at creating Polynesian fantasy through easy-listening music that was not particularly authentic. Numerous artists like Jerry Byrd and the famed Don Ho recorded tunes like Little Grass Shack and Pearly Shells. Even celebrated songs like Somewhere Over the Rainbow were remade "Hawaiian style."

The Hawaiian category eventually devolved into a subgenre of easy listening. Many Polynesian-themed albums were nothing more than symphonic collections with tropical covers. Others, like Elvis Presley's Blue Hawaii and those by charting artists like Andy Williams, erased any legitimate South Seas connections.

Surf

tion of surfers during

the middle of the 20th century hit the public's TV screens with the Ventures' theme track for the Hawaii 5-0 television series.

Surfing began in cal-style entertainment Hawaii but became a cult phenomenon in Southern California in the 1950s and 60s. With it came a style of music rooted in fast electric guitar and percussion intended to evoke the waves and excitement of the sport. The style is distinctive, making heavy use of reverb to create an echoey sound termed "surf drip."


> One artist, Dick Dale is largely responsible for the style. His 1962 debut album Surfers Choice contained what would become a surf anthem, Misirlou. The next year, the Surfaris released what is probably the best-known surf tune, Wipe Out. Other surf bands like The Astronauts and The Shadows spread the sound.

> Surf music was integral to the success of early 60s beach movies like Beach Blanket Bingo and television shows like Gidget. Artists like the Beach Boys and Jan and Dean tried to make the sound more mainstream by adding vocal harmonies. That became known as the "California sound" but it never captured the energy of classic surf. All of it quickly faded during the British invasion.

Original Album Art

While vintage exotica, surf, and Hawaiian music are all streamable and available on CDs, nothing replaces the visceral experience of 12 inch albums, with their beguiling cover art. It's arguable that the value of the original albums rests as much in their covers as the music!

The album art for these styles of music is filled with fantasized images of tropical settings or those illustrating how western culture once portrayed the for-The opus for a genera- eign and mysterious. Although the imagery


often stereotypes and is out-of-date with today's standards, it is nonetheless intriguing. For the retro fan, these albums make great display pieces, and plenty of framing options are available.


Tiki Music Revival

The tiki revival that started in the 1990s exhumed all three of these musical traditions. Not only did vintage exotica resurface, but new bands like Don Tiki and the Tikivaki Orchestra resurrected the genre. Arguably more popular with tikiphiles than neo-exotica is surf music. Modern bands like the Surfrajettes and Los Straitjackets get as much attention as their counterparts from a generation ago. There are even contemporary Hawaiian artists like Amy Hänaiali'i Gilliom and Israel Kamakawiwo'ole who are keeping the islands' musical traditions alive.

So, whether your tastes run to the exotic sounds of Martin Denny, the reverb of the Ventures, or the slack guitar of vintage Hawaiian, there is plenty to hunt. Original albums make great conversation pieces - and they supply the right sound and can serve as amazing decor for a properly outfitted home tiki bar.
