# Epic Auctions took bidders to the movies in style

LESLIE, Mich. — Epic Auctions and Estate Sales recently hosted a very colorful event consisting of 450 lots of movie posters, autographed celebrity photos, and related items dating from the 1940s to the present. This online event was just the first of several being held to liquidate a massive collection consisting of more than 2,000 items. By presenting this inventory online, it was easy to inspect each lot and read the related description, including condition detailed reports. The prices shown here do not include the buyer's premium.

In the 1940s Jack Baker, a.k.a., Dr. Silkini toured from city to city presenting "Dr. Silkini's Spiritualistic Séance and Ghost Show", later known


as the "Asylum of Horrors". This live event consisted of spooky monsters in costume, horror movies, illusions, skits, and humor. The poster offered at this auction contained the phrases "3 full hours of thrills, chills, and laughs", "it separates the men from the boys", and "Frankenstein direct from Hollywood". If that wasn't enough to attract an audience, the poster also promised "Beautiful, curvaceous Hollywood starlets". The poster measured 56 by 41 inches and had suffered a few tears as well as a piece missing from the bottom margin, but with its historical significance it still proved irresistible. It left with a final bid of \$400, the highest of the sale for this unique treasure.

Most people remember

# Wallets open wide for antique dental cabinets

Like many professions, dentistry has changed over the last 150 years, especially in how dental



and stored. In the mid-1800s, dentists often traveled from town to town, treating patients. These dentists made regular circuits, often in a small buggy or horsedrawn van. Some of these vans had a wooden tooth displayed on the top of the van as an early form of trade sign. Some dendentists had patients sit or lay on any chair or table available.

As these dentists rode their circuits, they carried their dental instruments in large wooden boxes that contained multiple, velvet-lined com-

instruments are sanitized partments and small, sliding drawers. On the top of the dental box was a sturdy handle so the box could be grabbed and easily carried if need be. Dentists of this early period valued organization and portability of their instruments over cleanliness. Dental instruments of this era were durable, but dentists carried crude dental tists would often use an chairs in their vans while instrument on a patient, wipe off the instrument with a rag, and place it back in its allotted drawer, ready to be used on the next patient. Years would pass before dental instruments were boiled on a regular basis to sterilize them.


In large cities by the late-1800s, dentists began stationary dental practices, but in rural communities and small

towns, dentists remained circuit riders until the early 20th century when dentistry more or less became a business conducted in private dental offices. These dental offices often consisted of a small room with a desk, a dental chair, and a cabinet. When the change between traveling dentistry and stationary dentistry took effect, a change in instrument storag was needed. Cabinetmakers began making dental cabinets consisting of a potpourri of small drawers and compartments that were designed to hold all of the dental

# JD lawn mower mows down a \$875 bid at VanderKolk

DORR, Michigan -VanderKolk Auction & Appraisal Company ran an online only auction to help sell out the WJ Love estate. There were some very nice lawn and garden items offered including a John Deere D130 Mower. This work horse was in great condition

and brought a generous bid of \$875. This riding mower boasted a 22-HP, V-Twin, John Deere branded engine with plenty of power and torque to handle tough mulching, mowing, and bagging conditions. It had a hydrostatic transmission with a two-pedal foot control system and cruise control for ease of use. Sporting a 42-inch

edge cutting system, this mower was ready to help out with the yard work.

A Sears's 10XL garden tractor brought a final bid price of \$101.

A Miller Millermatic 135 115Volt wire welder drummed up quite a bit of interest. It came with a gas bottle and a box of accessories. Even though this unit is no longer available new, it was

worth picking up used. This is a welder that you can use flux core welding wire or solid wire with shielding gas. So it is flexible in uses. Another plus with this welder is that

you can plug it into and run it on normal 120V household power. The final bid price for this wire welder tacked out at \$778.

Bringing in a final bid

of \$244 was a Craftsman lathe. This handy little machine was mounted on a bench, and was in working condition. Anyone

Elvis Presley as the flashy singer and performer. A poster for the movie Charro! shatters that image. Elvis is shown with a beard, and the quotes on the poster include "On his neck he wore the brand of a killer. On his hip he wore vengeance!" It was the only movie that Elvis appeared in where he did not sing. This Western film features a gripping plot with Elvis at the center of outlaw violence, theft, and revenge. The 1969, 41 by 79 inch poster advertising this obscure movie drew a final bid of \$170 despite some wear.

John Wayne fans had several options to choose from celebrating that actor's long Hollywood career. There was a 1968 movie Les Berets Verts or The Green Berets starring John Wayne, David Janssen, and Jim Hutton. This collectible was claimed with a final bid of \$140. The poster for his 1957 movie The Quiet

Man drew a final bid of \$120, as did the poster for the 1959 film Rio Bravo.

Arnold Schwarzenegger was featured in a 1977 docudrama Pumping Iron, the story of the world of professional bodybuilding. It depicts the competition for the title of Mr. Olympia. It is interesting that this is not strictly considered an Arnold Schwarzenegger film such as Terminator or Conan because of the content and format. The poster states "This movie has heart, soul, blood, guts, perspiration, and plenty of muscle", and features a triumphant Arnold with hands raised, smiling, and wearing only his shorts. This original theatrical movie poster in black and white was taken with a final bid of

Some vintage posters also did quite well. The poster for the French Man Who Knew Too Much, an Alfred Hitchcock movie from 1956 starred James Stewart and Doris Day. The 40 by 27 inch poster for this suspenseful American thriller finished at \$120. An original Italian 1950 theatrical movie La Rosa Nera (The Black Rose) starring Tyrone Power and Orson Welles told the story of a Saxon nobleman, adventure, and conquest, in 13th century England and his flight to the Far East. This large format poster earned a final bid of \$110.

Autographed photos of celebrities were plentiful at this auction. A tender 7 by 9 inchcolor photo of a very young-looking Johnny Cash and June Carter Cash with both of their autographs finished with a bid of \$110. Not far behind, a Julie Andrews autographed monochrome photo showing her singing to a bird on her hand while she wore a maid's apron closed at \$80. An autographed black and white photo of Vincent Price, the prince of horror, reached a \$45 final bid, a photo of a young Elizabeth Taylor from National Velvet earned \$35, and a photo of Bette Davis gazing into the camera also drew a \$35 bid.

The rest of the auction included some interesting, somewhat related items. A 1998 unopened bottle of Dom Perignon Champagne was offered in its original green velvet lined box. This unexpected treasure was claimed with a final bid of \$100. Several small model buildings depicted landmarks, various including movie theatres, concert halls, and other notable locations. The model of Radio City Music Hall was paired with the model of The Grand Theatre, part of the contemporary Dept 56 "Christmas in the City" series. This nostalgic duo earned a \$70 bid. A Halloween-themed Dept 56 lot consisting of a 2004 LaGhosti movie theatre (which made Halloween sounds), Haunted Theater, and some characters was taken with a bid of \$30. There were several others as well.

Atlanta's Loew's Grand Theater was the site of the 1939 premiere of "Gone With The Wind". It

was built in 1893 and destroyed by fire in 1978. A brick from this historic site was offered and was numbered 1884 of 2000. There was paperwork on the back explaining the origin of this relic. It left

with a final bid of \$25. And for those wishing to capture the feel of a Hollywood studio, a mixed lot consisting of a film camera, a clapboard, and a "Now Showing" sign was offered, and exited with a final bid of \$10

#### Dental cabinet

instruments needed in any dental office. It was not long before manufacturers began turning out assembly line dental cabinets.

Dental instruments were stored in pre-determined drawers inside the dental cabinet, laid out much like a mechanic stores his wrenches and sockets in Snap-On tool chests today. Even in the early 20th century, dental instruments were stored unwrapped and often un-sanitized since dentists, by and large, were still unaware that infection and disease could be transmitted from one dental patient to another through un-sanitized instruments. However, dental cabinets truly helped organize the dental trade since these cabinets were built with features no other cabinet possessed, such as dozens of small, lined drawers (some cabinets had drawers within drawers), revolving doors, swing out trays giving the cabinets work surfaces, removable draw trays, and louvered roll top storage areas much like old roll top desks had.

The very real possibility of the transmission of disease through unclean dental instruments directly led to dental manufacturers designing and building dental cabinets with a built-in sterilizer unit in the upper areas of the cabinets. By 1910, dental cabinets had become fundamental storage compartments for dental instruments in nearly all dental offices in America.

Today, collectors and interior decorators eagerly search for old dental cabinets, both wooden and metal, as unique decorator pieces for homes or offices. The multitude of draws make nice places to store photographs, jewelry, business cards, coins, memora-

bilia and other small treasures, such as baby shoes or your grandfather's pocket watch and knife.

Collectors love old, wooden dental cabinets that were crafted with brass trim, velvet lined drawers, beveled or leaded glass panels, dovetailed drawers, marble shelves and counter tops, compartments and drawers with quality drawer locks, and highly decorative design work of inlaid wood or mother of pearl.

Refinished wooden dental cabinets show rich, ornate grain designs, and many of the oldest cabinets have small beveled mirrors attached similar to a shaving mirror. Metal cabinets are prized for their quality-enameled surfaces and varieties of sleek metal designing, such as Art Nouveau and Art Deco cabinetry. Metal Art Deco dental cabinets are considered machined cabinets, but their curvy, industrial look is often tarnished with rust, which is nearly impossible to remove.

In the late 1800s and early 1900s it was customary for cabinetmakers to use several different types of wood, both fine and common, to build cabinets, and dental cabinets were no exceptions. Today, especially after professional restoration, a dental cabinet may show signs of walnut, bird's eye maple, cherry, oak, mahogany, maple, or, for framing, pine. Today, different hardwoods used on the same cabinet make for beautiful furniture pieces in a home.

American dental cabinet manufacturers included The American Cabinet Company of Two Rivers, Wisconsin, A.C. Clark & Company of Chicago, Illinois, Ransom & Randolph Company of Toledo, Ohio, and Lee Smith & Sons of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.







#### Inflation fears did not stop thousands from shopping Springfield Extravaganza

The weekend of September 15-18 was picture-perfect for the 53rd fall running of the Springfield Extravaganza. Amidst inflation fears, high gas costs, and interest rate hikes, thousands of shoppers and vendors still flocked to the show, making it a stellar event.

The biannual antique Extravaganzas run each September and May. This time, 2,100 vendors participated, which was nearly 100 more than last September. Current inflation might help to explain the increase in the number of sellers. Many were not professional sellers; rather, a healthy number were average people trying their hand at vintage-selling side businesses as a way of making ends meet. Selling at events like Extravaganza can be a good source of side income. Booth costs are reasonable and a well-run space can often bring in hundreds of dollars each day of the

ties help explain the bump in dealers, they don't explain the thousands of patrons who were there to spend money. Despite the highest inflation in forty years, Extravaganza remained a pilgrimage for plenty of people. Thousands of shoppers came from Ohio, nearby Midwest states, and even further away. Many boasted of tak-

ing home carloads of merchandise.

Scores spent \$50 to attend Thursday's Line Buying event, in which vendors sold from the backs of their vehicles while waiting to load in. By 7 a.m. Friday, shoppers had lined up all the way to the interstate, willing to pay the \$15 early bird admission to get ahead of the

crowd. Even the thousands who could attend a single day gladly parted with \$10 to get into the popular event.

Attendees' exuberance withstanding, sharp vendors were sensitive to people's thinner budgets. There was a conspicuous level of wallet-friendly pricing. It was




