1967 Corvette Stingray raced to \$82,000 at Cryderman

ARMADA, Mich. - Vintage car and motorcycle enthusiasts were given an opportunity recently to feast their eyes on some rarely seen treasures as Chuck Cryderman & Associates Auctions hosted an online-only extravaganza of vehicles and related items. Boasting 191 motorcycles, 10 automobiles from the 1930s-2000s, plus parts, signs, trailers, and even gas pumps, this was a rare chance to shop an inventory of quality items. There were 551 lots total, and prices listed do not include the buyer's premium.

Closing well ahead of the

pack, the star of the auction was the 1967 Rally Red Corvette Stingray convertible. This amazing vehicle featured a Turbojet 427 tri-power 400 HP engine, 4-speed manual transmission, disc brakes, and black interior. It was restored to its original beauty 15 years ago and drove off with a final bid of \$82,000.

The next highest finisher was a very interesting car. This 1974 Shelby Cobra Tribute model was a custom built 351 Windsor GT with a high performance Holley carburetor, and many other impressive features. In addition, it sported the image of a cobra snake on the underside of the hood, creating an eye-catching detail on this classy vehicle. With only 23,000 miles, it was claimed with a final bid of \$50,000.

in the older models, there were a few nice ones to select from. The 1939 red Ford pickup with black running boards, 3-speed manual transmission and V8 engine was in exceptional condition. It showed 85,773 miles on the odometer and came with new tires and rims. It was reported that the former owner drove it to work on nice days. It left for a new home with a final bid of \$18,000. A 1940 gray, 2-door Chevrolet with a 327 Chevy engine, 3 speed transmission, and 12-bolt rugged rear differential plus a Mustang front end looked like it had just driven out of an old movie scene. A high bid of \$17,600 was required to take it home.

In a different category, the 1975 yellow Cadillac Eldorado convertible with V8 engine and 88,698 miles was a flashback to a time when large luxury cars were the norm. It came with a removeable matching hard top, was reported to start, run, and drive just fine, and proved popular, drawing a final bid of \$9,900. Some of the other automobiles included the tan 1953 Chevrolet Bel Air that closed at \$9,900, a silver 2007 Ford Mustang GT Special California tribute edition at \$9,700, and a 1940 Chrysler Windsor in need of some repair that still drew a final bid of \$5,900.

With 191 vintage motorcycles offered, there were

selections from several makers, years, sizes, and conditions. The Harley Davidson 1971 Super Glide Boat Tail sporting the colors red, white, and blue presented an impressive package. It was in great condition, had both an electric and kick start, and some aftermarket parts. This top-selling bike commanded a final bid of \$10,900. Not far behind, the 1973 Kawasaki H2 750 Triple proved to be very much in demand despite needing some wiring and body repair. This candy-tone purple racing bike left with a high bid of \$9,600. Other motorcycles that did well include a 1977 Triumph T140 that earned a

bid of \$6,200, a 1968 Royal Enfield 750 Interceptor leaving for \$6,100, a 1972 Norton 750 Commando Cafe Racer Special at \$5,200, and a 967 BSA A65 650 twin carb Lightning going for a high bid of \$4,900. There were dozens more bikes and motorcycle parts also available.

Related items were also offered at this very diverse auction. Two gas pumps were high-selling, popular attractions. The vintage Mobil gas pump manufactured by Gilbert and Barker had been beautifully restored with reproduction glass but still retained the original metal ring. This charming relic closed with a final bid of \$2,700. The second was a restored Pure Oil Company Racing Gasoline Tokheim 339 pump which featured their red Firebird logo. While missing the back glass it otherwise was in excellent condition and drew a final bid of \$1,700.

A few signs were eagerly claimed during this auction. An original oval Ford blue and white steel sign measuring approximately 4-feet long was stamped "Sales Equipment Co. Detroit, Mich". It had suffered some damage over the years, including pitting and rust, but this didn't stop the collectors from driving the final bid up to \$2,100. A single-sided, round porcelain Gulf sign with a maker's mark SPS '64 that measured approximately 5-feet in

diameter closed at \$1,700. An approximately 3-foot Citgo 2-sided square porcelain sign drew \$600.

For the adventurous members of the bidding audience, a 1958 custom-built old school dragster bearing the name "Soc Hop" was offered. It was equipped with a 1957 Cadillac 365 V8 engine, log-type intake, four 94 carburetors, and a direct drive transmission. The 113 inch wheelbase provided stability. There were many quality parts taken from different manufacturers to truly make this a one-of-akind vehicle. It came complete with a custom trailer that tilts back to unload. The package left for its next adventure with a final bid of \$6,200.

To finish up with something completely different, there was a very large, top-opening Coca Cola cooler with a well-worn tag that identified it as being manufactured by Westinghouse. To make it even more desirable, it was mounted on a small trailer frame and had two speakers installed in the front panel. This unusual item closed at \$1,500.

met Lily Dracula. In 1865, Herman and Lily married. Eventually the couple, along with Lily's father-Grandpa, moved to America, and Herman joined the US Army and fought in World War II. Herman works for Gateman, Goodbury and Graves, a funeral home, where he started out as a "box boy."

Fred Gwynne played Herman as a lovable, good-natured, and clumsy man, who behaves in childish ways, throwing temper tantrums that are more humorous than scary. Herman is kind to everyone he meets, but his naivety about human behavior sets up weekly problems that Herman must get out of.

Herman Munster is incredibly strong, just like the Frankenstein monster in the movies. In one episode, Herman is shown lifting a solid metal demolition ball (an average wrecking ball weighs 5,000 pounds) with one hand like it is a is asked how much he weighs, and he answers. "Three spins," meaning the dial on a scale spins around three times when

own fan base, by and large, collectors search for Herman Munster items since Herman has always been a beloved television character.

In 1964 Mattel started a Herman Munster collectible fan club when the company came out with a Herman Munster doll that featured Fred Gwvnne's voice and spoke ten random phrases with the pull of its "Chatty Ring" cord. This was a spin-off of Mattel's highly successful Chatty Cathy doll, for which the talking mechanism had been invented. This doll is still highly collectible and is occasionally seen on eBay for around \$1,000.

Since the first Herman Munster doll, many other dolls and figurines have been produced, including a mid-1960s Herman blow mold toy, a Herman hand puppet that in its original packaging sells for over \$1,500, and a Polystone 1/6th scale Herman Munster figurine from Sideshow Collectibles that is routinely offered on Internet auction sites for \$650.
