ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Willy's Jeep was parade ready and drove a \$15,400 bid

COLEMAN, Mich. — John Peck Auctions recently hosted the Sayers Estate dispersal, which included a great selection of farm equipment, tools, antiques, household items, and a “Parade Ready” 1951



Army Jeep. There were many useful items in very good condition available to take home and put into service. This online auction featured 159 lots and prices shown do not include the buyer's premium.

If only objects could talk! There was a 1951 Willys Overland Army Jeep offered that would have a wealth of stories to tell. This unusual vehicle was listed as running great. The star logo and words “US ARMY” still showed prominently on the olive drab body. The Chilton and Haynes

repair manuals were included along with American flags and a plastic bag with patches, certificates, and other memorabilia. This proved to be the leader of the auction, drawing 247 bids and a closing bid of \$15,400.

Continuing the military theme, there was a US Army Corps of Engineers Airborne Equipment metal dump trailer with a half-ton capacity manufactured by the Convento Manufacturing Company of Cambridge City, Ind., dated 1942. It measured 3.5 by 5 feet and was still quite useful in spite of the rust. It was taken with a

Collectors love to 'meet the Flintstones'

Every Baby Boomer knows The Flintstones' theme song by heart:

Flintstones... Meet the Flintstones,

They're a modern stoneage family.

From the town of Bedrock,

They're a page right out of history.

In the years since his birth on television, Fred has become a household name to millions of

children and adults through his continued presence on TV, the big screen, and product endorsements.

Premiering September 30, 1960, The Flintstones broke new ground on television. Airing on ABC, the show ran for six seasons (166 episodes), with the final episode airing on April 1, 1966. Produced by the team of William Hanna and Joe Barbera, The Flintstones broke television tradition by becoming the first animated situation comedy on television and the first true prime-time cartoon.

The storyline closely duplicated the classic television show The Honeymooners, starring Jackie Gleason. The four principal characters in The Flintstones were Fred Flintstone, his wife Wilma, his best friend Barney, and Barney's wife Betty. Each of these cartoon characters'

personalities closely resembled the four principal characters of The Honeymooners.

Originally designed as a program for the “entire family,” The Flintstones became primarily “children's television” when syndicated in 1967. The story line each week revolved around a working-class man and his family and their day-to-day activities. They suffered from all the maladies of a modern family.

Collectors love The Flintstones for the enormous amount of items available on the secondary market. John Michlig (Baby Boomer Collectibles, August 1994) argued that The Flintstone's collectible field began in their first year on TV. “Before The Flintstones' first season was over, one could play “The Flintstones Pre-Historic Animal Rummy Game” by the light of a



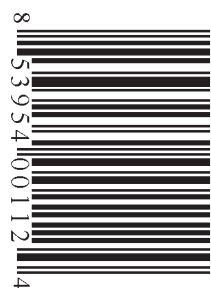

handsome Fred-shaped Flintstone lamp. Fred and friends were merchandized to the hilt.” In fact, during the first minute of each show,

final bid of \$520. There was also an open box, wooden 5 by 12 foot HD tandem axle shop built trailer that was claimed with a \$310 bid despite needing some repair.

Part of dispersing this estate included the sale of a 1996 Catalina Coachmen travel trailer. This massive 26-foot-long model was in excellent condition and included a beautifully furnished interior with sofa, dining table and seats, gas cook stove, refrigerator, ample cupboard storage, lavatory, and a queen size bed. Ready to hit the open road, this prize left with a high bid of \$2,751.

There were many equipment and tool options offered from what appeared to be a very busy working farm. Leading this category were two vintage but well maintained Ford 9N tractors. Both had been repainted, the original seats replaced, and their engines were clean and ran well. The first one came with a draw bar and 3-point stabilizers, and it closed with a high bid of \$1,401. The Pittsburgh 5 foot 3-point rear blade pictured with this tractor sold separately for a \$157 bid. The second tractor was comparable but lacked the extras, and it finished at \$1,126.

Numerous implements

for field work were available and eagerly claimed. The top selling item here was a massive ten-foot pull type cultipacker with a 4 inch axle. This sturdy device is an important part of the farming arsenal, and it proved its value by drawing a final bid of \$680. The red Ford or Ferguson 3-point 2 bottom plow left for a new assignment with a high bid of \$290. There was a 7 foot 3-point cultivator that was taken for \$211, while a 5-foot version left for \$169.

Handy for many applications, the 5 HP, 60-gallon Silver Bullet V single stage vertical air compressor that was rated 12.7 SCFM at 40 PSI along with ample hoses was rehomed with a final bid of \$240. A 30-space QO Load Center 200-amp Square D electrical box, still new in its package, with circuit breakers included proved popular, requiring a final bid of

\$256 to take it. A well-stocked older Kennedy toolbox with clutch adjusting tools, numerous drill bits, a metal L-square, and other tools, plus an antique buggy lamp was claimed with a high bid of \$160. A 5000-watt DeVilbiss GB5000 Powerback generator earned a \$180 bid.

Household appliances were well maintained and desirable. A Husqvarna Viking Designer 1 sewing and embroidery machine complete with carrying case and all accessories was taken with a final bid of \$307. A very large lot combining a Rainbow vacuum cleaner, walking sticks, picture frames, and several VCR and DVD movies was claimed with a \$126 bid. Another combination package featuring a Samsung 31-inch flat screen television with stand, numerous DVD movies, plus a Magnavox DVD and a Sony VCR player drew a final bid of \$97.

This estate sale included some lovely home furnishings as well. A beautifully crafted antique curved front sideboard with leaded glass door & drawers measured 46 inches wide by 54 inches tall. This attractive item was in very nice overall condition with just some minor wear on top. A show piece for any home, it was carried away with a final bid of \$465. A set consisting of two white chests of drawers, a matching framed mirror, and an oil lamp all in excellent condition left with a final bid of \$177. Another natural wood-col-

ored set topped out at \$152. Dining tables were also popular, with a handsome 48 inch round oak dining table and 5 chairs going for a \$177 bid and an apartment size dining table with 1 leaf and 4 chairs drew a final bid of \$76.

A few collectibles rounded out the sale, starting with a vintage Dazey #4 butter churn with red football top and round tulip glass jar that was claimed with a high bid of \$100. A group of antique items included an L.C. Smith and Brothers typewriter, three glass insulators, a flatiron, a wood Tone Rite AM radio, a Zenith plastic AM radio, and a very rustic antique phonograph that went as a lot for \$66. Another selection of items including a National Washboard Company glass washboard, a metal washboard, galvanized pails, and possibly two wood sluice gate handles ended at \$30.

Mecum lays claim to the most expensive motorcycle sold at auction

WALWORTH, Wis. — Mecum Auctions, the world's largest auctioneer of collector cars and vintage motorcycles, is no stranger to amazing prices for vintage vehicles. However, the sale of a motorcycle during a five-day Las Vegas auction set a record that garnered national press.

A 1908 Harley Davidson Strap Tank sold for \$935,000, making it the most valuable motorcycle ever sold at auction. It is among the oldest surviving examples of this rare early Harley-Davidson model.

Strap Tanks, named for the steel bands attaching the fuel and oil tanks to the frame, are significant because they were the first production

models Harley Davidson manufactured. In 1906, Harley's first year of production, a mere 50 were built.

In 1908, production increased to 450 units. They were powered by a 26.8-cubic-inch single-cylinder engine delivering 4 horsepower and driving the rear wheel via a 1-inch-wide leather belt. Top speed was around 40 mph. One was ridden in a 1908 reliability run by company founder Walter Davidson, setting a fuel economy record of over 188 mpg.

The motorcycle was discovered in complete condition in 1941 in a barn near Milwaukee, Wis. It remained in Wisconsin for the next six decades before being professionally restored by Indiana's Paul Freehill. His restoration included rebuilding the engine, and replacing the fuel tank, wheel rims, and engine belt pulley.

survive. It was based on an Indian racing frame and racing forks modified to Cyclone's racing configuration. Power is delivered from a 61 cubic-inch 45-degree V-twin engine also tweaked to racing specifications. A four-year restoration was spearheaded by sculpture and motorcycle enthusiast Jeff Decker, who consulted with surviving principals of the original Cyclone company.

Many of the extraordinary motorcycles came from consigned collections, like the 105 highly-collectible Harley-Davidsons that were part of Ohio Harley-Davidson dealer Jim Godwin's "Forever Collection." The array, which brought in more than \$1.4 million, represented much of what he amassed since opening his dealership doors in 1961.

The top-seller from that collection was a 1972 Harley Davidson Knucklehead custom chopper built to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Jim's Harley-Davidson dealership. Selling for \$55,000, it featured a pan-shovel engine and was finished in black and gold custom paint with airbrush work on the tank and fenders.

Three 1940s-era Cyclones in racing configuration known to

Another exceptional vintage motorcycle was a 1914 Cyclone Racer. The gavel went down on that at \$575,000. Cyclone production lasted just three years. The racer was considered the most technically sophisticated motorcycle of its era - the first to employ an overhead camshaft.

This 1914 model was one of only three Cyclones in racing configuration known to

Knuckleheads also came out of the collection. A 1947 model - the final year for the heavyweight motorcycle - sold for \$52,800. Only driven 2 miles, it featured a 74 cubic-inch overhead valve 4-stroke V-twin engine, chain drive, and a 4-speed gearbox. Bold red paint was augmented by chrome and black trim and a black leather saddle seat.

Also hitting \$52,800 was a 1940 Knucklehead with just 1 mile on the odometer. It was powered by a 61 cubic-inch, 40-horsepower, air-cooled overhead valve V-twin engine. Chain drive and a 4-speed manual gearbox could push the motorcycle to 100 mph. Its light gray

finish was highlighted with black and chrome trim.

Mike Wolfe's (of American Pickers fame) "As Found" collection was also showcased. No doubt, Wolfe's fame helped generate nearly \$2 million from more than 60 vehicles, led by a 1936 Harley-Davidson EL Knucklehead that sold for \$132,000. 1936 was the first year of production for the Knucklehead. This one - one of 1,500 made - was in original condition and considered period correct. It was painted in rare green with silver pinstriping and fender trim.

American Pickers fans



know Wolfe's penchant for Indian Motorcycles. So, it was no surprise for a 1941 Indian Four to show up, eventually scoring \$115,500. The barn find came from western

Nebraska. Well worn, the Indian with its 1265cc inline 4-cylinder engine still sported its iconic skirted fenders and two-tone green and white paint.

Wolfe's offerings extended to a 1962 Messerschmitt Microcar that was acquired on an episode of the show. The odd little vehicle, manufactured by the same company that built German World War II warplanes, was called a Kabinenroller (scooter). with a passenger cabin). It contains a Fichtel & Sachs 191cc fan-cooled 2-stroke single-cylinder engine capable of going 40 mph. It sold for \$33,000.

Other noteworthy vehicles included A 1963 Russian military DNEPR Twin with a sidecar that hit \$8,250. Decked as a museum piece, it included a life-size uniformed soldier, machine gun mount with inactive machine gun, ammunition can, inactive grenade canister, fuel cans, and tow ropes.

Selling for \$5,720 was a 1960 Harley Au4 Topper Scooter. Power was supplied by a 165cc single-cylinder 2-stroke, 9 horsepower engine, with

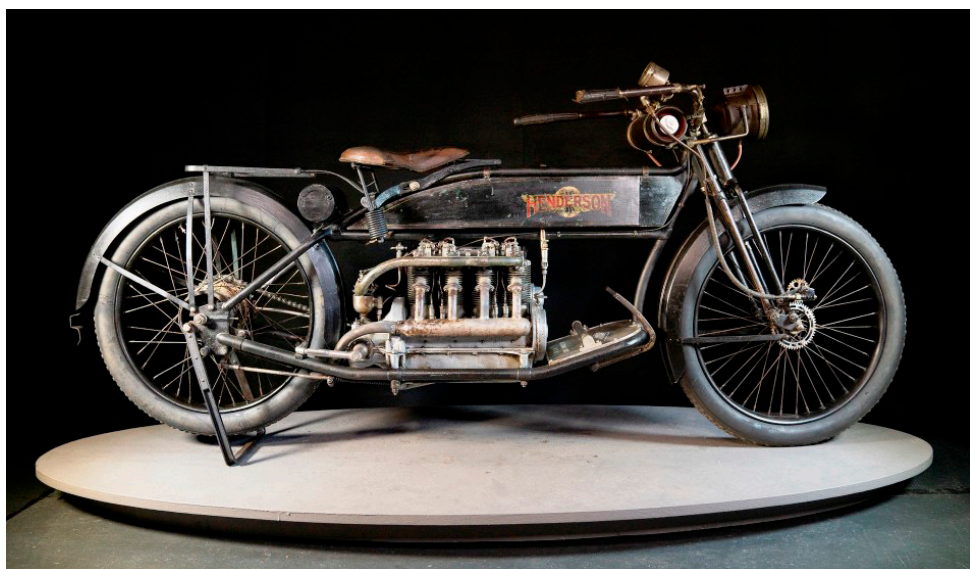
a lawnmower-type pull starter. The unit had been repainted in original Strato Blue with white accents,

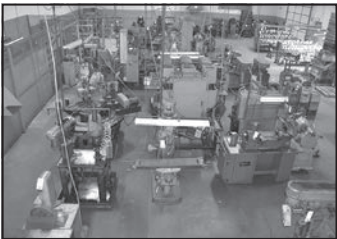

Fred would come into the house plugging the sponsor's product, whether it was Alka-Seltzer tablets one week or Winston cigarettes the next week.

Following The Flintstones original cancellation, a 1966 movie—The Man Called Flintstone—enjoyed minor success. The Flintstones received a new lease on life, of sorts, in the 1970s with a series showing Pebbles (Fred's daughter) and Bamm-Bamm (Barney's son) as teenagers. In addition, two live-action films have been made of The Flintstones—The

Flintstones in 1994 and The Flintstones in Viva Rock Vegas in 2000. If all of this exposure were not enough, Flintstone Theme Parks, called Bedrock City, appeared all around the world, and is one still operating in Arizona as part of the Raptor Ranch Conservation Park.

While Flintstone items routinely show up at auctions, in 1994 one of the largest comic character auctions ever held (at that time) was almost exclusively a

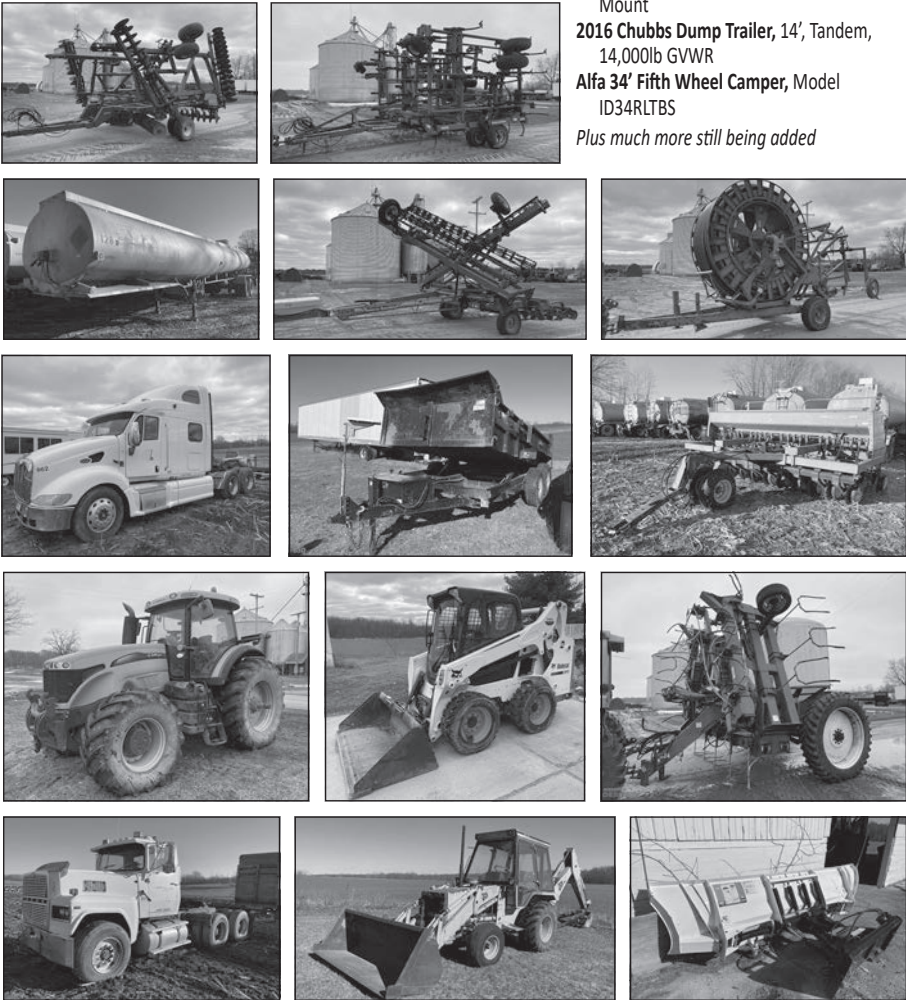

Flintstone auction. Held by Ted Hake (owner of Hake’s Americana and Collectibles in Pennsylvania), the Baby Boomer Comic Character Auction had so many Flintstone items that Hake held some of the Flintstone material back so the auction was not completely “Fred-filled and Barney-bursting.”

Hake said at the time, “The Flintstone loot was

easily the most popular up for bid. Every item sold.” Hake attributed the public’s interest in the Flintstone auction to their exposure “to so many generations that they’re not ‘time-bound.’ There’re so many different items that you see quite a bit of crossover interest—people who collect by the type, be it cookie jars, salt and pepper shakers or puppets.”

Michlig called the entire range of Flintstone collectibles “staggering.” He said, “Flintstones

printed matter is predictably extensive—from comic books to Little Golden Books to puzzles. Flintstone comic book series have run variously under the Dell, Gold Key and Charlton publishing labels.” However, Hake said, “First time around’ items (primarily items from the 1960s) certainly have the most value.”

Among the “first time around” items that collectors look for are the tin toy Flintstone collectibles. A “Fred Riding Dino” wind-up toy is especially popular.

Made by Marx in 1962, the sheer size of it makes it a popular collectible. One of these toys sold for \$418 at Hake’s auction in 1994. Today this same collectible routinely is offered on eBay in the range of \$250 - \$700.

The list of Flintstone collectibles is so extensive that Michlig stated the list of domestic licensees for the 1994 movie was “long enough to test any stapler; 32 typed pages consisting of

approximately 260 different product-types ranging from embroidered boxers to Flintstones medical scrubs.” It would take a lifetime just to collect one each of these 260 items.

While some of you may wonder why Flintstone items have remained popular with collectors, Joe Barbera, one of Fred’s original creators, summed up the appeal best, “Great characters and great stories” make The

Flintstones “timeless.” Moreover, as Fred celebrates his 63 birthday this year, there appears to be no end in sight for the “timeless” TV celebrity and the huge amount of collectibles he generates.

The Flintstones Collectibles by Debra Braun (Schiffer Publishing, 1999) is an excellent history and pricing guide for collectors interested in Fred, Barney, and the rest.

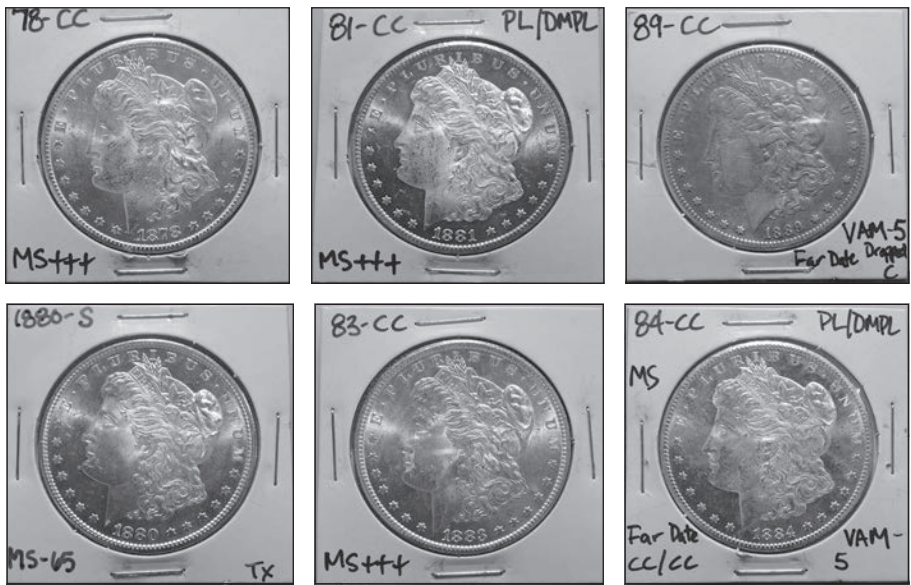
