

Hubley + motorcylces = a match made in heaven

John Hubley founded the Hubley Manufacturing Company in Lancaster, Pa., in 1894. The company offered a wide range of cast-iron doorstops and Company of Freeport, bookends. The first Illinois, that also pro-Hubley cast-iron toys appeared in 1909. These toys included horse-drawn vehicles, several breeds of dogs, steam shovels, cap

pistols, farm tractors, and its line of motorcycles, Harley Davidson motorcycles.

Hubley enjoyed unparalleled success for a number of years when their only true competition was the Arcade Manufacturing duced cast-iron toys. Hubley's early cast-iron toys were known for their complex designs. Hubley was especially known for



small delivery vans. Hubley's casting process for cast-iron toys involved several steps. For a particular Harley Davidson motorcycle, metalworker designers would first carve a wood form of the motorcycle.

Pressing the motorcycle's wooden form into finely compacted sand created an impression that was used for molding. Castiron heated to 3000 degrees was poured into the sand mold and, when cooled, the form would pop out. Workers used metal rasps to file away rough edges, making the mold ready for mass production casting.

Painters applied a base coat (usually white or cream but sometimes black) to some cast-iron motorcycles, and then colorists used a variety of hues or color tones to highlight important details on the motorcycle, such as the engine or the rider.

By the 1950s, the hey-


day for many toys, Hubley was manufacturing very sophisticated cast-iron toys, such as the 11 ½ inch long Indian cast-iron motorcycle that came complete with parts and accessories.

Hubley Manufacturing switched to die cast toys, and continued producing simple die cast toys

through the 1970s.

The Harley-Davidson motorcycle company was founded in 1903 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Harley-Davidson and Indian Motorcycles were the only two motorcycle companies to survive the Great Depression.

design handles and finial and was impressed with the designer's name, model number, and Denmark origins on the bottom.

Bidding came in lower at \$400 for a 19th-century Tahan Paris tantalus set. Its outer box was a combination of parquetry walnut and engraved brass with a hinged cover and sides. Inside was a lift-out rosewood tray holding four floral-etched decanters and 13 matching cordials. Overall condition was good although the case showed some wear and the original cordial complement was not complete.

Dozens of lots of fine two-dimensional art from the 19th and 20th centuries were offered. An 1830s John James Audubon (1785-1851)aquatint engraving went for twice auction estimates at The original \$4,000. hand-colored piece titled "White Ibis" came from the "Birds of America" Havell edition. The framed 20 by 18-inch painting on J. Whatman paper had some minor wear.

Bidders took another Audubon aquatint to \$1,300. It was also part of the "Birds of America" collection, titled "Wilson's

Phalarope" and Whatman paper. The framed 38 by 25-inch composition showed light

At the opposite end of the bidding spectrum, going for just \$100 was a mid-20th-century Ernest Bradfield Freed (1908-1974) intaglio print. The wood-framed signed and numbered piece, titled "Balancing Bears" measured 12 by 30 inches and showed minor wear.

Three-dimensional art came from all corners of the globe. A 19th-century Korean gilded bronze statue, portraying the Buddhist prophet

Maitreya, landed \$3,250. The 37-inch-tall statue had provenance to Fran Weiss Antiques Gallery.

A trio of 18th-century carved alabaster Peruvian Huamanga tableau figures went for an impressive ten times estimates at \$2,200. Each figure was approximately 6 inches tall and showed minor wear and damage.

Bidders with smaller wallets found plenty of pieces going for more modest sums. One was a carved eagle by Canadian Inuit Ben Henry that sold for \$160. The good-condition 10-inch soapstone carving was signed "Ben Henry, Six Nations, Ont. Canada" and dated 2003.

As with art and decor, furniture offerings were outstanding. Numerous pieces of designer mid-century modern furnishings were available — as was plenty of fine furniture from earlier eras. A ninepiece teak Danish modern dining set by George Tanier rose to \$3,000 nearly triple high estimates - even with age and use-related wear. The set table (expandable to 154 eight dining chairs with woven fiber seats.

A mid-century Florence Knoll sofa sold for a moderate \$700. The 62-inch chrome-based couch retained its original gray woven upholstery and original "Knoll" labels under the cushions. There was some upholstery wear and the original cushions had hardened with age.

From a world and age away came a 19th-century Chinese display table that sold for \$1,100, nearly triple the high estimate. The 32-inch-tall by 21-inchwide hardwood table featured an inset marble top, shaped lower shelf, carved skirt, and intricately-carved legs with paw feet. It bore its original dark finish but showed some wear and minor damage.

From Peru came a 19th-century folk art retablo altar. The 22-inch cathedral-shaped carved wood piece contained two carved saints inside and had a gilded and polychrome-painted lower attributed it to the consisted of a 78-inch oval Peruvian "Ministry of "Vicksburg The piece Culture." showed only minor wear

and damage and sold reasonably at \$300.

The sale included plenty of noteworthy items not of the art/furnishings variety. Among them was a 1960's Harmony H54 "Rocket" electric guitar with a hollow body design, dual pick-ups, and a rosewood fingerboard. It showed some surface wear and crazing but sold nicely at \$500. An early 20th-century Edison "Psycho-Phone" phonograph with stenciled oak case bid to \$300. And, an drawer. Certification 1863 Civil War-era Illysses S Grant Victory" bronze medal, awarded by "Joint Resolution of





Indian, founded in 1901, is called "America's first motorcycle company." Indian motorcycles were produced from 1901 to 1953 in Springfield, Massachusetts, during the 1910s Indian Motorcycle became the largest manufacturer of motorcycles in the world.

Hubley contracted with Harley Davidson and Indian around 1915 to produce cast-iron motorcycle toys, such as its **Hubley Champion Harley** Davidson and Rider castiron motorcycle. This seven-inch-long motorcycle was a "Police Special," and, today, it sells for as much as \$750 in "played with" condition. This beautiful machine had rubber whitewall tires. Another highly collectible Hubley motorcycle is its Indian motorcycle with sidecar and riders that was developed in the 1930s.

Hubley made a large assortment of Harley Davidson and Indian castiron motorcycles, including, but not limited to, police motorcycles, motorcycles with sidecars, US Mail motorcycles, US Parcel Post sidecar motorcycles, motorcycles with open wagon traffic cars, and civilian riders on motorcycles with sidecars.

One exceptionally rare Hubley cast-iron motorcycle is its Popeye Patrol motorcycle from the 1930s. Popeye's arms articulate up and down, and the cycle has small broken or missing pieces. whitewall rubber tires. In

good condition this toy is valued at around \$3,000.

Things to look for on all Hubley cast-iron motorcycles include original "Hubley" stickers, original "Hubley" rubber tires with "Hubley" on the tire, stickers on the gas tank that read "Indian," and the original rider or riders on the motorcycle. Because some of these toys are nearly 100 years old, the rubber tires have cracked or split and are often in poor condition, and always look for the original rear wheel clicker (that actually clicked when motorcycle was rolled across a floor). The clicker is missing on quite a few of the old Hubley cycles.

Also expect that toys this old have scratches on the paint. Cast-iron is easily broken, so before spending too much money at auction on a Hubley cast-iron motorcycle, look the toy over carefully for

Hubley ran into finan-

cial problems in the 1960s due to over diversification, weakening the company. In 1969 toy maker Gabriel purchased Manufacturing, bringing to an end nearly 60 years of original cast-iron toy manufacturing. While Hubley toys continued to be made by Gabriel and other companies, die hard collectors search for pre-1969 toys, knowing that original toys from the Hubley Company make the best collections.

Precious coral has been adorning people for centuries

Warm, coral-toned fruits, flowers, shells, and sunsets have charmed people since time immemorial. Precious Coral, bright organic invertebrates found along the coasts of Spain, northern Africa, Italy, and the South Pacific, is prized for both its beauty and mystical powers born of nature.

Ancient Greeks, believing that precious coral turned from plant to stone when exposed to air, deemed this peculiar matter "agreeable to the gods." Since this sea gem was associated with health, life, and luck, people evidently carried bits on their person to deflect winds, wild beasts, witchery, thunderbolts, hailstones, hurricanes, and all manner of disease and danger. Women wore coral bead necklaces and adorned their gold earrings with amuletic coral beads.

"Precious coral, or red coral, is the common name given to a genus of marine corals, Corallium. The distinguishing characteristic of precious corals is their durable and intensely colored red or pink-orange skeleton,

which is used for making Crushed coral, mixed jewelry," according to with powdered pumice Wikipedia. and pulverized date pits,

Others believed that bright coral was born of blood. According to Greek mythology, when Perseus, son of Zeus, beheaded the snake-haired monster Medusa, her blood, dripping into the water, turned its seaweed red. So, coral-inspired amulets featuring Medusa's likeness were considered lucky as well.

In addition, Greeks relied on crushed red coral to cure bladder disorders, diseases of the spleen, and all sorts of bleeding ailments.

Crushed coral, mixed with powdered pumice and pulverized date pits, cuttlefish bones, and burnt salts, was also considered an effective teeth-whitener.

Romans believed that precious coral held healing powers too. Besides





Auctioneer Dave Kessler obituary

RICHMOND, Ind. — Auctioneer David A. "Dave" Kessler, age 85, died March 5 at Forest item when I was 12 for 25 Park Health Campus in Richmond. He was born on January 30, 1938 in Richmond, Indiana, son of the late Frank Elwood & Betty Ellen (Baumgardner) Kessler.

Kessler was a longtime auctioneer and owned Kessler Auctioneers in New Paris, Ohio. In 2008 he was inducted into the Indiana Auctioneers Hall of Fame.

In a 2008 article in AntiqueWeek, Kessler said he had been an auctioneer since 1957, but he had a wide array of talents and interests. He was an author, painter, publisher, poet, musician, widely-noted teller of and a great cook.

In that article Kessler said, "I bought my first cents and sold it for \$18. Then I was hooked.'

Kessler said in 2008 he became serious about writing in the 1960s. "My first weekly column It's Old Stuff ran into the late 1970s." From the late '70s to about 1985 Kessler published The Auction Bottom Line tabloid paper. It had subscribers from all over the United States and Canada. He has written books titled Antiques Across the Auction Block, The Best of Dave Kessler and Selling Real Estate at Auction.

He wrote a column for Farm World beginning in 1981 and running through jokes and grand stories, 2015 called Skinny Cooks

Kessler traveled for years when he was on staff of the Missouri Auction school giving seminars and teaching other auctioneers.


He was preceded in death by his son, Bruce Kessler in 2019.







Precious Coral

draping small amuletic twigs around children's necks to keep them from harm, they used it, powdered in water, to cure snake and scorpion bites, block life-threatening blood loss, smooth scars, and even diagnose disease. Additionally, coral ash, valued for its soothing, cooling powers, was added to eye salves.

From the 1st century CE, traders bartered fragments of this costly, highly desirable "red gold" along ancient caravan routes stretching from the Mediterranean to Central Asia, India, and farther. People not only incorporated bits in personal ornamentation but also embellished their shields, weapons, helmets, and horse trappings with protective coral inlay.

From the mid-1200s, when the Mongol Empire stretched from Europe to Asia, precious coral, carried along great Eurasian trade routes, left bright rosy traces in its wake.

Bits of this precious matter eventually embel-

lished Mongolian beaded necklaces, Turkish belt buckles, Uzbekistani jewelry, Tibetan ritual masks, Indian amulets, Nepali and dagger sheaths. Even as civilizations rose and fell and trade routes sank into the sand, belief in precious coral's mysterious origin, spiritual nature. visual allure, and protective powers endured.

As early as the 15th century, the shallow waters around Corsica, Sicily, Sardinia, and Naples, Italy had become major centers of precious coral fishing and jewelry production. Initially,

workers cleaned and sorted heaps of these rough, knotted, gnarled, fibrous, highly prized coral twigs. Smaller bits, softer and more fragile than other precious gems, were carefully hand-cut, drilled, ground, then filed into convex, flat-backed cabochons for iewelry or variously sized beads for rosaries. Coarser strings of coral, meant for the expanding East Indian and African trade, were briefly hand-polished with pumice stone. Finer beads, however, were placed in pumice-filled canvas bags which craftsmen labori-

ously kneaded in water until they reached a high, glossy sheen. Then these were strung on necklaces or mounted on brooches, earrings, or rings.

Larger pieces of Italian precious coral, which took longer to develop. were exceedingly popular during the Victorian era. British gentlemen favored vibrantly hued cabochon or carved coral

cufflinks. Their wives wore dramatic button brooches or delicately carved florals, gold-set cameos, rosy pink pendants, brooches, and bracelets gleaming with cloisonné, seed pearl, sapphires or diamond accents. Others preferred exotic pieces featuring natural, spiky-shaped branch coral forms, sometimes enhanced with freshwater cultured pearls.

Salmon-hued, orange, red, pink, or less desirable pinkish-white "angel skin" precious coral jewelry soon charmed Americans as well. Through the early 1900s, companies, like Van Cleef & Arpels and Cartier, introduced a wealth of dramatic, deeply-hued Art Deco coral items, often paired with pearls, garnets, rubies, diamonds, enamel, marcasite, jet, or onyx set in gold or platinum. By mid-century, multistrand necklaces featuring precious coral beads petite or plump, as well as fancy, cabochon cut coral cocktail rings, pendants, and stud earrings became trendy.

By this time, Mediterranean precious coral, introduced to the American southwest centuries earlier, had also become an integral part of the Native American economy. Though typically passed from one generation to the next as protection from envy, jealousy and "bad medicine," in times of need, coral also served as portable wealth. To this day, coral-tipped silver bracelets, bolos, concho belts, cuff bracelets, rings, and necklaces are not only exchanged for horses, sheep, and cows, but also serve as pawn pledges at Native American reservation trading posts. Only if unclaimed do these authentic, Nativeworn "old pawn" treasures reach the general market. Though they may be very costly, to many, they are wildly

collectible. Additionally, examples are often found in prestigious museums. Contemporary Native

American creations are far more accessible. Produced in large numbers for the international market and the tourist trade, most feature bright, angular precious coral and turquoise patterns set in silver. Some pieces, like pins, bangles, and earrings, feature tiny, coral "needlework" bead patterns or naturalistic bits of coral worked into traditional designs. Others, like Zuni chokers, pendants, and brooches, feature fine channel work or inlays combining coral, shell, mother-of-pearl, black jet, and turquoise bits forming traditional images of Sun Face, Rain Bird, or Thunderbird. Other Native American creations, like Hopi and Navajo necklaces, feature amazingly tiny, tube-shaped precious coral beads, dramatic twigs, or plump, polished, multi-stone combinations. Yet among coral connoisseurs, works like Kenneth Begav's diamond and gold collages, Charles Loloma's elegant inlays, and Verma Nequatewa's subtle, stunning mosaics are far more collectible.

Some people look for stunning sculptures, natural specimens, or protective coral amuletsrather than jewelry.

Though jewels featuring pink, salmon, or "angel skin" coral is alluring and relatively inexpensive, those worked in deep, dramatic blood-red coral are most desirable. These also tend to be the most expensive. Fine red coral carved brooches, depending on their designs, size, and settings, can cost anywhere from several hundred to several thousand dollars. A necklace, depending on its design, length, weight, and bead size, can command well over \$10,000. Coral pieces enhanced with a wealth of sparkling gemstones generally cost

considerably more. Enthusiasts may enjoy perusing "Living Jewels" by Ruth Peltason, a sumptuous book that, covering 200 years of fine jewelry history, depicts hundreds of pieces fashioned from natural materials — including coral. Others may find the expansive, highly embellished volume, "Where Corals Lie: A Natural and Cultural History" by J. Malcolm Shick, of interest. It explores our relationship with coral through the prisms of art, jewelry, literature, folklore, history, commerce, politics, geology, and biology. It also discusses threats to its continuing existence.
