Full-steam ahead for torpedo bottles

By Larry LEMASTERS

Torpedo bottles, a type of soda/mineral water bottle, are unusual in that they were not designed to stand upright. Instead, the rounded or pointed bases were designed to ensure that the bottle was laid on its soda bottles are actually side so that the wired down cork would not dry out and shrink. This kept the contents from losing carbonation evaporating.

Commonly referred to "Hamilton's" by English collectors (William F. Hamilton of Dublin, Ireland, was granted the first patent for them in 1809), torpedo bottles used to be referred to as "ballast bottles"

since many, if not most, torpedo bottles were imported from England as "ballast" (weight) in ships returning to the United States. Torpedo bottles are also known as "bombs" or "eggs" or "eggshaped" bу other collectors.

Although round bottom different than torpedo soda bottles (torpedo bottles look more like Greek amphorae), in discussions many (including this one) the namesinterchangeable.

Torpedo soda bottles were made of thick heavy glass (some bottles weigh as much as a pound) to withstand the carbonation pressures of soda and

Monday. Coinciding are hundreds of town yard sales that start as early as Thursday.

The main event at the JCSC brings as many as 750 vendors who set up across five acres, offering everything from hunting and fishing gear to antiques and even small animals. These days, as many as 35,000-55,000 guests arrive, which can mean quite a packed facility.

Part of the event's draw is that it remains rooted in its field sports and rural heritage. There are events like archery and BB gun tournaments and plenty of sellers with guns and other hunting equipment for sale. Given the modern era, some find the gun sales disconcerting. However, show officials emphasize that state laws for the sale of are strictly enforced. Turkey Federation. Others voice concern over pet and animal sales, although such

sales are common in rural communities.

Club officials are quick to share that Swappers Day is family-friendly. In an interview in the Columbus Dispatch, Sportsman Club trustee Mark Gavin asserted, "There's No alcohol, no pornography...this is a family event." The JCSC's community mindset carries over into their using proceeds from the event to help support local nonprofits. Past beneficiaries have included local veterans' organizations, food pantries, and national outdoor groups guns and ammunition like the National Wild

Johnstown for the townwide yard and garage sales. Area residents benefit from the show's draw by setting up sales in their yards, barns, and even at the town square. The village of Johnstown encourages things by foregoing yard sale permits for Labor Day and the days before.

However, things are changing. In September 2022, Intel broke ground on a microchip factory near Johnstown that will be one of the largest manufacturing facilities in the country and is expected to bring 3,000 workers to the rural community. State officials laud the economic benefits but area residents have more mixed feelings. Many lament the looming loss of the agricultural way of life that has defined the area for nearly two centuries.

There are already waves. The once sleepy farm town is now home to two coffee shops, several restaurants, and a handful of shops, including Antiques on Main and the multi-dealer Flea Market 24/7. Real estate prices have skyrocketed, roads are being widened, and cornfields are giving way to new housing developments. Still, the occasional John Deere can be spotted tooling down the road.

For the last couple of years, Swappers Day shoppers and vendors have felt the growing pains. The main road-

way, Route 62, used to be a peaceful ride, but now speeds and congestion can make it dangerous to stop for a sale. While the uptick in shoppers is positive, sellers say it can get overwhelming. One resident said, "I've been setting up on Thursdays for years. By 8 this morning, there were so many cars you couldn't get down the street!" His nearly 100 Longaberger baskets were snatched up in the fray. Another echoed much the same, "I was putting stuff out at 6 a.m. and had all kinds of people stopping."

Only time will tell what effects Intel's coming will ultimately have on the area. Meanwhile, traditions like Swappers Day will continue. Crowds and traffic withstanding, Swappers Day is still a fantastic activity for Labor Day weekend.

If you would like to attend next year, the official JCSC event is held at 7357 Sportsman Club Road in Johnstown. Admission is \$6 per day, with children 10 and under free. Parking is free and handicapped parking is available.







mineral water. Although true torpedo bottles could stand up, some rounded bottom soda bottles had a small flattened area in the middle of the base that allowed them to stand upright even though they wobbled.

Torpedo bottles had several manufacturing advantages over flatbottomed bottles. 1) Forcing the bottle to lie on its side kept the liquid in constant contact with the cork and thereby prevented leakage of air. 2) The shape allowed it to be much stronger than conventional bottles of equal weight, so torpedo bottles were less likely to crack under pressure. 3) Torpedo bottles were easier to pack in crates and safer to ship. And 4) Torpedo bottles were difficult to set down once opened, so you had to drink until you finished the contents. Customers were forced to drink faster, so they purchased more drinks.

Round bottom soda bottles were usually produced in a true twopiece mold where the neck, shoulder, body, and base were produced by the two halves of the mold, so these bottles are a rounded base version of the "hinge mold" that has a single mold seam that runs continuously from around the British Isles. one side of the body, around the base, and cities, expect Belfast,

then up the other side. Round bottom soda bottles were the last type of two-piece mold bottles manufactured after the 1870s.

Because early torpedo bottles were hand blown, look for imperfections and bubbles in the glass. Imperfect bottles reflect age, which may make the bottle more valuable.

A torpedo bottle's finish is also unique. The finish of a majority of the bottles is a thick heavy blob, which allowed for the wiring down of a cork closure. The blob finish was a ring of glass applied around the jagged top to give the opening added strength for when the cork was hammered home. The irregular crack often seen inside the blob top is the original jagged top (where the blowing rod was broken away). Other finishes to look for included a crown cap finish (post 1900) and a Codd's ball stopper finish; although, the Codd's finish is quite rare so the price of these bottles, if found, is expensive. Oil and mineral finishes can also be found, but they quite rare in comparison to the number oftorpedo bottles available for collection.

The majority of torpedo or round bottom soda bottles that were sold in the United States were imported from Great Britain. Most were embossed with company names and cities from If you look for different

Some collectors only collect torpedo bottles that were either made in the United States or made in Europe for U.S. bottlers. Many of these bottles were advertised in U.S. bottle makers catalogs during the early 20th century as "Round Bottom Ginger Ale" bottles. Two names to watch for are the Illinois Glass Company and Saegertown, Pa., Mineral Springs water bottles.

The Saegertown bottles are from the late 1800s.

It is difficult to know whether a bottle is of European or American manufacture. European bottle making techniques, during the 19th century, were a decade or two behind American techniques, which seems strange given that the Industrial Revolution began in Europe. But a bottle manufactured in Europe in the late 19th century or early 20th century could have been

manufactured in America as early the post Civil War years up to 1880 when round bottom bottles ceased manufacture in America.

Because America imported millions of these bottles, they can be found buried in historic sites around the United States and in garbage dumps from the era. Torpedo bottles of the same manufacture found in America are also found around the world, in British colonial countries such as Australian and even India, since British manufactured goods were exported everywhere. The greenish aqua color, prevalent in many torpedo bottles, is often seen bottles in manufactured in Britain; however, that color was not used exclusively in England, making the manufacturer's country difficult to trace.

While the majority of round bottom/torpedo soda bottles date from the 1870s to the 1910s, there are some American made torpedo bottles that date as early as 1840. These are exceptional bottles to add to a collection, but they are rare.

Just before the end of the torpedo bottle era, crown cap bottles became prevalent (1895 and onward). With a crown cap, bottles no longer had to be laid on their sides to keep corks wet, so torpedo bottles with crown caps were often displayed upright.

Machine-made examples of round bottom soda bottles were made from the early 1910s until about 1925 when torpedo bottles slipped into history.

From soap to cigarettes: Movie stars sold it all

The year was 1929. Makeup maven Max Factor had just signed its first batch of Hollywood stars to endorsement contracts for his blossoming line of beauty products.

With the blessing (and active nudging) of their studios, the performers would soon appear in print ads promoting Max's cosmetics. Not so coincidentally, those ads would also promote the studios' latest movie releases.

Over the years, Max Factor's movieland roster came to encompass a significant slice of Hollywood history. were There silent screen sirens Clara Bow and Pola Negri; legendary beauties Loretta Young, Elizabeth Taylor, and Lana Turner; and drama divas Bette Davis and Joan Crawford. Lucille Ball, who signed her first Max Factor contract in 1935, even insisted on the services of the salon's "Director of Beauty" for her divorce court appearance vs. Desi Arnaz.

Of course, the stars would need to be compensated. So what sounds fair? Millions? Thousands? Hundreds? GET IN THE SWING..

GO SWEPT WING!

Connect Convertible—In the lowest priced series of the Dodge line.

LAWRENCE WELK SAYS: "Folks, you don't know the fun you are missing until you 'go swept-wing' in a new '57 Dodge. It's just wonderfull and your Dodge dealer will make it easy for you to own a Swept-Wing Dodge. So see him soon. You will be glad you did."

Nope. The "Max Factor Girls," as they came to be known, each received annual compensation in the heady amount of — one dollar. And the ladies who contracted with Mr. Factor were happy to have it.

So why were the stars of Hollywood's Golden Age so acquiescent? Well, every evening on the silver screen, movies offered up plenty of faces for public consumption. Glamour photo magazine ads like Max Factor's made sure that

new faces had a chance to register with fans, while at the same time making sure that familiar faces weren't forgotten.

Other star-themed

ads also zeroed in on beauty products. The stars shone brightly for an entire cosmetics counter's worth of glamour goodies. Among the favorites: Woodbury Cold Cream & Powder (Dorothy Lamour, Veronica Lake, Gloria De Haven); Lux Soap (Judy Garland, June Allyson, Marlene Dietrich, Loretta Young); Lustre Crème (Ava Gardner), and Drene (Virginia Mayo). During the nylon-deprived World War II years, Barbara Stanwyck, on behalf of Armand Leg Make-Up, opined "it's patriotic to save your hosiery." (Barbara, noted the ad, was "now appearing in Lady of Burlesque," where those made-up legs were presumably displayed in all their glory.)

"Stars," as the term implies, existed in another realm. Keeping them secure on their pedestals—yet down-to-earth enough to believably hawk every-day products—had advertisers walking a continual tightrope. Here's a soapy (yet subtle) sampling, courtesy of Lux:

Loretta Young: "We women know how important day-to-day care is in order to look and keep looking our prettiest. It's 1 part beauty, and 9 parts beauty care. Lux really makes skin lovelier."

Marlene Dietrich: "Romance and lovely skin just seem to go together. It's romance—love—that any woman really wants. No wonder 9 out of 10 screen

stars use Lux."

June Allyson: "I'm a Lux girl. . .and Lux girls are lovelier."

Once advertisers saw how favorably consumers responded to movie stars hustling beauty products, the race was on, as other sponsors competed for Hollywood placement. Huffing and puffing their way to the top of the heap: those relics of another time, cigarette ads.

While beauty ads were often black-andwhite, cigarette advertising took a flashier approach: full-color back-cover promos in such general circulation publications as Look and Photoplay. The primary intent: persuading buyers just how inoffensive a particular brand could be. Most of the big names were lighting up for Chesterfield. Among them: Deborah Kerr, Richard Widmark, and, in a bizarre World War II Christmas ad, an army-helmeted Santa Claus. All the cast members of 1948's The Paradine Case, from ingénue Valli, to curmudgeoness Ethel Barrymore, were posed with Chesterfields in hand. Bing Crosby, pulling a new carton out of his desk drawer. noted, "There's no friend like an old friend—and that how I feel about Chesterfields."

The floodgates were now open wide. Jolene Shoes joined forces with bandleader/ cari-
