## ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

### Bids rolled out for beer steins at breweriana auction

SOMMERVILL, Ohio — Beer stein collectors had a special treat in mid-September. Ohio's Lunsford Auctioneers held the first installment in a series offering a single owner's lifetime col-

lection of beer steins and brewery collectibles.

The sale opened on Sept. 7 with online bidding. Then, on the Sept. 17, a live and simulcast auction was held. In this installment, 492 lots were offered, filled with German and other European steins, brewery

signs, and a large collection of tankards and beer glasses hailing from Cincinnati's brewing heritage.

One of the auction's more atypical pieces, snagging the overall auction high of \$350, was a 33-inch tall, hand-painted, and numbered German figurine of a gnome holding a sack. There was a tie among three lots for second place, at \$275. One was a 28-inch, circa 1894 German drinking horn with a silver-plated eagle top. It was immediately followed by a 9-inch, circa 1895 Armin Berkowitz (Hamilton, Ohio) liquor jug. Near the auction's conclusion came a box lot of beer advertising with an Old Hickory Ale sign, a Heidelberg wooden shoe, a beer stein painting, and a reverse-paint-

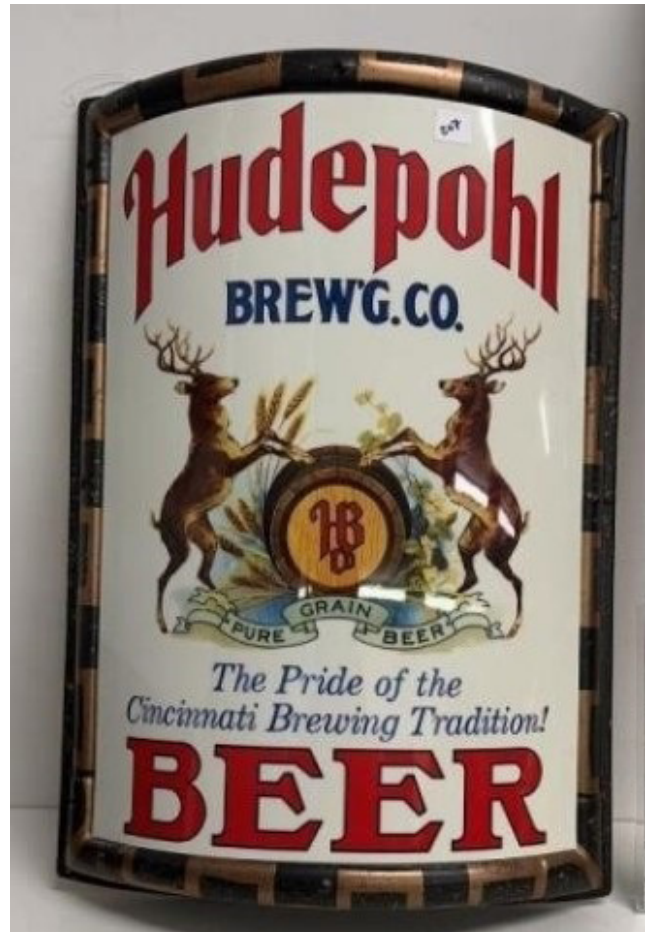
ed Heidelberg Terrace picture.

While not landing the auction's highest bids, the headliners were still the steins, with 16 racking up bids of at least \$100. More than half of the lots contained steins, tankards, or other decanters, many dating to the 19th century. Around ten percent were manufactured by common producers like Gerz and Thewalt. The remainder were from rarer makers like Albert Stahl and Frauenkirche, including two dozen that hailed from the famed stein-making region of Mettlach, Germany by

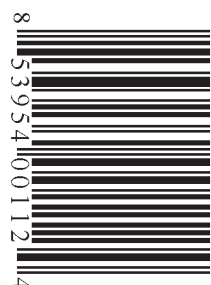

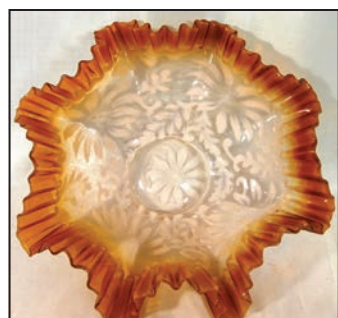

makers like Villeroy & Boch.

At the top, a robust \$225 was anteed for a circa 1899 “Remember the Maine” half-liter stein with a pewter lid. A 16-inch, circa 1885 Hauber & Reuther 3 ½-liter vessel painted by Von Eduard Grutzner sold for \$160 and a Mettlach Otto Hupp-designed 1-liter stein hit \$130.

Nearly a third of the steins and tankards got double-digit winning bids, like the \$80 tendered for a 6-inch 1890s Mettlach ½-liter cherub-embellished stein with a pewter and pottery lid. \$65 won an 1890s ½-liter hand-painted amber glass stein with a pewter lid, while \$50 took home an 1830s-era 10-inch 2-liter copper and brass tankard made in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Beer glasses also did

surprisingly well, with seven lots exceeding \$100. Taking the lead, at \$225, was a 1905 Cincinnati-made Bruckman’s Old Lager glass. Three lots later, a circa 1900 Cincinnati Brewing Company, Schwabs Pure Gold beer glass picked up \$180. Ten other beer glasses sold for tidy two-figure sums, like the \$60 bid that won a 5 1/2 Inch, 1889 Lion Brewery (Cincinnati,

Ohio) Windisch-Muhlhauser Beer embossed glass.

For collectors desiring something other than a drinking vessel, there were pieces like a 13-inch, circa 1886 high-relief Moser Bohemian covered amber glass jar, picked up for \$150. A 12-inch, circa 1900 hand-blown Biedermeier glass jug with Lowenbrau pewter lid reached \$80. Another \$80 grabbed a slightly damaged 1895 W. J. Smith (Lexington, Kentucky) 3-gallon liquor jug. Later, a 1920s Royal Doulton beer pitcher was snapped up for \$40.

In addition to containers, brewery advertising like signs, trays, and coasters was available. Two different signs snagged the category’s top figure of \$150. One was a 37-inch, 1960s Schoenling Lager Beer, “Cincinnati’s Finest Beer” lighted sign in working condition. The other was a 23-inch vintage Hudepohl Brewing Company, “The Pride of the Cincinnati Brewing Tradition” beveled sign. A half-dozen other signs were won with two-figure bids, including the \$70 that scored a 26-inch working lighted vintage Schlitz Malt Liquor sign designed like a stained-glass window.

Winning bids on non-sign advertising tended to fall below \$100. One exception was a circa 1890 Lion Brewing Company’s Windisch Muhlhauser export beer tray carried away for \$130. A 20-inch vintage Pabst Blue Ribbon thermometer came close at \$100. Bidding hit \$85 on a slightly dented 1905 Mathie Brewing Company (Los Angeles) bar tray. A box lot of 18 antique and vintage bottle and can openers pulled \$25.

Approximately half the lots sold for \$25 or less,

confirming that, while the rarest pieces may command impressive prices, steins, and other brewery-related collectibles remain very approachable. Among the budget-friendly lots were a circa 1940 Capodimonte HP porcelain-covered tankard won for \$20 and a set of six German Thewalt Hudepohl 14k-trimmed beer glasses scored for \$10.

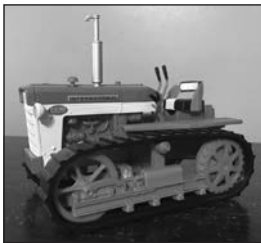

for a variety of tasks, the teacup and saucer-drying chore gave the towel its name—tea towel.

The earliest tea towels were made of linen because they would not scratch delicate china or crystal services. These towels also became canvases for beautiful art work, making them decorative as well as utilitarian. Women often embroidered or embellished in some way linen used for their tea service.

Although the terms “dish towel” and “tea towel” are often used interchangeably, there are minor differences in the two towels. Tea towels are crafted from linen or cotton and tend to be thinner than the average dishtowel. Dishtowels are often crafted from terry cloth and serve to dry all the dishes used in the kitchen rather than just expensive tea sets. Terry cloth is much more absorbent than linen, but as soft as terry cloth is, it tends to scratch delicate china cups.

Tea towels never lost their decorative flair, and when they crossed the sea to America, American housewives quickly began decorating their kitchens with tea towels that reflected the seasons. Christmas tea or dish towels grew to be the most used decorative kitchen towel, but Halloween tea towels best reflect the eerie season they symbolize, and the images attract the imaginations of the entire family, including children who are often

given the task of drying the dishes.

Tea towels as kitchen decorations hit their heyday in the last 30 years or so as manufacturing processes improved and towels, in general, became cheaper and more accessible to all families. The love of seasonal decoration has never ended. In fact, today people often use tea towels to gift wrap presents so the wrapping becomes as much a part of the gift as the gift itself, especially if the gift happens to be baked goods or cheeses. Tea towels, especially spooky Halloween towels often double as placemats or even napkins, adding both seasonal color and scary imagery to your table fare.

Tea towels have gained a new outlook on life as decorating with seasonal tea towels has become popular.

Today, collectors strive to not only collect but to decorate using seasonal tea towels. Halloween tea towels include images of ghosts, black cats, pumpkins, jack-o-lanterns, and witches. Witch imagery remains the strongest and most sought after Halloween imagery on any Halloween collectible, including tea towels.

# Tether cars are on track with racing collectors

In the 1940s, the sport of tether car racing was hot in the United States. At its peak there were an estimated 3,000 racers and 440 tracks across the country. Today, the small size of these vehicles makes them an interesting collecting field.

Tether car racing gets its name as each

car races while tethered to a pole. Each car races independently of one another with winners being determined by the highest average speed spread over several laps.

Tether cars are narrow and are comprised of parts similar to a full-size car, including a combustion engine, exhaust pipe, air intake, flywheel, gearbox, and

driveshaft, all enclosed inside the body of the racer. As a rule, racers are one to two feet in length and weigh in the range of two to six pounds. Racing is a serious business; in international competitions, five different engine classifications participate. The largest, the 10cc engine class, can propel the tether car to over 200 miles per hour. The two-cylinder engines provide exceptional speeds in these races. The cars' bodies consist of lightweight magnesium and aluminum.

At the height of their popularity in the 1940s, 25 manufacturers and several individual shops turned out tether cars. Beginning in 2015, electric motor-driven cars

that run on batteries, have also hit the market.

Maximum speed is the objective of building these cars. Some have

referred to these little dynamos as "bullets on wheels." According to the American Miniature Racing Car Association, with a top speed of 214

miles per hour, a tether car races well above the top speed of most

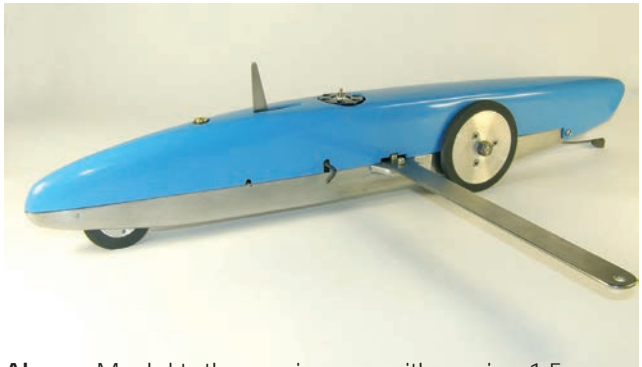

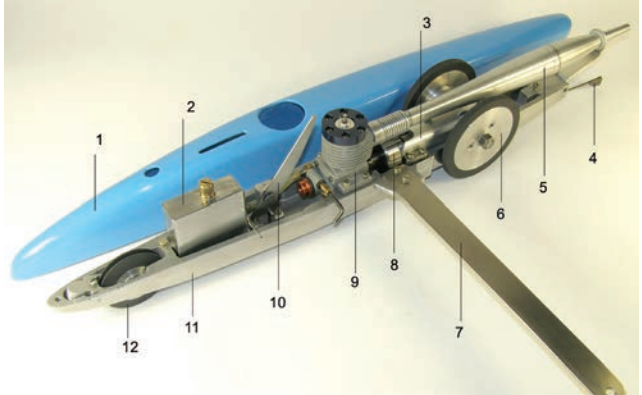

full-size cars. The draw of these speedsters is building them. Each tether car has a number of the same components found in a full-size automobile, but are much smaller. They can be easily worked on, as they come apart without a problem, allowing

the driver, the name given as the one who makes and operates the tether car, to fine-tune the cars to outperform others on the track, just as those race cars in the Indy 500. Racing these tether cars is taken seriously. A lot of prep time is put in prior to each heat. The Dooling Brothers are credited with pioneering the teth-

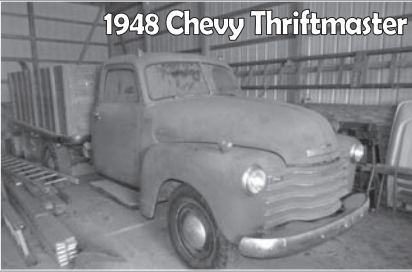
er-car phenomenon. The brothers initiated the use of model airplane engines for their model cars. During the late 1930s and early 1940s, the brothers built tether car engines and racers. With the onset of

World War II, scrap metal drives severely curtailed the hobby. And once the war was over, land development for new homes gobbled up many of the tracks. During the 1980s, the hobby was on the wane,

and by 2008 American Miniature Racing Car Association membership count was only 150; a far cry from the 3,000 from decades before. But at the same time, the hobby was still widespread in many

European countries and Australia. Original specimens of the early cars, made from the 1930s to the 1960s, are passionately collected today with prices fetching in the thousands of dollars.

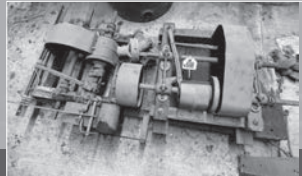
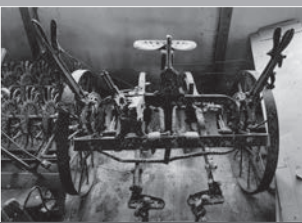

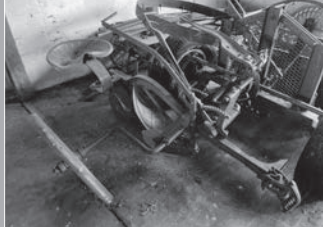

# Halloween Collectibles

Samhain, donning costumes and lighting bonfires to ward off ghosts. The early Romans honored the dead with an end-of-October celebration of a holiday called Feralia. And in the eighth century, Pope Gregory III designated November 1 as All Saints' Day, thereby making the night before All Hallows' Eve. And as European settlers came to America, they brought with them their holidays.

In the early days of the 20th century, typical Halloween celebrations included parlor games, many of which centered around fortunetelling and courtship. As American society shifted after World War II, Halloween increasingly became a time marked with a flurry of family-friendly activities, including carving pumpkins, trick-or-treating, and community parties. Homemade costumes, generic in nature, included witches and gypsies; little more than a white bed sheet was all that was needed to create a ghost or mummy disguise.

Gradually, Halloween became increasingly commercialized, as candy was manufactured, packaged, and marketed specifically for trick-or-treaters. Inspired by movies and television shows, costumes became more elaborate, as simple costumes made from materials found at home were

replaced by purchased outfits in the likeness of favorite licensed characters.

Today, Halloween merchandise is in stores well before October 31. And one can only wonder if Skelly, a 12-foot poseable skeleton that has leapt off the shelves of big box stores, will be the collectible of the 2070s and beyond.

Vintage Halloween collectibles

"In the antique holiday field, Halloween is the hardest to find," according to Laura Turner, a Halloween enthusiast and collector. Unlike Christmas decorations, which are traditional in nature and handed down from one generation to another, Halloween items are generally

disposable and made for one-time use, she pointed out. As proprietor of the Frizellburg Antique Store, she displays some favorites from her personal collection, including a Steiff black cat, three dolls (two witches and an early pumpkin-head store display), and a Dennison tissue paper scarecrow. To the dismay of customers, she added ruefully, each one bears the label "not for sale."

On the other hand, among early items she does offer for sale are Halloween postcards, which provide clues as to how the holiday was once celebrated. However, they are "among the most expensive of holiday postcards," pricier than many Christmas postcards and "clearly surpassing" those associated with Easter. Similarly, homemade costumes from the 1920s are "very sought after" and, at the same time, "really hard to find." Collectors generally display them rather than wear them, she added.

But all is (literally) not lost, as many of the seemingly most fragile of mid-century Halloween collectibles have survived. Thanks to the preponderance of holiday merchandise made in the 1950s and beyond, these mid-century items are relatively

easy (and less expensive) to collect. All of which is good news for nostalgic baby boomers who want to revisit the days of their childhood, as well as for those who merely appreciate a simpler celebration of Halloween, one not ghoulish but, in Turner's words, "all about fun."

Beginning collectors might consider starting with party-related items. Turner said that party goods, including napkins and noisemakers in their original packaging, can be purchased for less than \$25. Similarly, unopened packages of crepe paper tablecloths and streamers are affordable, as are paper Hallmark centerpieces, never used and once again for sale, albeit for more than their original price of \$1.50. With a somewhat larger budget, ceramic luncheon sets and Halloween-themed vintage tablecloths can be procured.

Perhaps there is no material more closely associated with mid-century America than plastic. And black and orange plastic candy containers, depicting witches and pumpkinheads, are desirable (note: beware of reproductions). Plastic flashlights and handled trick-or-treat pumpkins

that once held pennies, candy, and gum are also fun reminders of another time.

Old costumes transforming trick-or-treaters into witches and black cats, ghosts and scarecrows, and pumpkins and bats have survived the years, often with plastic face masks. And don't overlook Pez dispensers; look for ghosts, witches, and pumpkins, as well as a variety of those that depict monster heads.

And then there's paper, from paper pulp lanterns, which were not made to last a half century (but have), to jointed paper decorations, with seemingly fragile "honeycomb" parts. Even unused treat bags can still be found by diligent collectors.

Think outside the box and assemble a collection of Halloween-themed magazine covers. Norman Rockwell produced a number of iconic "Saturday Evening Post" illustrations in celebration of the holiday. But don't overlook other magazines, including "Calling All Girls," "McCall's" (with the paper doll, Betsy McCall), and even "Mad" magazine.

Collectors have their choice of a variety of Halloween-themed board games, including a Whit-

man fortunetelling game dating from 1934 to a series of games from the 1950s and beyond, ones that were inspired by Casper the Friendly Ghost. Dolls dressed for the holiday were offered by Madame Alexander, and, in 1997, the first of an annual series of Halloween Barbie dolls was introduced. Finally, don't overlook the possibility of collecting all things related to the Great Pumpkin. Introduced by Charles Schulz in his Peanuts comic strip dated October 26, 1959, it inspired the 1966 animated television special "It's the Great Pumpkin, Charlie Brown," as well as a bevy of licensed items.

Turner concluded that many collectors display their favorite Halloween-themed collectibles year-round, and indeed, her shop, formerly a general store in rural northern Maryland, has been a sea of orange and black for the past several weeks. But with the flip of the calendar page, it's time to "think Christmas": The Frizellburg Antique Store's annual Christmas Open House, set for November 18 and 19, is just around the corner.
