

and Thomas Nast, a poet and an advertising artist, both from New York, became the driving influences that pushed Santa to the exalted position he holds at Christmas time and to Coca-Cola wanting to The legend of Santa re-invent Santa for its own purposes.

Thomas Nast, often called the "Father of the American Cartoon," is credited with creating by handing out small the modern version of bags or gifts at Santa Claus. Nast mainly drew for Harper's Weekly magazine, and American thought became so great that President Teddv Roosevelt once said, "Thomas Nast was our best teacher." Nast's iconic depictions of Santa Claus are widely credited as forming the popular depictions of Santa used today; however, Nast's Santa, while outfitted in red,

was darker and far more psychologically complicated than the Santa Claus Coca-Cola would give to us a half century later.

The Coca-Cola website states, "While Coca-Cola did not create the legend of Santa Claus, Coca-Cola advertising played a big role in shaping the jolly character we know and love

today. Before 1931, there were many different depictions of Santa Claus around the world including a tall gaunt man and an elf, some even featured Santa Claus in a somewhat frightening manner. The friendly, warm and grandfather-like image we see of Santa today appeared 1931 when Coca-

commissioned illustrator Haddon Sundblom to paint Santa Clause for the company's Christmas advertisements.

Haddon "Sunny" Sundblom (1899-1976) was an American artist best known for the images of Santa Claus he created for The Coca-Cola



of \$4,100. A bright yellow 1960sprofessionally restored Bowser Super-Shell gas pump complete with milk glass globe and a 1990s Lens brass pump handle was taken away with a final bid of \$1,700. A completely different style of pump was also offered. This 1920s Wayne model 517 Standard Oil visible cylinder gas pump with glass chamber and white crown globe on top had some damage, as it was unrestored, but still looked impressive. It found a new home with a final bid of \$1,500. A brilliant orange and black Harley-Davidson Wayne 1940/50s gas pump in excellent, restored condition was

ready for a new owner with a final bid of \$1,300.

There were several


There were several eye-catching, unusual motorcycles to capture the imagination of those dreaming of the open road. While not quite ready for prime time, the leader of this pack was the 1960s Royal Enfield British Motorcycle. The orange gas tank bore the Royal Enfield shield, the frame was mostly intact, and the seat and tires were good. It was listed as needing restoration, but that didn't stop its fans from taking the final bid up to \$3,000. Next in line was the early 1970s BSA "Birmingham Small Arms" Company Lightning Motorcycle. The frame, lights, gas tank, and seat all appeared to be in good condition, but it was also offered for resto-

ration. It finished with a high bid of \$2,000. Others from the 1970s included a Yamaha 250 Torque Induction motorcycle for \$1,700, an unusual Hodaka Pabatco trail bike with an interesting company history that closed at \$1,600, and a blue Honda 350 motorcycle in good condition for \$1,200.

The attraction to vintage machines continued with a selection of snowmobiles. The top of the line here was the 1966 Arctic Cat 460D snowmobile complete with its original 29.1 ci 12 hp Kohler engine. This very special model is rare, as only 31 were produced, a fascinating piece of Arctic Cat history. This coveted prize was eagerly claimed with a high bid of \$3,200. With a tag that read "Created Expressly for Dean Smith", a 1970s Arctic Cat Panther Snowmobile with Rockwell engine, windshield, and many extras was listed as a great one to restore. It earned a final bid of \$1,700. A custom-built Polaris Indy Classic 500 snowmobile and a 1993 Polaris Indy Storm 800 were specially made for the owners of the estate and used as their personal snowmobiles for several years. They have recently been in storage and were in great condition. They left with final bids of \$450

and \$500. There were also other Arctic Cat, Wheelhorse Safari, and Sears snowmobiles to choose from.

For an impressive highlight in any man cave, there was an autographed guitar from the Millionaire Gallery (an art gallery in Florida that specializes in original art and authentic memorabilia) bearing the signatures of John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison, and Ringo Starr, along with a photograph from their 1964 debut performance on the Ed Sullivan show. Titled "The Fab Four", this framed set measured 49 inches by 25 inches. It commanded an impressive final bid of \$2,200.

Wall art is important for setting the right mood in the man cave. The 1950 "Drink Vernor's Ginger Ale, deliciously different" vertical 54 inch tall original metal advertising sign featuring the company's gnome provided a glimpse at Vernor's history. It was rehomed with a final bid of \$1,200. An impressive 5 foot long Budweiser neon sign in excellent working order was taken with a final bid of \$275. Keeping with the beer theme, a collectible 1stedition Budweiser lighted World Champion Clydesdale pulling a beer wagon. In great condition, this beer advertisement hanging light was taken with a high bid of \$450.

A completely restored Ideal Heater antique No. 421 cast iron potbelly stove standing 65 inches tall was ready for use and taken with a high bid of \$300. There is a certain appeal to a 1950s wood Bell System telephone booth. Complete with working light and fan and equipped with a 1985 3 slot payphone, it was ready for display for a final bid of \$190. Finally, one could settle into an early 1900s antique barber chair made by the



Company. Lou Prentice, a friend of Sundblom's, first sat as the model for Santa Claus.

Sundblom gave us an image of a friendly, warm hearted, grandfather-like Santa Claus. His first Santa Claus images graced Coke products in 1931, and while Sundblom drew inspiration from the 1822 poem by Clement Clark Moore, Sundblom's Santa Clause had rosy cheeks, a white beard. twinkling blue eyes, laughter lines, and a fluffy red suit, and he carried a huge brown bag full of toys for good little girls and boys.

Coca-Cola gave us a Santa Claus that warmed the heart of every child or adult that saw him, renewing America's belief in a commercialized Christmas while restoring our belief in happiness and humanity. Santa Claus proved the perfect image to promote Coca-Cola as America's soft drink.

Sundblom wasn't the first artist Coke hired to illustrate Santa. In 1930, Coca-Cola hired


Fred Mizen to paint a department store Santa Claus that was set up in the department store Famous Barr Co. in St. Louis. Coca-Cola used Mizen's Santa in print advertising Christmas 1930.

In 1931, Coca-Cola wanted an advertising campaign that would show Santa as both realistic and symbolic. Coca-Cola wanted their Santa to both increase revenue during $_{
m the}$ Great Depression and to help lift the soul of America out of the tormented life the Depression had brought. Santa's great gift that year was smiles that warmed the heart of very poor and needy Americans striving to simply live in difficult times. Coca-Cola's Santa Claus was an instant success.

Coca-Cola collecting culture has sprung up around the world. Prices for some Coca-Cola collectible products escalate each year. Often the most valuable Coca-Cola collectibles involve ones of Santa Claus based on Sundblom's art.

Sundblom's cheeked and cheerful Santa in a red suit will once again fill homes and collections this Christmas Season, again reminding us of Francis Church's famous New York Sun editorial to Virginia O'Hanlon on September 21, 1897:

"Yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus! Thank God! He lives, and he lives forever. A thousand years from now, Virginia, nay, ten times ten thousand years from now, he will continue to make glad the heart of



George Lesmer, Chester, Vermont" and back incised "Fairchild family Old Brookville".

Jeffers said, Wheeler chest came from John Boulware. John is awesome. His shop was a standout there for decades; he was THE place to go for Americana in Denver, and arguably all of Colorado. He had identified the correlation between his chest and one featured in an exhibition at The Shelburne Museum. They are unmistakably the same hand. It is a neat thing - but again, price was held back (I think) by two factors: size, because it is pretty bulky; and the esoteric nature of such a regional piece."

Decorative arts also sold strong at the Friday session. An English, 8 inch high, mocha pitcher having a barrel shape with multicolored banding and cat's eye and earthworm decoration soared to \$3,480.

Two blown glass jars; one olive green with a flared lip and broken pontil, 7 ½ inches tall; and the other being an amber jar with a folded rim and iron pontil at 9

inches tall sold together for \$2,000.

Leading the lovely stoneware presented for bids was the incised "W. ROBERTS BINGHAM-TON. N.Y." 17 ½ inch tall decorated stoneware jug which made \$2,160. The four-gallon, 19th century jug wore a freehand cobalt crested bird and vining flowers.

And a Darke Coun-

ty, Ohio, long rifle; approximately .36 cal; 54 inch long, by Daniel Marker Sr. (Kentucky/Ohio, 1774-1853) with a carved tiger maple full stock, engraved silver inlays and a patch box engraved with a Native American's profile was bid to \$4,062.50.

"The patch box on this was so spectacular," Jeffers noted.

Leading the two day event was no shocker. During the second day of this auction, a gouache on paper by Alexander Calder (1898-1976), titled Homage to Miro signed at lower right was estimated to bring between \$40,000 and \$60,000 sold for \$72,000. The gouache had been purchased by the consignor; a central Ohio couple, in 1989 from Pace Galleries.

"I love that Pace Gallery connection to Columbus, and when I was at Garth's, I had a long standing connection to the leadership of Pace. It is just such a small world," Jeffers

explains, adding, "I was grateful and proud the consignor went with me - though she had been pitched by several gallerists and a New York auction house."

Other fine art and decorative arts highlights (and there were many) during Day Two of this sale included, a platinum and yellow gold engagement ring by Argo & Lehne Jewelers which boasted an oval cut diamond weighing 3.01 ct. 


