### 1930s clock face gas pump dispensed a bid of \$4,100

HALE, Mich. — A man cave is defined by the Oxford Dictionary as “a room or other part of a home used by a man as a place to relax and pursue hobbies away from the rest of the family.” The

recent auction conducted by Freeland Auction Services was appropriately termed a Man Cave Memorabilia Estate with 294 desirable lots available for use or decorating in that environment. There were also multiple vintage motorcycles, gas

pumps, and snowmobiles for fun outside the cave. Prices listed here do not include the buyers' premium.

A very hard to find 1930s Erie Model 10 clock face gas pump led the auction. This interesting relic featured a clock-face style meter on the front with a hand that moved in a circular motion to show the number of gallons pumped. It was topped by a 1950s Osceola Premium globe with some damage, but the uniqueness of the gas pump drove bids to a final value

### Coca-Cola helped give us our modern image of Santa

While Coca-Cola certainly did not invent Santa Claus, the soft drink firm had a lot to do with how we view Santa today.

The legend of Santa Claus began hundreds of years ago when a monk, named St. Nicholas, became the patron saint of children by handing out small bags or gifts at Christmas.

Over the years the legends of Saint Nicholas morphed into the legends of Santa Claus, who is also known as Kris Kringle. It was not until the 18th century that Santa Claus became world famous. Clement Clark Moore

and Thomas Nast, a poet and an advertising artist, both from New York, became the driving influences that pushed Santa to the exalted position he holds at Christmas time and to Coca-Cola wanting to re-invent Santa for its own purposes.

Thomas Nast, often called the “Father of the American Cartoon,” is credited with creating the modern version of Santa Claus. Nast mainly drew for Harper's Weekly magazine, and his influence on American thought became so great that President Teddy Roosevelt once said, “Thomas Nast was our best teacher.” Nast's iconic depictions of Santa Claus are widely credited as forming the popular depictions of Santa used today; however, Nast's Santa, while outfitted in red,

was darker and far more psychologically complicated than the Santa Claus Coca-Cola would give to us a half century later.

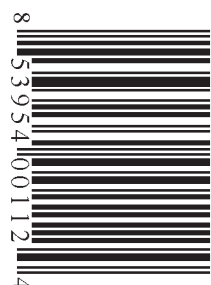
The Coca-Cola website states, “While Coca-Cola did not create the legend of Santa Claus, Coca-Cola advertising played a big role in shaping the jolly character we know and love

today. Before 1931, there were many different depictions of Santa Claus around the world including a tall gaunt man and an elf, some even featured Santa Claus in a somewhat frightening manner. The friendly, warm and grandfather-like image we see of Santa today first appeared in 1931 when Coca-

Cola commissioned illustrator Haddon Sundblom to paint Santa Clause for the company's Christmas advertisements.”

Haddon “Sunny” Sundblom (1899-1976) was an American artist best known for the images of Santa Claus he created for The Coca-Cola

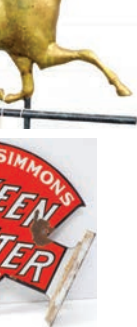

of \$4,100. A bright yellow 1960s professionally restored Bowser Super-Shell gas pump complete with milk glass globe and a 1990s Lens brass pump handle was taken away with a final bid of \$1,700. A completely different style of pump was also offered. This 1920s Wayne model 517 Standard Oil visible cylinder gas pump with glass chamber and white crown globe on top had some damage, as it was unrestored, but still looked impressive. It found a new home with a final bid of \$1,500. A brilliant orange and black Harley-Davidson Wayne 1940/50s gas pump in excellent, restored condition was

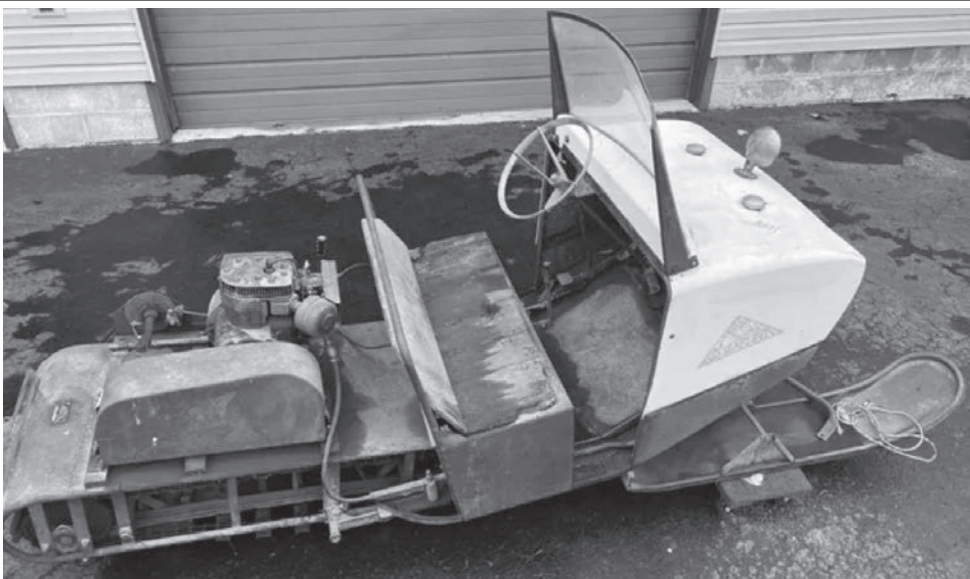
ready for a new owner with a final bid of \$1,300. There were several eye-catching, unusual motorcycles to capture the imagination of those dreaming of the open road. While not quite ready for prime time, the leader of this pack was the 1960s Royal Enfield British Motorcycle. The orange gas tank bore the Royal Enfield shield, the frame was mostly intact, and the seat and tires were good. It was listed as needing restoration, but that didn't stop its fans from taking the final bid up to \$3,000. Next in line was the early 1970s BSA "Birmingham Small Arms" Company Lightning Motorcycle. The frame, lights, gas tank, and seat all appeared to be in good condition, but it was also offered for resto-

ration. It finished with a high bid of \$2,000. Others from the 1970s included a Yamaha 250 Torque Induction motorcycle for \$1,700, an unusual Hodaka Pabatco trail bike with an interesting company history that closed at \$1,600, and a blue Honda 350 motorcycle in good condition for \$1,200.

The attraction to vintage machines continued with a selection of snowmobiles. The top of the line here was the 1966 Arctic Cat 460D snowmobile complete with its original 29.1 ci 12 hp Kohler engine. This very special model is rare, as only 31 were produced, a fascinating piece of Arctic Cat history. This coveted prize was eagerly claimed with a high bid of \$3,200. With a tag that read "Created Expressly for Dean Smith", a 1970s Arctic Cat Panther Snowmobile with Rockwell engine, windshield, and many extras was listed as a great one to restore. It earned a final bid of \$1,700. A custom-built Polaris Indy Classic 500 snowmobile and a 1993 Polaris Indy Storm 800 were specially made for the owners of the estate and used as their personal snowmobiles for several years. They have recently been in storage and were in great condition. They left with final bids of \$450

and \$500. There were also other Arctic Cat, Wheelhorse Safari, and Sears snowmobiles to choose from.

For an impressive highlight in any man cave, there was an autographed guitar from the Millionaire Gallery (an art gallery in Florida that specializes in original art and authentic memorabilia) bearing the signatures of John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison, and Ringo Starr, along with a photograph from their 1964 debut performance on the Ed Sullivan show. Titled "The Fab Four", this framed set measured 49 inches by 25 inches. It commanded an impressive final bid of \$2,200.

Wall art is important for setting the right mood in the man cave. The 1950 "Drink Vernor's Ginger Ale, deliciously different" vertical 54 inch tall original metal advertising sign featuring the company's gnome provided a glimpse at Vernor's history. It was rehomed with a final bid of \$1,200. An impressive 5 foot long Budweiser neon sign in excellent working order was taken with a final bid of \$275. Keeping with the beer theme, a collectible 1st edition Budweiser lighted World Champion Clydesdale Carousel featured a detailed team of horses

pulling a beer wagon. In great condition, this beer advertisement hanging light was taken with a high bid of \$450.

A completely restored Ideal Heater antique No. 421 cast iron potbelly stove standing 65 inches tall was ready for use and taken with a high bid of \$300. There is a certain appeal to a 1950s wood Bell System telephone booth. Complete with working light and fan and equipped with a 1985 3 slot payphone, it was ready for display for a final bid of \$190. Finally, one could settle into an early 1900s antique barber chair made by the

Emil J. Paidar Company with all its original porcelain and leather for a final bid of \$170.

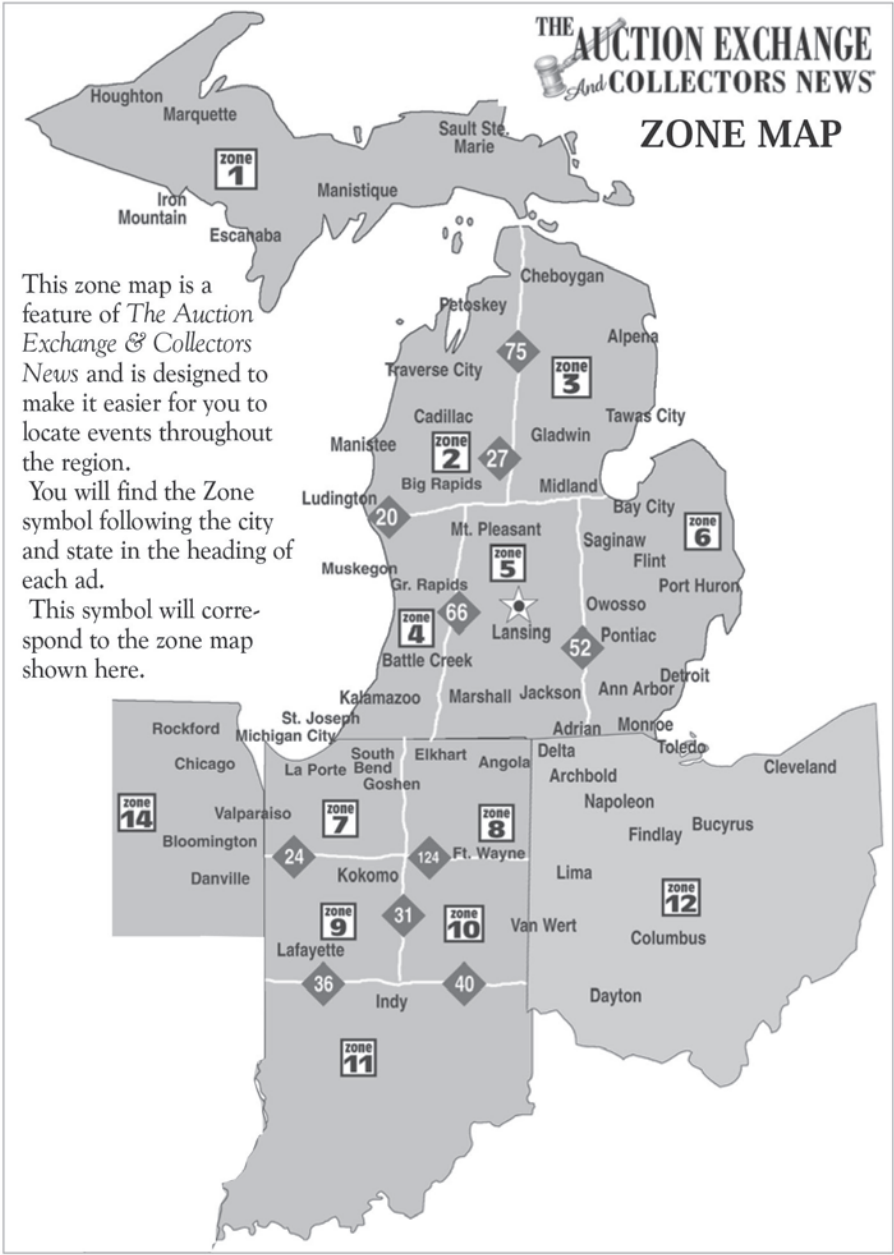

# Alexander Calder work hits \$72,000 at Amelia Jeffers return to Garth's Barn

DELAWARE, Ohio — Auctioneer, Realtor, and publisher, Amelia Jeffers, could not contain her joy Friday, Nov. 24; when she found herself behind the podium once again, conducting the annual Thanksgiving Weekend auction at the former "Garth's Barn" in Delaware, Ohio. A beloved tradition for antique enthusiasts nationwide for more than 60 years this is the event that has always been synonymous with the kick-off of the holiday season for collectors in love with antique decorative arts and Americana.

What a wonderful homecoming! With a sell through rate of 91 percent; a sale total coming in just over \$450,000 and having

more than 100 buyers in attendance, and 2,200 registered bidders overall there were a plethora of happy people during this two-day affair.

Not surprising, a great deal of interest was seen for any piece wearing wonderful paint. A two-piece, pine, possibly York County, Pennsylvania, corner cupboard dressed in its original exuberant paint - red, green, and yellow on the exterior; salmon interior; sold for \$7,200 despite needing a big corner as it was quite broad. Prices include a buyer's premium.

Surprising – a great deal of "brown" furniture also generated strong sales with the Sheraton chest of drawers attributed to Ebenezer Wheel-

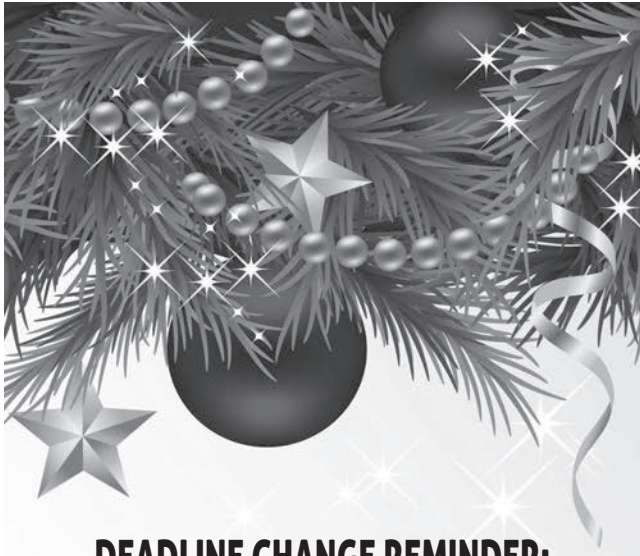
