Lambert Hitchcock automated chair production

Historically speaking, Henry Ford's greatest invention was not the Model T car; his real invention was the assembly line that built the car. However,



nearly 93 years before Henry Ford incorporated the assembly line into the production of Model T Ford automobiles, Lambert Hitchcock, a Connecticut cabinet-maker, saw the wisdom in mass-producing parts and using an assembly line for production of chairs.

Hitchcock, who was a student of the Industrial Revolution, decided to revolutionize the production of chairs. Instead of making one chair at a time Hitchcock wanted to use standardized patterns and parts to

mass-produce chairs, making him a man ahead of his times.

At its heyday (the 1820s and '30s), The Hitchcock Chair Company employed 100

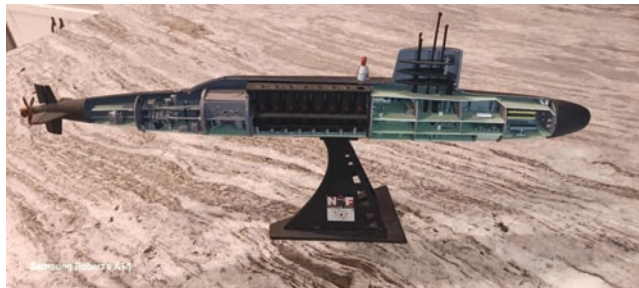

Submarine collectors dive to all depths for models

In 1963 when the USS Thresher, the United States first nuclear submarine, sank, I was just a little boy. Sixty odd years later, I still remember the prayers said for the sailors, the cold-war fears, and the quest for the ocean's deepest secrets that America searched for. On April 10, 1963, the Thresher imploded below crush depth, and all 129 men on board died.

Humans have always had a fascination with the ocean, fueled in no small part by the publication of Jules Verne's "Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Seas," which was originally serialized in 1869. Verne showed the world the dark and mysterious sea with all of its known and unknown life forms and death traps. The true star of the book is the Nautilus, Captain Nemo's famous submarine. Few people had even heard of

a submarine before Verne wrote his tale, and most people became enchanted with the sea after reading the novel.

Verne, however, did not invent submarines. In fact, he modeled his Nautilus, including the submarine's name, after one of the world's earliest built submarines — the Nautilus built by Robert Fulton in 1800.

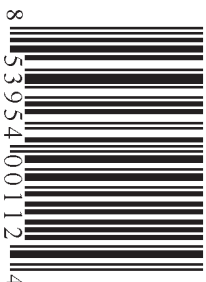
Cornelius Drebbel built the first known submarine in 1620. Drebbel used a leather-covered wooden frame to build a submarine that carried 16 passengers and, using six oars, could remain underwater for three hours, cruising at a depth of 15 feet.

Brutus Villeroi was inventor and builder of an 1832 submarine that he also named the Nautilus after the deep-

people and produced up to 300 chairs a week, using an assembly line, averaging nearly 15,000 chairs a year for many years. This was a truly remarkable feat for the times.

Hitchcock's use of an assembly line was greatly influenced by Eli Terry, the legendary clock maker, who designed cheap wooden clock works to replace expensive brass works inside of clocks. According to Fred Taylor author of "The Real Hitchcock Chair: How to Tell Originals from Reproductions," "Terry devised an assembly line process of cutting and assembling the various parts. Hitchcock wanted to do the same for chairs."

Each chair was a mixture of wood. Hitchcock often employed poplar, birch, maple, and oak — sometimes all in one chair. The types of wood were unimportant since Hitchcock painted each chair black or a brownish black, which he thought imitated ebony wood.

At a time when most chairs were stained, Hitchcock's use of paint allowed for the interchangeable parts and different woods that truly made his chairs mass-produced.

Many hand-made chairs of the early 1800s were decorated along the back with beautifully carved designs. Instead of carvings (which cost both time and money in the manufacturing process, thus raising the overall price of the chair), Hitchcock deco-

rated each chair with elaborate stenciling of flowers, baskets of fruit, or leaves on the back and sides. Using bright, metallic paints (often gold, red, and white), and a bronzing finish coat, Hitchcock's chairs had a fresh, bright look about them that appealed to consumers.

Other notable characteristics of Hitchcock chairs included square seats made of cane or rush, footless legs on most chairs with ball feet on higher-end chairs, rear legs rising to form the chair stiles, and turned front legs (ringed or beaded) with gold pin striping on them.

When new, Hitchcock chairs sold for 50 cents up to \$1.50 per chair. Today, on the secondary market, Hitchcock chairs in good condition bring \$300 each with chairs possessing unusual stenciling selling at higher rates. In December, a set of four Hitchcock Chair Ltd. "Bicentennial Presidents" chairs were offered on eBay for \$3,800.

Nearly all of

Hitchcock's chairs, after 1815, had a stencil signature on them. Chairs made from 1823-43 were stenciled: "L. Hitchcock Hitchcocks-ville. Conn. Warranted." And chairs from 1832-43 were stenciled: "Hitchcock, Alford & Co. Hitchcocks-ville, Conn. Warranted." And from 1843-52: "L. Hitchcock. Unionville, Conn. Warranted." Adding to the confusion of signatures, some of the chairs produced between 1832 and 1843 had the two "n"s in "Conn." printed backwards.

Hitchcock died in 1852 and his chair factory quickly fell into disuse. In 1946 John Tarrant Kenney formed the new Hitchcock Chair Company, taking over the site of the old Hitchcock factory. The new company's mission was to reproduce original Hitchcock chairs, but lack of sales forced the new company to close in 2006.

These reproduction chairs used Hitchcock's original stenciled signature: "L. Hitchcock

Hitchcocks-ville, Conn. Warranted." However, along with backward "n"s, the new company added a trademark symbol, which was not on the original chairs.

Decorators today like to work with Hitchcock chairs, especially when trying to achieve an "early American" look or design. In many ways, the Hitchcock chair is timeless since it incorporates ideas from Empire chairs and Baltimore chairs

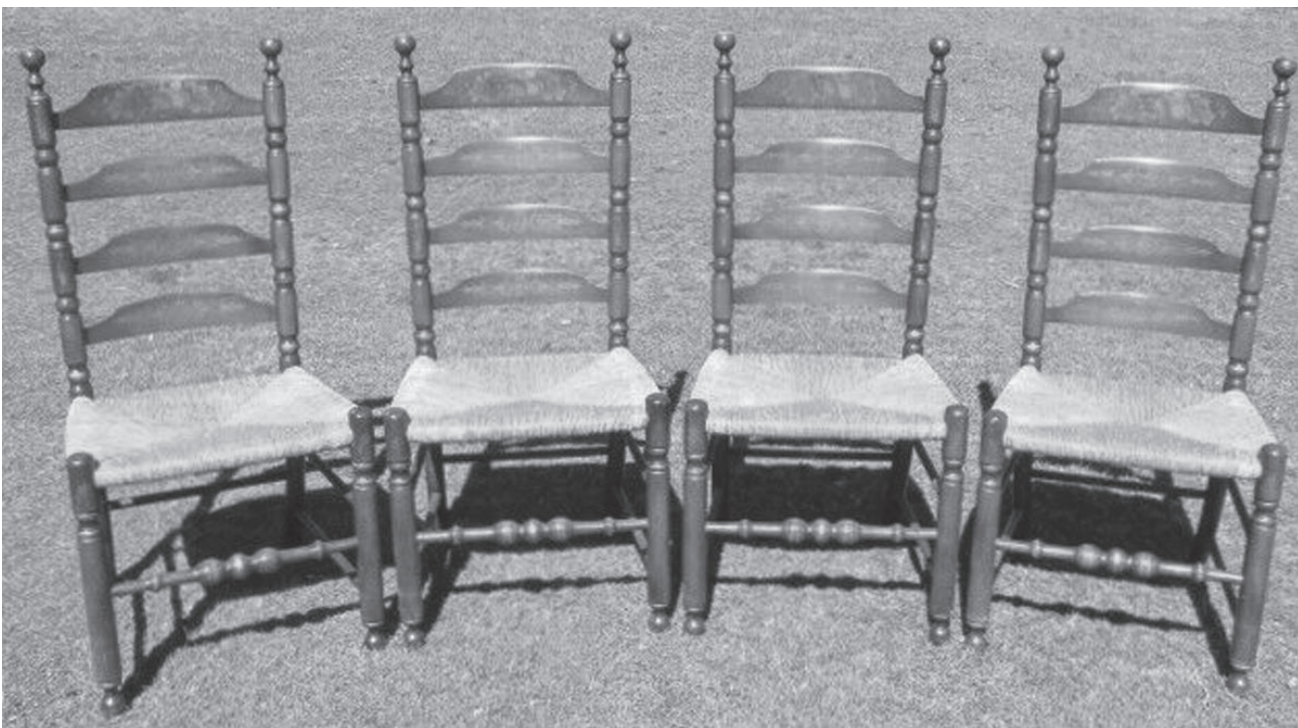
while deviating only slightly from the famous Sheraton chairs of the early 1800s.

If you are looking to invest in authentic Hitchcock chairs, study the signatures carefully. While the 1952 reproductions are also collectible, they are but a shadow of the original L. Hitchcock chairs.

sea creature. This early Nautilus was nicknamed "fish boat," and could cruise at a depth of 20 feet.

In 1861, Villeroy built a submarine, called the USS Alligator, for the United States Navy. The Alligator was 47 feet long and made of iron. She was the first operational submarine to have an air purifying system. On April 2, 1863, the USS Alligator floundered in stormy weather off of Cape Hatteras, forcing Rear Admiral Samuel Francis du Pont to set the Alligator adrift. She immediately sank into the silent and froth-filled sea.

In 1864, near the end of the Civil War, the Confederate navy's H. L. Hunley became the first military submarine to sink an enemy vessel, the Union sloop of war USS Housatonic, using a gun-powder keg as a torpedo charge. However, this historic event also sank the CSS Hunley as the explosion's shock

waves killed the Hunley's crew instantly.

April 11 is National Submarine Day, and this special day celebrates the purchase of the USS Holland, the first modern commissioned submarine. On April 11, 1900, the United States Navy purchased the Holland VI for \$150,000. Irish-American inventor John Phillip Holland designed the Holland, which had dual propulsion systems, a fixed longitudinal center of gravity, separate main and auxiliary ballast systems, a hydrodynamic advanced shape, and a modern weapon system. It marked an important breakthrough for the US Navy.

Today people are drawn to the sea and life as a submariner through scale model submarine collections. A scale model is a replica of a real-life object, in this case a submarine. A true replica of a submarine is designed and made to scale, and it appears in every way like a miniature of the original submarine.

Most modelers know that plastic submarine

(also known as "ship") model kits are cheaper than metal kits, but plastic lacks the fine detail of metal. Metal kits have far more parts, which provide beautiful detailing but sometimes confuse the modeler putting the kit together. The alternative to submarine kits is to buy ready-made models that

come preassembled. Most submarine models, kit or preassembled, need painted in order to bring out the realism of a full-size submarine.

Submarine models may replicate actual warships, or the kits may simply use a generic form of a submarine. Many models show no interior views of the

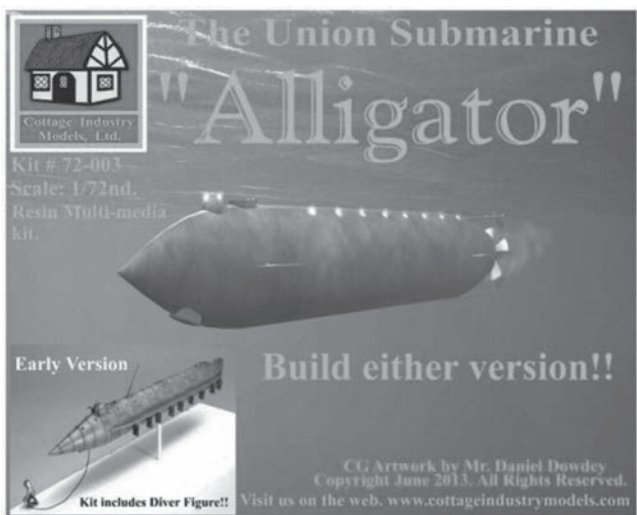
submarine, so they lack interior deck levels and other submarine features. However, in the last 60 years, submarine modeling has grown in popularity as modelers have begun to create and scratch build their own models. Toy modeling companies have also begun producing more realistic ship models,

using die cast metal fittings and accurate appearing decals. Many modelers prefer these new die cast models to the problems and frustration of scratch building.

Many submarine collectors spend hours at their workbenches, recreating the perfect ship to replicate the lonely sea and sky.

Vintage calendars have collectors turning pages

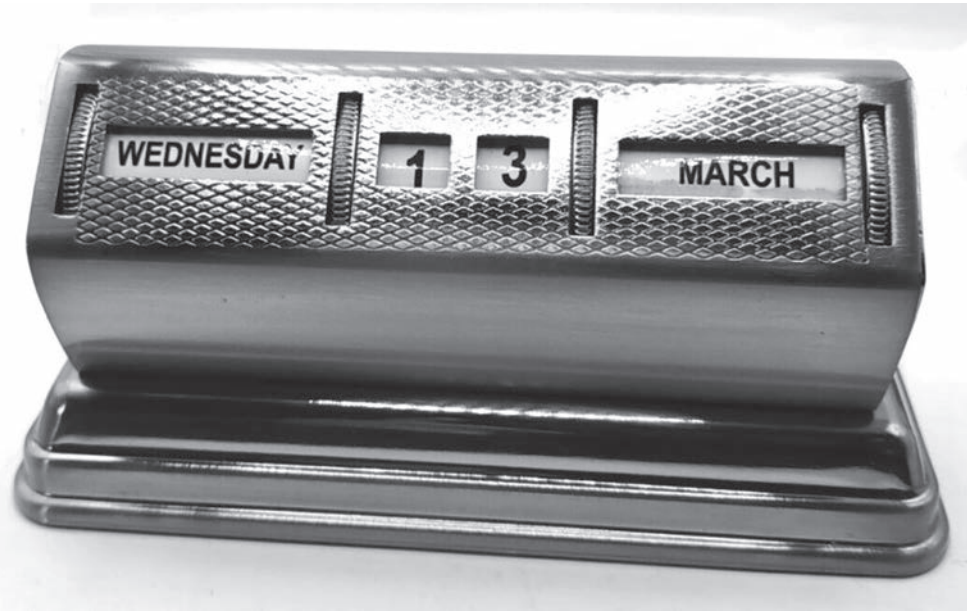
Just a few short weeks ago it was the first of January. With the flipping of the calendar came the promise of a new year. Holidays in February and March came and went. Now, tax time looms, necessitating a reminder in our schedules. Keeping track of all those holidays, appointments, and other milestones, underscores the importance of calendars in our lives.

For most of us, calendar apps are now our preferred scheduling tools. Wall and desk calendars, once a common sight in homes and businesses, are becoming something of a relic. Yet, physical calendars somehow hang on.

Calendars have existed in one form or another for thousands of years. Ancient civilizations from the Mayans to the Egyptians had some form of calendar. Archeological evidence suggests that



numerous prehistoric Stonehenge, may have structures, including been used to mark astro-

nomical cycles. In 45 BC, the Romans adopted a dating system now referred to as the Julian calendar, named for Julius Caesar. It consisted of 12 named

months, each with either 30 or 31 days. Calendar advancements by the Greeks, Jews, and Romans led to the seven-day week, with days named similarly to those in use today. The modern Western calendar, also known as the Gregorian calendar, named after Pope Gregory XIII, came into use around 1600. It corrected astronomical imprecision in earlier versions.

Before the 1600s, existing calendars were often circular diagrams, forming a kind of perpetual calendar that portrayed lunar cycles. The adoption of the Gregorian calendar, combined with the development of early printing presses, gave rise to today's grid-like format, which could be easily printed.

American publisher Robert Aitken is credited with inventing the first daily planner in the late 1700s. It was a blank pre-set grid, similar to modern planner pages. For the first time, people could see their months/weeks/days laid out, and mark reminders for important events.

Advances in printing during the Industrial Revolution led to printing on a mass scale. One of the early products printing companies offered was functional calendars. At first, calendars were spartan; over time, printers started adding decorative elements and eventually included illustrations.

Advances in printing technology also created new ways for businesses to advertise, including cre-

ating calendars with their business names affixed. A free calendar given to a customer would hang in a home or business for an entire year, providing long-term promotion.

The more attractive the calendar, the more impactful it would be. It wasn't long before entities from banks to retailers were competing to stand out with the calendars they gave away each year.

One of the most notable companies to use calendars as advertising was Coca-Cola, which issued its first promotional calendar in 1891. Making good use of that era's printing technology, the piece, featuring a young woman drinking a Coke, was done in full-color lithography.

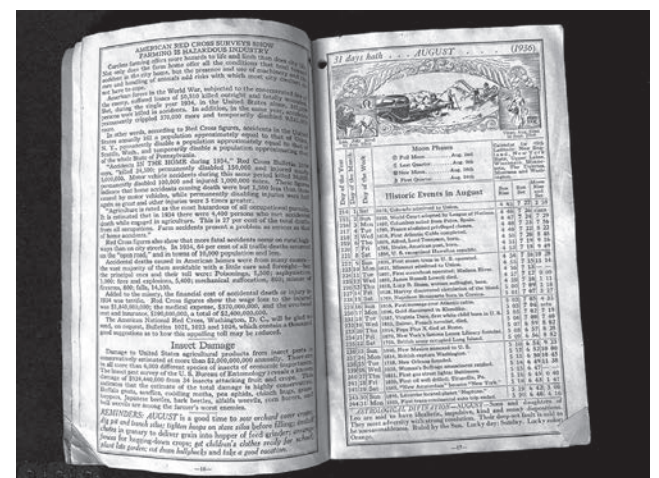
In the 1940s and 50s, pinup calendars became popular, particularly for male-dominated businesses like gas stations and garages. Those illustrated by famed glamor artists George Petty and Alberto Vargas are particularly popular today.

Although illustration remained popular, calendar art started migrating toward photography in the 1950s. At least one company, Christian Studios Freshour Family, developed a process to transfer a portrait or family picture as the background image on a calendar.

At first, the predominant type of consumer calendar was the wall calendar. They came in two varieties: one had small

imprints of each of the twelve months; the other featured either tear-off monthly pages or pages that could flip up. The latter usually had blank spaces for each day for writing notes. Wall calendars are the most popular collectible variety.

Eventually, smaller versions of printed calendars were developed, designed to sit on a desk. Many were die-cut into various shapes that, like roadside advertising signs, added novelty and helped advertisers to stand out. By the 1980s, desktop calendars began transitioning from the monthly variety to thick pads of daily pages, each often inscribed with an illustration or slogan.

Mechanical desktop calendars and perpetual calendars became popular in the 1960s. Those came in many forms. Some used disks or dials that could be turned to select the year, month, and day. Others used a set of blocks with the month names and numbers for each day imprinted on the sides. In the 1980s, a perpetual

wall calendar emerged, with 31 numbered tiles that could be slid onto rails to form the month.

Calendars also came in a variety of specialty forms. One of the first was the almanac, which first appeared around 1500 and is still printed today. Almanacs went beyond simply providing dates, to serving as mini-encyclopedias filled with useful information like astronomical charts, tide tables, and measurement conversions.

Advent calendars,

which are used to count the 24 days of Advent, are also long-standing. They are German in origin, first appearing around 1900. By the 1920s they began to sport small doors that originally held Bible verses, then eventually candy.

In the first few decades of the 20th century, calendar plates were popular. Calendar towels replaced them in popularity in the 1950s. While both were usually treated as keepsakes, they nonetheless offered utility beyond simply presenting dates.

In the go-go 1980s, executives and salespeople started spending big money on refillable proprietary time management systems like Daytimers and Franklin Planners. These were housed in often elegant ring binders that could be refilled each year. Each company touted its system's advantages rife with pages not only for scheduling, but ones for managing contacts and projects, and even those filled with motivational material.

Whether it's a circa

1900 wall calendar or a 1980s Day-at-a-Glance desktop example, part of the appeal of old calendars, is that surviving specimens actually exist. Calendars are not expected to last. They are expected to be written on, their pages torn off, and at the end of the year, get tossed out. A calendar that has survived the years is a piece of history one can hold.

That so many calendars survive is also a testament to the beautiful imagery they contain. Even today, those by companies like Lang contain artwork that is often repurposed and framed. For vintage calendars, artwork by important illustrators of their day — like Currier and Ives or Norman Rockwell — has natural appeal.

A calendar's subject matter is tied to illustration. Calendars featuring celebrities or prized things like cars or pets have their audiences, and those from long-lost hometown businesses strike a nostalgic note.

Pricewise, calendar collecting is a very approachable hobby. Many antique and vintage calendars can be purchased for \$5-\$50. Rare and exceptional-quality examples can naturally command much more. Original pre-1930s Coca-Cola calendars, for

example, can sell for hundreds and sometimes thousands of dollars. One very rare 1900 Coca-Cola calendar sold at Morphy's for \$210,000. Recently, a 1912 Winchester ammunition calendar sold on eBay for nearly \$3,000. Unfortunately, with prices like that, counterfeits do exist. Thus, if you are after rare examples, with commensurate prices, it's best to purchase from a reputable dealer who vets their merchandise.

Although condition may be a deciding factor at the higher end, it's not necessarily the driver for many pieces. Collectors recognize that calendars were meant to be used, and that's how they'll find them. In fact, many collectors appreciate the handwritten notes left by generations past. Still, most buyers will shy away from a badly torn, creased, or stained piece, no matter how inexpensive.

Even though much of the world now relies on digital devices for scheduling, physical calendars have shown remarkable resilience. Wall calendars are still sold each year and promotional calendars are still given out by businesses. In fact, calendars are still ranked among the top three promotional products. So, while today's collectors chase examples from decades past, new issues ensure that collectible calendars will exist for years to come!

If you would like to investigate this fascinating hobby, there are a few good resources. One of the better books is "Memorable Advertising Calendars Through the Ages" by Halpin O'Reilly. And, the Ephemera Society of America (www.ephemera-society.org) regularly dives into the calendar topic.
