The top selling lot of the day was the 14-foot Starcraft aluminum utility boat, just in time for fishing season. It came with a 15hp Evinrude outboard motor, TrailMaster custom trailer, two padded seats, oars, and gas tank. The motor had a

new pump water installed in this year. This complete set up was claimed with a final bid of \$1,800. A separate Mercury Marine 9.8hp outboard motor with Thunderbolt ignition and a gas can left for \$243.

Coins and currency proved popular in this

sale, as some unusual items were offered. First, the 1915 Austria 4 Ducat gold coin, featuring the bust of King Franz Joseph on one side and the arms of Austria on the double-headed Imperial Eagle on the reverse. It was rated as 13.9636 grams and .9860 pure

gold. It was housed in a bezel with a pendant mounting which did not appear to damage the coin. It cleared a final bid of \$900. An 1878-CC Morgan silver dollar was taken with a high bid of \$404, an 1883-CC Morgan silver dollar left

Art Deco furniture still appeals to buyers

The term "Art Deco" was first used in 1966 in Paris at the 1966 Exposition Internationale Decoratifs des Arts exhibition. "Arts decoratifs" (in French) roughly

means "decorative arts." The term was shortened to Art Deco, and the name stuck, but it referred to an art style that developed 40 years before the name.

The Art Deco Movement reached fruition between the two world wars 1920-1939;

however, some scholars date the Art Deco period from 1900 until the mid-1950s, but in general, the 19-year gap between the European world wars is regarded as the Art Deco Era.

A "modernization" of many artistic styles and themes from the past distinguishes the Art Deco era. Looking at Art Deco furniture, it is easy to detect the influence of Asian design. Other Deco elements and themes influences noted in Art are Deco furniture are Greek, Roman, Egyptian, and Mayan themes. Modern elements that influenced this movement include the echoing of machine and automobile patterns and machinery shapes such as stylized gears and wheels. The modern art movements of Cubism. Futurism, and Constructivism alsoinfluenced Art Deco. Natural elements such as

sunbursts and flowers also are found throughout Art Deco. With all of these different themes, it is sometimes difficult to know which furniture is Art Deco and which is not.

Items that fully showcase all of the Art interiors furnishings. It is in these two areas, especially furniture, that many of the Art Deco new materials, such as glass block, neon, chrome, terrazzo, peach or cobalt mirrors, and opaque colored glass panels, became common elements.

Paris became the center for high end Art Deco furniture. The cutting



for \$252, an 1890-CC Morgan silver dollar closed at \$234. The 1929 Federal Reserve Bank note was an interesting find. Printed during the Great Depression, these bank notes read Currency" "National across the top and were issued to help stabilize the US economy at a time of cash hoarding. This one said, "Federal Reserve Bank Cleveland" and was in very good condition. It left with a high bid of \$192.

Advertising signs are always a crowd pleaser. Leading this category, a Funk's G Hybrid sign took top honors. The Funk Seed Company offered their "G" hybrid corn seed internationally. Displaying a hardy looking ear of corn, this full-color metal sign stood 45 inches tall and

was claimed with a high bid of \$404. A fun 1955 round metal sign read "Welcome to Yankee Stadium, Bronx, N.Y. Tickets, parking, and reservations" and had a hand with index finger pointing in the direction to travel. This black and white, 12-inch round porcelain sign must have stirred a memory for a sports fan who claimed it with a high bid of \$316. A round white Kendall Motor Oil double sided hanging sign with mounting frame measured 23

inches in diameter. A bit of mystery surrounds the red hand with two fingers raised on the logo. It either represents the fact that Kendall Motor Oil at the time was superior because it could last 2,000 miles between oil changes, or it is the sign language symbol for the letter "K". Either way, the sign was won with a final bid of \$303.

In the area of more useful items, there was a Drader Injectiweld kit W30000 industrial plastic welder. This handheld plastic welding fabrication kit and repair system came in a case with all the necessary accessories and looked to be in like-new condition. It left for a new assignment with a high bid of \$800.

For the amateur radio operators, there was a vintage Johnson Viking Thunderbolt tube linear amplifier available. This unit was paired with an Electro Model EFB filtered D. C. power supply, a HealthKit power supply, a Cornell-Dubilier Electric (CDE) direction antenna rotor control, a cylinder, and miscellaneous wiring. This well-worn selection of equipment found an appreciative new ham shack with a high bid of \$352.

There was a poster that seemed a bit unusual, as it showed five

members of the Detroit Red Wings hockey team with images of the flag Russian and American flag above them. A bit of research revealed that these were the "Russian Five", Sergei Fedorov, Slava Fetisov, Vladimir Konstantinov, Slava Kozlov and Igor Larionov, who had been recruited to defect from Russia and join the team in 1990. The framed poster was numbered 1007/3000 and measured 29 inches by 36 inches. This historic keepsake was claimed with a high bid of \$180.

A delicate Fenton hand-painted 20 inch satin lamp earned a high bid of \$156. An ornate solid brass holy water box that stood 18 inches tall had two doors on the front that opened to reveal the inner compartment. There were angels decorating the doors, as well as the symbols for the alpha and the omega inside. A key was included to lock this vintage box. Its condition was worn but good and this unusual item cleared a final bid of \$174.

edge of modern taste celebrated in the 1925 Paris Exposition drew French and immigrant furniture designers. Soon French furniture designs achieved international recognition, especially

wealthy among Americans, traveling to Paris in search of the latest fashions.

Few English furniture designers attempted the innovative and indigenous styles of Art Deco. Instead, English tastes remained stolid and true, favoring conservative, formal French taste and design over the more modern Art Deco. However, some English furniture designers, notably the Brothers, Epstein represented the Art Deco movement in their use of fine walnut veneers in furniture.

Following the Paris Exhibition, many American furniture designers, including Heywood-Wakefield, quickly moved into interpretive French designs, using mahogany, Brazilian rosewood, Makassar ebony, and ivory in their furniture designs. Jacques-Emile Ruhlmann achieved great prestige and popularity in America when $_{
m his}$ furniture was promoted by the B. Altman department stores. Other American furniture makers soon reproduced Ruhlmann's designs.

Many of the Art Deco furniture designers were architects. One notable architect turned furniture designer was Eileen Gray. She ventured to Paris and soon developed a modern style of lacquered wood and tubular-steel furniture. Other famous Deco furniture designers are Pierre Legrain, who combined bold African imagery with fashionable French taste, and Armand-Albert Rateau, who incorporated Egyptian and exotic motifs in his furniture. Jean-Michael Frank boldly used luxurious materials such softleathers, parchment, sharkskin, vellum, and mellow, blond woods in his furniture designs. Frank's work inspired both modern ripoffs and true reproductions. making his Art Deco designs a lasting influence on furniture design.

After copying many French furniture designs, two Art Deco furniture schools evolved America. The first was Decorator and the second was American Modern.

Decorator furniture offered select patrons custom-made, unique Art Deco designed furniture. One of the premier furniture Decorator designers was T. H. Robsjohn-Gibbins, who worked mostly in the United States from the 1930s to the 1950s. He specialized in exaggerated neoclassical designs. Designers of the American Modern movement include Donald Deskey, Paul T. Frankl, Warren McArthur, and Norman Bel Geddes. All of these designers worked in geometric styles, using innovative materials.

Collectors often look for pieces designed by Gilbert Rohde, who designed functional wood furniture for Herman Miller and Heywood-Wakefield.

Perhaps the greatest American Art Deco furniture designer was the great architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Many scholars consider him the

greatest American influence on the American Art Deco style. Wright began working in Art Deco style as early as 1904 when he designed rectilinear metal furniture for the Larkin Office Building in Buffalo, New York.

If Art Deco furniture ever achieved the label "as American as apple pie," it was in the work of Paul Frankl. Frankl's work embodied American Modernism with most of his pieces designed for New York apartments. Many consider Frankl's pieces inseparable from the culture of New York itself, which is the city that symbolized the American move into the modern world.

Most American Art Deco furniture is unsigned, so it is easily affordable. Two interesting and innovative American's styles to look for are the glitzy Hollywood style that



used mirrored surfaces and blue glass and a sleek, streamlined style that was popular from the early 1930s through 1945. The streamlined style can be found in dining tables and chairs from American roadside diners of this era.

And, finally, for those of you who collect furniture for investment, Art Deco room screens are some of $_{
m the}$ mostvaluable American Art Deco pieces around. These screens were highly popular from the late 1920s. Most room screens were signed, so watch for particular designers; although, any signed piece is valuable.





Fenton pancake lamps lit up the bidding with \$600 at Amanda



AMANDA, Ohio - Here is Amanda Auction Gallery's April 7 sale by the numbers: On a beautiful Sunday afternoon, some 239 online bidders came together with 60 inhouse folks for a "fantastic" sale, centered around the personal collection of an Ohio resident from Washington Courthouse. Up for bid were 246 lots, primarily American art pottery and sundry Victorian wares. Bidders hailed from 26 states, representing four countries (the United States and Canada, as well as China and Italy).

Auctioneer Jon LeMay conducted the auction. Not surprisingly, the highest hammered price of the day was for a pair of hand-painted Fenton pancake lamps, in working order and measuring nearly one foot tall. "They're rare," noted Dave Tuggle, the gallery's owner, adding that it was an internet buyer who won them for \$600.

Twentieth-century wares from prominent Ohio potteries dominated the sale, with Rookwood Pottery posting

the strongest prices, according to Tuggle. Topping five other lots of Rookwood Pottery was a grouping of three ewers, all signed on the bottom, with one also signed on the inside; collectively, they sold for \$275. A pair of striking blue partridge bookends made \$225, and a small grouping that included Zing tiles sold for \$250.

On the other hand, it was a 7-inch Roseville Pottery Falline vase, a pattern intro-

duced in 1933, that brought \$500. Competing bidders, including one phoning from Cleveland, soared past the pre-sale estimate of \$150 to \$300. But there was no need for Roseville collectors to be discouraged, with 37 additional lots offered. A number of examples of the Pine Cone pattern were sold, including a striking 18-inch green pitcher (\$225), as well as a lot consisting of a blue vase, eight inches tall, and a green bowl, six inches tall, \$140 for the pair. Two lots featured Pine Cone triple bud vases, one in brown, offered with a vase and a small bowl (\$160), and the other in green, paired with a single-handled small vase (\$120). Other Roseville Pottery patterns did well, with an impressive blue floor vase in the "Fuchsia" pattern making \$200, and an eightinch handled blue Blueberry bowl topping out at \$160.

Eighteen lots of Weller

Pottery found new homes, with the most impressive example, a Jap Birdimal umbrella stand, commanding \$225. Two pairs of bird figurines from Weller's Brighton line were sold: a pheasant and a kingfisher (\$130) and two bluebirds (\$110). "Thinking spring," buyers snapped up a Woodcraft chalice vase (\$90) and a pair of Woodcraft wall pockets, decorated with amusing squirrels (\$110), as well as a 1920s Glendale vase decorated with birds with eggs in a nest (\$130).

"Instant collections" included a number of lots each consisting of 10 ceramic cow pitchers selling for \$30 to \$40, and groupings of wall pockets at \$20 to \$40 per lot. Cabinets in which to display these new treasures were sold, including a handsome four-stack oak bookcase with bottom drawer, hammered down at \$400. Among other pieces of furniture sold were a stylish oak hall seat, complete with an oval mirror (\$225); a maple two-piece kitchen cupboard in excellent condition, with nine drawers, three doors, and a dough box (\$425); and a handsome musical wooden sewing box with inlaid trim (\$475).

Last minute bidding resulted in an auction surprise: A small Jumbo peanut butter tin, showing wear, sold for \$275, several times its pre-sale estimate. A glass-domed taxidermy bird display sold for \$350, while two framed taxidermied birds, a scarlet tanager and a parakeet, made \$150. A coffee grinder advertising "Golden Rule Blend Coffee" from nearby Columbus brought \$120, and another advertising piece, an ice water bucket marked "United Indurated Fibre Company," sold for \$120. Among a variety of mourning items was a Victorian hair wreath with

the words "Our Hattie At

Rest," which made \$250.

Amanda Auction Gallery is currently preparing for what Tuggle called "our biggest sale of the year." Set for April 21, the auction will feature advertising and country store items; more than 300 lots that will include, among other things, colorful neons and advertising signs, scooters and bikes, and store displays and cash registers.






