Commercial belt sander spun \$11,100 bid

MILLINGTON, Mich. — From March 25-April 1, Albrecht Auction Service held a liquidation sale of the former McClelland Millwork cabinet shop. The fully online auction, held on Albrecht's BidNow platform, offered 200 lots of woodworking machinery, forklifts, storage items, and materials.

The auction's top bid went for a Timesavers Series 200 51 inch dual head speed belt sander, with a Model 252-2 belt conveyor. 154 bids took it to \$11,100. It was the sole item to receive a five-figure winning bid.

Left: 16 lots held railroad carts. Some were sold singly; others in groups. One had been modified into a rolling cabinet.

Three lots sold for four-figure sums. The highest, at \$2,650.20 on 71 rounds of bidding, went for a Buss Machine Works Model 44 precision 36 by 8 inch planer. Bids went to \$2,350 for a Mattison Machine Works Model 202 rip saw with a 65 by 77 1/2 inch table. A tidy \$1,250 scored up an Ayen OSB 23 Model D-7046 horizontal boring machine.

From there, bidding dropped into the three figures, with 41 lots selling in that range. Topping those was a 220-volt Blum Minipress MSP Model 1990 with a 123-inch wide fence. It sold for \$927, not including the cabinet it sat upon.

A Cark LP gas forklift, with a 5000-pound capacity, rolled off at \$596.

While in running condition, it leaked some oil, and the sale did not include the gas tank. The subsequent lot held a Hyster LP gas forklift that made it to \$460 (gas tank also not included). It

was in running condition but would not move forward or reverse but did have a functioning mast.

To be expected, most of

Parlor lamps became known by famous movie name

Gone with the Wind oil lamps (also known as chamber lamps, hurri-

cane lamps, or parlor lamps) were immensely popular in the late Victorian Era, roughly 1890–1910. These lamps were widely produced by a variety of glass companies.

The name "Gone with the Wind" attached to these parlor lamps following the release of the movie "Gone With the Wind," starring Clark Gable and Vivien Leigh, in 1939. Depending on which lamp historian you ask, parlor lamps became Gone with the Wind lamps when these lamps were used on the movie's set, inspiring a new generation of collectors. However, many historians will tell you that this is nothing more than a myth. Lamps such as these were never used in the movie—not even in one scene. Still, dealers today advertise these lamps as Gone with the Wind lamps even though

the movie was released over 40 years after these parlor lamps lost their appeal.

In general, the top shade of a Gone with the Wind lamp is a round shade, and it is absolutely essential that both shades match perfectly in color. Many Gone with the Wind lampshades have intricately and beautifully painted motifs, including flowers, ivy, or other plant life, giving the lamp a sense of elegance and lasting beauty. Most of these lamps had four-footed bases, and some of the bases had figural statues attached to the base.

Authentic parlor lamps (remember, these lamps were not called Gone with the Wind lamps until after 1939) appeared in the late 1800s with blown glass shades and, predominantly, brass parts and scrollwork. Many collectors search for lamps with decorative appeal,

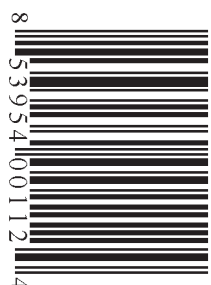

such as lamps with tassels or hanging prisms. Parlor lamps were typically produced in all types of glass, including milk glass, cut glass, etched glass, and colored glass. These lamps were

made to burn kerosene, so the bottom globe of the lamp served as a fuel reservoir, which is called a font. Many original parlor lamps have been elec-

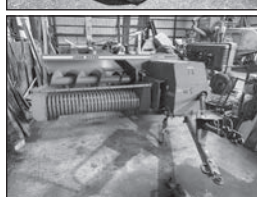

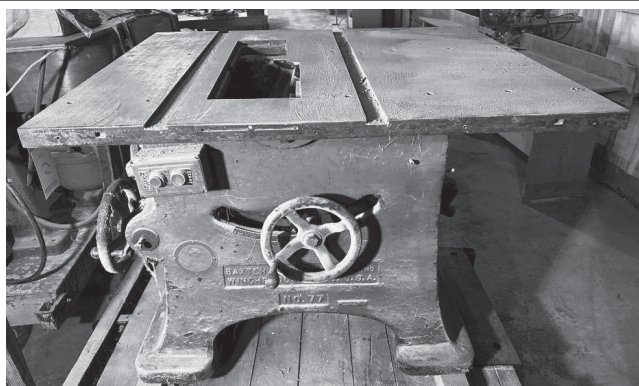

the commercial wood-working machinery bid within the three-figure range. Among the equipment was a 240-volt 3-phase Rockwell Delta table saw, with a 38 by 48 inch table. It left for \$410. Also selling for \$410 was a 40-inch wide Beach Manufacturing Company 5-hp, 220-volt, 3-phase wood shaper. A \$300 bid won a floor-standing ½-hp Rockwell Model 15 drill press, with a 10 by 10 inch table, ½" Jacob's chuck, variable belt speed, and 115-volt, 1-phase motor.

Many buyers were able to get good pieces of equipment, even when winning bids fell below \$100. Among the wallet-friendly scores was a Baxter D. Whitney No. 77 table saw, picked up for \$80. It featured a 5 hp, 220/440 volt, 3-phase motor, and a 40 by 46 ½ inch table. Coming close at \$75.80 was a 68 inch tall Oliver No. 91-D mortising machine,

thought to be 3-phase. And, a 50 by 64 inch Oliver Model 125-D tenoning machine, with a 220-volt, 3-phase motor, was snagged for just \$52.

In addition to machinery, there were numerous lots containing parts and accessories. A \$375 bid won a 37 ½ inch high by 29 inch wide by 24 inch deep shop-built 10-drawer cabinet loaded with wood shaping bits. A large group of router and other bits hit \$146.50, while two sets of eight saw horses sold for \$102 each.

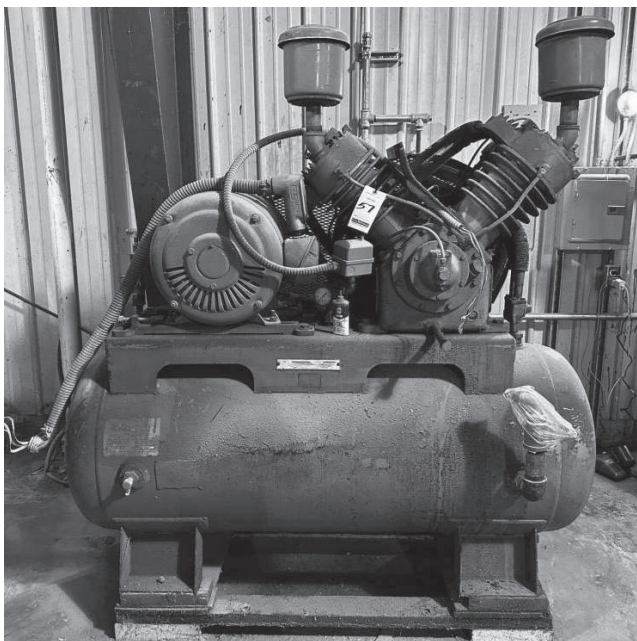
There were also nine

lots of materials and hardware. Those included a batch of approximately 18 pieces of rough-sawn oak in assorted widths and lengths up to 11 foot long. That went for \$178.88. A group of approximately 20 pieces of ash, mostly 1 by 8 inches up to 16 feet, hit \$114.87. A full rack of laminate veneer and some miscellaneous pieces of mirror material (rack not included) was scooped up for \$70.

Perhaps the most unusual lots were ones with antique railroad carts, sold in singles and sets. The highest, at \$650, went for a collection of five in assorted sizes, the largest measuring 36 by 63 inches. A set of four carts, also of assorted sizes, brought \$500. Five single carts each rolled off for bids ranging from \$56-\$125.

Because of the size and weight of many of the items, winning bidders were instructed to schedule pickup appointments. The company had a forklift available during scheduled days/hours to assist with loading.

Obituary: Dennis Jackson

ANDERSON, Ind. — Long-time auctioneer Dennis Ray Jackson, 77, died on April 13. He was born on September 27, 1946, in Cincinnati, Ohio and resided most of his life in Anderson, Ind.

Jackson graduated from Anderson College in 1968 with a BA in Business. He graduated from Ball State University in 1973 with a master's degree in education. Dennis was a school teacher for 10 years before becoming a full-time auctioneer.

Jackson graduated from the Nashville Auction School in 1970 and received his auctioneer's license in 1971. In 1975 he began teaching continuing education courses for auctioneers and realtors. He taught for the Indiana, Michigan and Kentucky State Auctioneer Associations as well as at the National Auctioneer's Association.

He opened his own firm Jacksons Auction Co in 1978 in Anderson, Ind. In 1990 he formed Fine Arts Auction Co, Jackson and Wickliff Auctioneers in Carmel. In 2005 he left Jackson & Wickliff Auctioneers and created family owned Jacksons Auction & Real Estate



Company with his children.

He won the Indiana Auctioneer's Association bid calling championship in 1988 and served as the president of that association in 1992. Also, in 1992 he was a finalist in the bid calling contest at the National Auctioneers Association convention.

The firm was well known for selling Indiana art and in 2004 Jackson sold a T.C. Steele painting for \$200,000, which was a world record.

He was an active member of South Meridian Church of God since the mid-1960s and enjoyed

being involved with leading the youth group and later as a Sunday School Teacher.

Jackson is survived by his wife, Sheila (Smart) Jackson; children, Bryan (Karry) Jackson and Michele (Wayne DeVeydt) Jackson; 16 grandchildren, and one great-grandson.

Services were held on April 20. Burial took place at Anderson Memorial Park.

trified, which eliminates the need for kerosene or lamp oil and the smell attached to the kerosene. However, any lamp that does not have a fuel reservoir is not an authentic

parlor lamp.

As with all antiques, values for parlor lamps depend on a variety of factors, including globe color, overall condition of the lamp, age of the lamp, has the lamp been altered or electrified, manufacturer, and rarity of the lamp.

Authentic parlor lamps from the 1800s with original wick and burning components are sought after collectibles, so these lamps, in general, have the highest values for parlor lamps, often running in the thousands of dollars.

Decorators often use parlor lamps to stage a home with a late-Victorian look. If a collector's goal for purchasing a Gone with the Wind lamp is decorating more than it is investment, then the collector should make a

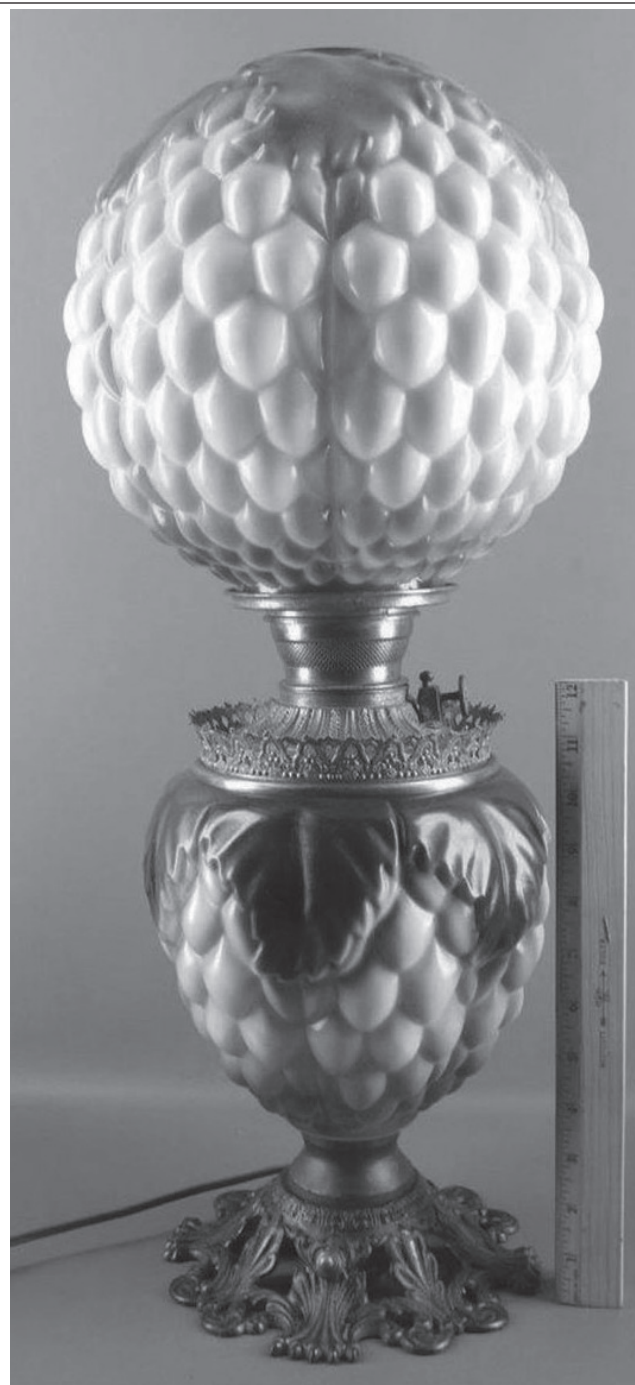

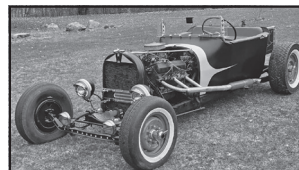

New owner for Ohio Country Show has great debut

WILMINGTON, Ohio — The Ohio Country Antiques show returned to its customary home at the Roberts Center near Wilmington on Saturday, April 13. An exciting transition was afoot as a new owner, Steve Sherhag, took over the decades-old show.

For 36 years, Jennifer Sabin had run semi-annual Ohio Country Antiques

Shows in Ohio along with Heartland at Richmond in Indiana. She stepped down after the October 2023 Ohio event, handing the reins to Sherhag.

Sherhag, who is based in Canfield in northeast Ohio, was a long-time vendor and assistant at Sabin's shows. He brought event coordination experience from a dozen years as the promoter of the Ohio-based Hudson Antique Show and

manager of the nearby Zoar Antique Show. He's also the owner of the Hartford House near Youngtown, Ohio, a small co-op of six dealers that focus on traditional antiques.

When asked why he took over Sabin's Heartland Antique Shows circuit with his already full plate, he replied, "I didn't want to see the show die," adding, "There aren't enough good country and Americana shows in Ohio." He pointed to the need for such a show on the western side of the state.

To ensure a successful transition, one of Sherhag's first orders of business was to line up a cache of top-quality dealers. 45 filled the event space - and, as if he wasn't busy enough coordinating the event, he had his own well-appointed booth.

Their offerings were impressive, for sale was everything from museum-quality 18th-century furniture and primitive home decor to 19th-century paintings and folk-art toys. Merchandise was also top-tier, and it was not uncommon to see items

with three- and four-figure price tags.

Many vendors came from nearby, from locales like Dayton and Lebanon, Ohio. They also came from surrounding states like Indiana and even further. While there were a few new faces, most had been with the show for years, attesting to Sabin's success at courting and maintaining quality dealers.

One of those long-timers, participating since the 1990s, was Jane Langol who arrived from Medina, Ohio, near Cleveland. She acknowledged the sustained presence of many vendors. "Many are loyal followers of Jennifer [Sabin]. Many dealers are here because she worked with them over the years." That said, she went on to laud the transition, "Steve brings a lot with him. He's a skilled woodworker and has a background with East Coast shows that he brings to the Midwest."

Ray Mongenas of Mongena's Antiques, from nearby Loveland, Ohio, is strictly a show seller and has been at this one since its inception. He was very positive about the transition. "Steve is very ener-

getic and he fully understands how to run this show." Tom Graham from Dayton, Ohio, has been with the show for only five years. He complimented the pre-show logistics. "The process was very organized, very efficient." Langol lent an interesting perspective, "Load in was wonderful. Steve brought in vehicles in sequence," she said, then mentioned that Sherhag was Sabin's traffic manager.

Another top concern, of course, was bringing in shoppers. Contemporary forms of promotion were big on Sherhag's agenda. He put up a new website and utilized lots of targeted social media marketing on Facebook, Instagram, and TikTok. He's used similar tactics at his other shows. "For the Hudson show we use 90 percent digital advertising and get 900 in the door - in March!"

What he employed seemed to work. Twenty minutes before the 9 a.m. start, a line had formed halfway down the conference center's hall. Matt Ehresman, a dealer from Akron, Ohio, said, "It's a good first promotion. The crowd seems better this year." Brent Gray of Indiana's Gray Granite Antiques commented, "We are very impressed with the attendance."

As important as the numbers, attendees came to buy. Within 15 minutes of opening, items across the room

were flagged with "sold" signs, particularly on popular furnishings like primitive pie safes and country tables. By and large, it's an older audience and they know what they want. They appreciate the high-caliber traditional antiques, and despite the conspicuous prices, aren't afraid to open their wallets for good-quality pieces. Nevertheless, dealers seem amicable toward negotiating.

With this transitional event behind him, Sherhag is now planning for his next, the Heartland at Richmond (Indiana) on June 1. The next Ohio Country Antiques Show is on October 9.

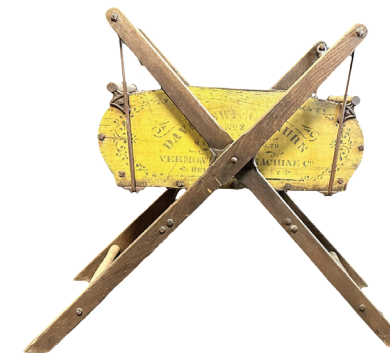
