ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Bids radiated for Swarovski crystal figurines

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. — On June 3, EDS Fine Estate Auctions held a fine furnishings, antiques, sterling, and art auction. The online-only sale contained 430 lots from multiple estates and consignors. Among the offerings were early 20th-century furniture, sterling silver flatware, and Swarovski crystal figurines, along with sketches, paintings, and pastels.

The auction's top lot of \$480 went to a signed/numbered folio entitled, "Physiologus Theobaldi Episcopi De Naturis Duodecim Animalium (Physiologist Theobald Bishop on the Nature of the Twelve Animals) illustrated with 12 lithographs and 10 woodcuts attributed to painter/

printmaker Rudolph Otto Pozzatti (American, 1925-2021). The circa 1964 volume had a cloth-covered clamshell box with a pasted woodcut on the front and gilt titles on the spine. It was in expected

used condition.

Second place went for a good-condition pair of Savonarola Dante-style Italian gilt iron chairs, at \$450. The 26-inch wide

Buttons in realistic shapes make a 'goofy' collection

If you walk into almost any antique store, the odds are good that you'll see an old mason jar full of buttons for sale.

Gertrude Patterson

started modern button collecting when, in 1938, she was a recurring guest on the "Hobby Lobby" radio show. Patterson chatted excitedly about her passion for button collecting, and since the Great Depression was robbing women of spending

money, women enthusiastically followed Patterson's advice and began collecting buttons, which were objects they already had around their homes.

During the 1930s, buttons were cheap and plentiful, allowing even the poorest of women to acquire a button collection. Button collecting skyrocketed so fast, that in 1939, just a year after Patterson championed buttons, the National Button Society formed. Cities all across America formed Button Clubs where rousing songs started meetings and members held parties with button themes.

These clubs started at an opportune time in American history for button lovers. Celluloid, an early-type plastic, research soon led to

harder, better plastics, such as Bakelite, and buttons that had formerly been made of metal, shell, or wood now could be molded and cast with plastic, allowing shapes to change and prices to drop.

by 17-inch-deep chairs featured thick hide seats and armrests upon heavy iron finial-capped frames.

Nearly four dozen other lots of furniture were offered, including a tufted leather Wrangler by Flexsteel club sofa that landed \$280. The 84-inch long by 39-inch wide couch was in very good used condition. It sported nail-head trim, a wooden base, and two seat cushions attached with Velcro straps.

Bidding went to \$145 for an antique four-drawer dresser with a marble top. The 41-inch wide by 36-inch-high piece was made of solid wood with mortise and tenon construction, dovetails, brass drop pulls, and brass lock escutcheons.

Surprisingly, bidding stalled out at \$85 on one

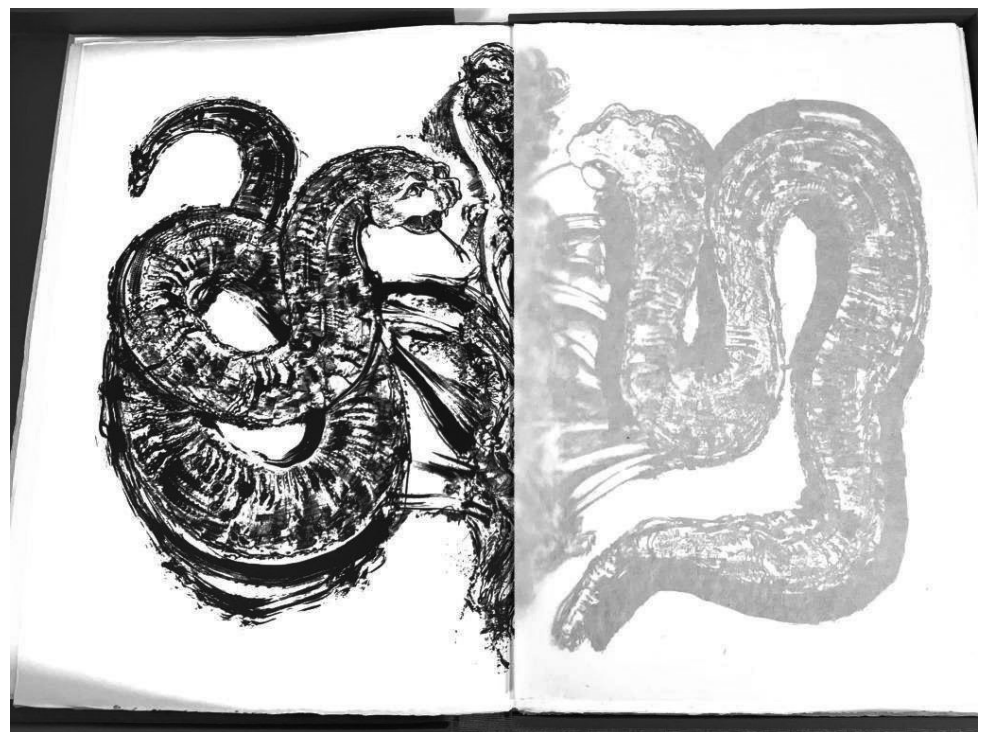
of the showcased lots, a five-piece Art Deco living room suite, circa 1920-1930. The collection included a 15-inch-wide settee, three 26-inch armchairs, and an ottoman/footstool. The set was “skyscraper” style with angular wood frames and Lurex/metallic upholstery that may have been original. Everything was in

solid condition but the fabric and springs needed some attention.

Another spotlighted category — the Swarovski crystal figurines — did not disappoint. In all, there were 47 beautiful pieces on the block. Taking top bid, at \$205, was a 1997 annual edition figure entitled, “The Dragon” in its original packaging. In excellent condition, the 5 ½-inch long cut-crystal creature had gem eyes and frosted detailing.

A bid of \$125 took home a boxed 2002 piece called “The Magic of Dance Isadora.” The 7 ¼-inch figure was in like-new condition with its original box. Later came a nine-piece Swarovski Nativity scene. It contained miniature figures of an archway, the Holy family, a shepherd, and three kings. Included was a slightly damaged Christmas Memories crystal angel ornament. The bundle was won for \$115. The smallest winning bid for a Swarovski piece was \$20, offered for a 1 ½-inch diameter birthday cake with a mirror stand, in excellent condition, from 1992.

Sterling silver proved popular, with winning bids hitting as high as \$240 for a sterling S. Kirk & Son set of eight

Repousse salad forks. Weighing in at 292 grams, the lot sold for around its metal value.

However, the \$220 bid offered for a 20-piece flatware set that held just 85 grams of sterling was well over its silver value. The set contained five spoons, 12 dinner knives, a two-piece carving set, and a pair of ice tongs.

Coming in at \$130 was a set of four sterling coasters, a weighted sterling compote, and an engraved plate. The coasters measured 3 ¾ inches, while the compote came in at 5 ½ inches high and 5 ¼ inches in diameter. The compote was marked, “Preisner Weighted Sterling”, the coasters, “Newport Sterling”, and the plate, “Fisher Sterling.” At 188 grams, the set sold just shy of its silver value.

Art consisted mainly of two-dimensional works, both framed and unframed, spanning from oils to etchings. A framed vintage embroidered sampler portraying birds and flowers made it to \$370, earning it the auction’s third place. The 27-inch by 29-inch piece, by an unknown artist, was framed and wired, ready for hanging.

Coming close, at \$360 was an etching of the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, signed by Axel Tallberg (Swedish 1860-1928) who taught at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Stockholm. The 21-inch by 16-inch picture was also framed and

wired for hanging.

Another \$360 picked up a circa 2010 acrylic painting entitled “Music Lovers” by Peter Bruning (Dutch/American, 1923-2018). The acrylic on canvas, measuring 19 inches by 15 inches was in good condition and signed by the artist.

Other interesting pieces included an M.A. Hadley blue and white pottery cat-shaped lamp that grabbed \$210. A 6-inch glass and

metal bee-shaped honey server with the paddle left for \$140. And, a 10-inch contemporary Chinese cast-metal dragon figure, black with verdigris color highlights, sold for \$72.50.

Buttons FROM PAGE 1

Following World War II, plastic production swept America, and as an increasing number of buttons were injection molded using plastic, a new term entered our lexicon—"goofies."

"Goofies," according to Dorothy Foster Brown (Hobbies—The Magazine for Collectors, December 1946), who claims to have originated the term, are "recent, object buttons made of modern plastics, wood, china, etc." Brown further stated, "It is immaterial to me what the buttons are called, but I thought, and still think, that the name 'Goofy' describes them quite well. It is distinctive, if not 'elegant' and is in no danger of being confused with any other button name or classification. And if, as a name, it is not particularly dignified—well, neither are the buttons!"

A better definition of "goofie" might be: realistic plastic buttons sold in sets of up to eight, primarily in the 1940s and '50s. For those new to button terminology, a realistic button is a button that has the shape of the object it represents, for instance a banana realistic goofie button would be shaped like a banana and probably made of yellow plastic. Goofies came as either a sew-thru or with a shank for attachment.

Most of the 1940s goofies

were sold in sets, four or eight to a card. Besides Disney, some of the sets included packaged cigarette buttons (Old Gold, Camel, Chesterfield, and Lucky Strike), making these buttons cross collectibles.

Beryl Stewart in her article Sets of Goofies (Hobbies—August 1946) described several sets of goofies: a baseball set with catcher, pitcher, batter, short stop, and umpire; a USA set where the "U" is white, the "S" is red, "and the "A" is blue; a nut set with what looks like pecans and peanuts; and a beautiful flower set with six flowers—a wild rose, a white daisy, a pink rosebud, a red tulip, a yellow zinnia, and a blue flower of unknown type.

Among the earliest goofies "Made in the USA" are turtles, but since few if any goofies have any identifying marks, there is no way to actually date them.

Brown summed up goofies quite well when she wrote, "Few of these modern buttons are beautiful. They are clever and colorful, but they are victims of mass production which sacrifices quality to quantity."

It is their quantity that interests today's collectors since goofies from the '30s, '40s, and '50s are still easy to find and are still relatively cheap to own.

It seems difficult to believe that buttons termed "Modern Plastics" are now 85 years old.

Pabst Breweries sign drank up a bid of \$27,060 at Morphy

LAS VEGAS - On June 7-8 at their Las Vegas gallery, Morphy's popped the cap off an effervescent selection of vintage soda pop signs and other colorful advertising pieces at a spirited auction that totaled \$1.4 million. The 1,329-lot sale was led by a gorgeous all-original porcelain and neon Pabst Breweries sign that attracted strong collector attention at the preview and went on to sell for more than four times the high estimate.

The glossy double-sided Pabst sign, marked "ACME CHICAGO" and executed in brilliant primary colors, showed off unique Pabst graphics and time-defying fine condition. The 60 by 42-inch dazzler simply could not be faulted. It retained its original bubble glass inserts and "can." The sign's origin was documented by the original stamped metal tag reading "Local Union 15 International Association Of Sheetmetal Workers" and a second metal tag that was numbered "10720." Entered with a \$2,000-\$6,000 estimate, it racked up 29 bids before claiming top-lot honors at \$27,060.

Early soda fountain syrup dispensers found

favor with collectors and included a stunning example of a hard-to-find Hires Root Beer ceramic dispenser with graphics of the company's mascot, known as the "Ugly Kid." Created by the esteemed German ceramics company Villeroy & Boch, the 19-inch dispenser was marked by the manufacturer and displayed excellent grade-9 condition, with the original metal spigot and lid still intact. It sold near the midpoint of its estimate range for \$18,450.

A rare circa-1896 ceramic syrup dispenser made by Wheeling Pottery Co., was an example of the first style of dispenser ever released by the king of soft drinks,

Coca-Cola. The highly sought-after 21-inch-tall soda fountain antique caught bidders' attention because it is of a type seldom seen in the marketplace. It sold for a within-estimate price of \$10,455. Another elusive dispenser, a circa-1910s production emblazoned "Drink Grapefruitola 5¢," was decorated in an appealing palette of colors and graded a strong condition 9. It sold for \$6,765 against an estimate of \$1,500-\$3,000.

When it comes to innovative product marketing, no other soda pop brand has ever matched the success of Coca-Cola, which blazed a trail for others who followed. Since the company's first

ad appeared in 1886 in the Atlanta Journal, its panoramic array of promotional signs and merchandise has inspired a legion of competitors who've battled for dominance - some more skillfully than others - in the lucrative soft drink market. Several lots in the auction demonstrated the ingenious way in which Coca-Cola inserted its product into every aspect of American life, often using the power of suggestion. For example, as a customer entered a mom-and-pop grocery store, they might grab the Bakelite handle of a Coca-Cola door-pull sign, like the one Morphy's auctioned for \$4,920. Once inside the store, a shopper's attention might easily be diverted by a 42-inch-tall Coca-Cola bottle on an electrified rotating base imprinted with the message "Hospitality Can Be So Easy..." And in the midst of all those reminders, a carrier carton of refreshing Coca-Cola was never far from one's grocery cart. Pure genius! The fully-functional grade-8.5 revolving bottle with base offered by Morphy's was chased to a winning bid of \$5,166 against an estimate of \$800-\$1,600.

Other Coca-Cola items of special note included a circa-1900 "Hutchinson" Coke bottle of pale amethyst glass with a slug plate embossed Jasper, AL. Graded 8.75, it sold above high estimate for \$6,765. An unusual circa-1910s Coca-Cola die-cut leather bottle clock de-embossed with the message DRINK BOTTLED Coca-Cola / SO EASILY SERVED was graded condition 8 and sold for \$5,166 against an estimate of \$1,000-\$2,000. Of a later era but certainly no less desirable, a shiny circa-1950s Coca-Cola single-sided die-cut tin sign showing a six-pack of Coke bottles in a white carton was graded 9.25. It ended its bidding run near the high estimate, at \$7,380.

A circa-1940s Orange Crush single-sided embossed tin sign with an image of the brand's iconic "Crushy" mascot and the message "Feel Fresh! Drink Orange Crush Carbonated Beverage" sold above high estimate for \$7,995. A great-looking double-sided painted tin flange sign with a 7Up bottle graphic and the message "We Proudly Serve 7Up" sold within estimate for \$7,380.

Mountain Dew was another brand that ignited bidder interest. A vibrant example of a rare single-sided vertical tin sign emblazoned "Yahoo! Drink Mountain Dew" displayed excellent colors and an image of a Mountain Dew bottle with whimsical "hillbilly" graphics. It rose to \$4,920. Following right behind it, pricewise, was a rare and desirable Mountain Dew figurinal point-of-sale display featuring the familiar mountain man character holding a "stoneware" jug. Standing 48 inches tall it sold for \$4,428.

After the sale, Morphy Auctions' president, Dan Morphy, said, "We've always known there were many active collectors of soda pop and other types of antique advertising in the western states because ever since we launched our business 20 years ago, those collectors have been bidding remotely in our Pennsylvania-based sales. Now we're bringing the merchandise to them, which they especially appreciate because our satellite gallery is located in a city known for fun and entertainment."
