Nautical treasures await at Big Ship Salvage in Ohio

MILAN, Ohio — Nestled in the heart of

the Midwest, Ohio's Lake Erie shoreline stretches over 300 miles, offering an array of natural beauty and touring opportuni-

ties. From bustling cities to serene parks, the lake's coastline provides something for everyone. The Sandusky area offers a unique slice of Lake Erie, with a delightful blend of scenic waterfront, thrilling attractions, and small-town charms.

One of those nearby small towns is Milan, Ohio, where historic buildings and quaint shops line the picturesque town square. Milan's heritage is rich, with landmarks such as the Thomas Edison Birthplace Museum and a section of the former Milan canal, once home to a Great Lakes shipbuilding port, to explore.

Big Ship Salvage is a family-owned affair, in business since 2002. The company is owned by Jim and Kelly Unger. Jim was

raised in the Lake Erie area. He worked in higher education for nearly

Collectors seek Bossons line of chalkware heads

W. H. Bossons and his son W. Ray Bossons founded W. H. Bossons, Ltd. in Congleton, England, in 1948. Bossons, Ltd. was a ceramics company that specialized in ceramic wall masks (Bossons Head Plaques), animals, barometers, thermometers, book-ends, mirrors, lamp bases, pottery figurines, and many other decorative ceramic pieces.

Dr. Robert Davis (The Imagical World of Bossons, Book 1) stated that

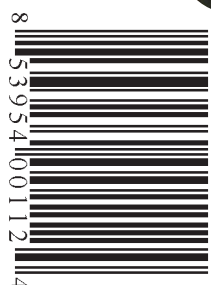

the history of the Bossons companies was essentially the story of two men, and "to borrow a phrase from Charles Dickens, a tale of two cities, or, to be more exact, a tale of two towns in England."

The towns that played such an important part in the lives of W. H. and W. Ray Bossons were Stoke-on-Trent, a manufacturing center in Staffordshire, England, and Congleton, a small rural community about eight miles north of Stoke-on-Trent where W. H.

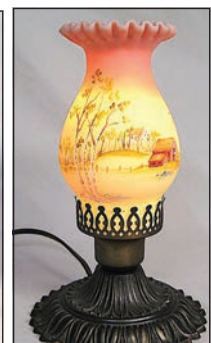
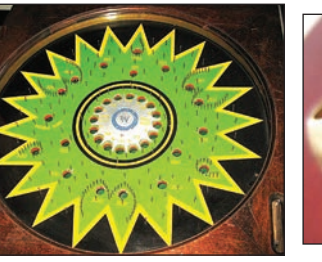
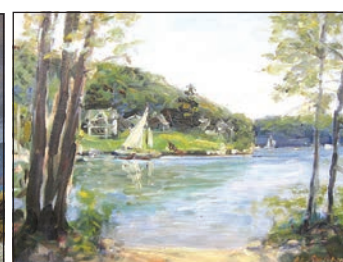

three decades, including serving as the former president of Herzing University in Akron, Ohio. Kelly had a similar tenure managing area businesses. Their son Mitch, a graduate of Edison High School and Ohio University, eventually joined the business, bringing his knowledge of e-commerce, which has proven invaluable.

The company was originally based in South Carolina. After deciding it was time for a career change, Jim Unger purchased it from the founder in 2002 and relocated it to Milan. It has since grown into the largest inventory of authentic nautical lighting and related nautical antiques in the country.

Their warehouse holds thousands of nautical artifacts and antiques from around the globe, with aisles lined with items like anchors, binnacles, lanterns, portholes, and ship wheels. Unger said they work with some of the largest ship-breaking operations in the world, salvaging parts from decommissioned ships that are at the end of their useful life. They often acquire scrap from shipyards by the ton.

Most of what you will find in the warehouse and online has been painstakingly refurbished. Unger noted that the elapsed time from acquisition to an

item being available for sale can take as long as nine months. Since the items are generally salvaged from working vessels being cut up for scrap, they are covered in layers of industrial paint, rusty, and otherwise in disrepair. The staff at Big Ship Salvage removes old marine paint, polishes the metal, rewires lamps, refinishes wood, and makes repairs to most of the pieces. Whether onsite or online, shoppers will find a vast array of glimmering brass and polished teak.

Architects, designers, and restaurateurs often turn to Big Ship Salvage

for custom nautical décor that adds a distinctive touch to their projects. And while many of those customers intend to place pieces on display in homes or businesses and want them pristine, plenty of others want artifacts with the original 'patina.' 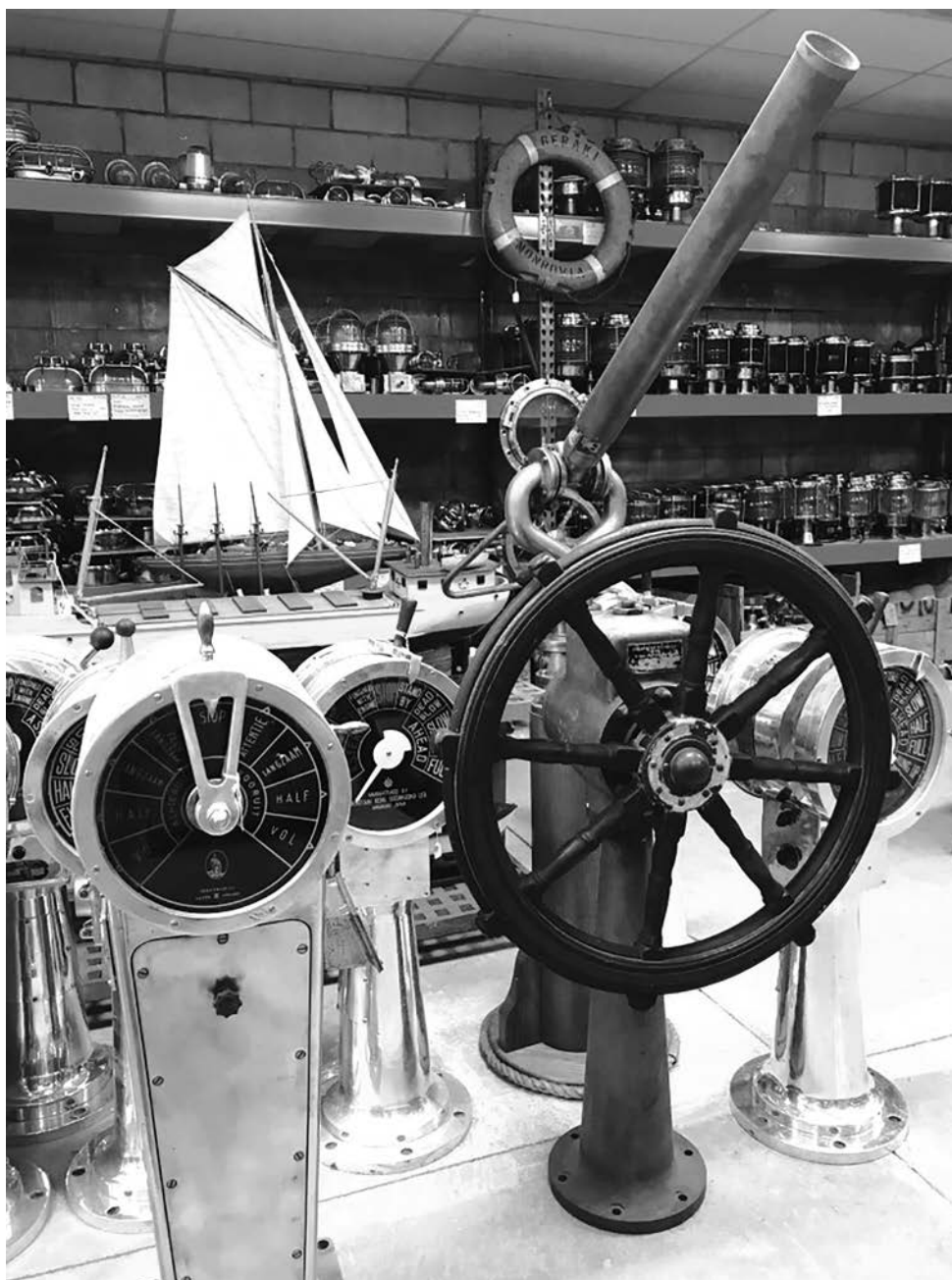

1960 Corvette revved up bidders to tune of \$70,000

SHINNSTON, W.Va. — A businessman commissioned Joe R. Pyle's auction company to sell off a collection of ultra-rare items that he had been collecting with the plans of opening a museum. However, his plans changed due to life changes, and he decided to have everything he had amassed auctioned off. Estimating that it would take eight sessions to auction off this massive accumulation to find new homes, the first two sessions were scheduled, and the sale was on.

A 1960 Chevrolet Corvette Convertible with a four-speed automatic transmission and a 328 CID small block engine was auctioned. It showed just under one hundred thousand miles on the odometer, so the mileage was relatively low for the year. It was a brilliant cherry red with a black top and a red leather interior. This beauty brought a high bid of \$70,000.

A bit older, a 1957 Chevrolet Corvette closed at \$66,500. This one popped with its beautiful turquoise color and contrasting white top. It had a beige interior, a 283-V8 engine, and an automatic transmission. The mileage on this one was extremely low, showing just over 26,000 miles. A 1954 Chevrolet Corvette was red with a tan top and a red interior. It was an automatic with a 235 engine that boasted one-hundred and fifty horsepower. It showed almost 87,000 miles on the odometer. This museum-quality automobile brought the hammer

down to \$56,500 before it found a new home.

A 1967 Chevrolet Corvette, in eye-popping dark green with a contrasting white top and leather interior, brought in a bid of \$52,000. Showing almost 90,000 miles on the odometer, this one was a real find. It had matching numbers, which is rare. It came complete with the owner's manual and guide. A 1954 Chevrolet Corvette convertible was white, with a red top and interior. It came with paperwork and a manual. It had an automatic two-hundred and thirty-five engine and one hundred fifty horsepower. With just under 90,000 miles showing on the odometer, this beauty sold for \$42,000.

A 1955 Beck Porsche 550A Spyder replica was put up for bid. This one had been rebuilt, and all the paper proof was going along with the car. The

color combination of silver with a black top and the red leather interior made this one stand out. It was sold for \$57,750.

A 1981 DeLorean DMC-12 was offered up. This one was a coupe with a stick shift. It was stainless silver with a grey interior. The mileage

showed was almost 23,000. It boasted a 2.85 liter V6 engine and a five-speed transmission. With the wing doors open, there was no doubt this was a real show-stopper. It sold for \$41,500.

Some automobile-related signs were put up. A two-sided Texaco porce-

lain sign that measured 30 inches around sold for \$700. It showed the bright red star with the "T" in the center and had Texaco in black across the top.

Advertised as "always fresh," Trump's long-cut tobacco sign drew much interest. This 1920s treasure, made of porcelain

and 23 inches long, was plain on the back and meant to be displayed on a business wall. The background was navy with a white oval in the center, which made the lettering stand out.

Owning this treasured history took a final bid price of \$3,000.

Selling for \$1,500 was an OK used cars sign. This round neon sign measured 48 inches in diameter. It glowed blue outside with a large red OK in the center. In neon green at the top and bottom were the words "used cars." It sold for a final bid price of \$1,500.

The interest in a 1920s fire alarm and police telephone call box was widespread. This bright red piece from the past measured 28 by 12 by 6 inches and weighed around 15 pounds. It was in great shape and sold for \$1,400. A 1920s Texaco restored air pump sold for \$1,600,

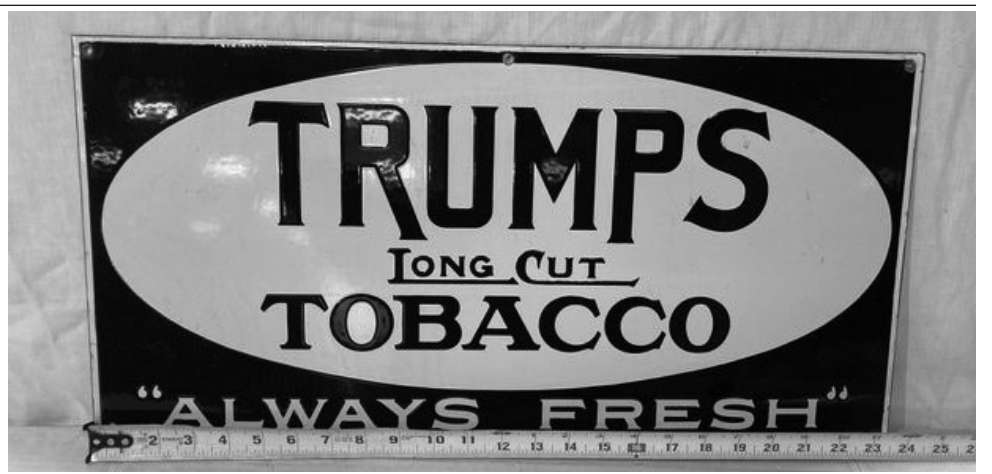
and a vintage Texaco gasoline motor oil neon sign measuring 44 by 49 inches sold for \$2,500.

A unique serving bar was sold. It was made from a 1958 Chevrolet Corvette. This one was red, with the plexiglass top missing. This would be easily replaced, and the front-appearing Corvette would make an exceptional bar in any man cave. It sold for \$1,600. To complement the bar, a 1959 Cadillac car sofa was offered. This one was red with three black stripes, one in the middle and one on each end. It was a fantastic showpiece that could withstand much wear and tear. It sold for \$1,650.

A 1965 AC Shelby Cobra car sofa was white with baby blue stripes. It looked very comfortable

A picture and negative of the iceberg that the Titanic struck garnered its share of interest. It went to \$3,300 before the bids stopped, making it sold. Two Titanic items sold for the same bid price of \$2,100. The first was a first-class deck chair

blanket. It was a red plaid blanket and looked to be in good shape. The other item was one of the grand staircase cherubs. This one stood on a base that measured 16 inches tall. The total length, including the cherub, was

20 inches.

An unusual item sold was a 1920s casino wheel. Moore and Hook made this one, and it was 60 inches tall. It measured 5 feet in diameter, and the pole that went with it was 7 feet tall. It weighed somewhere between 150 and 250 pounds. The final bid price on this hard-to-find item was \$2,500.

Currency was front and center during this entire sale. A set of United States Treasury bills from Chicago with \$1000 PMG 64 EPQ & Chicago \$500 PCGS 64 PPQ graded currency brought much attention. They sold for \$10,250.

But have no fear. Superman flew in to save the day. A Superman III uniform worn in the movie by Christopher Reeves came with a certificate of authenticity. It was in great shape, and the bidding was pretty competitive. The hammer finally fell at \$5,100.

Bossons established his ceramic factories.

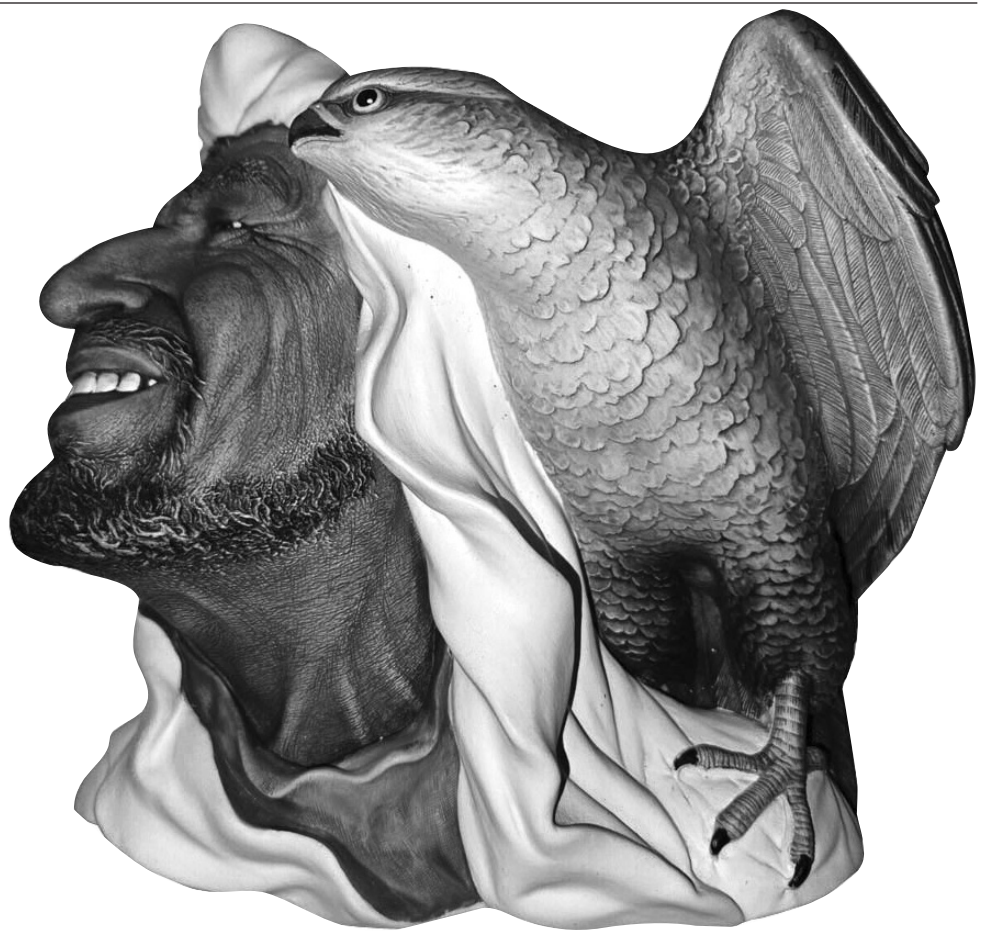
Both father and son Bossons were schooled in Stoke-on-Trent, so it is here, in this potteries district of England, that their love of all things ceramic began. W. H. Bossons graduated from the Burslem School of Art in Stoke, and he went on to be an honors student at Stoke-on-Trent College of Ceramics. Bossons son, W. Ray, followed in his father's footsteps and trained in pottery making at the Burslem School of Art in Stoke.

W. Ray Bossons served for six years in the British Royal Artillery during World War II. In October of 1946, he returned to Congleton where he helped his father found W. H. Bossons, Ltd.

Both men brought special talents to the company they founded. In 1944 W. H. Bossons' health became a major concern, and he moved to Congleton to basically live out his life. Looking for something to occupy his time, he began to form lead soldiers and, using plaster, to make Christmas ornaments. Bossons' technical skills that included mold making allowed him to build

his own molds for casting lead soldiers and plaster molds for the ornaments he created. What started out as a hobby soon became a profitable business as people not only urged him to create but also paid him for his work.

His son, W. Ray, also had special talents that helped Bossons, Ltd prosper. Prior to World War II, W. Ray

trained in advertising and publicity. In 1938 he became a Diploma Member of the Advertising Association of London. He also attended Manchester University, taking a Federation of Master printers' course in printing technology. For a short time, he worked for Smedley

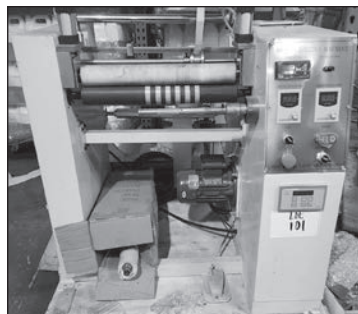

Advertising at Stoke-on-Trent that specialized in ceramic designs for local potteries.

W. H. Bossons died in 1951. W. Ray continued heading Bossons, Ltd. for the next four decades, stopping production and closing the company in 1996 just three years before his death in 1999.

Today, collectors search for anything Bossons, Ltd. produced; however, one of Bossons most collected wares is its line of Character Head Plaques. Sometimes these heads are miss-called Bosson Heads, but in reality they are Bossons Heads, named for W. H. Bossons who created them.

Bossons Heads were made of high-quality chalkware. Chalkware is actually an American term for figurines made of molded plaster of Paris. The figurines are usually painted with oil paint or watercolors. Chalkware has been popular in three separate historic

periods. The last period was the Mid-century Modern period when decorative lamps, figurines, and wall décor were made of chalkware, roughly from the late-1940s – 1960s. This is the time period that Bossons, Ltd. was at its height, turning out thousands of pieces of chalkware wall décor heads. Each piece was hand-painted with a 3D effect.

These heads represented people from all walks of life, and it was almost guaranteed that a homeowner could find a set of heads that reminded the homeowner of friends or family or some historic figure.

Most Bossons Character Head Plaques remain inexpensive with the average piece selling for less than \$30, but some rare pieces are offered on Internet auction sites, such as eBay, for thousands of dollars.
