Scott Shows offer plenty of variety

By William FLOOD

COLUMBUS, Ohio — Scott Antique Markets, with 16 shows across two cities, offer a unique shopping experience for antique and collectible seekers, with each event offering a distinct atmosphere. The November Columbus show contrasts perfectly with the chaos of Black Friday, while December invites shoppers to a "shop local" hunt for one-of-a-kind holiday gifts. January kicks off a new season, giving shoppers a chance to beat the winter blues and resellers a place to score some off-season deals.

Founded by Ohio native Don Scott, the events originally focused on traditional antiques and collectibles, including furniture, glassware,

estate jewelry, militaria, and vintage toys. Over time, the markets grew to feature a broader selection, such as Persian rugs, upcycled décor, vintage clothing, and unique specialty items. Today five shows are held from November to March at the Ohio Expo Center in

Columbus and eleven shows running from February to December at the Atlanta Expo Center.

The January 25-26 Ohio show provided a welcome escape from two weeks of snow and brutal temperatures that had gripped the Midwest. As the weather eased, eager

shoppers flocked to the fairgrounds for a day of antique hunting. This round, the show was relocated to the smaller Voinovich Center at the back of the fairgrounds, a shift from its typical centralized and larger location at the Bricker

Hart banks were heavy hitters in the toy savings industry

Toy air rifle collectors may recognize the name

Hart If Hart had not had to produced certain banks. compete with Daisy, Hart might still be making air rifles today. collectors of toy banks are familiar with the name Hart for the line of toy safes it manufactured in the late-1880s. Although Hart Manufacturing is known manufactured toy banks, it is difficult to tell which banks were manufactured by Hart. Collectors strive to compare construction, lock mechanisms, finish, and even weight of the banks to speculate as to whether or not Hart Left: Hart Mfg. antique cast iron bank, measuring 5.25 inches high, with handles on the side. Hart appears to have manufactured two types Still, of toy safes—the "Safe Deposit" and the "Fidelity Trust." Made of cast iron with brass handles and locking mechanism, all Hart toy safes have the same manufacturing date, May 12, 1885, have incised in their bottom panel; although, the company made these toy safes for a number of years. The Fidelity Trust appears to have been manufactured in one size only, 5.25 inches tall, while the Safe Deposit came in two sizes. The smallest one was 5.25 inches tall and the large one was 8.5 inches tall and weighed nearly 12 pounds, making it a very heavy toy.

The large Safe Deposit was also the fancier of the



Building. While Voinovich has housed the show before, it hasn't been the site of the January opener. The move was necessary due to redevelopment of the fairgrounds, including the demolition of several buildings, leaving limited space for concurrent events.

Though Voinovich was smaller and somewhat harder to find, dealers were generally pleased with the venue. They appreciated the easy load-in, made possible by multiple overhead doors, and good lighting that made merchandise more visible. The smaller size wasn't an issue, as the January show is smaller than others. Nevertheless, around 200 vendors filled 400 spaces spread across the main auditorium, a



hallway traversing the building, and a smaller secondary space.

Dealers seemed quite pleased with the turnout. Show officials anticipated 5,000 to 10,000 attendees over the weekend. Since Scott doesn't charge admission, patronage benefits from spillover traffic from other events happening at the Expo Center. This time, four functions - including a golf show and a swimming pool/hot tub expo brought a nice influx of shoppers on top of everyone who came solely for the antique show.

Compared to those pre-holiday, the January market had a distinct bargain-hunting flavor, with more collectibles and glassware than higher-end antiques. Many spaces featured \$1 and \$5 merchandise, giving the show an inviting, deal-hunting atmosphere. It's also one of the few places in the Midwest where resellers can load up on wholesale inventory during the colder months. Shop owners and vintage dealers were often spotted buying in bulk from show vendors.

While sports memorabilia and pop culture merchandise may have been prevalent, serious antiquers still had much to explore. Spread throughout were quality



Many of the better antiques were offered by vendors who have participated at Scott for years. One of them, Natalie Palma from Cincinnati, co-owner of BN Antiques, has sold at every Columbus Scott show for 14 years. In her booth was everything from antique photographs to country store furnishings. It was also one of the booths where resellers were snapping up inventory.

From Columbus came Dennis Eifel and fellow dealer Ray Bullock, fixtures at Scott shows. Eifel specializes in early 20th-century Ohio-made pottery like Hull and McCoy and had an impressive array of Royal Copley wildfowl figures. Both he and Bullock praised the venue and noted how busy Saturday had been.

Representing mid-century era — and making its Scott debut was special guest Gay Fad Studios from nearby Lancaster, Ohio. Founded by pioneering female entrepreneur Fran Taylor, Gay Fad was a leading maker of glassware from 1939 to 1962. The brand was revived by Jason and David Annecy, who offer remaining sets of Taylor's original merchandise alongside new cocktail glasses that stay true to the originals, often hand-painted with atomic-era patterns.

Another new arrival was LeAnne and Kyle Taylor, owners of Columbus' Retro Revival.

The Antique Mechanical Bank Reference Guide (www. mechanicalbanksonline. com) lists a "Presto, Penny Changes to Quarter" toy bank that was made by Henry C. Hart Mfg. Co. in 1884.

According Mechanical Banks Online, Henry C. Hart Mfg. was still manufacturing toy safes as late as 1898 when it produced the "Smyth X-Ray Bank." Smyth X-Ray banks have proven to be quite expensive on the secondary toy market. One sold in 2017 for \$2,700.

Two things all Hart toy banks had in common was they taught children to trust banks and save money and they were nearly indestructible.

HartThe Manufacturing Company may be best known for producing the "Matchless"


Today, collectors love Hart's toy safes. Their rugged, cast iron construction allowed for many of them to survive the past 125 years nearly intact, making them highly sought after toy banks.

If you are looking for these vintage pieces of Michigan's toy past, expect to pay about \$150 for one of Hart's safes. But keep it because it is guaranteed to earn you interest on your initial investment if you hold on to it long enough.

with his specialties being Winchester firearms, Savage 99 lever action rifles and historic military arms.

"Whenever you came to his shop, he would be behind his desk, with his feet up, telling stories, (several of which were rumored to actually be true)! He was the classic knowledgeable, old gentleman that would invite you for a cup of coffee and talk guns, or anything else that would inspire a joke or another story," according to Albrecht staff members.

Highlights of the auction include several Savage 99s, lots of Winchester 86 and 73's, model 100's and even a rare model 36 9mm rimfire. In Winchester shotguns, a near perfect Model 41, Model 12 in 20-gauge, and an excellent Model 12 trap. Also offered is a perfect Ithaca Model 51 with exhibition grade wood, and a nice Model 37.
