Christie doll in its original box hits \$270 at Hasty

COLDWATER, Mich. — Brian Hasty Auction Company didn't let a bit of cold weather and a fresh blanket of pure white snow dampen a recent auction held in Coldwater. The snow had been coming off and on for a few days, but the prices at this auction kept going up.

"I thought having an auction live inside where it's warm, would give people a chance to get out of the house," said Hasty. And he was right.

Most of the items for

sale at this auction belonged to Hasty's mother, who passed away a few years ago. "She never met a doll or a figurine she didn't like," said Hasty. And there was indeed a vast selection of collectible dolls and enough variety of miscellaneous items to keep everyone's attention.

One of the top-selling items of the day may have surprised most of the people in attendance. It only takes two people bidding against each other to drive prices up, and there was no doubt that at least two in attendance knew exactly what they were looking at inside a small sandwich bag. It was filled with vintage Wearever and Parker fountain pens. The dubs appeared in excellent

condition. With a great selection of pens, this grouping was auctioned off for a final bid price of \$200.

A few vintage children's toys were offered. A United Van Lines toy advertised "Moving with care everywhere" on the side. It was missing the back door and in played-with condition, but it would still display well. This orange and cream-colored van-type truck was sold for the respectable bid price of \$80.

One toy that brought back many family memories for the older crowd was a Jackie Gleason bus. This tin toy proclaimed to be the "Honeymooner's special" and showed the television show's main characters riding on the

Collectors love taking a swing at Goudey baseball cards

Traditionally, bubble gum chewing and base-

ball cards share a long-standing history that dates back to the early years of the Great Depression. The tradi-

tion of including a free baseball trading card in every pack of bubble gum began in the 1930s when Goudey Gum Company started inserting a baseball card into a pack of bubble gum. This combination of baseball cards and bubble gum became hugely popular in the United States.

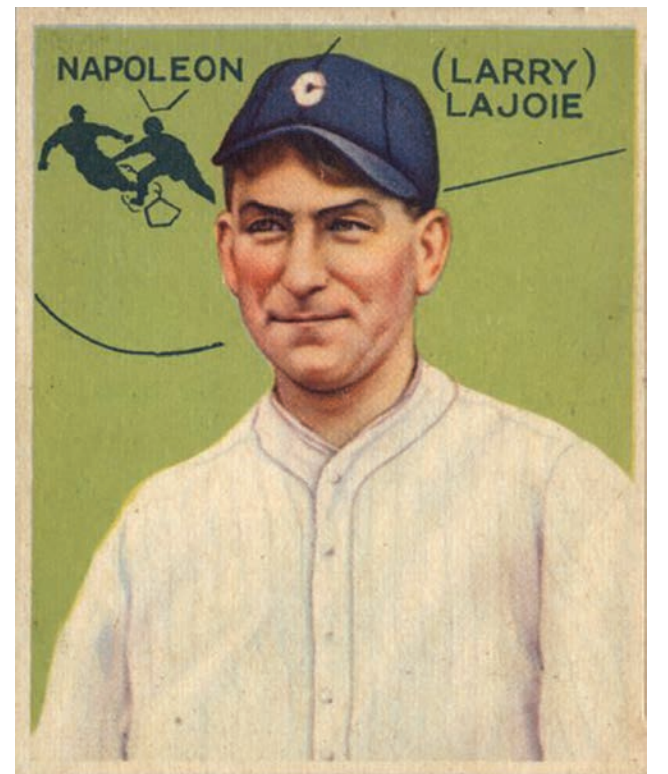
Enos Gordon Goudey founded the Goudey Gum Company in Boston in 1919, later moving his business to Allston. Goudey retained ownership of the company until 1932 and retired from the

company in 1933. William Wrigley, of Wrigley Gum, called Goudey, "The penny gum king of America."

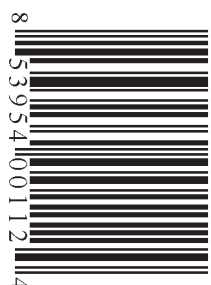
Baseball cards and bubble gum helped ease some of the heartbreak of the Depression by allowing youngsters to chew gum while playing with and trading baseball cards. There is little doubt that children in the 1930s and '40s knew more about baseball players than children at any other era in



American history. Bubble gum served as a bonus item in a package of baseball cards, adding an element of

chewing excitement to the hobby of baseball card collecting.

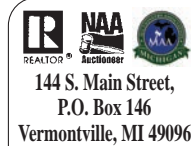

on their faces. Made by Emerald City Toys, this piece sold for \$110.

A toy pipe-carrying truck was in excellent condition. It was still loaded heavily with the matching pipes that occupied the truck's bed. The wheels looked as if they hadn't even rolled along the ground. It sold for a bid of \$65. A Texaco truck with a white cab and the associated red color of Texaco was offered. The Texaco lettering on this toy was still in great shape. It was rolled away for a bid of \$50.

A filled fishing tackle box had everyone gathering around. It was sold as one unit, and no choices were offered first. So if you wanted to own one of the many items inside, you had to bid on the entire box. The bid's kept rising since it was full of valuable lures, weights, and other fishing supplies. It took an impressive bid of \$185 to close this box and carry it home

to see what treasures were in the bottom.

A vintage wall-hanging clock was sold for a bid of \$65. It had the small clock face on the top of a cabinet, and then the picture of a beautiful girl graced the door that opened on the bottom. No idea if the clock worked, but the clock hands were there and with just a bit of cleaning and tender loving care, this would make a gorgeous display piece.

"Drink Pepsi: Cola Bigger. Better" didn't waste any space on the chalkboard; it was written on. This chalkboard was a great original piece and stood out. This valuable piece of history couldn't be taken away until the bid reached \$170.

She came with her book, and Midge took good care of her things since the book was still wrapped in plastic with her. It took a bid of \$140 to tuck away this best friend.

In 1983, Chatty Patty came along. Patty could talk if you pulled her string. This one was still in her original box, in unplayed condition. She was made by Mattel just like Barbie and her

friends. In her cute pink dress and all original, it took a bid of \$100 to tuck Chatty Patty away.

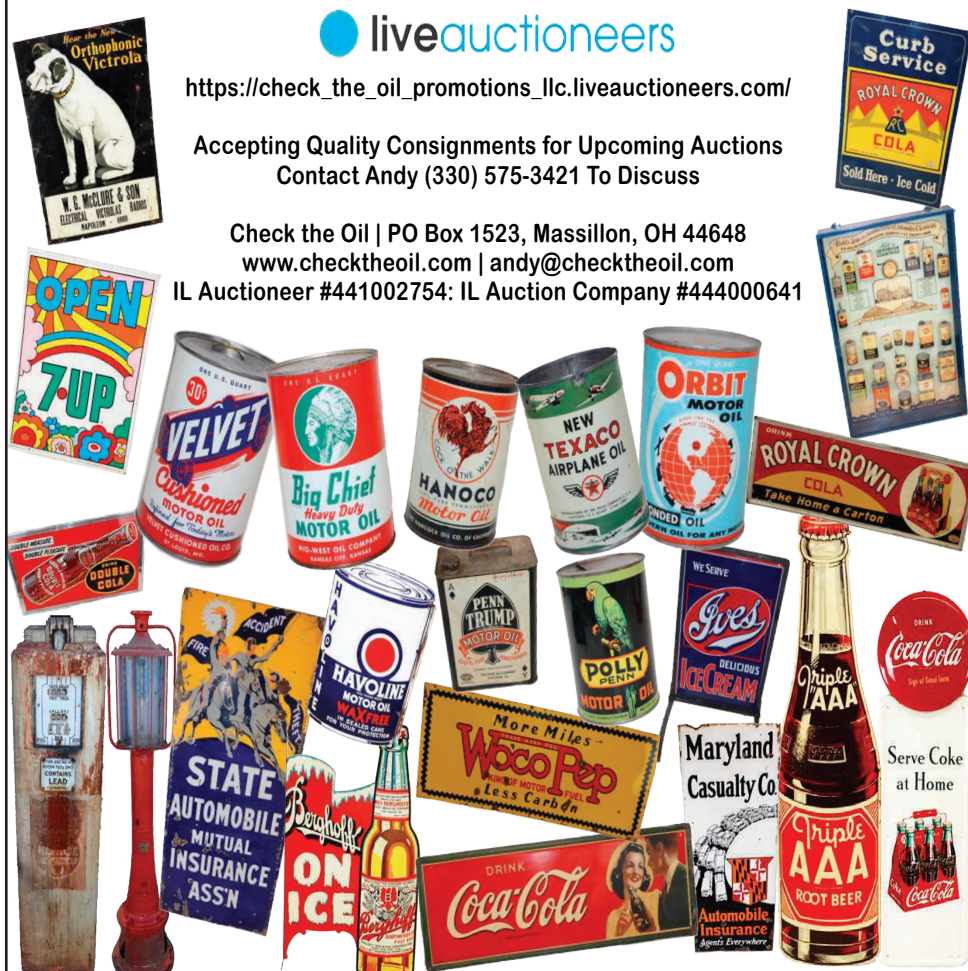

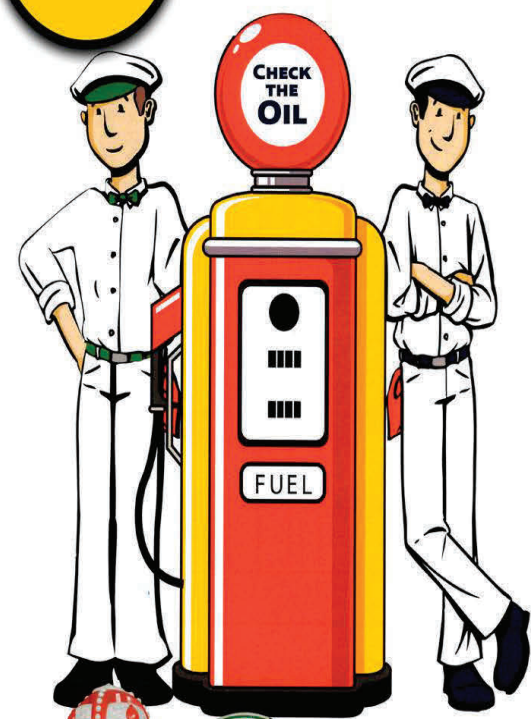

Topps Chewing Gum, founded in 1938, became the leader in the growing baseball trading card industry. Topps dominated the baseball trading card market in the 1940s, '50s, and '60s, when chewing gum and trading baseball cards was the rage among young boys. In many ways, from the 1970s and on, Topps dominated the collecting field as well.

Die-hard collectors, however, strive for diversity and uniqueness in their baseball card collections, and there is no greater or sought after baseball card mini-collection than owning all of Goudey Gum's original 1933 baseball cards.

Goudey's 1933 240-card set were the first ever baseball gum trading cards. This set, along with the T206 and 1952 Topps are considered the "Big Three" in baseball card sets.

The rarest, and most sought after, trading card from Goudey's 1933 set is card number 106, which featured retired player Napoleon "Larry" Lajoie. Lajoie

played second base for 21 seasons, beginning his career with the Philadelphia Phillies in 1896.

When Goudey baseball cards were first designed, there were 240 cards to a set. Each card could be obtained in a pack of Goudey gum, so any collector could collect all 240 cards, or so the public thought. Card #106, Napoleon Lajoie, was not printed or included in the original 240-card set. Goudey did not mention this oversight to the public. When Goudey finally had a stack of Lajoie cards, the company kept them, issuing a card only to collectors that sent letters to the Goudey Gum Company

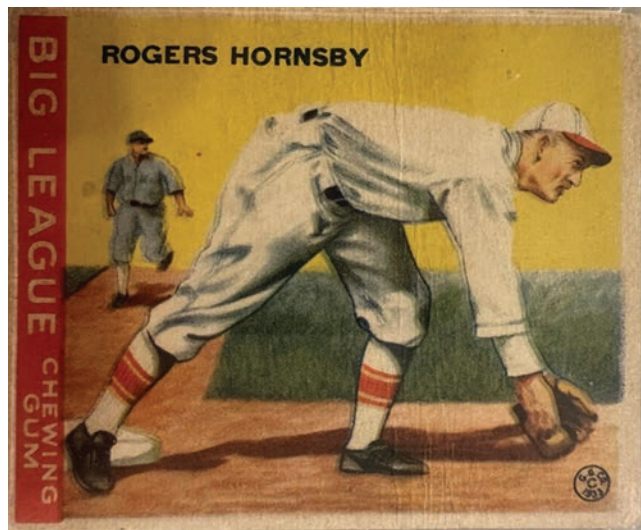
complaining about the lack of the Lajoie card.

Today, the 1933 Goudey #106 Napoleon Lajoie card is known as one of the "Big Three" collectible baseball cards along with two cards from the T206 set depicting Eddie Plank and Honus Wagner. A good condition Lajoie card sells for around \$385,000.

Some of the famous baseball players that appeared on Goudey baseball cards include Lou Gehrig, Babe Ruth, Ty Cobb, Bennie Bengough, Dick Bartell, Mel Ott, Paul Waner and Joe DiMaggio.

In the 1960s, following the collapse of Goudey Gum, most of the company's unreleased baseball cards and the printing plates that made them were thrown away, guaranteeing that no original cards, beyond those already owned by collectors, would ever be available again.

Collectors should beware of 1933 Goudey baseball card reprints. The Renata Galasso Company reprinted the entire 1933 Goudey set in 1983.

Ohio's Tiki scene explodes at Mai Tai Mayhem

RICHFIELD, Ohio — Here's an enticing cocktail recipe: combine one part Polynesian Pop art, decor, and clothing. Stir in a generous dose of mid-century-inspired events and workshops. Pour in plenty of rum, and top it off with a vibrant shake from bands playing a retro tiki soundtrack. Serve it in a nostalgic setting — and voila — you have the makings of the country's newest "tiki weekender," Ohio's Mai Tai Mayhem.

Hardcore tiki fans are passionate about their events, with weekend-long gatherings stirring up the most excitement. The grand-daddy of them all is San Diego's Tiki Oasis which has been going strong for a quarter century. The Hukilau, started in Atlanta and later relocated to Fort Lauderdale near the legendary Mai Kai Polynesian palace, is only a few years younger. Newcomers include Atlanta's Inuhele and Tiki Caliente in Palm Springs. Mai Tai Mayhem landed on the grass skirt map near Akron on the weekend of March 7-9.

The event was conceived by Sean and Jessie Coffee, owners of Akron's Tiki Underground, after attending Inuhele with a colleague. Jessie recalled, "He encouraged us to do a similar weekend-long celebration in Ohio and was convinced that even people from New

York would attend." Planning began two years ago, with a trial run last year.

After the trial run, attention turned to finding the right venue for several hundred guests. A former Holiday Inn Holodome — itself a piece of mid-20th-century history — was the obvious choice. Holodomes were indoor entertainment areas featured in many Holiday Inns during the 1970s and 80s. They offered climate-controlled spaces with amenities like swimming pools, bars, mini golf, and arcades, ensuring year-round fun regardless of the weather. CNN once referred to them as, "Adult amusement parks of yesterday." A bonus: it was

just 10 minutes from Tiki Underground.

Mai Tai Mayhem took over the entire property (now a Quality Inn & Suites), which offered ample presentation and vendor space, dining areas, and the convenience of enjoying the weekend without ever needing to leave the building. It also allowed for "room crawls" — pop-up bars hosted by adventurous guests alongside multiple Ohio tiki bars. Considering the two inches of snow that fell on Friday, holding things in the warm, indoor tropical atmosphere was certainly the right choice!

Things unofficially started Thursday evening with bus excursions to Cleveland's Porco Lounge and the nearby Tiki Underground. Friday marked the official kickoff, featuring events like a free tiki item swap, themed Putt-Putt, and "easy listening" bingo. Seminars included local mixologist and author Tim Harnett's session

on using whiskey in tiki drinks, Margo Scott (aka Rocket Betty) offering tips on thrifting an affordable Polynesian wardrobe, and tiki road-tripping by author and photographer Tiki Tom Tom. Additionally, Friday saw the unveiling of the Ohio Tiki History exhibit featuring artifacts from the beloved, though long gone, Columbus Kahiki restaurant.

By Friday evening, two dozen vendors had arrived from as far as Chicago, Milwaukee, Torrance, Calif., and Westchester, N.Y. They filled a convention room, the adjacent hall, and several nearby rooms with Polynesian Pop furniture, hundreds of new and vintage tiki mugs, mid-century barware, carvings, Oceanic art, nautical decor, retro-themed handcrafts, and plenty of classic Aloha wear. A special guest was Gay Fad Studios from Lancaster, Ohio, which has been making waves with its revival of the company's mid-century glassware designs. Impromptu shopping began long before Saturday's marketplace officially opened.

Throughout the day and into the evening, DJs and bands played a tiki soundtrack while guests mingled, enjoyed activities, and imbibed on a selection of tiki cocktails offered at multiple locations. As night

fell, more bands took the stage, and the room crawls began, featuring four bars nicknamed the Ohiohana — Tiki Underground (Akron), Huli Huli (Columbus), Porco Lounge (Cleveland), and Tiki Tiki Bang Bang (Cincinnati). Additional drinks were served by Ohio home bars like Columbus' Shipwreck Shirley's.

Alongside Saturday's centerpiece, the marketplace there was also a vinyl record swap. The day also held a presentation on the golden age of tiki in Ohio, a hula-hoop making workshop, and rum tastings. A special "supper club" dinner featured the acclaimed melody percussionist Roland Remington, who played Exotica from tiki's mid-century heyday. After dinner, the night continued with three more hours of live bands and room crawls.

The festivities wrapped up on Sunday with a lively Aloha brunch before attendees began their journeys home. As things came to a close, Jessie Coffee took a moment to reflect on the weekend's success. A remarkable 23 states were represented. "The response was much better than we

expected, and the feedback has been great." Vendors shared the sentiment. Stephen Razdik, owner of Pittsburgh's U'Niki'An'Tiki, arrived at Mai Tai Mayhem right after the DC Big Flea. "From the moment I walked in the door, I could feel the energy and the oha-na," he said. Ohio tiki historian and DJ Jeff Chenault said much the same, "A wonderful event and so very well organized...the food, vendors, entertainment, and seminars were all top-notch!"

Jessie Coffee acknowledged it was a major undertaking. "There were lots of moving parts, but it all worked." When asked about how she envisioned the future for Mai Tai Mayhem, Coffee remarked, "Our goal is to draw in people who are unfamiliar with Ohio. It's important to have something like this in Ohio because the state has such prominent tiki history and culture." With that said, it looks like all the ingredients are in place for another unforgettable Mai Tai Mayhem next year.

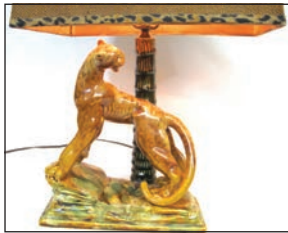
