### Brass centerpiece vessels carried a \$14,000 bid at Neue

Auctions concluded a 400+ lot auction offered inent Ohio estates: one a Chinese

meticulously filled saltbox-style home in Hudson, Ohio, and the other a BEACHWOOD, Ohio fourth-generation - On March 14, Neue Cleveland family. The highly anticipated sale on rare collectibles, span-Live Auctioneers, featur- ning Shaker furniture ing items from two prom- and Georgian glass to porcelain,

American and European art, and schoolhouse samplers. Many pieces had never been available to the public before.

Highlights included a pair of circa 1925 "Aufsatz" brass centerpiece vessels, which received the auction's highest and only five-figure bid at \$14,000. Designed by Josef Hoffmann (Austrian, 1870-1956) and made by the Wiener Werkstätte, the 7.5 by 11-inch vessels feature gadrooned forms, scalloped rims, whimsical curlicued handles, and circular pedestal feet. Only 293 were made, with a pair exhibited at the 1925 Paris Exposition Internationale des Arts Décoratifs.

Two dozen additional lots received four-figure

56 by 26-inch Chinese lacquered doors that brought \$7,000. Despite age-related wear, the doors were in good condition and featured dragons chasing flaming pearls with bronze hardware. A 14K gold, circa 1963 cigarette case fetched \$4,900. Measuring 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> by 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>

bids, including a pair of inches and weighing 124 grams, it had a solid vellow gold case, hinged cross security, and interior monogramming. A bid of \$1,500 won a 19th-century Roman-style faux marble architectural niche. Standing 44 inches tall, it consisted of a triangular pediment sitting on four columns on a

stepped base with faux flaming urns.

Four of two dozen paintings and prints breezed past \$1,000. Among them was a 28 by 33-inch (framed) 19th-century American School oil on canvas

### From corn to cookie jars; Shawnee Pottery delights

Brothers Malcolm A. Schweiker and Roy W. Schweiker founded Shawnee Pottery of Zanesville, Ohio, in 1937, and, at the peak of their President McKinley in production, Shawnee Pottery was producing Encaustic's main product 100,000 ceramic pieces per day.

The Schweiker brothers used the remnants of the American Tiling Encaustic

American Encaustic Tiling opened its milliondollar facility, located at 2200 Linden Avenue, on April 19, 1892. The building was dedicated by Governor William McKinley, who became 1897.American was the manufacturing of tiles, requiring a two-step process that first fired the clay and then the glaze. These tiles were quite durable due to the high

manufacturing companies in the world, but due to the Great Depression, American Encaustic closed its doors in 1937 when the building and its kilns were sold.

Shawnee Pottery continued the two-step process used by American Encaustic Tiling Company, which helped Shawnee manufacture a very durable dinnerware. The greenware (unfired

under glaze was applied to the pottery, and the pottery was fired again. Finally, paint was applied. The application of paint over the glaze was referred to as cold paint. Due to the age of Shawnee pieces, the cold paint has noticeably deteriorated over time. In its infancy, Shawnee Potterv produced

George depicting Washington's Newburgh, N.Y., headquarters, bid to \$2,800. The good-condition painting showed some craquelure and an old repair. A 1916-era 11¼ by 16½ Japanese woodblock print by William Charles Bartlett (1860-1940), published by Watanabe, brought \$1,600. Bidding also reached \$1,400 for a 27½ by 33½ inch (framed) 19th-century oil on canvas of a homestead and hay harvest, with minor condition issues like craquelure.


Three out of more than a dozen sculptural items also surpassed \$1,000. The highest went to a 19th-century items also attracted Italian marble bust of a Medieval beauty, gar- 17th/18th-century nering \$6,500. The American excellent-condition, 22 two-drawer chest that by 18 by 9-inch bust, was carved from polished white marble and sat atop a 45-inch pedestal with a green marble base. Several furniture strong bids, including a pine reached \$2,600. The 36<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> by 41<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> by 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-inch chest, featuring old hand-made iron hinges, had a rectangular lift top over faux drawers, two long lower drawers, Kepenyes and sat on a molded base with ball feet. A back cupboard scored \$2,000. This 78.5 by 38

by 18-inch cabinet, with good patina, had a rectangular top with hinged doors opening to fixed shelves and a lower section with hinged doors on a tapered leg base. Bidding went to a modest \$1,000 for a 70-inch-tall Massachusetts-made Eldred Wheeler Queen Anne-style tiger maple flat-top highboy. It was constructed as two parts, with a fan-carved drawer over two short drawers and four long drawers on top, and a frieze drawer and three deep drawers on the bottom, all resting on cabriole legs with pad feet.

While some lots commanded impressive pric-

The 12-inch-tall vessel with loop handles and hand-painted cobalt detailing, featured stenciling that read, "Joseph Fleming Wholesale and Retail Druggist, No. 84 Market Street. Pittsburgh, PA," and was in good condition with small chips.

style diamond necklace garnered \$1,700, while two pairs of 18K yellow gold clip earrings brought \$1,100 each. Meanwhile, a 3-gram vintage amethyst and diamond ring in 10K vellow gold, featuring four oval-cut amethysts and melee diamonds. grabbed just \$50. 





dinnerware for George Rumrill. The first products were primarily decorative items like figurines and cookie jars that could be found in "five and dime" stores, such as McCrory, S.S. Kresge, and F. W. Woolworth Company.

Not long after Shawnee Pottery began production in 1937, Sears Roebuck and Company approached the pottery and asked the company to design a line of dinnerware known as Valencia, and a line of

kitchenware exclusively for Sears stores. This contract with Sears helped stabilize Shawnee Pottery and ensure its success.

Sears' 1945 catalog offered sets of the Shawnee salt and pepper shakers (farmer pigs, watering can, and winking owl) at 47cents each and Shawnee teapots for \$1.29 (horizontal ribbed base) and \$1.59 (vertical ribbed base) each.

According Bev to Mangus, author of "Shawnee Pottery," the firm began manufacturing dinnerware at just the right moment in history. As World War II approached many 'Buy American' campaigns were conducted". These "Buy American" campaigns coupled with Shawnee Pottery's durable dinnerware gave the fledging pottery some much needed sales.

Shawnee Pottery quickly became known for its line of novelty ware, including vases, planters, lamps, cookie jars, and flowerpots. The company Right: Rare, Shawnee Pottery "Howdy Doody" bank from 1957. This bank was only produced for one year and is valued at \$475.

also produced three dinnerware lines - Corn, Lobster Ware, and Valencia. Its line of Corn King pottery became its most successful line. This line included White Corn utility pieces (produced in 1945), Corn King pieces (produced from 1946 -1954), and Corn Queen ware (produced from 1954 - 1961). The Corn King and Corn Queen lines of dinnerware were molded and color glazed to resemble actual ears of corn. Pieces in these lines included teapots, dinner plates, and salt and pepper shakers.

Today, collectors search for Shawnee Pottery items and relish finding Corn King pieces or Shawnee's prized colorful pig cookie jars. Shawnee Pottery's earliest Smiley Pig cookie jars were cold painted and offered with either a red or



blue scarf. When first produced, these cookie jars sold wholesale for \$12 per dozen.

If you are interested in all of the marks used on Shawnee cookie jars, Mike Schneider's "The Complete Cookie Jar Book" is an excellent resource.

A declining market, due largely to imported dinner wares and plastic wares, forced Shawnee Pottery to close its doors in 1961.

Everything Shawnee Pottery produced is collectible, but cookie jars are what collectors desire most. The Smiley Pig, Puss n' Boots, Winnie Pig,

Muggsy Dog, and Dutch Jack and Jill are some of the more sought after cookie jars produced by Shawnee Pottery. Smiley Pig is the most desired of all Shawnee cookie jars. Smiley Pig gold-trimmed jars are the most desired and they normally cost the most. In 2002 a Shawnee Pottery Smiley Pig cookie jar sold for \$6,750 at Kent Mickelson Auction House in Missouri.

Novice collectors should study vintage Shawnee Pottery cookie jars before making expensive purchases. Terrace Ceramics bought Shawnee

Puss N' Boots cookie jar by Shawnee Pottery with creamer, salt and pepper. This set is valued at \$85.



Pottery's cookie jar molds when the company closed in 1961. Some Terrace cookie jars look like a Shawnee Pottery jar, but Terrace Ceramics' cookie jars lacked the quality and design that Shawnee was famous for. These inferior jars should clearly be marked "Terrace Ceramics."


Also, in the mid-1990s, a second Shawnee Pottery Company began selling cookie jars with the markings "USA" and "Shawnee" impressed on their bottoms. Collectors need to recognize these knock-off Shawnee cookie jars.

### Prohibition did not stop people from drinking as barware attests

Prohibition may have made the purchase of liquor illegal in the United States between 1920and 1933; but that did not stop people from imbibing. Prior to Prohibition consumption of alcohol was something often done outside of the home; but during Prohibition people began to became better acquainted with the tools of the bartender's trade.

Manufacturers responded to this by turning out items that could serve a wide variety of purposes - including consumption of alcohol if the consumer knew what he or she was looking for. For example there were portable "serving carts" with the notation they "can be padlocked". These could be "noiselessly rolled out with all the fixings". . .and just as noiselessly rolled back, into an unobtrusive dining room or sitting room corner. There were ice buckets. Ice crushers. Ice strainers. And, such a host of oversize "water pitchers" and jumbo "water gob-

lets" that it seemed most Co. ad, "eager hands 1930s consumers must have lived within gasping distance of Death Valley.

Prohibition When finally gurgled its last, consumers were quickly treated to a heady (and, at long last legal) brew of drinking accessories. "For the first summer of Repeal," crowed a 1934 Chase Brass & Copper

reach for Chase."

Prohibition When faded from view, the burgeoning market for bar essentials remained, and giftware makers jumped into the fray. Drinking buddies could now debate —openly — the merits of Kensington's "Coldchester Cocktail Shaker" ("cleverly fitted with cork") versus the Chase

"Blue Moon" ("it pours without dripping").

Even prior to Repeal, manufacturers had tacitly acknowledged that some of their product line was put to other than intended uses. The July, 1930 issue of "The Gift and Art Shop," for instance, mentions Chase beverage trays treated with a "lacquer which makes them

impervious to the disastrous effects of some popular liquids." They weren't talking about Ovaltine.

This sparkling new vista seemed to inspire Deco designers. At Chase, the line of "Drinking Accessories" ranged from the practical (the Harry Laylon/Theodore Low "Squeezit Bottle Opener"), to the fanciful ("Corker Sets" with odd little toppers depicting such characters as a "Flapper" and a "Cuckoo"), to the breath-taking (the "Bacchus" set by Ruth and William Gerth).

An interesting sidelight was the tandem popularity of items related to drinking only by association. Consider, for instance, the Chase "Pretzelman," that first appeared in "The Gift And Art Shop," of May 1933. Beer and pretzels must have been a popular pairing: along with "Pretzelman," three pretzel holders from other companies were also on view in the article, under the heading "New Things for the Thirsty."

On other fronts, colorful glassware and ceramics jockeyed for space with shiny metals on the shelves of home bars. McKee Glass brought out the "Bottoms-Up Tumbler," a racy "nudie" number that was a top-seller with the college crowd. More formal

were Morgantown's "Top Hat" cocktail glasses, with a dapper top-hatted gent on each stem. Visual variety was provided through the use of modernistic designs and textures, from ribbed to rippled. Among the most interesting: Morgantown's "Palazzo" cocktail glasses with their stacked-disk stems: McKee's "donut hole" decanter, its open center repeated in the design of the corker; and the many-edged, crushed-paper-bag styling of Consolidated's "Ruby Rombic" decanter set. Aladin even produced figural flasks that did double-duty as music boxes. Most decidedly Deco of all: figural Robj decanters, which decamped from Paris, and found new fans on domestic shores.

Introduced in the early 1920s, Robj decanters, flasks, and liqueur bottles are among the most sought-after (and most expensive) barware collectibles. Combining colorful European costuming and themes with a bright sense of whimsy, they continue to charm, decades after their original contents have disappeared down the hatch.

While the 1920s and '30s gave birth to plenty of sophisticated barware, those decades also gave birth to plenty of sophis-



Among them: multiple, and increasingly complex, variations on that Art Deco mainstay, the "cocktail."

In black-and-white movie musical extravaganzas of the 1930s, night-clubbers watching a lavish floor show invariably clutch omnipresent cocktail glasses. The concept of the mixed drink had, however, been around long before then, and the stories surrounding its creation are numerous. The most drama-filled has the cocktail making its debut in Revolutionary War days. The upper crust of American and French military men patronized a Yorktown, N.Y., tavern operated by Betsy Flanagan. For the Americans, the drink of choice at Flanagan's was gin or whiskey; for the French, wine or vermouth. When the time came for a toast, the liquors were often combined with joyous abandon.

Perhaps filled with liquid courage, one enterprising officer absconded with a rooster belonging to a nearby farmer still loyal to the Crown. The ever-practical Betsy cooked up the rooster for her guests, putting its colorful tail feathers to good use adorning their mixed drinks. The toast for the evening: "Vive le cock-tail!" A beverage legend was born.

During the Deco years, the names of the numerous cocktail combos available were often more interesting than the drinks themselves. There were the seemingly-innocuous ("The Sweet Patootie," "The Fairy Bell"); the high-hat ("The Vanderbilt," "The Fox Trot"); the slightly risqué ("The Soul Kiss," "The Widow's Dream"); and even the potentially lethal ("The Rattle-"The Knocksnake," Out," and "The Third Rail"). The hallmark of the cocktail, however, remained constant: combining the unlikely with the unusual, to create the un-put-down-able. The rooster feather was optional. Throughout Prohibi-

tion, the Deco home bar was, by necessity, a movable feast. But make no mistake about it: drinks were still quite definitely on (and in) the house. After Repeal, it was a veritable "happy hour" for Art Deco designers, with a heady flow of accessories specifically intended for the now front-and-center home bar. Perhaps because the field of drinking accessories was a relatively new one, designers felt-or were given-more freedom to experiment with form and function.

The"Exposition Internationale des Arts Décoratifs et Industriels Modernes" opened in Paris 100 years ago this month. Often referred to as the "Art Deco Exposition," the event ran from April 29 thru Oct. 25, 1925, and served as an inspiration for many designers of the era.




