1965 Chevy Impala drives off with \$73,000 bid

NEAPOLIS, Ohio — Whalen Realty & Auction Ltd. recently held a large advertising auction, which generated some impressive sales numbers.

The king of this show was the featured item, which was a 1964 Impala. This Chevrolet Super Sport appeared to be all original, except for the battery and fuel pump. It showed only 8,077 miles and featured a 327 turbocharged engine. It was equipped with a four-speed transmission. It was a two-owner car. locally owned in the area where it was being sold. It didn't have any working brakes, but neither did the bidding, so it was perfectly

issue either, as the beautiful bluish-gray paint job made for a delightful image. The price continued to rise for this collector's dream, and it took someone digging deep into their

paired. Rust wasn't an pocket to become the new owner of this beauty. It ultimately reached a final bid price of \$73,000 before being declared sold.

A second Chevrolet Impala was also offered. This one was a 1963 four-

door. It was all original, with 42,667 miles showing on the odometer. It was powered by a 283 smallblock automatic and had been family-owned since new. This automobile was the same color as the other

one, except it sported a white top. It brought a final bid of \$17,000,

A national Simplex clock face gasoline pump was offered. Even though this one needed to be completely restored, it stood a proud

90 inches tall. And it showed it was in demand when it pumped out the highest price of any of the gasoline pumps offered for sale. The hammer didn't

Rabbits have been holding doors open for years

Most people know that a doorstop is an object or device used to hold open a door from opening too Decorativewidely. doorstops were quite popular in the late 1800s

and early 1900s, up until about 1960 when air conditioning became for the affordable masses. It was the Industrial Revolution a door or used to prevent that allowed cast iron doorstops to, quite literally, sweep open the doors of America, and it was on December 10,



1878, that Osborn Dorsey (a 19th century black American inventor) was given credit for inventing what is commonly known as the doorstop. Dorsey received patent number 210,764 for his invention.

Since Dorsey patented his doorstop mechanism. many other inventors have received patents for their own doorstop ideas and variations. Floormounted doorstops, door-mounted doorstops, rotating doorstops, electronic and magnetic doorstops and "wedge" traditional doorstops are all in use. However, the doorstop that attracts collectors is the old-fashioned, castiron doorstop.



America has always been a country based on themes or interests, and doorstops collecting exemplifies this statement. Some doorstop collectors seek any decorative, cast-iron doorstops that interest them; however, many collectors organize their doorstop collection around a theme. One popular theme is Easter rabbits.

The Easter bunny is a folklore figure and symbol of Easter, depicting a rabbit, often dressed in clothes, that brings Easter eggs to good children. This



fall on this project until the bidding reached an impressive \$4,300.

Trying not to be outpriced was a Fry visible gasoline pump. This one had a Texaco reproduction globe and a Powell twospeed nozzle. It had a plastic cylinder and a replacement top. However, it was also in demand and sold for the final bid price of \$3,500.

A Wayne Model 70 gasoline pump showed off a Sinclair H-C glass. It featured a Sinclair Power-X over 100 octane globe and had a super-octane cover. It was in nice shape and would make a good restoration project. It took \$2,800 to load this giant

A blue Sunoco Martin & Schwartz Inc. gasoline pump was only 62 inches tall. This one was more modern in appearance, but it came in with a final selling price of \$ 2,450. There was a partially restored

Tokheim gasoline pump. This one was a Shell visible unit and brought a respectable bid of \$2,350.

Another visible gasoline pump was offered. It needed restoration as it had rust holes and the glass was broken. It stood 115 inches tall, and despite its rough condition, it brought a final bid price of \$ 1,900. A Gilbarco gasoline pump that required complete restoration was sold for \$1,100. It was 78 inches in

height.

The advertising signs drew their share of bidders. An Ethyl Bartles gasoline sign was double-sided. This one measured 30 inches in diameter. It had some surface damage across the "Gasoline" lettering. The Ethyl Gasoline Corporation, based in New York, had its information lettered in the center of the sign. With a pretty skyblue background, it was easy to see the wording on this sign. It took a bid of \$3,000 to take home this rare piece of advertising.

A Texaco sign was displaying the familiar red star associated with the brand. This one was a grand 72 inches in diame-

sign for the brand sold for \$2,200.

ter and was double-sided porcelain. It sold for \$2,700. The red star had a large green "T" in the center, with "Texaco" written above it.

A 42-inch diameter Pontiac sign had attracted attention before it reached the auction. Someone had used it for shooting practice and left several holes in the piece. This sign showed the red colored outline of an Indian's head in the center, and this is what was shot at. However, the Pontiac

Authorized Service sign was still an excellent display piece. The signature dark blue background made the lettering stand out, and this historical piece still had lots of life left in it. It was double-sided porcelain, allowing it to be seen from either direction. It garnered a respectable bid of \$2.600.

Falling a bit short of the Pontiac sign selling price, a Goodyear Tires sign still commanded a bid of \$2,300. This double-sided sign came complete with the flange sign bracket. The winged flying shoe was meant to convey that the Goodyear tires would move one down the road in record time.

Selling for \$2,200 was a Magnolene Motor Oils

advertising piece. It was double-sided porcelain and measured almost 30 inches in diameter. The Magnolia Petroleum Company branded its name around the outside edge of this piece, and the lettering in the middle advertised that Magnolene Motor Oils were available for sale at this location. The white lettering stood out against the dark red and blue background.

A beautifully restored refrigerator attracted attention. This model was a Philco automatic, dating back to the 1950s. The glossy red finish made it pop. It brought a final bid price of \$2,000.



Celluloid toys rattled, rocked and rolled into Easter baskets

What would Easter be without bunnies, chicks and eggs, and what kid wouldn't be thrilled to wake up in the morning and discover their basket stuffed with chocolate, jellybeans and a few surprises as well?

Just as it is today, that's the way it was a hundred years ago - but little playthings were very much different than they are now. In days of old, most Easter toys were fashioned out of a light-weight plastic material called celluloid - and they were adorable. Small enough to fit into eager little hands and charming enough to rattle, rock and roll into the hearts of collectors today.

The Viscoloid Company of Leominster, Mass., was established by Bernard Doyle and three other men in 1901, with the intention of replacing cattle horn with celluloid for the production of decorative hair combs and dresser sets. Their faux tortoise shell and imitation ivory goods enjoyed great success until around 1910 when ladies' hair styles began to change. With sales lagging, the company needed to expand their product line in order to make money.

The opportunity pre-

sented itself in 1914, with the onset of World War I. At that time trade with European toy makers ended and opportunity knocked on the door of Bernard Doyle. In order to enter the toy making industry, Doyle hired artist Paul Kramme — a German designer and sculptor, whose whimsical designs reflected a distinctive old-world charm.

Metal molds for the toys were intricately detailed. They were fashioned into two parts one side with rows of the toy front, and the other side featuring the back. In order to form the toys, ored celluloid were put two sheets of ivory colinto the mold, then steam



was blown between the celluloid sheets via a hollow tube. By the use of heat and pressure, the plastic became pliable and expanded into the mold, fusing the front and back together. Upon cooling, the toys hardened and were then removed from the mold and separated from each other by snipping apart.

The next step involved employees who did pieceLeft: Many of the standing anthropomorphic Easter toys actually rattle. This fashionable couple pose as companion pieces dressed in fine clothes. The boy holds the Easter basket of eggs, and the opposite side of the girl shows her holding a chicken. Everything Celluloid co-administrator Donna Donelon of Quakertown, Pa., shares this picture saying that the Easter toys are her favorite.



the task "tickling," probably as an explanation to a child as to what they were doing when cleaning up the mold lines on the bellies of animal toys.

Stories were told of Leominster families sitting around the table after dinner "tickling toys" by the light of a kerosene lamp – which in itself was a dangerous hazard as celluloid plastic is extremely flamma-

Once the tickled toys were finished, they were brought to the Viscoloid painting department where they were sprayed with enamel colors through carefully fashioned stencil templates. The eves and other tiny details like ribbons, neck ties, buttons and smiles were all hand-painted. Quality control appears to have been lacking at times because some of the toys are beautifully decorated with multiple colors while others appear shoddily painted with only two colors.

By the end of the war and the dawn of the roaring twenties, the Viscoloid Company employed 350 full-time workers in their toy making division. Their Easter toys were especially delightful and affordable. In 1924, a toy catalog advertised a display of "Kiddie Easter Playthings," in 24 different styles measuring 3 1/4 inch tall, for the wholesale price of \$9.15 gross or 79 cents a dozen. A display of larger toys measuring 5 ¼ inches tall could be bought for \$2 a dozen.

Spring was in full bloom on the charming little Easter novelties. Figural rattles, roly-poly

chockablock with bunnies, chicks, ducks, geese, swans, lambs, bonnets, baskets, flowers and

Whimsical transportation themes were made with bunnies or chicks driving stylized cars loaded with eggs or little animals. Movable wheels were added to some vehicles or platform pull toys and these are harder to find than those with wheels molded into the design.

Another popular theme featured birds and animals pushing baby carriages, wheelbarrows and carts full of precious cargo. It appears only two toys with little lambs were made, and they are few and far between.

Some of the most desirable and difficult to find items are the rocking toys that feature bunnies and chicks riding or standing opposite one another on a curved base. Patti Guthrie, one of the administrators on the

al pieces, like the rocking bunnies, can command high prices because of rarity.

In 1925, the DuPont Company struck a deal with Bernard Doyle and they acquired Viscoloid but they continued to make celluloid toys in Leominster. That same

year Doyle sold off some of the toy molds to Irwin Cohn, who started making celluloid toy tea sets in 1922.

Cohn eventually began to include the circular Irwin banner trademark on some of the toys. Later, in the very late 20s or early 30s, Irwin began to use non-flammable, brightly colored cellulose acetate plastic in place of celluloid. These were thicker and sturdier toys that came in bright white, pink, yellow and blue.

In addition to the Everything Celluloid site on Facebook, a companion page "Everything Celluloid for Sale" is the platform for buying and selling. Those interested in starting a collection or adding to an existing one, should check it out.

All celluloid collectors are invited to a three-day convention hosted by Anita Behrens in Minnesota the weekend of July 11 - 13. For more information visit Everything Celluloid online. For those interested in learning about the history of celluloid there are two great resource books chock full of information photographs. and Although they are out of print, they can be found second-hand online. Look for the Celluloid Collector's Resource and Value Guide by Keith Lauer and Julie Robinson, and Celluloid Dolls, Toys and Playthings by Julie Pel-Robinson letier (Robards).

German tradition dates to at least 1682.

Folklore, mythology and American popular culture often depict rabbits as tricksters. This depiction exemplified in cartoons where rabbits often outsmart farmers. The concept of the cunning rabbit is also found in rabbit doorstops, cast-iron especially doorstops depicting Bugs Bunny.

Doorstop rabbits are posed anthropomorphized (giving human characteristics to nonhuman things, such as rabbits) positions. Such use of rabbits, such as the White Rabbit in Lewis Carroll's Alice's Adventures Wonderland or Beatrix Potter's Peter Rabbit stories, offer humans comedic depictions of rabbits.

Collectors of rabbit doorstops should be aware that the same molds were often used by different companies and, sometimes, many years apart. If a mold was cast existing from an doorstop, the newer doorstop will be smaller than the original. Also, popular doorstop castings, such as a rabbit wearing tails and a top

hat, were often manufactured at the same time by different companies with different paint and surface techniques. Albany Foundry manufactured a "Rabbit with Top Hat" (No. 94) around 1930. Today, this doorstop is valued at \$950. However, the same exact mold was used by other companies, often designated No. 89, and sells for around \$275, which is a big difference.






