Pair of pocket watches right on time at Pioneer

ALMA, Mich. Pioneer Auction Service recently hosted the third sale from a collection that featured many unique items from around the world.

Two handsome antique pocket watches together in one lot provided the most activity for this sale.



The first was an American made Hampden 14K Dueber with what appeared to be an inscription "Alice W. Gray 1902." It had Roman numerals and a very ornate cover for the case. The slightly smaller gold filled Swiss Watch Company pocket watch also had initials engraved on the back of the ornate case, but no cover. Together this duo earned a final bid of

Numerous jewelry offerings provided desirable and eye-catching options. Several beautiful

turquoise examples were gathered into a single lot, including a necklace consisting of 10 approximately ½ inch diameter squash flowers. To complete this set there was a squash flower ring, and a detailed brooch also made with turquoise stones. This coveted group was taken with a final bid of \$600. Two seemingly unrelated selections were offered together with great success. First was a 10K gold 1953 class ring from Wilber Wright high school, possibly from Ohio. Dayton, Accompanying this was a box containing four lovely pendants combined onto one cloth string. There appeared to be a heart-

Aviva made fun line of Peanuts toy vehicles

Peanuts is a syndicated comic strip written and illustrated by Charles Schulz. The comic strip's original run was from 1950 to 2000, and it has continued in reruns to this very day. In all, Schulz published 17,897 original Peanuts comic

Although written about children, Peanuts offered adults a wonderful and truthful look at the complex interactions and relationships that make up friendships and fami-

Peanuts merchandising and memorabilia has captured the hearts of collectors. "The Peanuts

Collectibles: Identification & Value Guide" by Andrea Podley lists 2,700 Peanuts collectibles, which is a staggering amount of comic strip collectibles. Podley's guide was written in 2000, so tens of hundreds more Peanuts items have been manufactured in the ensuing 25 years.

In the 1970s, Aviva Toys issued one collectible series of Peanuts themed toys. Most of these tovs were Peanuts themed die cast models with some based on Tomica castings. They can have either the Tomica or Aviva brand on the toy's base. Some of these toys were manufactured in Japan and some were manufactured in Hong Kong.

Tomica is a line of die cast toy vehicles manufactured since 1970. Tomica die cast toys were

a subdivision of Tomica World, a line of motorized train accessories that Tomy created.

Collectors have often considered Tomica the Japanese Matchbox when

it came to manufacturing small toy vehicles..

Tomica began producing vehicles with famous cartoon characters sitting in the toys. The first such toys were the Snoopy

character cars from the 1970s. These toys were produced for Aviva, who sold the toys under the Aviva brand name. By

aquamarine shaped stone, a gold rose, a large oval maroon stone, possibly jasper, and a ruby colored stone, each mounted in gold fittings. This gathering was claimed with a final bid of \$475. Turquoise continued to prove popular with a set of white buffalo cuff bracelets with inlaid turquoise finishing at \$250 and a selection of five sterling silver brooches with turquoise details featuring a roadrunner, a St. Labre Indian chief, and other pieces that drew a final

bid of \$225.

One of the unusual collectibles was the threehole wood deadeye from the schooner A.J. Rogers. Handsomely mounted on a rustic wood base, it stood 21 inches tall. It had a plaque that read "Grounded on a reef Oct 9, 1898, Old Mission Point, Lake Michigan". A deadeye is a thick, round disc with holes that is used to run rigging through in conjunction with pulleys on a sailing vessel. This collectible was claimed with a final bid of \$275.

Two very different lots of animal figures did well. First, there was a dark brown glass whimsical sitting hound dog produced by Viking Glass, formerly New

Martinsville Glass Co. of West Viginia, in the mid-1900s. It still wore the paper label that identified the company, measured 8 inches tall, and was taken home with a final bid of \$275.

One of the few lots presented at this sale with a reserve was a petrified buffalo skull. It measured 26 inches across from horn tip to horn tip and was accompanied by a certificate of authenticity from an American Indian art dealer, as well as pages of information about the item. It cleared the reserve and was taken with a final bid of \$275.

Several cultures were on display with figures representing their unique symbols. The Mandalay Burmese carved wood smiling Buddha was an example of the sophisticated art of Myanmar. The statue featured glass inlay on the elegant, gilded robe and realistic human facial features. This impressive figure stood 33 inches tall and was claimed with a final bid of \$200. Towering over the others, a 51-inch-tall wood carved Baule female sitting figure from the Ivory Coast of West Africa earned a \$190 bid. A peaceful, contemplative Ming Dynasty 17th Century 10-inchtall Longquan celadon figure of Gianyin, a Buddhist deity, reached a final bid of \$170, and a set of nine nesting dolls

Claus and a toy soldier doll was claimed with a \$160 bid. An intricately carved 8-inch tall hetian jade dragon wine pot from the Qing Dynasty also reached a final bid of \$160.

One lot consisting of about 30 sterling spoons, including a "Baby's Spoon Community Plate" still in the original vintage cardboard box did well, drawing a final bid of \$325. There was also an appealing array of lamps, with one in particular drawing attention. It was a stretching cat lamp, featuring the feline posed with a Tiffany style glass lamp shade suspended from its tail. The lamp was cast iron, and the contented kitty featured lifelike green glass eyes that lit up. This 16-inch-tall vintage electric table lamp was taken home with a final bid of \$110.







the 1980s, Tomica was producing and selling toy vehicles using Muppet characters. Around 1990, the company began producing vehicles with Disney characters driving.

Aviva seemed to focus on Peanuts vehicles only. The company history of Aviva and its production schedule is sparse. Little is known about the company, including its founder. However, collectors are well aware that Aviva not only made Peanuts plastic and die cast cars, but the company also made lots of other a licensing agreement Peanuts memorabilia in the 1970s into the early 1980s.

In the 1980s, Hasbro began producing Aviva's designs and products. By mid-1980s, International Trading Technologies also began producing toys using Aviva designs. However, International made some modifications on Aviva's designs, resulting in a loss of quality in the toys. Overall, Aviva toy vehicles have much cuter images of Peanuts characters.

The earliest Aviva Peanuts toys were made of plastic in the 1960s. These were rolling toys and included a Charlie Brown train locomotive and a rolling Snoopy in a bubble bath.

In 1976, Aviva signed with Charles Shultz to manufacture a series of toys based on Schulz's

Peanuts characters. This series of toys are die cast vehicle models with a Peanuts character as the driver on each model. Tomica manufactured the earliest castings for these toys and had them cast in Japan. These early models were called "Snoopy Mini Die Cast" and focused on the Peanuts character dog Snoopy, who has always been the favorite of Schulz's comic strip characters. Later models were manufactured by Aviva in Hong Kong and represented the whole Peanuts gang.

These toys became so popular they included models using Snoopy's doghouse and Lucy's wood "Psychiatric Help" booth. Peanuts collectors quickly snatched up these unique models.

Aviva Peanuts vehicles are still affordable. making them an ideal collectible for individuals or families.

They measured just a little over 6 by 9 inches, but their pages packed a wallop of information. Small-footprint magazines like Popular Mechanics, Popular Science, and Mechanix Illustrated informed and inspired multiple generations of American read-

These small periodicals, centered on DIY, science, and technology, were a favorite on coffee tables for a primarily male audience. Often called "digest" or "pocket-sized" because of their compact format, they were created for portability and cost-efficiency. Like mass-market paperbacks and other small publications like Reader's Digest, their size helped keep prices low and fueled their popularity.

Though many of these started with intellectual goals, most broadened their scope to attract a general readership eager to learn about modern advancements. Featuring everything from aviation and electronics to automotive and home repair, they made science and technology both engaging and accessible to American con-



Science has a slightly different history. It can trace its origins to The Popular Science Monthly, which was founded in May 1872 by American science writer Edward L. Youmans. Youmans' goal was to create a platform that made scientific knowledge accessible to an educated audience. Over time, it became a space where some of the greatest minds of the era, including Charles Darwin, John Dewey, and Louis Pasteur, could share their groundbreaking ideas with the learned public.

That original mission of presenting complex scientific ideas to an educated audience had inadvertently limited its appeal. By 1915, readership was in decline and the publisher was in financial trouble. After several editorial changes, a new version — Popular Science — emerged, featuring short, easy-toread articles aimed at hobbyists who wanted to learn about the world of science and technology. Like Popular Mechanics, later volumes featured alluring cover design and were filled with ample illustration. Circulation for the newly revamped design doubled in its first year.

Popular Science also began featuring articles on captivating topics like rocket science and space exploration. However, that material often shifted away from purely scientific reporting, leaning toward futuristic ideas that many times had a "Buck Rogers" feel, which attracted some criticism.

Mechanix Illustrated debuted 20 years after both Popular Mechanics and Popular Science. It was founded in 1928 by American publisher Fawcett Publications to compete against those established titles. Right from the start, it emphasized content on autos, along with home project topics like remodeling to woodworking. Monthly vehicle road tests, which ran from the 1940s through the 1970s,

became especially popular. They were also often filled with visionary vehicles like automotive-aircraft hybrids and personal hovercraft.

In the same era, a wave of similar magazines followed the lead of their predecessors. Electronics Illustrated (1958) and Popular Electronics (1954) focused on electrical and electronic projects, while Popular Homecraft (1928) was a DIY-centered journal. Science Digest (1937) set itself apart from Popular Science by focusing on lay audiences from the outset. Along the way, many of these issued focused, special editions with titles like Concrete and Masonry, Ultimate Toolbox, and Weekend Projects aimed squarely at the do-it-yourselfer.

During World War II, these tiny periodicals became a favorite among American G.I.s for their convenience and portability. Even after the war, their popularity continued, thanks in part to their classified advertising promoting job-training opportuniaircraft, and watercraft ties and a range of monschemes, ey-making from envelope stuffing to stock trading, which appealed to those seek-

Pocket-size periodicals didn't remain exclusive to men, either. Recognizing the untapped potential of female readers, publishers also began targeting women in households, to both broaden their reach and break the stereotype that DIY was only for men. Digest-size magazines such as Homemaker and Practical Householder hit shelves, offering practical advice for women on everything from simple plumbing fixes to furniture refin-

By the mid-1970s, the digest-size format started to lose its appeal, and the standard 8.5 by 11-inch size took over. This change signaled the end of an era, with Popular Mechanics and Popular Science both transitioning in 1975. Mechanix Illustrated, however. held on longer, continuing with the small footprint until the 1990s.

During the late 1970s and into the 1980s, Popular Mechanics, Popular Science, and Popular Electronics devoted much of their content to the rise of consumer Below: After World War II, many G.I.s turned to home-study courses like this one on electronics repair in the pages of Popular Mechanics, to help their employment prospects.



electronics, particularly personal computers. By the 1990s, as they ventured further into hightech topics, their publishers found themselves competing with those dedicated solely to computers. At the same time, many of these once DIY and science-focused journals had changed hands and had drifted from their original missions. Popular Mechanics, for instance, was bought by Hearst Publications in the 1960s, and by the end of the century, it had become more speculative and politically charged. It now publishes only bimonthly. Popular Science changed hands multiple times, being owned by Times Mirror, Tribune, and Time-Warner, and underwent a revamp in 2014 to include new topics like environmental science. In 2021, it switched to a digital-only format. Meanwhile, Mechanix Illustrated merged with This Old House in 2021, which

shuttered in 2024. Although these magazines have evolved, the older editions still attract a dedicated group of collectors. For most, collecting these vintage publications is more about personal enjoyment than financial gain. They have undeniable charm, yet remain very affordable. Most issues are priced under \$5, and they're often available in bulk at great prices. It's rare to see them go for over \$10,


except in cases of pre-1930s editions, limited foreign-language runs like the Spanish Mecanica Popular (1947-2003), or issues in pristine condition, particularly if sought by collectors looking to complete their

Ultimately, old journals such as Popular Mechanics and Popular Science hold a unique nostalgic value. While they may not fetch high resale prices, they provide an affordable way to collect the past while offering a fascinating

glimpse into the inventive mindset of previous generations. Keep an eye out at yard sales and flea markets, where these relics may turn up waiting to be rediscovered.

If you'd like to browse some of these old publications before you acquire physical copies, nearly complete archive of both Popular Mechanics and Popular Science, plus many from Mechanix Illustrated and others, are available through Google Books.


