Jenny Lind continues to sing in collectors' hearts

The Dyer-Botsford Doll Museum in Dyersville, Iowa, features among other things a massive portrait of Jenny Lind.

old Englishman, came to Iowa in 1847 and became immensely wealthy on riverboat investments. He entertained President Ulysses S. Grant and other famous dignitaries.



the "Swedish Nightingale," Jenny Lind, who was called the "darling of Europe" before she toured America, singing opera and ballads in over 100 different shows for the famous showman P. T. Barnum. Most of her shows were held along the eastern seaboard, but she did venture inland for a few shows. One such show was held in the opera

house in Dyersville, Iowa. Lind was famous before coming to America in 1850, but by September

m first}$ entertainment superstar and America's "songbird." Her popularity and her wealth would easily have topped 21st century entertainers.

> Barnum spent a fortune advertising Lind, before he ever met her, and offered her the largest singing contract of the 19th century when he paid her \$1,000 per night for performances. On every poster advertising her performances, Lind was shown in often elegant, low-cut dresses. However, Lind was a morally straight, humble woman who wore plain white clothing while performing and always wore simple, plain makeup.

There was a darker blue around the base of the bowl, which made the faces stand wonderfully. out Flowing down the three legs were some green ivy pieces that tied the entire piece together. high in the selling price It dated to 1858 and was made by Baron Marochetti, model number 718. 

Standing just over 13 inches tall was a Krause majolica decanter. This was a giraffe figural piece that had a professional repair to the ears and hat. This piece sold for \$5,500.

Selling for the same price of \$5,500 was a Hugo Lonitz pair of birds and bird nest wall pockets. There was a tiny hairline crack on the back of one. These measured about 9 by 7 inches.

T.C.Brown Α Westhead Moore piece was sold for \$2,750. This majolica maple leaf and wicker toast rack had one leaf that was professionally repaired. It measured 8 by 5 inches.

A beautiful conversation piece sold for \$2,300. Sarreguemines majolica quail platter was responsible for this bid. There were three quail pecking wheat. It was set in a woodland scene looking ponds, lilies, and foliwas adorned with oak leaves and branches, set against a vibrant cobalt background. It measured 24 by 16 inches.

Jenny Lind

In her portraits, including the one at the Dyer-Botsford mansion, Lind appeared to be a self-confidant woman with average looks and above average clothes. Poet Nathaniel Parker Willis said of Lind's portraits, "Her likeness is never quite what the average person has of Lind in his or her mind."

In her short time here, Jenny Lind captivated American hearts and imaginations. Streets,

cities, towns, buildings, ships, furniture and stagecoach trunks were

named "Jenny Lind" in her honor. Arkansas has a town called Jenny Lind on its western border. It does not matter that the majority of Americans never saw Jenny Lind or heard her sing.

Today, Jenny Lind still has many admirers in the form of Jenny Lind collectors. When one through walks antique store or previews items at an antique auction, one will probably encounter the name "Jenny Lind" on all types

of furniture, including Jenny Lind baby beds, nightstands, and spindle beds. However, most collectors associate the name Jenny Lind with stagecoach trunks, dating to the 1850s and '60s. When Lind arrived in New York, she brought several trunks with her, which had been made in London. Trunk makers all over America soon began copying Lind's trunks, calling them "Jenny Lind" trunks.

When looking at Jenny Lind antiques, it is important to remember that "Jenny Lind" is not a brand name. "Jenny Lind" represents a style furniture decorator items that began in people's imaginations of the 1840s and continues to this day.

One category of Jenny Lind decorator items that collectors search for is Jenny Lind dolls, which come in a potpourri of styles. There are Jenny Lind paper dolls, which are quite rare; Jenny Lind porcelain head dolls; Jenny Lind half dolls; and Jenny Lind play dolls, which

are rare and are often far more valuable than porcelain manufactured dolls.

Beloved characters and ornaments found new homes at Hixson auction

Ohio LAKEWOOD, - Resonating with each bid placed, Bill Hixson's favorite phrase, "We do not have things for sale. We offer you memories" was never felt more than July 19 as Rachel Davis Fine Arts sold the contents and the memories created over the years at Hixson's Flower Barn of Lakewood.

Opening as a modest flower shop in 1959, Hixson created an internationally recognized wonderland. Flowers were his mainstay, but he branched out and included Christmas items, designing ornaments that have graced prestigious venues including the White House during the Reagan, Bush, Clinton, and Obama administrations.

Box lots of ornaments from the Flower Barn sold during this online event with bulk lots selling anywhere from \$700 to \$400. Every whimsical ornament imaginable was on hand. A huge (1900 pieces, give or take) grouping sold for \$700 and included pharaoh to a polar bear playing golf examples as well as traditional Santas, angels, and Christmas trees. Large lots of miniature ornaments sold in the \$400

range. Eleven Metropolitan Museum of Art snowflake and star ornaments sold together bringing \$450. The set included four sterling silver examples; six with a sterling silver surface with pure gold, and one copper surfaced with gold. All sold with their original boxes.

When the world renowned Halle Broth-Co., (commonly ers referred to as Halle's) department store closed, Hixson had the foresight to snag some of their automated window displays which continued to delight shoppers at Hixson's Flower Barn.

The most beloved display item from Halle's was also the auction's top lot. "Mr. Jingeling-The Keeper of the Keys" was created in 1956 by Frank Jacobi; a Chicago-based advertising exec and friend of Halle's president, Walter Halle. He asked Jacobi to create a holiday character to promote toy sales. Jacobi created both a character and an origin story for Mr. Jingeling; saying;

"Mr. Jingeling was a locksmith who made keys for castle doors. One day, Santa lost the key to his Toyland workshop. Santa rushed to Mr. Jingeling begging

for his help. Mr. Jingeling immediately went to the North Pole, created a new key for Santa's workshop, and helped save Christmas. From then on, Mr. Jingeling became known as 'Keeper of the Keys to Toyland'."

The display featured a 28.5 inch tall composition Mr. Jingeling doll along with 25 cardboard keys and its Plexiglass display case, as well as a painted backdrop in the form of a book. It sold for \$2,600 blowing away its \$300 to \$600 estimate.

Several other displays originally from Halle's also did well. Automated, though not guaranteed to be working, composition dolls from the classic Dickson's A Christmas Carole crossed the auction block with a 36 inch tall Tiny Tim bringing \$700, as did the Bob Crachet working at his desk.

Alice in Wonderland composition dolls were also up for grabs. The Ugly Duchess at 39 inches tall made \$800; the Mad Hatter (30 inches tall) and Rabbit (33 inches tall) sold together for

\$550; and the wonderful Cheshire Cat was bid to \$475. Tweedle Dum and Tweedle Dee sold together for \$425, which is also the price paid for The Queen of Hearts.

Goebel bisque figurines did well. A vintage 1980 Goebel Hummel horse #46 013 24 with an incised signature in script of Gerhard Skrobek on the saddle blanket was won with a bid of \$750, while a Goebel elephant #46 012 32 with a Weihnacht backstamp and incised copyright date of 1980 went for \$500. This 11 by 13 by 6 inch pachyderm was from a nativitv set.

A variety of leaded and stained glass windows were also on hand. Four Gothic leaded glass windows sold for \$2,000. Two were arched (61 by 45.5 inches) and two were rectangular - one being 62 by 38 inches; the other 52.5 by 45.5 inches. A 40 by 80 inch leaded stained glass

window transom in green, tan, and orange tones brought \$900.

Two of the most iconic Cleveland Christmas items selling this day had to be the 16 to 17 foot tall Raggedy Ann doll. Greeting shoppers to Hixson's since the 1960s, this doll had a cameo in the cult classic, Cleveland-based, Christmas movie, "A Christmas Story." The doll realized \$600.

And the charming carved and painted wood "Christmas Shop" sign from Hixson's featuring cut-out carved lettering and a beautifully painted image of Santa was won with a bid of \$1,200 against an estimate of

2023 leaving Hixson's to his business partner, Matthias Burke. Burke plans to continue the Hixson's Flower Barn tradition but not at the store's original location. "Our goal through this sale is to re-imagine Hixson's by creating a smaller retail location or possibly pop-up venues
