Allegan Antiques Market kicked off with hot sales

ALLEGAN, Mich. — Summer temperatures reaching into the 90s greeted those attending the May 31 Allegan Antiques Market. One shopper in shorts, wide-brim hat and sunglasses, and pulling a cart full of goodies to her car in the parking lot, said “It’s a bit of a challenge with this warm weather, but I’m glad I came!”

A brief check of license plates in the Allegan lot showed shoppers traveling to the monthly event from Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin and Ohio – as well as Michigan.

Ayla Desjarlais says she travels to the Allegan show each month from her home in the Detroit suburbs because of “a love of

traditional antiques” and new-found interest in contemporary home furnishings. The newly-married homemaker said “the drive is worth it.”

Another Motor City resident, Dave Dent, sets up to sell in an outdoor spot at the show. Many stopped to admire his 1880s six-drawer quartersawn oak Yawman and Erb counter top filing cabinet with fancy drawer pulls, priced at \$785. Still others checked over his 1920s, Art Nouveau brass weave 12-by 34-inch luggage rack, priced at \$165.

A 43-year Allegan veteran Jim Green of Grand Ledge, Mich., said he shows each month at the event. He called attention to “a great show and good customers.” He

offered a 1915 24-inch-tall Miller lamp with grape filigree on top and bottom that could light up your home for \$425.

Serious toy collectors hovered around vintage playthings on display by Orville Miller, Fort Wayne,

Ind. They included a vintage 1930s Steelcraft Lockheed Sirius pressed steel 22-inch wingspan airplane tagged at \$1,200.

Hundreds of collectible bottles were shown on

Moon and Star pattern reminds us of vastness of universe

Adams & Company introduced the Moon and

Star glassware pattern for pressed glass in 1874. Originally, Adams called this glassware Palace glass, but by 1930 when

L.G. Wright began offering Palace glass, this type of glass had become popularly named Moon and Star glass because of the star-like design and round, moon-like, depression found on all Palace glassware.

Moon and Star Depression glass became quite popular during and following the Great Depression, and Moon and Star canister sets lined many American kitchen counters during the mid-20th century. Collectors, then and now, are drawn to the distinct Moon and Star pattern and the potpourri of colors it comes in, such as amberina, cobalt, green, red, ruby, colonial blue, yellow, and crystal.

Today, Moon and Star glassware is still popular among younger collectors who remember seeing the glassware on their grandmother’s or mother’s dining table or kitchen. Moon and Star canister sets

were especially popular in the late 1940s and early ‘50s. Middle-class families across America could afford Moon and Star glassware, which added both beauty and elegance to homes.

In general, Moon and Star patterns, whether in glassware or jewelry, has deep symbolic meanings. A moon often represents mystery, femininity, and

the cyclic nature of life itself, and the star most often represents hope, guidance, or a beacon of divine light.

The pairing of a moon and star reminds us of the vastness of the universe, the beauty of the night sky, the balance between the constant star and the changing moon. As Juliet said to Romeo, “Do not swear by the inconstant moon.”

Moons and Stars continue to decorate glassware and other decorative pieces. Stars are often used to represent excellence in craftsmanship and high quality,

such as a five-star rating. The use of the moon as decoration still symbolizes beauty, mystery, and the cycles of nature. We often see them combined in decorative motifs, such as celestial jewelry and in modern day Moon and Star glassware.

Some of the glass companies that produced

Moon and Star patterned glassware include Adams & Co (1880s), US Glass (1890s), L.G. Wright (1930s-’60s), L.E. Smith Glass Co. (1960s -’80s), and Weishar Enterprises, which currently produces the pattern.

L.E. Smith Glass Company was one of America’s greatest art glass companies. Starting in the 1940s, L.E. Smith reproduced pressed glass for the L.G. Wright Company. By the 1960s, Moon and Star pieces began showing up in L.E. Smith catalogs. Smith glassware was considered inexpensive glassware at the time. In 1962, L.E. Smith contracted with Joseph Weishar of the Island Mold Company to produce new pieces of Moon and Star for Weishar.

One interesting fact concerning L.E. Smith and its dominant role in producing Moon and Star glassware is that L.E. Smith never owned any of the Moon and Star molds it used to produce the pattern. All of L.E. Smith’s Moon and Star molds were leased from Weishar, and L.E. Smith paid royalties to Weishar.

Unfortunately, most of L.E. Smith’s Moon and Star glassware pieces are not marked, so field identification of these pieces is difficult. If you are a novice, look for an “S” with a “G” in the top part of the “S” and a “C” in the bottom part of the “S,” but finding L.E. Smith marked Moon and Star glassware is difficult, and

the marked pieces bring premiums on prices.

Adams & Company produced mainly clear glass Moon and Star pieces in the 1880s. Today, these pieces are popular with collectors and include sugar bowls, butter dishes, goblets, creamers, relish trays, candy dishes, and spoon rests, so entire place settings can be accessorized with Moon and Star glassware pieces.

Novice collectors should carefully examine every piece of Moon and Star glassware before purchasing it. Some Moon and Star pieces had beautiful details, such as twisted handles that were added separately to the piece.

Wave your pennant high to support your favorite team

In the early 1900s, students didn't wear t-shirts and hats to show support of their favorite teams. Instead, they most often waved a felt pennant attached to a slender dowel rod. The pennant would be adorned with the name of the team or college and often a graphic representing a specific sport.

Football pennants were especially popular and followed the sport as it grew around college campuses.

For nearly 100 years one of the most popular stadium souvenirs has been the team pennant. Many pennants from the early 1900s were works of art and several of them were nearly 35 inches long.

It didn't take long for manufacturers to capitalize on this lightweight souvenir. In 1908, an upstart company named The Reproduction Co. of New York City changed the way pennants were made. That's because this firm found a way to make screen printing commercially viable.

"One of the oldest

pennant companies to manufacture these collectibles was the Reproduction Pennant Company," says Ben Kozik, founder and owner of Mantiques online antique shop out of North Carolina. "People see these and they think the pennants are reproductions, but that was just the name of the company. Pennants from this company are authentic. And, there were many others jumping on this pennant bandwagon."

Kozik has been a pennant enthusiast and collector the past 40 years.

"In the early 1900s the pennants were either wool or felt, and they were stitched. Some were made of leather, and those are a bit harder to find and much more valuable," Kozik said.

"Any pennant that has that nostalgic look with a date, sports figure, or game score will draw more attention and draw the higher value," he said. "A pennant, say, from an obscure college may be worth more because they didn't make as many."

First-generation felt pennants around 1900 were hand-made. Many of them were cut by hand with scissors, causing slight variations from one pennant to the next. Within a few years, however, this would change. By 1910, power sewing machines and dye cutters helped manufacturers produce increasingly more intricate designs, which only made the felt pennant's popularity increase.

Mike Connor, a frequent vendor at the

monthly Urbana Flea Market in Ohio, collects and sells a wide range of vintage sporting goods. He recently sold a large portion of his collection of old college and pro football pennants at auction in Dallas, Texas. Connor found it difficult at time to accurately date some of his pennants.

"If you collect baseball cards, you know there's a bounty of books, websites and other materials available documenting everything you ever wanted to know about your hobby," Connor said. "You can find out who made the card, when it was made, where they made it and its value based on its condition. The same goes for stamp and coin collecting. I wish I could say the same for felt pennants and banners. Sadly, we can only make assessments about the decade a piece was made. And that's usually where the information completely dries up."

Connor says pen-

nant collectors have one resource, though, and that's Mike Egner's "Vintage Pennant Price Guide," a survey of the best pennants available for most professional sports teams through 1970. The guide includes 2,200 baseball and football pennants spanning 348 pages.

"Pennants generally bear little information on them identifying their date of production," Connor said. "Many early college football pennants lack any reference to a year."

The 1940s and 1950s are often considered

the "golden age" of pennant making, with unique artwork and hand-painted graphics. In these two decades the mix of felt blends that contained increasingly less wool, cut with other materials such as cotton and rayon, a synthetic fiber. The trademarking of team logos and mascots in the 1960s led to a decline in pennant production, as many manufacturers couldn't afford licensing fees. Today, pennants are experiencing a resurgence, with fans and institutions looking to create custom pennants.
