## Texaco Fire Chief pump pushed up bids to \$1,300

MIDLAND, Mich. — For Pam and Randy Bock, their ideal vacation was not a trip to Hawaii or a cruise. They would carefully plot a

route that included as many small items representing a variety of collecting passions, there were also some large, unique pieces that drew excellent bidder response. The leading example was the red and black Neptune Meter Company of New York Texaco Fire Chiefbranded lead gas pump. It sported a reproduction glass globe and some older restorations, but complete with hose, nozzle, lights and keys it made a desirable package. It drew the highest price of the auction, closing with a final bid of \$1,300.

A handsome selection of four vintage gold and silver pocket watches included one with a chain

## Jessie Smith illustrations bring children to life

Jessie Willcox Smith's illustrations of children at play graced the covers of hundreds of magazines in her lifetime. She is particularly noted for her covers of Good Housekeeping and Ladies Home Journal magazines. And her illustrations for children's' books, such as Clement Moore's 'Twas Night Before Christmas, delighted



children of all ages then and send collectors on scavenger hunts to locate her books now.

Smith was born during the Civil War and educated in private Philadelphia schools, so she benefitted from progressive educators who encouraged a woman artist. She took classes at the Philadelphia School of Design for Women, the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, and the Drexel Institute.

While at Drexel, Smith became life-long friends with two other American illustrators — Elizabeth Shippen Green and Violet Oakley.

One of Smith's first illustrated books was Mabel Humphrey's The Book of the Child (Stokes.

1903). These illustrations were sketched in charcoal and then colored with pastels, a medium that Smith would continue to use for the remainder of her artistic career.


Smith's illustrations of children are considered her finest work; however, she never married or had children of her own. Her love of children shows in her work, and she

confessed to enjoying watching her friends' children "busy with their own affairs."

Smith's work seems to capture children at play in a world unknown to adults.

Collectors search for the more than 30 books that Smith illustrated. including Louisa Mae



fascinating examples. An Evinrude Elto Pal 1.5 hp aluminum outboard motor from the late 1930s had been beautifully refurbished by the owner. He then mounted it in a showcase, presenting a museum quality display, complete with period appropriate bottles of Shell outboard motor oil and Marine Chief gasoline. It left for a new home with a final bid of \$375. There was also a Man-U Troll Motors Inc. model 3B hand crank trolling motor produced by Universal Projects of Jacksonville, Florida, possibly from the 1960s. Used in place of an outboard motor or an oar, the handle was manual-

to rotate the propeller and move the boat along. Complete with stand and in excellent condition, this device departed with a final bid of \$325.

such as Robert Louis Stevenson's A Child's Garden of Verses.

Smith illustrated more than 200 Good covers Housekeeping (from December 1917 through March 1933), easily making her one of most prolific illustrators of the 20th

century. Other publications that she illustrated for Scribner's, Woman's Home Companion, and Century. And she was paid quite well for her cover designs, commanding at much as \$1,500 per cover, which made her a wealthy woman.

If you are seeking Smith's illustrations, also look for paper advertisements from the early 20th century. Companies such as Kodak and Ivory Soap regularly used Smith's illustrations their magazine advertisements.

Smith also kept busy commissioned portraits of children. These original works are now quite valuable when they come to auction.

Collectors also search for complete series of Smith's works. One of






