Buyers painted pretty bids at BidItMI auction

LIVONIA, Mich. — Jennifer Lis was awarded

the designation Professional Associate by the American Institute of Conservation, a national

membership organization of art conservation professionals. She previously worked for Mackinac State Historic Parks and was responsible for a variety of large projects, including the restoration of several objects for the Manogian Mackinac Art Museum. She has owned Lis Art Conservation and Restoration Services for the last 15 years.

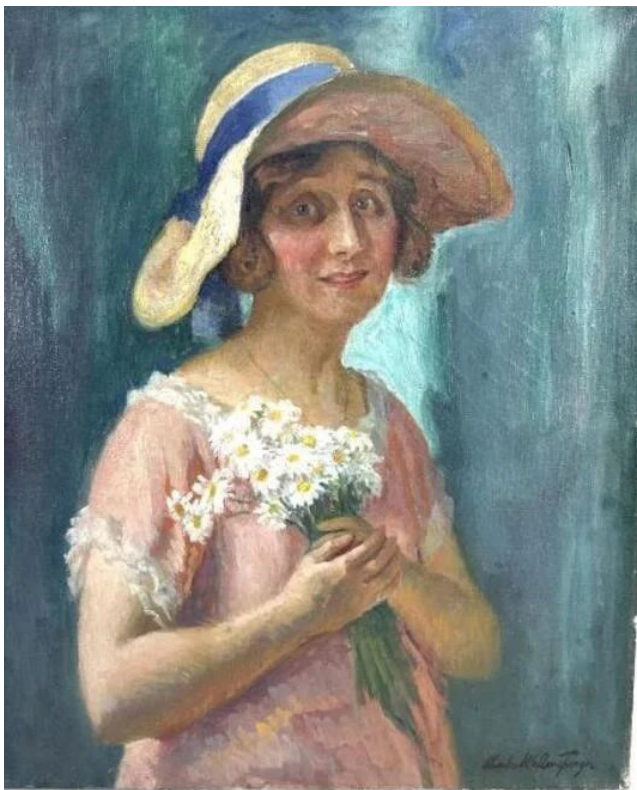

Standard oil has many fans among petroliana collectors

Those who collect gas station memorabilia often search for items from a specific brand or station. Standard Oil is among those iconic brands that is eagerly sought.

Standard Oil’s history began in 1863 when John and William Rockefeller, along with other investors founded the incorporated partnership of Standard Oil of Ohio. The company was established with \$1 million in capital. Rockefeller chose the name “Standard Oil” because he envisioned his company setting a new “standard” of business excellences in America.

Rockefeller and his investors signed the Standard Oil Trust

Agreement in 1882, actually forming what we think of as Standard Oil.

However, in 1892, the Supreme Court of Ohio dissolved Standard Oil, calling it a monopoly. In 1904, Standard Oil controlled 91 percent of oil refinement and 85 percent of final sales in the United States. Standard Oil of New Jersey then continued holding a monopoly in the American oil industry from 1899 until 1911 when the Supreme Court of the United States found



Standard Oil of New Jersey guilty of anticompetitive practices and ordered the company and all of its holdings dissolved.

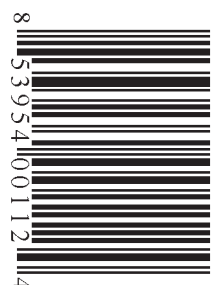
Following the dissolution of Standard Oil New Jersey, the company became Jersey Standard, and it was still the second largest corporation in the United States.

Today, many people

from New York, travelled the world, and in his later years settled in Detroit where he was active in the local art scene. That connection may have contributed to the popularity of his work here. The highest earning item of the day was a signed oil on canvas titled "Italian Alps- Goat Farm". This unframed original work measured 40 by 24 inches and depicted a hazy scene on a rocky coastline with goats lingering on the shore. It was taken home with a high bid of \$465. Another Teed painting showed a woodland landscape, possibly at sunrise or sunset, as the sky was blazing orange. Measuring 23 by 21 inches in an ornate gilt frame, this smaller Teed creation closed with a high bid of \$325.

A solitary oil on canvas portrait by Michigan artist Charles Waltensperger (1871-1931) proved desirable. Originally from Detroit, Waltensperger traveled and studied art in Europe before return-

ing to his home state. The painting featured a young woman in a wide-brimmed straw hat clutching a bouquet of daisies. She is wearing a pink summer dress and looking directly out with an interesting facial expression. This charming painting measured 21 by 17 inches and required a high bid of \$355 to claim it.

Lis received a Pablo Picasso (1881-1973) lithograph from a client who purchased it while traveling in France. "Two Small Bulls" (Deux Petits Taureaux) was created in

1945 and was printed on white, hand-made paper. Featuring two small, stylized bulls, the work measured 24 by 19 inches and drew a final bid of \$350.

Another familiar name at this sale was Frederic Remington, with two prints available. The first was titled "A Sioux Chief" and showed the image of a Sioux chief in full regalia mounted on a horse. This was a common theme for Remington, who specialized in scenes of the American Old West. The print measured 29 by 24 inches mounted in a rustic wood frame. It finished with a final bid of \$335. The second was titled "A Breed", (alternate title: Northwest Half-Breed or Half-Breed). The subject of the print is an Indigenous man on horseback, and it also measured 29 by 24 inches and was framed in a rustic wood frame. This piece drew a final bid of \$277.50.

There were light-hearted subjects representing cartoon animation. The most valuable was the Bugs Bunny animation cel titled "Look I'm Dancing". This limited-edition hand-painted cel was signed by animation legend Virgil Ross. It depicted Bugs Bunny in five sequential poses dancing down a street, reminiscent of a Fred Astaire scene. It was produced by Warner Bros., measured 32 by 18 inches

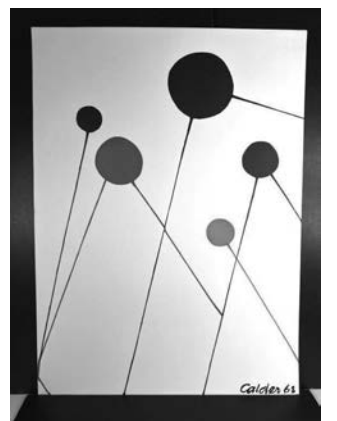
in the frame, and was claimed with a high bid of \$195.

There were several Disney sericels, including a framed Walt Disney "Sleeping Beauty" collage that was created for the 40th anniversary of Sleeping Beauty (1959). It consisted of six panels featuring scenes from the movie including one of the evil Maleficent and another with the image of Prince Phillip kissing Sleeping Beauty to wake her from the spell. This interesting piece measured 22 by 18 inches and left with a final bid of \$74.

There were many more beautiful examples of antique and modern art, done in oil, lithographs, and prints with subjects ranging from portraits to landscapes to abstract

designs. There was a selection of block print paper note cards designed by Michigan artist Gwen Frostic that consisted of green pine trees on white paper. For variety there were also six lots consisting of costumed Polish dolls that had been in the family and were sentimental collectibles.

Finally, a most unusual sculpture was included in this sale. Standing 12 inches tall, the Rollin Karg dichroic art glass sculpture on a stand resembled a giant marble in shape and color. It was created in 2003 in Kechi, Kansas at Karg Art Glass. This American glass artist is known for his free-form, asymmetrical, and dynamic use of color in glass sculptures. This stunning example was eagerly claimed with

a high bid of \$54.



add to the memory of Standard Oil by collecting petroliana associated with Standard Oil. One name that collectors know well is Esso, which is a trading name for ExxonMobil gasoline. Like everything connected to Standard Oil, Esso's name has an interesting history. Originally, the name Esso was used by Standard Oil of New Jersey after the breakup of the original Standard Oil Company in 1911. The company adopted the name Esso (from the phonetic pronunciation of Standard Oil's initials and as an acronym of "Eastern States Standard Oil").

One of the largest categories of petroliana collectibles is gasoline signs, both porcelain and tin. Tin lithograph signs are most common and are

found with embossed lettering or flat images. Porcelain signs are much heavier than tin, and porcelain signs have a glass-like finish that is free of brush strokes or unevenness. Patina on a Standard Oil sign is important when determining the age and authenticity of the sign, but beware! Patina, like most things, can be reproduced or faked.

The value of a Standard Oil sign to a collector comes down to two things—authenticity and condition. Original porcelain signs are worth far more than tin litho signs because the porcelain process is expensive and, for the most part, can't be faked with inexpensive materials.

There are some very fun, cross-collectible Standard Oil signs with Mickey Mouse and other Disney characters on the signs. These types of non-standard signs add depth to a Standard Oil collection.

Another category of Standard Oil collectibles is oil bottles. Glass oil bottles were used from, roughly, 1910–1934; however, glass bottles replaced cans again during World War II when steel, which is used in the production of tin, was needed for the war effort.

Many glass oil bottles look alike, or at least similar, so collectors look for embossed bottles that state the name of the oil company on the bottle. Some collectors concentrate their petroliana collection on oil bottles since there is enough variety in these bottles to keep a collector busy.

Nearly all petroliana collectibles increase in value over time, but Standard Oil collectibles have a singular place in collectors' hearts. Standard Oil not only set the "standard" for excellence in the industry, but the company has been a household word in America for over 160 years.

Trade with China was part of America's birth

BY BARBARA MILLER BEEM

No doubt the Liberty Bell and Constitution Hall will enjoy an increase in tourism this year in Philadelphia. But there are other stories to be told there of America's earliest days. And from now until Jan. 3, 2028, visitors to the Independence Seaport Museum, located in the City of Brotherly Love, can delve into a new and thought-provoking exhibition.

"Seeking Profit and Power: Philadelphia, China Trade, and the Making of America" invites museumgoers to take a step forward, to look beyond the War and the borders of the new country and consider the direction of America, just as it achieved its independence. The economic and political decisions made by everyday citizens of the fledgling country have proved to be fundamental to the viability of

the country that is now celebrating its 250th birthday.

To be sure, the years that followed the Revolutionary War were "a critical moment in the history of our nation," according to Peter S. Seibert, president and CEO of the Philadelphia-based museum. To accommodate museumgoers seeking to visit and revisit what is "the biggest exhibition in decades for this institution," "Seeking Power and Profit" is timed to be on display before, during, and after the official celebration of America's Semiquincentennial.

In a recent interview, Seibert set the stage, explaining that then-colonists had come to enjoy imported goods, while, at the same time, benefiting financially from the sale of their exports. Having won independence from Great Britain, however, the balance of trade agreements was suddenly upended. To be decided was how best to establish and maintain those economic relationships critical to the economy of the new nation. Telling this story are some 150 unique and rarely seen objects, ones that bear witness to the fledgling country as it came to establish its place in the world of global

trade. And as it happened, Seibert noted, "China became our first trading partner."

Not surprisingly, the colonists-turned-citizens were not about to give up the exotic luxuries that they had long enjoyed, including fine silk fabrics and imported porcelain wares, lacquerware and

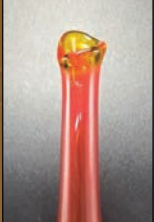
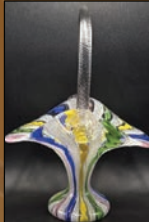

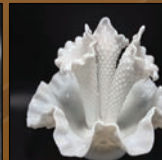

tea. The market for these items was not limited to wealthy city folk: Seibert personally attested to having found examples of imported porcelain wares at country household sales. At the same time, Chinese consumers had grown accustomed to exotic raw goods from North America, including silver and animal pelts.

Speaking on a broader level, Seibert explained that just as Europeans had looked westward to markets across the Atlantic Ocean, Americans looked westward across the Pacific. Private citizens, separated from the rules and regulations that governed overseas trade, risked their lives to make the trip halfway around the world, hoping to secure their fortunes. But the promise of wealth to be gained was more than enough incentive for many.

Thinking about the process that led to the mounting of this exhibition, Seibert recalled the decision to not interpret either Revolutionary War battles or the political processes that led to the

nation's formation. Instead, the focus was to concentrate on looking outward rather than inward. Addressing global trade issues was a comfortable fit for the Museum, in light of its location in the Penn's Landing complex along the Delaware River in Philadelphia.

Organized by guest curators Susan Gail Johnson and Brett Paley, the exhibition is divided into five parts: "Making a Nation," "Making it Work," "Making Money," "Encountering Each Other," and "The Old China Trade." Telling the story is a wide range of objects, from ship logs and silks to porcelain

wares and portraits. In addition to those holdings from the Independence Seaport Museum are items on loan from George Washington's Mount Vernon and The Society of The Cincinnati, as well as The Dieterich American Foundation and Andalusia Historic House and Gardens.

"People," Seibert observed, "go to a museum to see cool stuff." And to be sure, there is a lot of "cool stuff" currently on exhibit, visual reminders of the life and times of those who lived just as the country stepped onto the world stage for the first time. By way of enticement, Seibert offered a taste of what is in the exhibition. Of particular note is Captain John Green's sea chest, made of mahogany and bald cypress wood. Its design and construction suggest that it was made either in port or aboard ship, but it returned to Green's home shores with decorative hardware, probably applied in Canton, China.

Although the owner's identity remains unknown, an exquisitely decorated lacquer sewing box, publicly seen for the first time, is on view. Seibert found it of particular interest in light of the fact that the box was fully furnished with ivory utensils, including bobbin holders and a tool to organize embroidery floss. Another luxury item that traveled halfway around the world to an American woman is a burgundy-colored embroidered shawl,

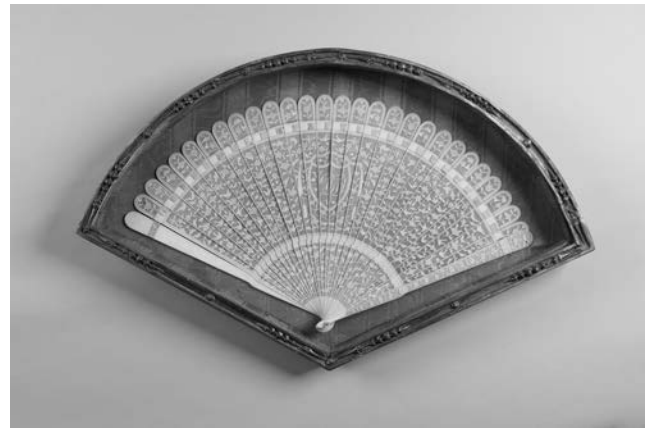
made of Chinese silk crepe and embroidered with silk floss.

On view for the first time is a porcelain salesman's sample cup and saucer. The border of the pieces is decorated with multiple designs from which consumers make their selection of a pattern. Similarly, silk swatches were affixed to a sample card, taking some of the guesswork out of ordering fabric. Also of interest is a porcelain bowl, probably made around 1790; it was decorated in Canton, with an American flag, intended to please an American customer.

After the celebration of the Semiquincentennial, the museum will continue to host special programs in connection with this landmark exhibition. And if all goes well, a seminar will take place in the fall. Seibert hopes that visitors to "Seeking Profit and Power" will find it to be an "engaging" visual experience, one from which "we can learn together."

And finally, in keeping with the spirit of the exhibition, Seibert confirmed that the commemorative souvenir wares sold in the gift shop were made in China. The old trade routes continue onward.
