ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Signal light showed smooth sailing with \$2,000 bid

LUXEMBURG, Wis. — JM Hobby Supply buys and sells a variety of fascinating items from shipwrecks, vintage motorcycles, and railroad related collectibles. They teamed up with Ihander Auctions to offer two days of online

bidding for hundreds of vintage and antique treasures from railroads as well as model train-related gear. Prices do not include the buyer's premium.

Signal lights are essential for safe railway travel as their colors and placement manage the traffic

on the rails. The highest selling item in this auction was a General Railway dwarf signal light. This antique relic consisted of nine lamps mounted on a circular plate. It came with all nine color lenses and shrouds, and the overall size was 26 by 15 by 13 inches. Requiring local pick up, it still earned an impressive final bid of \$2,000.

A Mars R250 Figure 8 signal light was offered for parts as it had the internal workings and rare 15-inch convex lens but was missing the red light. Measuring overall 20 by 18 inches it still proved desirable, drawing a final bid of \$1,400.

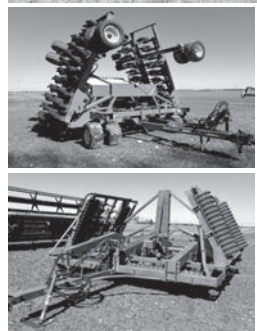

The Leslie Tyfon 200 airhorn removed from a Baltimore and Ohio (B&O) Railroad diesel locomotive had come from the estate of a long-time locomotive engineer. Some of the original B&O blue paint was still visible. These 26 inches long, aluminum, single-pitched horn drew a final bid of \$1,500. A similar B&O RR Leslie Tyfon 200R airhorn was claimed with a bid of \$850. In a much larger configuration, the B&O Leslie Supertyfon 3 chime airhorn measured 32 by 25 by 11 inches. It also retained some blue paint, was in very good condition and came from

It was in weathered but very good condition and a high bid of \$850 took it home. Two B&O Railroad diesel locomotive bells were offered, closing with bids of \$450 and \$425. 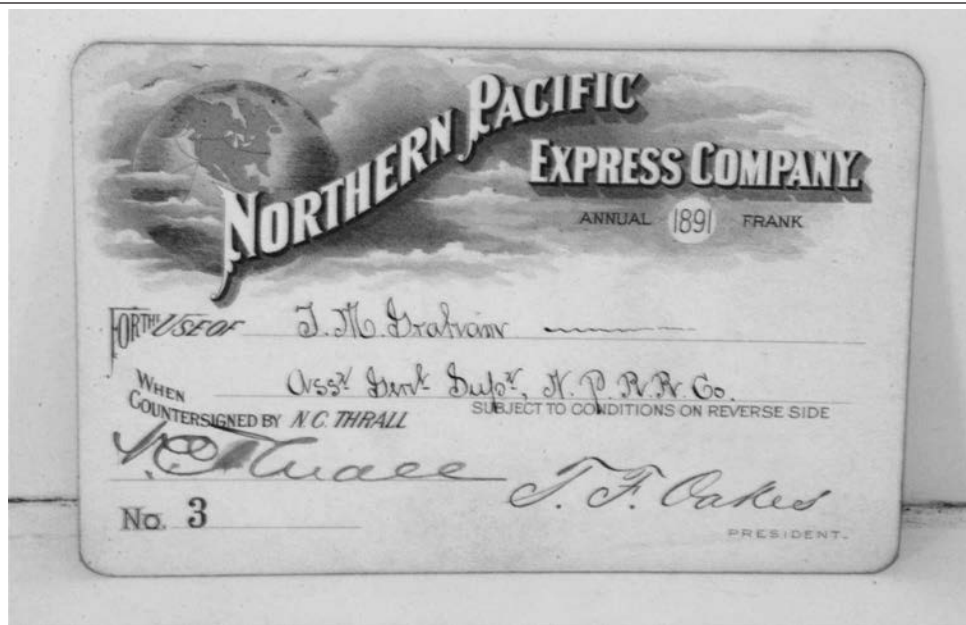

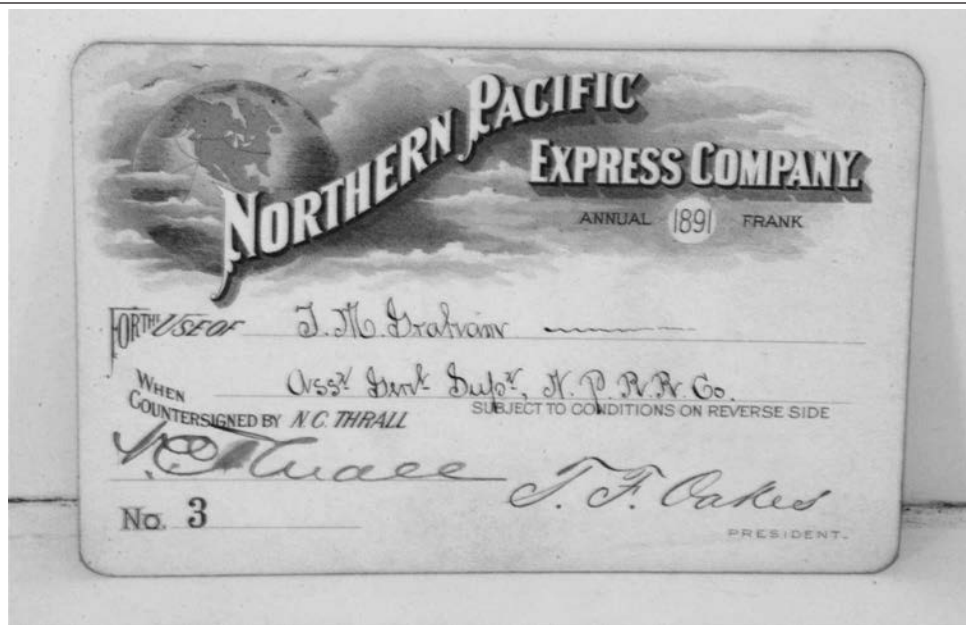

over the galaxy. The Jedi, of which Luke Skywalker is one, are peacekeepers for the Galactic Republic (the good guys), and the Sith (the bad guys) use the dark side of the Force to promote anger and aggression.

As with most blockbuster movie franchises, Star Wars inspired a potpourri of action figure toys. Kenner, an American toy company, produced the first Star Wars action figures. From 1977 through 1985, Kenner produced over 100 Star Wars toys, and a total of more than 300 million toys were sold during their original production run.

Demand for Kenner's Star Wars action toys was immense; so Kenner issued its "Early Bird Certificate Package." This Package debuted during the 1977 Christmas Season. Basically, Kenner could not produce toys fast enough to keep up with demand, so the company sold an empty box with a mail-in certificate, promis-

ing fans who purchased the empty box and certificate the first four figures — Luke, Leia, Chewbacca, and R2-D2 would be shipped to the fan sometime later in 1978.

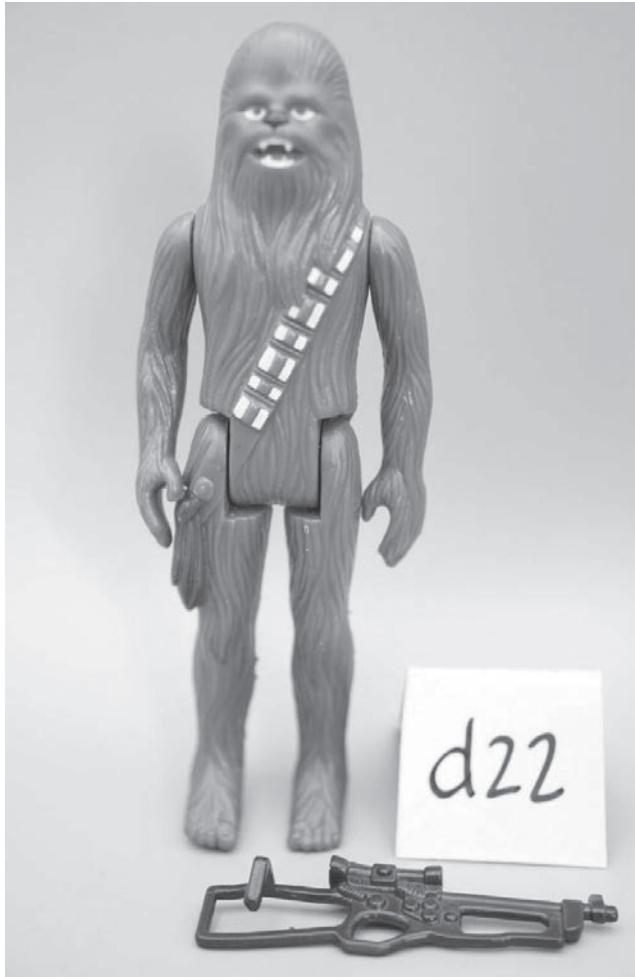
These Early Bird Certificate Packages included a display stand and stickers. Today, complete Early Bird sets are collectors' dream and are often the centerpiece in a Star Wars collection.

The original packaging box contained a diorama display stand, stickers, and a Star Wars fan club membership card. Following the first four figures, Kenner released the remaining eight action figures so the Original Collection has a total of 12 action figures in all. The remaining eight characters are Han Solo, Darth Vader, C-3PO, Obi-Wan Kenobi, a Stormtrooper, a Jawa, the Death Squad Commander (later renamed Star Destroyer Commander), and a Sand Person (Tusken Raider).

One thing that almost all Star Wars collectors agree on is this — original Kenner Star Wars action figures are expensive. Many of the original 12 sell for thousands, even tens of thousands of dollars at auction.

A Kenner prototype action figure of Boba Fett sold for \$1.342 million at auction in 2024, making it the most expensive toy ever sold at auction. Kenner released the Boba Fett action figure in 12-inch versions. Boba's accessories included a blaster, cloth cape, removable belt and backpack, and braided Wookiee scalps.

Die-hard Star Wars col-

lectors and fans each year celebrate May 4th as Star Wars Day, which is intended as a day to celebrate the entire Star Wars franchise. Celebration on this day spread quickly following the movie's release in 1977. The date, May fourth, was chosen as a pun. "May the Force be with you" is an iconic Star Wars phrase used to wish someone good luck, strength, and encouragement. Fans turned the phrase into a pun with the phrase "May the Fourth be with you," and this simple pun spread so much so that Lucasfilm and the Walt Disney Company chose May 4 as the annual day to celebrate Star Wars.

Griswold #14 skillet fried up the bidding with \$450

MIDDLEFIELD, Ohio — A recent antique and collectible auction in Middlefield conducted by Aaron Mast featured a wide variety of items.

A Griswold #14 cast-iron skillet took top honors. It featured the large block logo and had a fire ring. It sold for \$450. A #12 Griswold skillet from the same era sold for \$230.

Also selling well was a toy tractor complete with the original box took top honors at this auction. A

Farmall M tractor showed off the brilliant red color associated with Farmall. It was in great condition, and the toy bidders were present. It brought a final sale price of \$290.

A bright yellow Precision Case 580 backhoe was in great condition, and came with the original box. The box had been taped in spots, but it would still display nicely. It sold for \$140.

With the yellow tracks still covered with the factory plastic, the Precision JD 650H dozer was obviously in unplayed with condition. It made the winning bidder dig a bit deep to come up with a bid of \$135 to take this one home.

A couple of cast-iron Griswold pieces were sold. The #14 skillet had a large block logo and the heat ring. It sold for an impres-

sive \$450. A #12 skillet also had the large block logo and heat ring and reached \$230.

If you needed to call the gang in for the large dinner cooking in the skillet, use the dinner bell. The one offered at this auction was marked "USA 1" and sold for \$160. And if you needed a drink with your meal, look around for the beer barrel. The one at this

auction was from the Duquesne Brewing Company, which was easily readable as it was lettered around the top. Selling for \$210, this beer barrel still had all the straps on.

And there must always be desert. The White Mountain Jr. ice cream maker could help with that. The White Mountain Jr. ice cream churn dates back to the late 1800s. This is a much sought-after vintage item that ice cream collectors like to add to their collections. This company is the largest of its kind in the world. It started in Laconia, N.H., and became a cherished piece

of American history. The one at this auction brought a high bid of \$250.

An old electric Peerless fan had been restored and looked great. It had four blades and a cage and sold \$200. Lighting was always by oil before the homes got electricity. A beautiful brass oil lamp brought a bid of \$110. It was made by Buffalo Manufacturing and resembled an old genie lamp or a teapot.

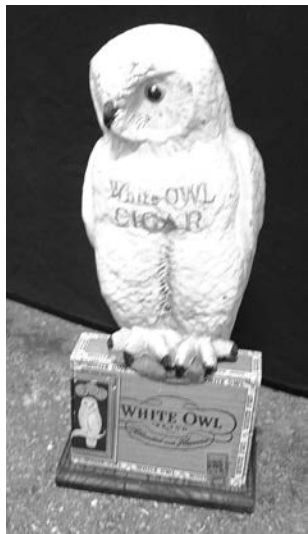

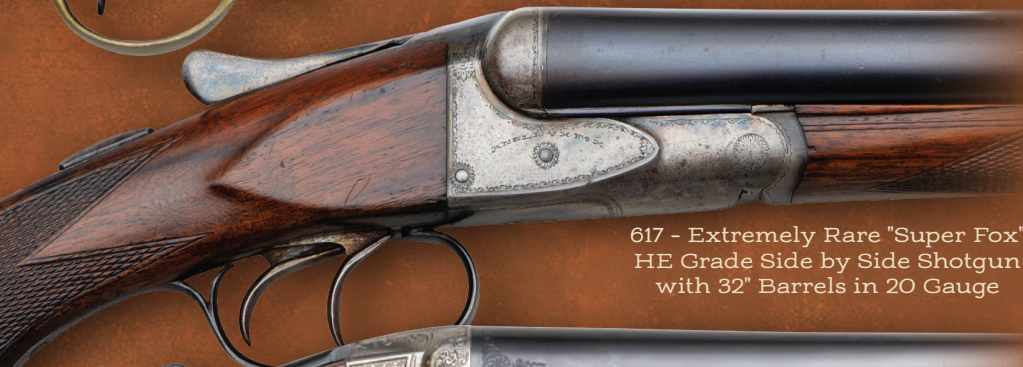

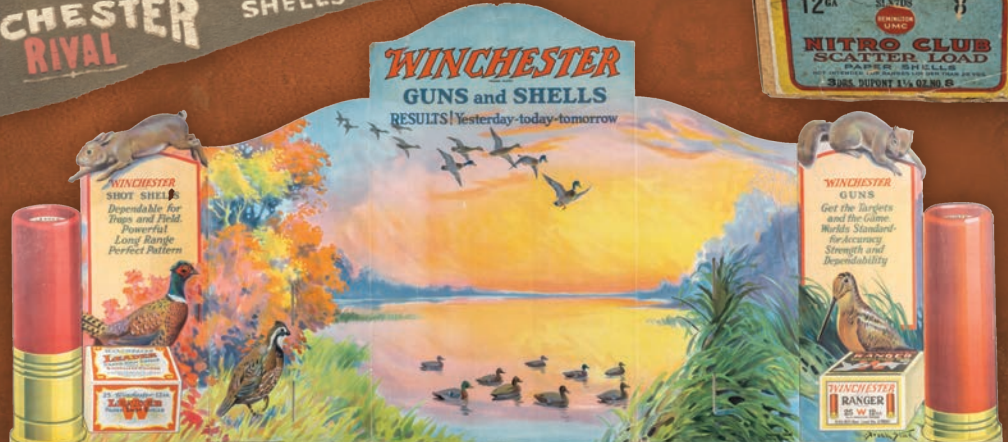
