ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Vintage glassware gleamed at Pioneer Auction

ALMA, Mich. — Collectors of vintage glassware had an exciting opportunity on April 16, when Pioneer Auction Service hosted the online-only Shantz Collectible Auction. Featuring 343 lots, the sale drew interest from

bidders eager to explore a diverse and carefully curated collection.

The Shantz family's eye for unique and charming pieces was evident throughout the sale. A wide array of glassware took center stage, with offerings ranging from sought-after Fenton and popular uranium glass to classic carnival and milk

glass. While glassware was the primary focus, the auction also featured an eclectic mix, from ceramics and traditional antiques to a few pieces of jewelry and even household goods, giving bidders a wide array of items to pursue.

Bidding was active. By far, the most represented category was Fenton, with 50 lots available in numerous colors, styles, and forms. The auction's top bid of \$140 went for a Fenton piece - a hand-painted and signed 95th anniversary edition Burmese glass ginger jar.

Other Fenton lots included a pairing of a yellow "butterflies and berries" basket alongside an amber glass basket with ruffled edges, which brought \$51. A hand-painted Fenton Burmese rose ruffled

bowl came close at \$50, as did a cranberry glass opalescent coin dot vase at \$49.

Seven lots of Wedgwood were also available. A six-piece Jasperware cobalt blue set, with a pitcher, teapot, sugar and creamer bowls, trinket box, and tray, went for \$53. Another six-piece Jasperware set in light blue - all vases and pitchers - hit \$47. A larger 14-piece Jasperware set in light blue, complete with cups, saucers, plates, a trinket jar, and a diamond-shaped bridge dish, sold for \$24.

There were five lots of Homer Laughlin/Fiestaware. Two featured popular Art Deco "disk" pitchers, one in yellow and one in blue, that got \$22 and \$21, respectively.

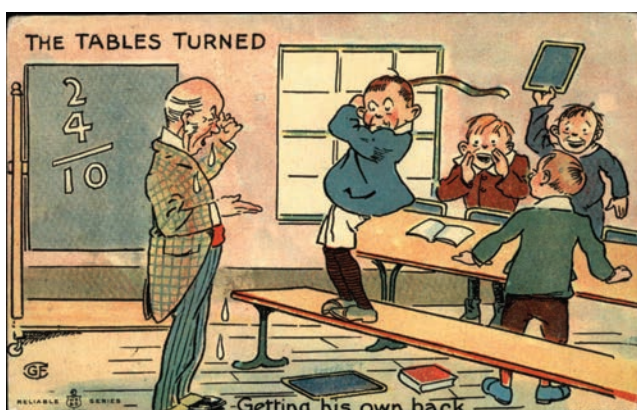
Vintage postcards could thank or prank teachers

The Tuesday during the first full week in May is National Teacher Appreciation Day. It is May 5 this year. The day is dedicated to saying "thank you" to all teachers for their time and dedication to educating our children.

National Teacher Appreciation Day is also known as National Teacher Day. The National Education Association describes National Teacher Day "as a day for honoring teachers and recognizing the lasting contributions they make to our lives."

A common sentiment is, "Every new business

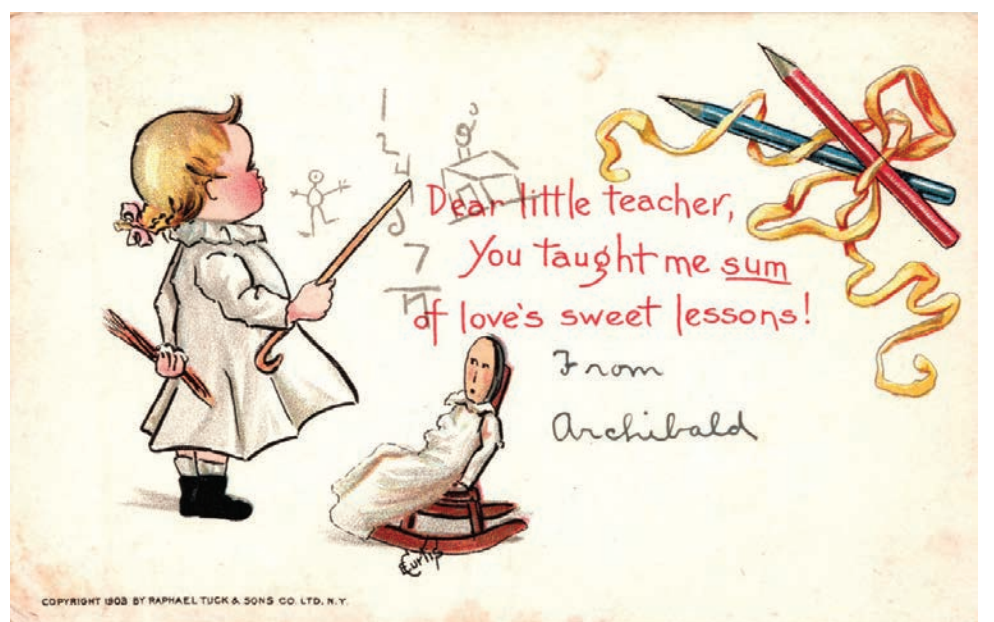


Above: This humorous postcard, showing the teacher in trouble with the students, was posted in 1908. The card is valued at \$13.

owner, doctor, engineer, or nurse can name a teacher who inspired him or her." Every one of us has at least one teacher in mind that encouraged and motivated us during our education. Take the time today to say 'Thank You' to the

exceptional teachers you know.

Discussions to honor teachers began in 1944 among both political and educational leaders. In 1953, Eleanor Roosevelt persuaded the 81st Congress to proclaim a National Teachers' Day, but it



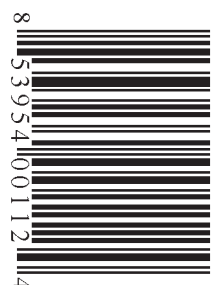

was only for that single year. It took Congress another 37 years but in 1980, Congress declared March 7, 1980,

as National Teacher Day. This day continued until 1985 when the National PTA established Teacher

Appreciation Week as the first full week in May, and National

A periwinkle blue Fiestaware teapot matched the \$22, while a set of four mixed-color plates settled at \$21.

Heisey made a single appearance with a custard glass footed jelly bowl, paired with a Northwood Intaglio glass holder. The pair hammered at \$51.

Styles proved just as plentiful as the brands. Milk glass, spanning multiple makers, stood out with 45 available pieces. Among them, a Fenton hobnail epergne landed \$38. Later, a Grapevine-pattern coffee cup and saucer service for 12 came in at \$24. At the lower end, just \$3 scored a trio of hobnail sherbet dishes.

Uranium and Vaseline glass also had a solid presence, with 10 lots presented. Leading the way, a set with a custard uranium bowl and seven matching berry bowls

climbed to \$120, the second-highest price of the sale. Then, an Imperial Glass opalescent lace-edged uranium bowl changed hands at \$32, while a uranium glass pitcher found a new home at \$26.

Opalescent glass crossed several makers, including Fenton, Imperial, and Jefferson. A Jefferson Glass green opalescent Meander pattern bowl landed at \$33. Meanwhile, a mixed grouping of two opalescent bowls and two divid-

ed dishes, unbranded, closed at \$9.

Carnival glass followed a similar pattern, with a wide spread in results. A pair of teal green Fenton carnival glass baskets reached \$22. One lucky bidder picked up a three-piece marigold grape-pattern set, with a tidbit tray, bowl, and compote for \$5.

Striking mid-century color came through in several Amberina pieces. A swung vase paired with a moon and stars bell struck \$40, followed closely by a moon and stars lidded candy dish and a handled basket at \$38. Bidding went as far as \$26 on a thumbprint pedestal dish.

The auction also held plenty of ceramics, including a McCoy "Thinking Hound" cookie jar drawing \$31, a 1950s gold-trimmed pink ceramic ice bucket that brought \$23, and a Robinson Ransbottom blue sponge-ware wash basin and

pitcher set for just \$5.

The ceramics included two dozen figurine lots. Among several Hummels was a trio bringing \$26, while another, complete with original boxes, pulled \$13. A 24-piece Christmas Village group netted \$11, and an offer of \$2 won a three-piece collection of Precious Moments figurines.

For bidders whose interests reached beyond glass and ceramics, the auction offered a handful of appealing alternatives. A U.S. Post Office lock box coin bank, complete with a few coins, left for \$24. A pair of ladies' watches - a Dufonte alongside a Jules Jurgensen, both with their original boxes - ticked in at \$21, while a Washington Cathedral bronze medal found its place at \$9.

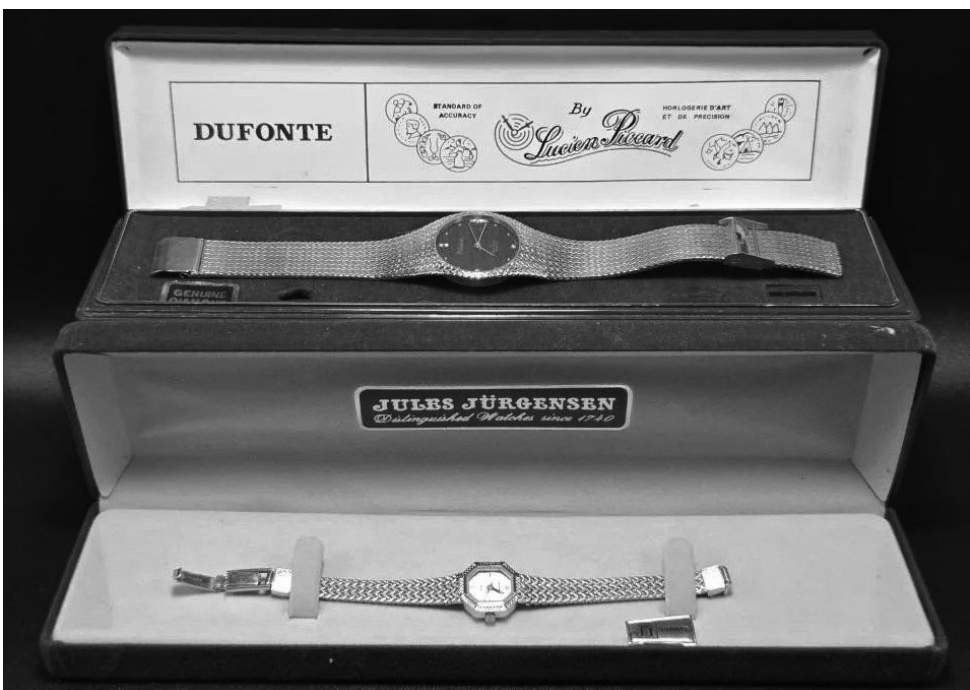

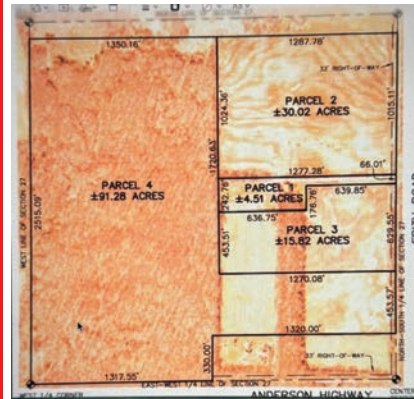

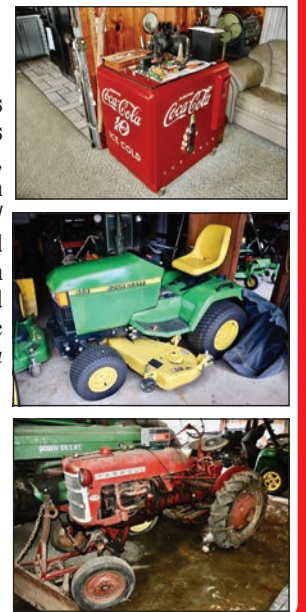

Tri-State Antique Market kicked off its 41st season

LAWRENCEBURG, Ind. — On Sunday, May 3, the Tri-State Antique Market opened its 2026 season.

With more than four decades behind it and a loyal following that spans multiple states, the Tri-State Antique Market continues to hold its place as one of the Midwest's most enduring events for antique and vintage shopping. For vintage lovers across the region, its spring opening is part of what signals the unofficial start of show season.

Held on the first Sunday of each month from May through October, the market has become a fixture for collectors, decorators, resellers, and anyone drawn to the character of older goods. Within easy driving distance of Cincinnati, Columbus, Indianapolis, and Louisville, it has earned a reputation as a true destination event. Over the course of the season, nearly 20,000 visitors are expected to browse more than 200 dealers each month, each bringing a changing mix of merchandise to every show.

One of the elements that sets Tri-State apart is its standards. Since its founding in 1986, the market has maintained a strict "old-only" policy: everything offered for sale must be at least 30 years old and out of current production. The result is a shopping experience that feels increasingly rare, especially as many shows blur the line between handmade crafts, imports, and genuine vintage goods.

Shoppers can expect a wide sweep of material culture, from 19th-century primitives and traditional antique furniture to mid-century and vintage merchandise. Dealers regularly bring everything from architectural salvage and vintage signage to glassware, jewelry, textiles, and Americana. It's the kind of place where a farmhouse table, a 1950s shell chair, and a crate of well-loved vinyl records might all turn up in the same booth.

The location adds to the market's appeal. The Lawrenceburg Fairgrounds, just off Interstate 275 along historic U.S. Route 50, sits essentially in Cincinnati's backyard and remains easily accessi-

ble from places like Columbus, Indianapolis, and Louisville. That convenience draws a broad mix of buyers, from casual weekend shoppers to seasoned pickers who arrive early, carts in hand, ready to cover ground.

The fairgrounds themselves offer a five-acre blend of open and tree-shaded fields, covered pavilions, and indoor spaces, with more than half of the vendors set up under roof, meaning the show operates rain or shine. And while it can take much of the day to see everything, it strikes a comfortable balance in scale - large enough to feel like a treasure hunt, but not so sprawling as to overwhelm. Paved walkways, modern facilities, and free parking make for an accessible visit, while food vendors throughout the grounds encourage visitors to linger.

Another quiet strength is the pricing. While there are certainly investment-level antiques to be found, the Tri-State has long been known for its approachable range. Serious buyers can uncover significant pieces, priced accordingly, while more casual shoppers often leave with decorative or unexpected finds for \$10 or less. That balance makes the market just as enjoyable for someone browsing on a modest budget as it is for a dedicated collector searching for a stand-out piece.

Taken together, these qualities continue to draw tens of thousands of visitors each year, many of whom return month after month, drawn by the constantly changing inventory and the promise of discovery.

The 2026 season runs on the first Sunday of each month through October, with the next show scheduled for June 7. Regular hours are 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. Parking is free,

with \$5 admission for adults; children under 18 are admitted free.

For those traveling in, nearby lodging options include the Hollywood Casino hotel close to the fairgrounds and the riverfront Double-Tree hotel.

Teacher Day was declared to be the Tuesday of National Teacher Week.

One way teachers were given thanks in the past was with postcards.

Following the American Industrial Revolution, roughly the late 1800s, production of postcards blossomed. Postcards became the quick and easy way for families and friends to communicate, so the

popularity of postcards rose exponentially. Teacher postcards often featured teachers in their classrooms, giving lessons to children.

Many noted postcard artists contributed to teacher postcard art, including Ellen Clapsaddle, Frances Brundage, and H. B.

Griggs (H.B.G.). Notable postcard publishers that are still collected include Tuck and Sons, International Art Company, and John Winsch.

By 1911, the heyday of the American postcard, teacher images illustrated a large variety of postcards. Humorous postcards often depicted a teacher learning as much from the students as the students learned from the teacher. Real photo cards were photo-

graphs of teachers with their students, often depicted a grade at a time, such as 5th grade students with Mrs. Riley. Real photo cards are historically accu-

rate snap shots, showing how schoolrooms even show historical desks, maps, globes, and other educational materials, making them valuable to social historians.

A quintessential humorous teacher postcard from 1910 might show a schoolroom scene featuring a teacher, most often a woman, frantically trying to control an unruly classroom of children. The postcard's illustration is often embellished with a child or two pulling a shenanigan, and the teacher is often given a humorous

name, such as Mrs. Barker. Students sent humorous teacher cards to their teachers as jokes, not as insults.

Collectors look for teacher postcards on paper trade shows, antique stores, and estate sales. Estate sales are good places to look for old postcards in general because you never know what might be tucked away in a drawer or book.

Even though National Teacher Day has been legislated by Congress, there are still some oddities when celebrating teachers. For instance, Massachusetts celebrates Teacher's Day on the first Sunday of June.

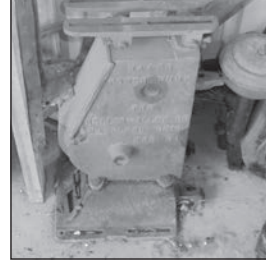
